Rhodes, who began the season as a slot receiver, rushed for a career-high 143 yards on 33 carries at Coastal Carolina, and added a five-yard touchdown "jump pass" out of the wildcat formation that gave GWU a 20-13 third quarter lead. Rhodes' 43-yard run on the first play of the third quarter set up the Runnin' Bulldogs' first touchdown of the night, and he recorded six offensive plays of 10 yards or more. He also hauled in three receptions for 20 yards and totaled 202 all-purpose yards in the win over the Chanticleers. Rhodes started at running back in place of injured starter **Kenny Little**.

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

KaJUAN LEE • DB • R-Senior
Liberty • Newport News, Va.

Lee finished with five tackles (three solo, two assisted) and returned an interception 100 yards for a touchdown in the Flames' win at Charleston Southern. Lee stopped the Bucs from scoring inside the red zone with his pick in the end zone and length of the field return to give Liberty a 21-0 advantage instead of a possible 14-7 edge if CSU converted on the drive. It was his first interception of the year, and set a school record for longest interception return.

SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

KEVIN FOGG • DB • Junior
Liberty • Raleigh, N.C.

Fogg opened the second half against Charleston Southern with an 82-yard kickoff return for a touchdown, shedding eight would-be tacklers along the way to push the Flames to a 38-0 lead. It was his second kickoff return for a score this season, making him one of two FCS players in the country with that total. Fogg also had one of Liberty's four interceptions, returning it 36 yards.

THE CRONS BRAND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

Austin tied a Big South single-game record with four field goals, including a game-winning 31-yarder as time expired to defeat Coastal Carolina. He finished the night with 14 points on 2-of-2 PATs and 4-of-4 field goal attempts, hitting from 22, 22, 32 and 31 yards. Austin's first field goal tied the game at 3-3, his second gave GWU a 6-3 lead early in the second quarter, and his third field goal capped a lengthy 5:14 drive in the fourth quarter that put the Runnin' Bulldogs ahead 23-17.

THERE'S A FIFTH TIME FOR EVERYTHING

Liberty is 3-0 in Big South play for the fifth consecutive season, becoming the first program in League history to open Conference action 3-0 five-straight years. The Flames are looking for their fifth-straight 4-0 start this weekend. Meanwhile, Stony Brook is 2-0 for the third-straight year and is looking to start 3-0 for the third consecutive season.

TURNING 40 ISN'T SO BAD

Stony Brook has scored at least 40 points in three-straight games, tying the Big South record for most consecutive games scoring 40 points. It is the sixth such occurrence in Conference history, the last being accomplished by Liberty in a three-game span from Oct. 2-16, 2010. Meanwhile, the Seawolves have scored 40 points in their last two Big South games, which is one shy of the Conference record in that category as well.

PICK 12

Liberty returned two interceptions for touchdowns this past weekend at Charleston Southern, a first in Big South history. **KAJUAN LEE** had the Flames' first pick six with a 100-yard interception return for a score in the second quarter -- the second 100-yard INT return in Conference history. A few minutes later, **SCOTT HYLAND** notched a 22-yard interception return for a touchdown. Liberty finished the day with four interceptions for a Big South single-game record 158 return yards.

BEVINS BECOMES BIG SOUTH'S CAREER SCORING LEADER

Liberty All-American PK **MATT BEVINS** made 5-of-5 PATs and 1-of-1 FG this past weekend at Charleston Southern to push his career scoring total to 305 points -- becoming the all-time scoring leader in Big South history. Bevins entered the game tied with former Coastal Carolina kicker **JOSH HOKE** (2003-06) with 297 points. Meanwhile, Bevins remains second among active FCS kickers in career field goals with a Big South-record 58 -- two away from becoming just the 11th kicker in the classification's history with 60 career field goals. Bevins, whose 11 career 10-point kicking games is most in League history, is second in Big South history with 131 career PATs.

OH, THERE YOU ARE PERRY

Gardner-Webb redshirt-senior WR **JAMES PERRY III** is the Big South's all-time receptions leader with 213 career catches. He remains second among active players in career receptions in the Football Championship Subdivision, trailing Butler's **ZACH WATKINS**, who has 231. Perry, who broke the League's receptions record in Week 6 against Liberty, needs 175 receiving yards to break the Big South career record in that category. The current record is 2,720 yards set by former Coastal Carolina WR **JEROME SIMPSON** from 2004-07.

