ADAM GLIEBE • SS Sr. • Winthrop St. Louis, Mo.

Gliebe batted .533 (8-15) with six runs scored, seven RBI, one triple and two home runs in four wins last week. He started his week with a 2-3 performance against Furman and scored twice, walked twice and stole two bases against the Paladins. Gliebe then batted .500 (6-12) in Winthrop's three-game sweep at High Point. He singled and stole a base in the series opener, then went 3-4 with two three-run home runs on Saturday. Both of his long balls gave Winthrop the lead. Gliebe wrapped up his weekend with a 2-4 day on Sunday, including an RBI-triple.

DANIEL BOWMAN • RF Jr. • Coastal Carolina Bridgewater, Va.

Bowman batted .455 (5-11) in Coastal's three-game sweep of Liberty. All five hits went for extra bases (two doubles, one triple, two home runs) and he drove in nine runs -- including a career-high six in Friday's opener. Bowman went 2-4 in game one, which included a three-run home run and a two-run double. On Saturday, Bowman hit a solo home run in the sixth inning that tied the game at 4-4, and delivered a game-winning sacrifice fly. On Sunday, Bowman went 2-3 with a triple and RBI-double, and scored the game-tying run.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal won two, one-run games against Liberty after dropping two one-run games at UNC Asheville the previous week. The Chants have now played in 11 one-run games this season, going 5-6 in such games ... Coastal Carolina extended its win streak over Liberty to 12 with a weekend sweep ... The Chanticleers have won 33 consecutive home Big South games, a streak that began April 18, 2008 ... Coastal Carolina, batting just .240 for the year, batted .340 for the weekend and held Liberty to just a .215 batting average ... In the midweek, Coastal played an exhibition against the defending American League Champion Texas Rangers. The Chants trailed just 2-1 through six innings before mass substitutions, including Texas pitchers pitching to their own players (score ended up 6-2). CCU pitchers **MATT REIN**, **KEITH HESSLER** and **MATT LANEY** worked the first three innings and retired all nine Rangers in order ... **SCOTT WOODWARD** had an outstanding week, batting .455 (5-11) with a team-best five runs scored, two doubles and two stolen bases ... **TOMMY LA STELLA**, who got the first hit of the game in the exhibition with the Rangers, went 4-10 with a two-run home run in the Liberty series ... **TAYLOR MOTTER**, who had an RBI single in the Rangers' exhibition, went 4-11 (.364) with a double and two home runs vs. the Flames ... Rein, who started in the Rangers exhibition and sat down the first three batters 1-2-3, pitched the final six innings in game two vs. Liberty and scattered five hits with no runs and no walks with four strikeouts to earn the win ... The Highlanders have wins in seven of the last nine meetings with the Blue Hose ... Radford also picked up its first win over neighboring Virginia Tech since the 2004 season, a 7-5 win over the Hokies last Tuesday night in Blacksburg ... **MATT HILLSINGER** and **MATT MACK** highlighted the week with offensive consistency, extending hitting streaks with multi-hit efforts in three of the four games last week. Hillsinger's streak is at a team-best 11 games while Mack is at 10. VMI scored 28 runs in the series against Gardner-Webb, the most the Keydets had tallied in a three-game set since last April 9-11 against those same Runnin' Bulldogs ... **ALEX HAITSUKA** extended his hitting streak to 10 games with a 3-6 effort in the finale, and is hitting .395 over that stretch.
