Roberts had a sensational week at the plate, going 11-15 (=.733) in four road wins last week. He also walked six times, including four on Sunday to tie a school record, and drove in nine runs -- including a lead-off home run in game two at Charleston Southern. In addition, he swiped six bases in seven attempts and scored eight runs, including four in Saturday's 15-12 Key-det win against the Buccaneers. All told, Roberts reached base in 18 of 23 plate appearances (=.783 OBP), including 9-of-11 against Charleston Southern. Other than a sacrifice fly in the CSU opener, Roberts was retired only once by the Bucs, going 9-10 with all six of his walks. He also picked up a save in the Saturday CSU game.

Rein pitched a career-high 7.0 innings and struck out a career-high nine batters in recording a win over Gardner-Webb. He did not allow a run, did not walk a batter, and scattered six hits. Of the six hits he allowed, three were in the first inning and Jacob May threw out a runner at the plate to keep GWU off the scoreboard. From that point, Rein retired 18 of his final 22 batters as he held the Big South's top-hitting team to a .222 batting average on the day. Rein also had to get four outs in the sixth inning as Dusty Quattlebaum struck out but reached first on a wild pitch. Undaunted, Rein fanned the next batter to end the frame.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Bucs were swept in Big South play this past weekend for the first time since March 18-20 when they were swept by Liberty ... **CHARLIE MCCREADY** gave up his first run since March 13 and his first earned run since March 9. He had been leading the nation in ERA (0.24)... The Bucs beat crosstown rival College of Charleston last week for the first time since 2007 with a 4-3 win on Wednesday. **BEN QUALKINBUSH** scored the game-winning run on a CoFC error in the top of the ninth inning. Qualkinbush has entered seven games as a pinch-runner and has scored four times ... CSU's win over CoFC was its 20th of the season, assuring the Bucs of their first 20-win season since 2007 ... The Bucs had 13 hits and seven RBI when batting with two outs last week. **MATT STILL** and **DEREK SMITH** each had two RBI with two outs on the board. TOMMY La STELLA may be the hottest AND most productive player in the country. He batted .571 last week (8-14 with 7 R, 3 2B, 1 HR, 7 RBI) and is batting .487 (19-39) in the month of April. In 11 games this month, La Stella has 4 doubles, 4 HR, 14 runs scored, 21 RBI. He has an .897 slugging percentage and, with six walks and four hit-by-pitches, has a .592 on-base percentage ... **DANIEL BOWMAN** has 11 extra-base hits over his last nine games. He has a nine-game hit streak which includes five doubles, a triple and four home runs ... In April, **TAYLOR MOTTER** is batting .378 with six doubles and two home runs while going 7-7 in stolen bases ... Coastal Carolina outfielders have 12 assists between them this season with Bowman, **HAYES ORTON** and **JACOB MAY** each throwing out runners at the plate this past week. The streak is the longest of the season for Liberty ... **DOUG BREAM** continued his hot hitting, batting .500 over the three games last week. He also hit his first home run of the season in the Flames' 7-1 victory in game one of Sunday's doubleheader. Over the past two weeks, Bream has hit .645 (20-31) with 13 RBI and a 1.000 slugging percentage ... **JUSTIN RICHARDSON** had a big day with the bat Sunday. PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE

The Blue Hose are off to their best record in the Division I era despite a recent tough stretch, racking up an 18-19 record thus far ... The PC pitching staff has improved greatly since 2010, boasting a 4.43 ERA, three runs better than last year's 7.80 ERA ... Freshman **BRAD ZEBEDIS** leads the team in nearly every hitting category, including average (.417), hits (60), total bases (102), home runs (nine, tied with **TONY MICKLON**), RBI (37) slugging percentage (.708) and on-base percentage (.472) ... The PC plays three more home games over the final 19 contests of the year. The Blue Hose return for a home series against Winthrop on May 6, playing eight-straight games on the road until then. Radford swept Winthrop over the weekend for its third Big South series win in the past three weekends. It marked the first time since the series began in 1985 that the Highlanders took all three games in a set from Winthrop. Radford is 9-3 against the Eagles in regular season play since 2008 ... The series sweep was Radford's first since taking all three from Presbyterian in 2010 ... A pair of Highlanders reached milestones -- **ABRAM WILLIAMS** picked up saves at both ends of the doubleheader to earn his 9th and 10th and become RU's all-time single-season saves leader. The save was the 10th in 11 tries for Williams ... Former record holder **JASON PATTEN** earned the save in game one of the Winthrop series to bring his career total to 16, two away from matching **BRET LIEBERMAN**'s school career record ... **JOE RACCUA** earned his 100th win as the head coach at Radford University in the finale on Sunday. Raccua is 100-95 in four seasons at Radford, where he earned his degree in 1995 ... **ALEX GUERRA** batted .533 (8-15) in four games last week with 3 HR and 12 RBI, including 6-13 in the Winthrop series with five extra base hits and 10 RBI ...