DOUBLED UP

Liberty owns the Conference record for most consecutive Big South games scoring in double figures at 31. Stony Brook has the next-longest active streak at 18 games, followed by Coastal Carolina at 14. Meanwhile, the Flames have scored in all 43 of their Conference games since 2002, while VMI has tallied points in all 40 of its League contests since joining the Big South in 2003. Presbyterian College is the final Conference member to have not been shut out in a League contest (14 games).

BIG SOUTH INFERNO

Liberty is in the midst of a Big South-record 13-game home Conference win streak. During this stretch, the Flames have scored 617 points (47.5 points per game), has scored more than 30 points in each contest, and has held its League brethren to 223 points (17.2). The last Big South team to defeat Liberty inside Williams Stadium was Gardner-Webb on Oct. 21, 2006 (27-24).

MORE CONFERENCE STREAKS

Liberty has now scored 30 points in each of its last 13 Big South contests -- breaking its own Big South mark of 12 games that was originally accomplished from Nov. 11, 2006 - Oct. 17, 2009. Meanwhile, Stony Brook has won its last eight home Conference games -- tied for the second-longest streak in Big South history.

HEY NORM!

Coastal Carolina DB **JOSH NORMAN**, who became the Big South's all-time leader in career pass break-ups in Week 7, broke up two more passes this past Saturday against Gardner-Webb to push his record career total to 34. Norman remains second to former Chanticleer safety **QUINTON TEAL** (2003-06) in Conference annals with 46 passes defensed and 12 interceptions, as Teal holds the all-time marks of 48 PD and 17 INT.

BIG SOUTH'S TV PACKAGE CONTINUES THIS WEEKEND

The Big South's television package continues this weekend with one game on the slate, as Coastal Carolina at Stony Brook will be televised live on ESPN3 at 4:00pm. **MATT HOGUE** (play-by-play) and **JAMES BUFORD** (analyst) will call the action from LaValle Stadium.

POINT OF ORDER

Liberty holds the Big South record for most consecutive games with a point scored at 71, having broken the old mark of 67 earlier this year that was first established by Coastal Carolina from 2003-08. Meanwhile, Presbyterian College has not been shutout in its last 59 games (41 as official Big South members), followed by Gardner-Webb (40), Stony Brook (34) and VMI (16).

2,000 RUSHING ODYSSEY

Stony Brook RB **MIGUEL MAYSONET** is 67 rushing yards away from becoming the 10th player in League history with 2,000 career rushing yards. He needs 62 to enter the Big South's all-time Top 10 in the category. Maysonet leads the Big South with 805 rushing yards and is on track to become just the third player in Conference history with consecutive 1,000-yard rushing seasons, joining Liberty backs **DRE BARNES** (2002-03) and **RASHAD JENNINGS** (2006-07-08). Maysonet would also become the fourth Big South player with two 1,000-yard rushing seasons, as VMI's **SEAN MIZZER** eclipsed the benchmark in 2003 and 2006.

RIGHT OF PASSAGE

Gardner-Webb freshman kicker **TREVER AUSTIN** tied a Big South single-game record with four field goals -- including a game-winning 31-yarder, this past Saturday at Coastal Carolina. Austin is the fourth freshman (true or redshirt) in Big South history to kick four field goals in a game, which has now been accomplished 11 times by seven different kickers.

WELCOME TO THE 300-30 CLUB

VMI linebacker **A.J. GROSS**, who became the ninth player in Big South history with 300 career tackles in Week 6, is currently sixth all-time with 310 and is four stops away from the Top 5. He also has 32.5 career TFL -- just one of two players in Big South annals with 300 tackles and 30 TFL, joining Charleston Southern LB **JADA ROSS** (2004-07), who had 454 career stops and 32.5 tackles-for-loss. Meanwhile, Gardner-Webb's **MARTY PATTERSON**, who has collected 32 TFL during his career, is 27 tackles shy of 300. He is looking to become the fourth Runnin' Bulldog on the Big South's 300-tackle list.

BIG BANG THEORY

Stony Brook RBs **BROCK JACKOLSKI** and **MIGUEL MAYSONET** have scored touchdowns in the same game two times this season and seven times overall since joining the Seawolves in 2010. SBU is 6-1 in those games (5-0 in Big South contests), with the two combining for 24 scores (Jackolski - 12, Maysonet - 12).

HIGH DENSITY FOGG

Liberty kick returner **KEVIN FOGG** returned his second kickoff for a touchdown this year, becoming the fourth player in Big South history with two kickoff return touchdowns in one season. Fogg is averaging 34.0 yards on his kickoff returns, which is 2.0 yards ahead of the Big South single-season record of 32.0, which was set by Liberty's **DOMINIC BOLDEN** in 2007.

