Tomasovich batted .667 (10-15) with five runs scored, four RBI, four walks, two triples and two stolen bases in helping Charleston Southern to a 3-1 record last week. He opened his week with a 5-5 effort at Georgia Southern, which included a triple, stolen base and a sacrifice. He followed that with a .500 clip in the Buccaneers' three-game sweep of High Point. Tomasovich posted a sacrifice fly, two walks and a steal in the opener, and followed with two walks and a triple in game two. He concluded the series with four hits, two RBI, two runs scored and a double in Sunday's victory that pushed CSU into a tie for third-place in the Big South standings. Tomasovich finished the week with a .700 on-base percentage and a 1.000 slugging percentage.

Meo was masterful against Radford, which entered the week as the League's second-best hitting team. Meo struck out a career-high 12 batters with no walks in eight innings and held the Highlanders to just three hits in earning his seventh win of the season. He struck out the side in the first inning and retired the first nine batters he faced -- five by strikeout. After allowing a leadoff single in the fourth, Meo promptly struck out the side and once again retired the next nine hitters -- fanning five in that span. After allowing his second hit, a leadoff single in the seventh, Meo retired six of the next seven hitters to end his day.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

NICK CHINNERS became Charleston Southern's all-time hits leader with 245 this past Friday at High Point ... **TOM BURKETT** hit his second home run of the season on Sunday vs. HPU. It was also the Bucs' second grand slam of the season. Burkett is third in CSU history with 23 career home runs ... **DEREK SMITH** also homered last week (at Georgia Southern) and is now second in CSU history with 30 career homers ... CSU is 33-of-96 (=.344) with runners on base in the last four games. The Bucs also went 65-of-113 (=.575) to successfully advance runners and were 11-of-14 (=.786) with runners on third in that same span ... CSU set a season high with 47 at bats at Georgia Southern ... The Bucs have reached 25 overall wins and 12 Big South wins for the first time since 2002. *Updated team leaders:*

COASTAL CAROLINA

For the first time in school and Big South Conference history, Coastal Carolina has thrown four-straight shutouts and have a 37-inning consecutive scoreless streak spanning five games (Coastal did not allow a run in the ninth of the second VMI game, shutout VMI in game three and shutout Radford in three games this weekend). The last time Coastal had as many as three shutouts in a row was April 1980, beating Morris (19-0 on April 15), Allen (7-0 on April 17) and Winthrop (2-0 on April 19) ... The Chants have six pitchers with an ERA below 2.50 and nine pitchers with an opponent batting average below .250 ... Coastal Carolina won its 21st consecutive home Conference series, ranking as the second-best such streak in the NCAA. Coastal has not lost at home in a Conference series since April 14-15, 2006 when Birmingham-Southern took two-of-three from the Chants ... Over the last six games, Coastal has a team batting average of .324 and a 0.50 ERA, while holding opponents to just a .167 batting average with 50 strikeouts (vs. 11 walks) in 54 IP ... Head coach **GARY GILMORE** is two wins shy of 900 for his career ... **SCOTT WOODWARD** needs six runs scored to become the Big South's all-time leader ... **DANIEL BOWMAN** has 39 career home runs and 154 RBI for his career. He ranks fourth on the CCU career home runs list and needs two more to enter the Big South all-time top 10. His 154 career RBI is tied for sixth on the CCU career list with **ADAM RICE** (2008-10) ... **ANTHONY MEO** is tied with former Winthrop pitcher and current Minnesota Twins hurler **KEVIN SLOWEY** for fourth in Big South history with 29 career wins. *Updated team leaders (Big South leaders in bold italics):*
