Watts batted .500 (8-16) with seven RBI in four wins last week. He also had two doubles, one home run, three walks, a .579 on-base percentage and a .812 slugging percentage. His two-run home run in game two vs. Presbyterian College gave Gardner-Webb a 2-0 lead in the first inning, while his two-run double in the first inning of game three against PC gave the Runnin' Bulldogs another early lead. Watts also had a key outfield assist in game two that prevented the Blue Hose from scoring, and he opened the series with a 3-5 day with two RBI. Watts also was 2-3 with an RBI double in Gardner-Webb's midweek win over Furman as he helped GWU go 3-0 in one-run games last week.

Their two wins in Saturday's doubleheader not only moves them to .500 overall, but 6-0 in true doubleheaders, as they went 2-0 vs. Radford and Siena as well ... With 243 career hits, **NICK CHINNERS** is just one away from tying the school's all-time record of 244 ... All three of CSU's weekend starters threw at least five innings this past weekend, with two throwing complete games. Friday starter **STEW BRASE** gave up just one earned run in 9.2 innings against Winthrop. **JESSE CADENHEAD** tied his career-high with nine strikeouts for the second time. COASTAL CAROLINA

Since March 13, Coastal Carolina has played 18 of 25 games on the road, going 15-10 over the span. After playing at UNC Wilmington Tuesday, Coastal will play 10 of its final 13 regular-season games at home ... The Chants will not play another mid-week, non-Conference game until May 17 when the Chants host UNCW ... **SCOTT WOODWARD** is riding an 11-game hit streak and has a hit in 16 of his last 17 games. He has led off each of the last four games with a hit. Over the 11-game hit streak, he is batting .452 (19-42) with 16 runs scored, 13 RBI and eight walks ... Meanwhile, Woodward continues to climb the CCU and Big South record books. He became the CCU career leader in runs scored and moved to 2nd in the Big South (237, 10 shy of League record); he ranks 2nd on CCU and Big South career stolen bases list (151, nine shy of the record); he moved to 2nd on the CCU and Big South career walks list (166, 13 shy of the record); and he is the CCU and Big South all-time leader, as well as NCAA active leader, in hit by pitches (77) ... **DANIEL BOWMAN** is riding a career-best 14-game hit streak. During the streak he has 13 extra-base hits and is batting .362 (21-58) with 22 RBI, seven doubles, one triple and five home runs.