NINE GAMES IN AND...

Seven of the first nine Big South Conference games this season have been decided by double figures, including five by at least 20 points, and the average winning margin currently sits at 20.0 points -- the fourth-highest in League history. Last year, the 21 Conference football games were decided by 20.8 points.

ON TOP OF LIBERTY MOUNTAIN

Liberty leads the Big South in both scoring offense (37.5) and scoring defense (18.8), a feat they accomplished in 2007, 2009 and 2010. The Flames are looking to become the first team in Big South history to lead in scoring offense three consecutive seasons, while their defensive prowess has them on track to have the Conference's top scoring defense for an unprecedented sixth-straight campaign.

LITTLE BIG MAN

Gardner-Webb RB **KENNY LITTLE**, who is third in the Big South with 594 rushing yards, is 23 rushing yards away from surpassing the team's leading individual rushing total from all of last year -- 616 by **PATRICK HALL**.

LIBERTY, BIG SOUTH RETURN TO TOP 25 NATIONAL RANKINGS

After a four-week hiatus, Liberty has returned to the Top 25 national rankings in both the *Sports Network* and FCS Coaches polls. The Flames are No. 23 in this week's *Sports Network* ranking, and No. 24 in the Coaches' weekly poll. The Big South has had a team ranked seven out of nine weeks this season -- Liberty was ranked the first four weeks of the 2011 campaign before falling out Sept. 26, while Coastal Carolina was a Top 25 program from Oct. 3-16. This is just the second time in Conference history that two Big South football teams were ranked in the Top 25 in the same season.

LIBERTY'S 4x1,000-YARD RELAY TEAM

Liberty WR **PAT KELLY** surpassed 1,000 career receiving yards this past weekend at Charleston Southern, making Liberty the lone FCS program in the nation with four active players with 1,000 career receiving yards. With 1,020, Kelly joins teammates **CHRIS SUMMERS** (2,312), **B.J. HAYES** (1,079) and **MIKE BROWN** (1,054) in the career 1,000-yard receiving club.

GO LONG

Five of Liberty WR **PAT KELLY**'s seven career touchdown receptions have gone for 50-yards or longer. He had three last season (79 and 65 yards vs. Stony Brook on Nov. 20, and a 75-yarder vs. St. Francis, Pa., on Sept., 4), and two this year (50-yarder vs. Coastal Carolina in Week 7 and 52 yards this past Saturday at Charleston Southern).

SEAWOLF TRAP

Stony Brook has held five of its seven opponents under 100 rushing yards, the second-highest total in Big South history. The record is seven games, established by both Gardner-Webb and Liberty in 2008. Stony Brook's rushing defense average of 92.4 is pacing ahead of the Big South single-season record of 108.8, set by Charleston Southern in 2006.

RUSHING UPDATE

Gardner-Webb RB **KENNY LITTLE** is 67 rushing yards away from 1,000 in his career, while Liberty's **ALDREAKIS ALLEN** is 143 yards away from the milestone. Below is a look at the Big South Conference's active career 1,000-yard rushers and where they rank in League history.

MASTRO OF THE UNIVERSE

Coastal Carolina sophomore **NICCOLO MASTROMATTEO**, who is the third player in Big South history with 40 career punt returns (42), is two away from becoming the all-time leader in the category. Liberty's **WYNTON JACKSON** (2003-07) holds the record of 43. Mastromatteo is fourth in League annals with 318 career punt return yards, 207 yards away from Jackson's Big South mark of 525. Meanwhile, Mastromatteo is fifth in Big South history with 81 combined kick returns in his brief career (39 KR, 42 PR). Former Gardner-Webb WR **TYSON PETTY** (2007-10) is fourth with 89.

CATCHING UP

Liberty redshirt-senior **CHRIS SUMMERS** is third in Big South history with 24 career touchdown receptions, and is six TD grabs shy of becoming the third player with 30. Summers is currently fifth in League history with 164 career catches and needs three receptions for the fourth spot. He became the sixth player in Big South history with 2,000 career receiving yards when he surpassed the milestone in Week 4 (now fifth at 2,312), and is 118 yards from moving into fourth all-time. Since the start of the 2010 season, Summers has 116 receptions, 1,695 yards and 20 touchdowns in 18 games played.

