McFarland batted .462 (6-13) with a League-best nine runs batted in during his three appearances. He had three multi-RBI games, two multi-hit games and collected three doubles. McFarland had a two-run double in the season opener on Friday vs. Towson, then went 3-5 with a pair of two-run doubles in helping Gardner-Webb defeat the Tigers on Saturday. Against The Citadel on Sunday, McFarland roped a two-run single in the first inning, and later singled to lead off a decisive eighth inning where he would eventually score the winning run. For the week, McFarland slugged .692 and had an on-base percentage of .500.

**NICK CHINNERS** is just two doubles away from moving into 4th-place all-time for career doubles. He currently has 39.

**COASTAL CAROLINA**

Coastal Carolina's 2-1 loss to Indiana in 16 innings marked the longest game on record for Coastal Carolina. The previous record was 15 innings on two occasions ... Coastal Carolina's crowd of 1,373 for its opener set a school record for a regular-season game at Watson Stadium ... Coastal Carolina used walk-off home runs to win games one and four of the weekend. On Friday, Coastal entered the ninth, down one. The Chants scored once to tie the game versus Boston College then, with two on and one out, senior **HAYES ORTON** blasted a game-winning home run for the 9-6 decision. Orton, a junior college transfer, only had 18 at bats for CCU in 2010 but has won the starting left field spot this season ... On Sunday, after allowing the go-ahead run in the top of the ninth, Coastal was down to its last out Sunday when freshman **T.J. McALLISTER**, making his collegiate debut, drew his fourth walk of the game. Pinch hitter and fellow freshman **TRIPP MARTIN** sent the first pitch over the left field wall for the 6-5 win over Virginia Tech ... Coastal's starting pitchers combined to pitch 22.2 innings, allow eight earned runs, 19 hits and seven walks while striking out 24 during the opening weekend.

**GARDNER-WEBB**

Gardner-Webb picked up a pair of wins over defending Southern Conference Champion The Citadel over the weekend, posting the best record in the three-team round-robin Citadel Memorial Challenge presented by Charleston Crab House ... GWU went 3-1 in the event, followed by Towson (2-2) and host The Citadel (1-3) ... The Runnin' Bulldogs held a 5-0 lead in its opening day loss to Towson, before three errors doomed a strong start ... The 'Dogs swiped eight bases in four games, paced by **ZEKE BLANTON** (3-for-4) ... The 'Dogs batted .324 as a team for the weekend and had at least a five-run lead in all but one of the games ... The team's 3-1 start is its best since doing the same with a veteran club in 2009 ... Gardner-Webb will open brand new John Henry Moss Stadium on Tuesday, Feb. 22, at 4:00pm vs. Appalachian State.

**HIGH POINT**

HPU opened the season with a four-game series at Troy, dropping all four games. High Point scored in the first inning of every game ... Senior **STEVE ANTOLIK** hit .615 in the series (8-15) with three walks and four RBI. He registered a hit in the first inning of every game during the weekend, including RBI doubles in the first two. Antolik also hit his first home run of the season ... Sophomore **ZACH TESSIER** had a breakout weekend, going 3-7 with a walk and two hit by pitches ... Freshman **JOHN MALONEY** made his collegiate debut on the mound, retiring Troy's top three hitters on eight pitches with two strikeouts ... High Point will host Elon Tuesday at 4:00pm in the home opener.

**LIBERTY**

Shortstop Matt Williams had at least one hit in all four games in their season-opening series at Mercer. The junior collected eight hits in 15 at bats (.533) in the series ... Outfielder Doug Bream and catcher Casey Rasmus also had a hit in each game of the series also ... OF/DH Ian Parmley had four hits in his debut in a Liberty uniform Friday ... Newcomer Garrett Baker made three relief appearances during the weekend and picked up the win in Liberty's victory on Sunday ... Josh Richardson pitched 2 2/3 scoreless innings, giving up one hit to record his first save of 2011. The sophomore had six saves as a freshman last season.

**PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE**

PC is 3-0 to start the season for the first time in Division I history and first time since the 1999 season ... Two players hit over .500 for the weekend and three others were over .400, including **GABE GRAMMER** -- who was 5-14 with six RBI and a grand slam in the opening game.

**RADFORD**

Radford opened its season with a victory over Army, the Highlanders' first opening day win since 2000 and just the second since 1995 ... Radford owns seven opening day wins, all-time ... 2009 Big South Freshman of the Year **JEFF KEMP** smacked a home run in his first at-bat since early 2010, a two-out first inning solo blast against Army on Friday. Kemp went 4-for-8 in his first two games with two homers and six RBIs. Kemp hit the second grand slam of his career on Saturday night against Army ... Kemp received a medical redshirt after playing in just six games last season ... 2010 All-Big South First-Team selection **MATT HILLSINGER** had the most consistent weekend, going 8-13 (.615), including 4-5 against Davidson on Sunday ... The 18 Radford runs against Army on Saturday night were the most since RU's 18-17 series finale win over High Point on April 18, 2010 ... RHP **EDDIE BUTLER** allowed a first inning run against Army on Friday, but carried a no-hit bid into the sixth inning (5.1 hitless innings). Butler set down 11-straight at one point, and struck out five in a row over the fourth and fifth innings ... **BOBBY BOLLING** struck out a career-high nine hitters in his no-decision against Davidson ... **MARK PETERSON** made his Radford debut, allowing one run on three hits while fanning five over five innings in his no-decision Saturday night against Army ... Radford travels to Auburn this weekend, continuing a 12-game road trip to open the season.

**UNC ASHEVILLE**

The Bulldogs are 3-0 for the first time since the 1993 season ... Asheville swept Murray State to open the campaign and rallied from an early 6-1 deficit to win 7-6 in Sunday's finale ... **GRANT GAJDOSZ** went 7-11 with three multi-hit games, and recorded a .714 on-base percentage and .909 slugging percentage.

**VMI**

The Keydets dropped their first three games of the season at No. 10 Florida State, falling to 0-17 all-time against the Seminoles ... VMI will return to action Tuesday, taking on William & Mary in the Keydet home opener at Gray-Minor Stadium.

**WINTHROP**

Winthrop posted a 1-2 record in its 2011 opening weekend against the San Diego State Aztecs and San Diego Toreros ... The Eagles opened the season with a 14-9 win against the Aztecs -- the first head coaching victory for new Eagles skipper **TOM RIGINOS**, before dropping two straight contests 7-5 to San Diego and 6-1 to San Diego State ... Redshirt-junior DH/1B **BRETT THOMAS** opened his career at Winthrop on a hot note as he went 3-4 with 5 RBI, including a first inning three-run double, in the opener against the Aztecs ... Senior catcher **EDDIE ROHAN** followed the performance by Thomas with 4 RBI, while sophomore 1B/DH **MATT LOBACZ** and redshirt-junior outfielder **SEAN SULLIVAN** drove in one run each ... In his first career appearance as an Eagle, sophomore **MITCHELL KNOX** earned the victory on the mound against San Diego State ... Against the 28th-ranked Toreros, Sullivan and redshirt-junior outfielder **CAM WALTERS** led Winthrop with two RBI apiece, and sophomore outfielder **MAX VOGEL** added one RBI ... Senior pitcher **ROBERT LAKE** allowed only two runs in 6.0 innings pitched against San Diego and allowed no walks ... In the weekend finale against the Aztecs, senior second baseman **TYLER COOK** drove in his first run of the season ... Freshman outfielder **TJ OLESCZUK** also picked up his first career hit as an Eagle against San Diego State ... Winthrop will open its home season this weekend (Feb. 25-27) hosting the 2011 Johnny Gill Memorial. The Eagles will face the Wagner Seahawks and Kent State Golden Flashes in the tournament.
