CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Buccaneers capped one of the most successful seasons in school history with a return to the Big South Tournament ... The No. 3-seeded Bucs -- their highest since 2002, earned their first Tournament win since that same season with a 9-3 win over No. 4 Winthrop ... CSU reached 29 wins for the first time since the 2000 season, when the Bucs took second in the Conference at 31-31-1. It is just the fourth time in school history they have won at least 29 games in a campaign The Bucs' 14 Big South wins is also the most since 2002 (14-9) ... Head coach **STUART LAKE** became the third coach in CSU history to earn Big South Baseball Coach of the Year honors ... **NICK CHINNERS** became the school's all-time hits leader on May 8 vs. High Point and departs CSU with 255 career hits ... The Bucs set new program records for at bats in a season with 2,049 as well as hits with 611 ... The bullpen recorded 16 saves, which broke the old school record of 11. *Final team leaders:*

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina had five players selected in the 2011 MLB First-Year Player Draft ... Coastal's season ended in the NCAA Regional. The Chanticleers defeated eventual Super Regional participant UConn in the first game, 13-1, before falling to host Clemson and to the Huskies. Coastal Carolina has won a game in the NCAA Regionals in six consecutive appearances, and is 13-9 in the NCAA Regionals since 2005, having advance to two Super Regionals ... Coastal Carolina won an unprecedented fifth-straight Big South Tournament Championship, going through the event undefeated for a second-straight year. Coastal won its 12th Big South Tournament title overall. Coastal Carolina also won its fifth-straight Big South regular-season title, its sixth in seven years and 14th overall ... Coastal Carolina won at least 40 games for the 12th time in **GARY GILMORE's** 16 years at the helm. The Chants have done so in each of the last five years and 12 of the last 14 ... **TOMMY La STELLA** was named a consensus All-American in 2011. He finished as the Big South's leader in home runs and RBI, the first player since 2009 to lead the Conference in both categories ... **ANTHONY MEO** threw the first no-hitter in Big South Tournament history as the Chanticleers defeated Radford, 5-0, in CCU's opening game of the Conference postseason ... **SCOTT WOODWARD** ends his career as the Big South's all-time leader in runs scored with 251. *Final team leaders (Big South leaders in bold italics):*

GARDNER-WEBB