BLOCK OF AGES

Presbyterian College DB **JUSTIN BETHEL** -- the only player in Big South history to block a punt and return it for a touchdown in consecutive games, blocked his third kick of the season against Gardner-Webb in Week 7. He has blocked two punts and one field goal this year, and needs one more blocked kick to tie the Big South single-season record of four. The Conference's all-time leader now with nine career blocked kicks, Bethel blocked a Furman punt attempt and landed on it in the end zone in Week 4, one week after blocking a California punt and returning it 17 yards for a score against the Golden Bears.

MONSIEURS 3,000

Liberty QB **MIKE BROWN** and Stony Brook RB/KR **BROCK JACKOLSKI** became the ninth and 10th Big South players, respectively, to surpass 3,000 career all-purpose yards in Week 7. Jackolski, who eclipsed the milestone a few hours after Brown, is now eighth in Big South history with 3,208 career all-purpose yards and 387 away from moving into seventh-place. Brown stands in 10th with 3,091. Meanwhile, Jackolski's per game average of 177.4 yards is pacing just behind the Big South single-season record of 179.5 (VMI's **TIM MAYPRAY** in 2007). Jackolski needs to average 183.3 all-purpose yards over the final four games to break Maypray's Big South single-season record of 1,975 yards.

PURE ESSENCE

In three games as Stony Brook's starting quarterback, **KYLE ESSINGTON** is 51-of-70 passing (=72.9 percent) for 822 yards and nine touchdowns, with one interception and a 211.07 passing efficiency rating. Essington and Liberty QB **MIKE BROWN** are the lone Big South quarterbacks to pass for more than 250 yards in three consecutive games this season.

RUNNIN' BULLDOGS

Gardner-Webb rushed for a season-high 223 yards this past Saturday at Coastal Carolina, its highest rushing total in a Big South game since gaining 228 against Liberty on Oct. 29, 2005.

NO LONGER ROOSTER FEED

Gardner-Webb's 26-24 victory over Coastal Carolina this past weekend ended the Runnin' Bulldogs' seven-game losing streak to the Chanticleers. Coastal's run was the second-longest win streak over one Big South member, as Gardner-Webb's current eight-game win streak over VMI is the longest in League history. Liberty owns the third- and fourth-longest streaks, as the Flames have now defeated Charleston Southern six consecutive times, and carry a five-game win streak over VMI into their Nov. 5 meeting with the Keydets.

SKIFF AND WESSON

Stony Brook PK **WESLEY SKIFFINGTON**, who became the school's all-time kick scoring leader in Week 4, ranks seventh in Big South history with 180 career points kicking. He is 18 points away from sixth-place. Skiffington needs two field goals and four PATs to become the sixth kicker in League annals with 30 and 100, respectively, in a career.

GROUND

Liberty QB **MIKE BROWN** was injured late in the first half this past Saturday at Charleston Southern and did not return to action. He finished the day 6-of-14 passing for 89 yards and two touchdowns, ending his string of consecutive games with 200 passing yards at 17 and marking the first time in 19 career starts at quarterback that he did not pass for 200 yards in a game. In his 19 career starts at quarterback, Brown has thrown for more than 200 yards a total of 18 times, is 377-of-576 passing (=65.5 percent) for 4,951 yards and 38 touchdowns, in addition to being 13-6. His playing status is day-to-day.

BROWN STILL ABLE TO DELIVER TOUCHDOWN PASSES

Despite leaving Saturday's game at Charleston Southern with an injury, Liberty QB **MIKE BROWN** became the sixth player in Big South history with 40 career touchdown passes when he eclipsed the milestone against the Buccaneers. Brown finished the day with two scoring strikes -- his sixth-straight game with at least two touchdown passes and the longest such streak in the Big South since Stony Brook QB **MICHAEL COULTER** had six consecutive multi-TD pass games during the 2009 season. Brown has thrown a TD pass in each of his seven games this season, and his personal streak of consecutive games with a touchdown pass now stands at 10. The last Big South QB with 10-straight games with a TD pass was Coastal Carolina's **TYLER THIGPEN**, who threw a touchdown pass in all 12 games of the 2006 season.

GROUND PACKAGE

Liberty QB **MIKE BROWN** remains fifth all-time in Big South history with 26 career rushing touchdowns and needs one to tie former Gardner-Webb rusher **PATRICK HALL**, who had 27 from 2007-10, for fourth-place. Brown's six rushing touchdowns this season are the fifth-most by a Big South quarterback in a single-season, and three away from matching his total from last year. The fifth player in Big South history with 1,000 career rushing yards at the quarterback position, Brown has rushed 270 times for 1,256 yards (4.65 average) and 16 scores starting under center. He is the Big South's fourth-leading all-time rusher among quarterbacks, and he is three rushing touchdowns away from tying the Conference's all-time mark for a QB (19 - Gardner-Webb's **NICK ROBERTS**, 2002-05).

