Quattlebaum batted .632 (12-19) with five doubles, one home run and nine RBI in leading Gardner-Webb to a 4-0 week, which included two wins over preseason Top 25 and 2010 Big East Champion St. John's. He had at least two RBI in each of the four wins, had a 1.053 slugging percentage and struck out just once. In the opener against the Red Storm, Quattlebaum had two of GWU's three hits, and he belted a game-tying two-run home run off of 2011 preseason All-American Kyle Hansen. He also snared a line drive at first base and doubled off the runner to end the game. On Saturday, Quattlebaum went 5-6 with three doubles, three runs scored and three RBI. He opened the week going 5-10 with four RBI in two games against Holy Cross, including a 4-5 day in the opener.

In the victory over Ball State, he allowed just two hits and no earned runs in six innings of work, while fanning six batters. He nearly matched that performance in Sunday's win over UAB, as he struck out six hitters and scattered six hits in six innings while allowing just one run (a solo home run) before leaving with a 4-1 lead. Birmingham's pitching line last week: 2-0, 12 IP, 8 H, 3 R, 1 ER, 3 BB, 12 SO, 0.75 ERA, .200 opponents' batting average.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

NICK CHINNERS entered the week one double short of entering CSU's all-time list for career doubles at 40 ... **JAREN SUSTAR** tied an NCAA record with 4 sacrifice bunts vs. Fordham on March 11. Three of his bunts resulted in runs. He is now one of four players to reach the mark. Earlier in the week he hit a grand slam for his first collegiate home run in the second inning of the team's loss to USC Upstate ... **ZACH HAGAMAN**'s first career hit was a two-run homer in the team's 11-2 win over Fordham on March 12.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina is 7-1 in the month of March with its only loss coming to Kent State (2-0) whose pitcher (Andrew Chafin) has yet to allow a run in 2011 ... The Chants have been led by strong pitching performances as of late. In five games last week, Coastal pitchers posted a 1.80 ERA and opponents batted just .197 off the Chanticleer staff ... The relief pitching has been especially tough, as five guys combined to pitch 16.2 innings over the last five games and allowed just nine hits and three earned runs (four total) with six walks and 24 strikeouts ... **SCOTT WOODWARD** raised his batting average 30 points this past week to a team-best .346 after going 6-14. Woodward has reached base safely (by hit, walk or hit by pitch) in all 16 games this season, including a game last week when he was 0-for-0 in two at-bats but walking twice vs. Wake Forest before being lifted in the blowout.

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb ran its win streak to eight games last week, sweeping Holy Cross in a two-game set and repeating that effort over 2010 Big East Champion St. John's on Friday and Saturday ... GWU is off to its best start since moving to NCAA Division I in 2001 (11-3) ... The 'Dogs are batting a robust .360 during the current win streak and are averaging 11.4 runs per game ... The team's bullpen rotation of **JEFF HOWELL**, **BRETT STACKHOUSE**, **ADAM IZOKOVIC** and **EMILIO PAGAN** have combined to give up just four runs during the past eight games, while striking out 26 and walking just seven in a combined 25.0 innings of work. The quartet is 3-0 with four combined saves out of the pen during the eight-game win streak ... Gardner-Webb's RPI had risen to 47 Monday morning according to BoydsWorld.com, the highest RPI in program history to date (Division I).

HIGH POINT

High Point went 3-2 last week with a sweep of North Carolina A&T over the weekend. On Sunday senior **MIKE CALDWELL** had a perfect game going through four innings that was broken up in the fifth. He went seven innings, allowing two runs on two hits with six strikeouts for his third consecutive win ... **STEVE ANTOLIK** has an 11-game hit streak which he kept alive Sunday with a three-run homer, his third home run of the season. Antolik's season average is up to .444 and he has 24 RBI, nearly double any other Panther. **MIKE MERCURIO** is second on the team with 13 RBI ... The Panthers will face Appalachian State and VCU in midweek action before starting Big South play this weekend with Presbyterian College.

LIBERTY

Liberty won all three of its games at the eighth annual Keith LeClair Classic, capturing the tournament's title, this past weekend. The Flames went 3-1 on on the week ... Keying the victories at the LeClair Classic was the Liberty pitching staff, which had a 1.69 ERA over the three games ... RHP **KEEGAN LINZA** ran his record to 3-0 on the year, with a 5-2 victory over Rutgers on Friday. The senior went the full nine innings for the first complete game by a Flames pitcher this season ... The following afternoon, RHP **JOHN NIGGLI** picked up his second win of the year, allowing two runs over seven innings in a 4-3 Liberty win over Monmouth ... Sunday, LHP **STEVEN EVANS** and RHP **DANE BEAKLER** combined on a four-hit shutout over East Carolina, 2-0 ... With nine strikeouts on Sunday, Evans has moved into eighth on Liberty's career strikeout list with 207 ... SS **MATT WILLIAMS** continues his hot-hitting, as he collected two or more hits in three of the four Liberty contests last week. He went 8-16 on the week (.500) to raise his batting average to a team-leading .409.

PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE

The Blue Hose are riding a six-game winning streak heading into Wednesday's game at No. 14 Clemson ... Two players batted over .650 last week, with **BRAD ZEBEDIS** going 9-13 with six RBI and two home runs (.692), and **TONY MICKLON** going 10-15 with 11 RBI and two home runs (.667) ... The six-game winning streak is the longest in PC's NCAA Division I history ... The Blue Hose scored in double-figures in every game this week and averaged a .430 batting average.

RADFORD

Radford cruised to a three-game sweep of Hartford over the weekend to open a seven-game homestand ... The Highlanders played the first 12 games of the 2011 on the road ... In the series against Hartford, the Highlanders outscored the Hawks, 41-9, and scored their most runs in a three-game series since plating 39 runs in three games at High Point last April (16-18) ... The 22 runs on Sunday were the most for the Highlanders since scoring 26 in the second game of a doubleheader against Canisius on March 7, 2009 ... **MATT HILLSINGER** hit a pair of home runs last week -- a solo blast at N.C. State on Tuesday and a grand slam -- the first of his career, against Hartford in the first game on Saturday ... **JEFF KEMP** had a breakout game in the finale against Hartford with 5 RBI, going 4-4 ... The Highlanders had 5 triples in the three games of the Hartford series. They entered the weekend with none in 2011 ... **BOBBY BOLLING**, who got four runs of support in his previous three starts, got 18 runs of support in Sunday's win over Hartford ... Radford's weekend starters of Bolling, **EDDIE BUTLER** and **MARK PETERSON** have a combined ERA of 3.42 while opponents are hitting .225 off the group.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville saw its losing skid extended to 10 games on the season, after going 0-4 on the week. Asheville fell to Georgia State on the road 7-1 before being swept at Eastern Kentucky by scores of 10-3, 10-6 and 13-6 ... The Bulldogs have not won since defeating UNC Greensboro on Feb. 22 ... UNC Asheville is in the middle of a 14-game road trip and will not play at home again until it hosts Coastal Carolina on March 25-27 ... Over the next two weeks, Asheville will play Southern Conference foes Davidson, Western Carolina and Appalachian State while also opening up Conference play with Gardner-Webb on March 18-20.

VMI

VMI went 3-2 last week, including wins over No. 27 James Madison on Tuesday and a pair of victories over New Mexico State during a round-robin tournament at Oregon State ... **GRAHAM SULLIVAN** paced VMI by hitting .476 (10-21) with five RBI, three of which came against James Madison ... The win over JMU was VMI's first in Harrisonburg in 35 years (1976), and first over JMU at their facility since the Dukes became a Division I program ... In Oregon, **JEREMY BROWN** and **ALAN WATTS** combined on a shutout for the second time this season for one of the wins over a New Mexico State team that came into the weekend hitting over .350 ... Brown's ERA is now 0.90, as he has surrendered just two earned runs in 20 innings. He is also the first VMI pitcher to start two shutouts in a season since Milwaukee Brewers farmhand **MICHAEL BOWMAN** did so in 2007 ... Freshman **JORDAN TARSOVICH** had his first three career hits on the Oregon trip, two of which drove in runs.

WINTHROP

Winthrop went 1-3 last weekend in hosting its final regular season tournament of 2011, the Bojangles Baseball Classic. The Eagles' lone victory of the weekend was an 8-5 win over the Michigan Wolverines. In the team's Bojangles opener, junior **CHAS CRANE** posted a team-best three hits and two RBI ... Sophomore pitcher **ERIC RUTH** struck out a career-high seven batters in 4.2 relief innings pitched. His 4.2 innings pitched also tied a career-best for him, which initially came in his only career start against Liberty in the 2010 Big South Tournament. Ruth now has a team-leading 2.70 ERA for pitchers who have thrown 10.0 innings or more, a team-low .207 opposing average and tied with senior **ROBERT LAKE** with 15 strikeouts ... Sophomore **MATT PIERPONT** tied his career-high of three hits in Winthrop's first game Saturday against the Stony Brook Seawolves. He posted three hits in a game twice last season against Marist (Feb. 22) and Coastal Carolina (May 10) ... In Saturday's nightcap against the Wolverines, freshman **REID LANGDALE** made his first career start at catcher and got his first collegiate hit in the contest ... In the weekend finale against the Seawolves, sophomore **MATT LOBACZ** and freshman **TJ OLESZCZUK** recorded career-highs in hits with three apiece. Lobacz also drove in a career-high five runs in the contest. Oleszczuk, along with **EDDIE ROHAN**, have team-leading 11-game hitting streaks entering this week's action. The 11-game hit streak is a career-best for Oleszczuk, and ties the best for Rohan, as he recorded a hit in 11-straight games as a freshman in 2008 ... The Eagles will face The Citadel Bulldogs in midweek contests, their firsts of the season, on March 15 and 16, before opening Big South play this weekend against the VMI Keydets in Rock Hill.
