Antolik batted .467 (7-15) with six runs scored, four RBI and three doubles in helping High Point to a perfect 4-0 record last week. He accounted for 10 of the Panthers' 23 runs last week and had hits in every game, including two multi-hit contests. Antolik opened the week with an RBI-double in HPU's win at Duke, and in the opening game of a three-game series with Dayton, he went 3-3 with three runs and came up with a two-run double in the eighth inning to break a 3-3 tie that put the Panthers on top. In the first game of a Saturday doubleheader with the Flyers, Antolik was hit by pitch and scored the game-winning run in the eighth to break a 1-1 tie. He finished the week with a .529 OBA and .667 slugging percentage.

Conway was dominant in a win at No. 18 College of Charleston. He struck out a career-high 12 batters in just 5.2 innings pitched, allowing four hits, two runs (both solo home runs) and two walks. After giving up a one-out, solo home run in the third inning, Conway struck out the next seven batters he faced, including striking out the side in the fourth. Overall, he sat down 10-straight Cougars - nine by strikeout, before having his streak ended with another solo home run. Conway struck out eight of the nine CofC hitters at least once. Conway's line last week: 1-0, 5.2 IP, 4 H, 2 R/ER, 2 BB, 12 SO, 3.18 ERA.

**CHARLESTON SOUTHERN**

The Bucs are off to the best start since the 2000 season at 7-4 ... **NICK CHINNERS** is one double short of entering the school record books (41 doubles would put him in a tie for 4th place all-time) ... CSU put up 10 runs in the sixth inning of Saturday's game one against Siena. The last time the Bucs had a 10-run inning was Feb. 20, 2007, when they put up 10 runs in the second inning vs. College of Charleston. It is just the second time in 11 seasons that Charleston Southern has put up a double-digit inning.

**COASTAL CAROLINA**

**JOSH CONWAY** set the stage for an impressive pitching week for the Chanticleers. First, starters Conway, **ANTHONY MEO** and **ANTHONY del PINO** each picked up wins. In 15.2 innings, they combined to allow just nine hits and five runs (four earned) and six walks with 24 strikeouts ... The relief pitchers were equally as dominant. At No. 18 College of Charleston, **MATT REIN** worked the final 3.0 innings and allowed just one hit (solo home run) and struck out two to earn his first save of the season ... Versus Ball State and Marshall, six pitchers (**KEITH HESSLER**, **AARON BURKE**, **JIMMY COUGHLIN** vs. BSU, and **RYAN CONNOLLY**, Rein and **JORDAN COONS** vs. Marshall) did not allow a hit or a run in eight total innings. They only walked four and struck out eight ... For the week as a staff, CCU pitched 27.0 innings and allowed 10 hits, six runs (five earned) with 10 walks and 34 Ks for a 1.67 ERA and .111 opponent batting average ... Junior **DANIEL BOWMAN** tied a career-high by hitting two home runs at College of Charleston. He now has 30 career homers to move to eighth on the CCU career list ... **SCOTT WOODWARD** moved into the Coastal Carolina top 20 last week with his 200th career hit. Already ranking second on the CCU all-time list in runs scored, his 206 runs is just 26 away from the CCU career mark. He is second on the CCU career list with 146 career walks and just 33 away from the school record, while his 137 career stolen bases are just 23 away from the school's all-time mark.

**GARDNER-WEBB**

Gardner-Webb is off to its best start since the 2003 season, when it also bolted to a 7-3 start ... The Runnin' Bulldogs currently rank first in the League currently in batting and fifth in team ERA ... The 7-3 ledger is the top mark among Big South Conference members so far in 2011 ... Reliever **JEFF HOWELL** has continued to shine for GWU, hurling 7.0 scoreless innings and fanning 12 batters with no walks in five appearances so far ... Starter **CONNER SCARBOROUGH** has gone 2-0 with a 1.50 ERA in his two starts this season, picking up wins over Towson and Butler ... Gardner-Webb will host preseason top-25 member St. John's for a three-game series in Boiling Springs beginning Friday, March 11 at 6:00 pm ... The game will be the first home night game in Gardner-Webb baseball history.

**HIGH POINT**

HPU extended its winning streak to seven games with a win over Duke and the weekend sweep of Dayton. It ties the program record for longest win streak of seven games, set last season ... The Panthers pitching was dominant last week, allowing no more than three runs in any of the four wins. The team ERA for the week was 1.75 ... The Panthers starting rotation of **CODY ALLEN**, **JARED AVIDON** and **MIKE CALDWELL** went at least seven innings each, allowing exactly one earned run each with a total of 19 strikeouts ... Sophomore **RYAN RETZ** earned his first career save in the final game against Dayton ... Senior **STEVE ANTOLIK** has a six-game hit streak.

**LIBERTY**

With its 12-2 victory over Binghamton last Friday, Liberty is now 28-5 in home openers at Worthington Stadium. In the victory, the Flames pounded out a season-high 20 hits ... RHP **KEEGAN LINZA** ran his record to 2-0 in Friday's contest. The senior has not been handed a loss since joining the Liberty roster last season (10-0). The senior scattered eight hits, allowing one run over eight innings, Friday ... Catcher **CASEY RASMUS** hit .500 (7-14) during the week. The junior has had at least one hit in every Liberty game this season ... 1B/DH **JUSTIN SIZEMORE** also had a strong week. The sophomore collected five hits, including his first home run of the season during the week ... INF **AUSTIN TAYLOR** drove in seven runs this week. The senior drove in a team-high seven runs last week, with four hits. Two of the four were Taylor's first two home runs of the season.

**PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE**

PC rebounded from a six-game losing streak to take the final two games from VCU to claim the series win ... The team's 6-6 record is still the best start for the Blue Hose in its NCAA Division I history.

**RADFORD**

After dropping its Tuesday game at James Madison, Radford scored three straight wins over the weekend at the Wake Forest Invitational ... After rolling with seven runs over the eighth and ninth innings in a 12-3 win over Towson on Friday, the Highlanders had to rally for back-to-back 5-4 wins over Fordham and Wake on Saturday and Sunday ... Radford trailed 3-2 in the bottom of the eighth against Fordham, when the 7-8-9 batters -- **CORY COOK**, **DANIEL WRIGHT** and **ZACH COSTELLO**, strung together three two-out hits, capped off by Costello's two-run shot to give the Highlanders the lead for good. Costello, a transfer from Delaware, hit the first homer of his career on Saturday ... In Sunday night's game, Radford used three ninth-inning runs while **JASON PATTEN** worked out of a bases-loaded, no out jam in the bottom of the ninth to beat Wake Forest, 5-4. After Wake loaded the bases, Patten struck out the next two men before inducing a fly out to end the game. The win was Patten's second of the season ... **CORY TURNER** extended a seven-game hitting streak last week, going 6-for-13 in the four games. Turner is 12 for his last 23 ... **JEFF KEMP** hit first-inning homers on Friday and Saturday -- three of his four homers this season are first-inning swats ... The Highlanders wrap up their season-long 12-game road trip at N.C. State before opening a seven-game homestand on Friday against Hartford.

**UNC ASHEVILLE**

UNC Asheville went 0-3 last week with losses to ETSU and Charlotte ... The Bulldogs dropped a midweek game with the Buccaneers at home, 13-5, after allowing an eight-run eighth inning before dropping a pair of games to Charlotte, 3-2 and 6-5, on Friday and Saturday. The third game of the series with the 49ers was canceled due to inclement weather on Sunday ... Asheville is now 4-6 overall, 3-1 at home and 1-5 on the road ... After starting the season 4-0, the Bulldogs have dropped six consecutive contests ... Asheville is currently fourth in the Conference in team batting and ninth in team pitching ... Junior first baseman **GRANT GAJDOSZ** is currently tied for second in the League in doubles with four on the season, while catcher **IAN GRAHAM** is fourth in the Conference in on-base percentage.

**VMI**

The Keydets went 2-1-1 last week, winning two of three from Bucknell and posting a tie versus Richmond ... the tie was the program's first since March 10, 1987, when VMI tied Florida Tech in a road matchiup, and is believed to be just the third in program history, joining a 1964 game with Mercer ... **SAM ROBERTS** saw his eight-game hitting streak snapped in game two versus Bucknell. During the run, he was 17-31 for a .548 batting average ... In the Bucknell series, the Keydets took two of three, including a doubleheader split on Saturday. The second of those games marked Coach **MARLIN IKENBERRY**'s 200th career victory, the most of any athletics coach in VMI history and the fifth-most in Big South baseball annals ... Roberts hit .417 last week despite having his hitting streak snapped, while **GEORGE PICCIRILLI** batted .400 (6-15) including his second career home run, which turned out to be a game-winner in the opener against Bucknell.

**WINTHROP**

Winthrop went 3-0 this past weekend after defeating the Notre Dame Fighting Irish in two games and the Manhattan Jaspers in one during the 2011 Coca-Cola Classic. The Eagles snapped their three-game losing streak with the 4-2 win over the Fighting Irish on March 4. It was the first time Winthrop had defeated both Notre Dame and the Jaspers in school history ... Junior pitcher **TYLER MIZENKO** pitched a career-high 8.0 innings against the Fighting Irish in the squad's Coca-Cola opener and surrendered just two runs on five hits, one walk and two strikeouts. It is the second consecutive start that Mizenko has set a career-best in innings pitched ... Sophomore pitcher **TOMMY LAWRENCE** earned his first save of the season in the victory against Notre Dame, and then earned his second save in as many days on March 5 in a 7-2 win over the Fighting Irish ... In the Friday nightcap against Manhattan, sophomore **ERIC RUTH** earned his first win of the season, hurling 3.0 scoreless innings of relief giving up no hits, two walks and two strikeouts as the Eagles defeated Manhattan, 10-3. The 10 runs scored by the Eagles was the second-highest run total of the season as they drove in 14 runs in the season opener at San Diego State on Feb. 18 ... Senior pitcher **MATTEO D'ANGELO** earned his first victory on the mound this season in Winthrop's 7-2 win over the Fighting Irish on Saturday, March 5 ... Sophomore outfielder **PATRICK GAMBLIN** recorded his first home run of the year, and the Eagles first of the season, with his two-run homer to left field in the seventh inning ... Freshman **LEIGHTON DANIELS** made his first career start against Notre Dame on March 5 at second base, and earned his first collegiate base hit in his first at-bat of the game. Daniels concluded the game with two hits in three at-bats ... Winthrop will host its final tournament of the 2011 regular season with the Bojangles Baseball Classic beginning on Friday, March 11. The three-day event will consist of the Eagles, Michigan and Stony Brook.
