However, the Flames rebounded to take the final two games of the series and are 9-1 over their last 10 games ... LHP **STEVEN EVANS** pitched his second complete game in as many outings and third of the year in a 6-4 victory Saturday. The win was the 25th of his Liberty career, moving him into second on the school's list. In addition, he also moves into third on school's career innings pitched list with 310.1 ... DH **JUSTIN SIZEMORE** hit a two-run home run in the fifth inning to give the Flames the lead in the contest ... Sunday, RHP **KEEGAN LINZA** recorded his Big South-leading ninth victory of the year in a 3-2 win. 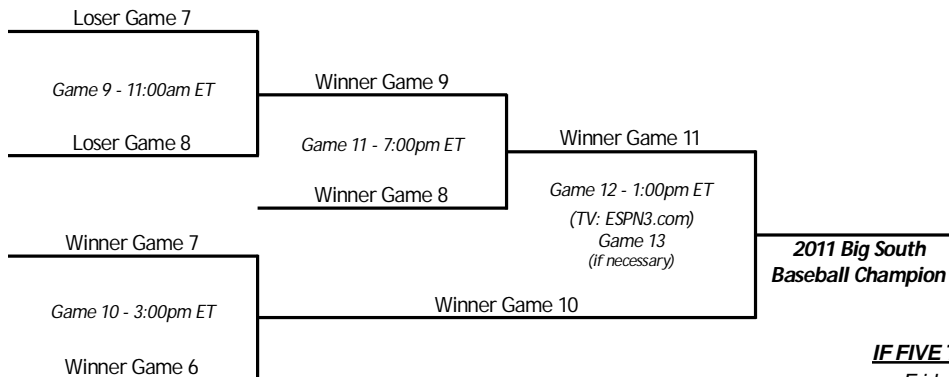

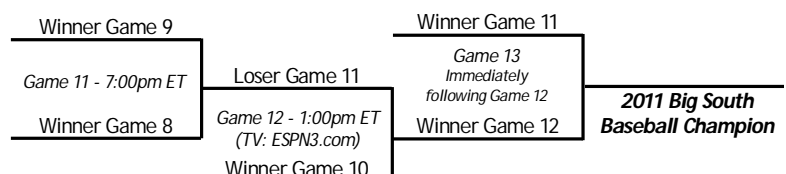
