Gliebe batted .533 (8-15) with six runs scored, seven RBI, one triple and two home runs in four wins last week. He started his week with a 2-3 performance against Furman and scored twice, walked twice and stole two bases against the Paladins. Gliebe then batted .500 (6-12) in Winthrop's three-game sweep at High Point. He singled and stole a base in the series opener, then went 3-4 with two three-run home runs on Saturday. Both of his long balls gave Winthrop the lead. Gliebe wrapped up his weekend with a 2-4 day on Sunday, including an RBI-triple.

Bowman batted .455 (5-11) in Coastal's three-game sweep of Liberty. All five hits went for extra bases (two doubles, one triple, two home runs) and he drove in nine runs -- including a career-high six in Friday's opener. Bowman went 2-4 in game one, which included a three-run home run and a two-run double. On Saturday, Bowman hit a solo home run in the sixth inning that tied the game at 4-4, and delivered a game-winning sacrifice fly. On Sunday, Bowman went 2-3 with a triple and RBI-double, and scored the game-tying run.

Through games of March 27, the Buccaneers ranked third in the nation with 40 sacrifice bunts. They were also 57th in batting average (.299) and 45th in hits (250) ... Pitcher **CHARLIE McCREADY** was tied for the nation's best ERA at 0.36 ... **JAREN SUSTAR** was 3rd in sac bunts per game (0.46) and 2nd in total sac bunts (11) ... **BRANTLEY MEIER**, who leads the team with 12 multiple-hits games, was ranked the 18th-toughest player to strike out ... **DEREK SMITH** ranked 20th in the nation in home runs (6) and 34th in HR per game (0.25). COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal won two, one-run games against Liberty after dropping two one-run games at UNC Asheville the previous week. The Chants have now played in 11 one-run games this season, going 5-6 in such games ... Coastal Carolina extended its win streak over Liberty to 12 with a weekend sweep ... The Chanticleers have won 33 consecutive home Big South games, a streak that began April 18, 2008 ... Coastal Carolina, batting just .240 for the year, batted .340 for the weekend and held Liberty to just a .215 batting average ... In the midweek, Coastal played an exhibition against the defending American League Champion Texas Rangers. The Chants trailed just 2-1 through six innings before mass substitutions, including Texas pitchers pitching to their own players (score ended up 6-2). CCU pitchers MATT REIN, KEITH HESSLER and MATT LANEY worked the first three innings and retired all nine Rangers in order ... SCOTT WOODWARD had an outstanding week, batting .455 (5-11) with a team-best five runs scored, two doubles and two stolen bases ... TOMMY LA STELLA, who got the first hit of the game in the exhibition with the Rangers, went 4-10 with a two-run home run in the Liberty series ... TAYLOR MOTTER, who had an RBI single in the Rangers' exhibition, went 4-11 (.364) with a double and two home runs vs. the Flames ... Rein, who started in the Rangers exhibition and sat down the first three batters 1-2-3, pitched the final six innings in game two vs. Liberty and scattered five hits with no runs and no walks with four strikeouts to earn the win ... Laney, who also worked a 1-2-3 inning versus the Rangers, won game three vs. the Flames and faced the minimum nine batters over the final three innings with no walks and six strikeouts ... K.J. PC is off to its best record in the Division I era and set the school win record in Division I with its 4-0 win over Wofford on March 30 -- the squad's 16th victory of the year. The record now stands at 17 ... The Blue Hose are 4-2 in non-conference games against South Carolina opponents this year. The team has seven more such games this season ... The Highlanders have wins in seven of the last nine meetings with the Blue Hose ... Radford also picked up its first win over neighboring Virginia Tech since the 2004 season, a 7-5 win over the Hokies last Tuesday night in Blacksburg ... MATT HILLSINGER and MATT MACK highlighted the week with offensive consistency, extending hitting streaks with multi-hit efforts in three of the four games last week. Hillsinger's streak is at a teambest 11 games while Mack is at 10. Mack went .625 (10-16) with a four-hit game in the PC opener, while Hillsinger went .556 (10-18) with four hits in the Virginia Tech win ...
