**CHARLESTON SOUTHERN**

The Bucs defeated Coastal Carolina last week for the first time since March 25, 2006 .... Charleston Southern has earned its highest seed in the Big South Tournament since 2002, when the Bucs also took the No. 3 seed with a Conference record of 12-9 ... CSU finished the regular-season 28-28, marking the seventh time in school history it has had 25 wins or more. It is the program's first 28-win season since 2000 when the team went 31-31. It is also the best Conference record since 1996 when the Bucs went 17-4 and won the Big South. *Updated team leaders:*

**COASTAL CAROLINA**

Coastal Carolina won its fifth-straight Big South regular-season title, its sixth in seven years and 14th overall. Coastal won a Big South-record six-straight Big South regular-season titles from 1988-93. Coastal will look for its fifth-straight Big South Tournament Championship this week and 12th overall ... **ANTHONY MEO** reached 30 wins for his career, becoming the first CCU and Big South pitcher to win 30 games in the first three years of a career. Meo is fourth on the Big South career wins lists, behind CCU pitchers and four-year players **STEVEN CARTER** (42), **SCOTT STURKIE** (36) and **RANDY STOKES** (33) ... **GARY GILMORE** collected his 900th career win with a 12-3 victory over UNC Wilmington on May 17. Gilmore's career record stands at 902-423-2 overall and 646-321 in his 16th year at CCU, and his first win at Coastal was on Feb. 14, 1996 against UNCW ... **TOMMY La STELLA** was named a semifinalist for the Dick Howser Trophy, marking the second-straight year a Chant has been in such select company (joining Meo) and the third Chant in history as **MIKE COSTANZO** was one of 16 finalists in 2005 ... **SCOTT WOODWARD** needs two runs scored to become the Big South's all-time leader. *Updated team leaders (Big South leaders in bold italics):*

**GARDNER-WEBB**

Gardner-Webb reached the 30-win mark as a team for the first time since 2004, when the team finished in a tie for third in the Atlantic Sun Conference standings and won 33 games ... GWU finished the regular-season in the top-100 RPI (boydsworld.com) for the first time ever, falling in line at No. 98 on May 23 ... GWU also batted above .300 as a team for the fourth season in a row ... The team's 14-13 mark in the League is the first finish above .500 in Big South Conference play since joining in 2009. GWU has finished at least fifth in all but two seasons since moving to NCAA Division I Conference play in 2003 (A-Sun) ... Reliever **JEFF HOWELL** has been a direct part of 16 wins for Gardner-Webb this season, posting four wins, six holds and six saves. *Updated team leaders:*

**LIBERTY**

Liberty split four games to finish the 2011 regular-season ... **KEEGAN LINZA** became only the fourth pitcher in Liberty history to win 10 games after picking up the victory in Saturday's regular-season finale. The senior right-hander joins former Flames **SHAWN TEUFEL** (2010) and **LEE GUETTERMAN** (1980 and 1981) with the second-most victories in a season. **JASON JONES** holds the programs' single-season record of 11 (2002) ... Earlier in the week against VCU, **MATT WILLIAMS** tied the contest in the ninth inning with a home run and **AUSTIN TAYLOR** singled home the game-winner in the 10th inning, as the Flames defeated VCU, 8-7. The home run by Williams was his ninth home run of the year, a career-high for the shortstop, and his third game-tying or walk-off home run of the year. Meanwhile, Taylor finished the regular-season with Liberty's hottest bat. The senior hit .406 over his last nine games, raising his batting average 31 points to .265 ... **IAN PARMLEY** finished the regular-season with 25 stolen bases, the most by a Flame since **JEREMIAH BOLES** had 31 in 2004. 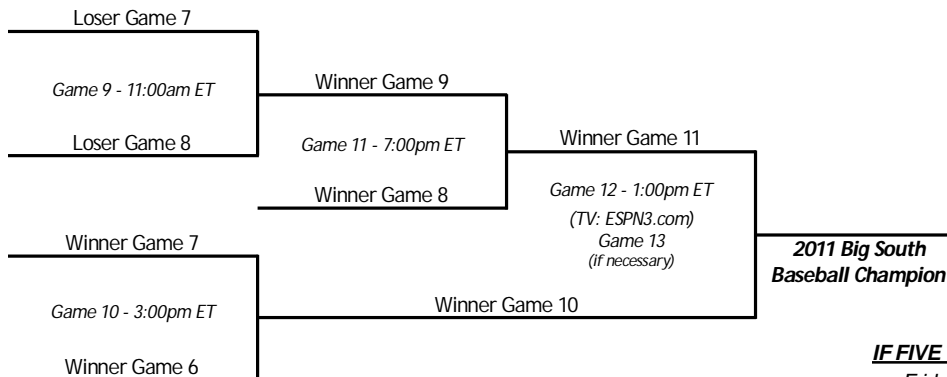

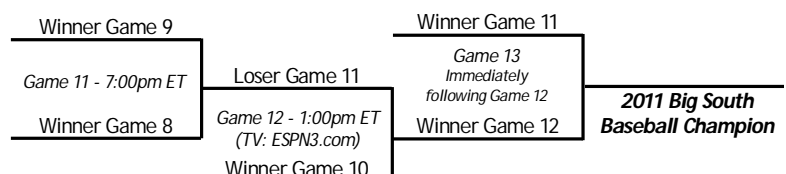