YOU COMPLETE ME

Liberty QB **MIKE BROWN** is the Big South's all-time career leader for completion percentage at 65.0 percent (398-of-612). He recorded his fourth career 300-yard passing game in Week 6 at Gardner-Webb, the third-most in League history. Brown also threw three touchdown passes against the Runnin' Bulldogs, marking the fifth time in his career he has achieved the feat -- the fourth-most 3-TD pass games in Conference annals.

TOTAL RECALL

Liberty QB **MIKE BROWN**, who has a Big South-record 12 career 300-total offense games, remains sixth in League history with 6,913 career yards of total offense. He needs 87 yards of offense to become the sixth player with 7,000, and is 226 away from fifth-place in Conference history (7,139 - Coastal Carolina's **ZACH MacDOWALL** from 2008-10). Brown's four 300-yard offensive games this year is already the fourth-most in a single-season in Big South history.

SOLO ARTISTS

Presbyterian College DB **JUSTIN BETHEL** is second in Big South history with 179 career solo tackles, and is 16 solo stops away from tying the Conference's career record of 195 established by Charleston Southern LB **JADA ROSS** from 2004-07. Meanwhile, Gardner-Webb LB **MARTY PATTERSON** moved into the career Top 10 in Week 7 and is now tied for sixth in League history with 155 career solo tackles.

30 BROCK

Stony Brook RB/KR **BROCK JACKOLSKI** is the second player in Big South history with 1,000 career rushing yards (1,663) and 1,000 career kickoff return yards (1,314). He joins VMI's **TIM MAYPRAY**, who had 2,456 rushing yards and 2,181 kickoff return yards from 2006-09. Jackolski, who is also one of three players in League annals with two 90-yard kickoff returns, is fifth on the Big South's career kickoff return yards list.

THE IGNITOR

Liberty QB **MIKE BROWN** is the only player in Big South history with 1,000 career rushing yards (1,752), 1,000 career passing yards (5,161) and 1,000 career receiving yards (1,054).

TAKING ATTENDANCE

Through 24 home dates, the Big South's seven football playing members are averaging a combined 7,626 fans per game, which is pacing ahead of the Conference's record attendance average of 7,488 in 2007. Liberty leads the Big South with its 17,394 per game average, and Coastal Carolina, Gardner-Webb, Presbyterian College and Stony Brook are all posting average attendance gains over last season. The Conference needs to draw 77,968 during its remaining 13 home dates (=5,998 average) to break the all-time combined total home attendance record of 260,998 that was established in 2008.

NEW CONFERENCE TIEBREAKER

The Big South Conference's football tiebreaker policy that determines the League's automatic qualifier to the FCS Playoffs has been changed and now includes road and home Conference wins as well as a point system based on complete schedule and wins. The changes, which are indicated in the chart to the right, replace the previous step iv., step v. and step vi. in breaking two-way ties and multiple ties, which were average points allowed in Conference games and Sagarin rating, respectively. The new tiebreaker policy is in effect and will be utilized if necessary.

ROLL CALL

The attendance of 19,111 for the Oct. 15 Coastal Carolina at Liberty game was the largest home crowd for a Big South game in League history. The previous best was 18,587 for the Flames' home game against Charleston Southern on Oct. 9, 2010.

TIGHT BEGINNING

Liberty TE **TOMMY SHAVER** became the second tight end in Big South history -- and second this season -- with 100 receiving yards in a game with his 110 in Week 6 at Gardner-Webb. VMI TE **MARIO THOMPSON** was the first to achieve this feat with his 114 receiving yards at No. 6/9 Richmond in Week 3.

"I'LL TAKE FOOTBALL GAMES FOR 100 PLEASE, ALEX"

Coastal Carolina and head coach **DAVID BENNETT** will play the 100th game in program history this year when the Chanticleers host Presbyterian College in the ninth game of the season on Nov. 5. In addition, Charleston Southern head coach **JAY MILLS** will coach his 100th game at the helm of the Buccaneers when CSU faces PC in the season finale on Nov. 19. Meanwhile, VMI will play its 100th game as Big South members this year when the Keydets host Gardner-Webb on Nov. 19.

BIG SOUTH HAS TWO WALTER PAYTON CANDIDATES

For the first time in Big South history, the Conference had two candidates on the Walter Payton Award Watch List in the same season. Liberty QB **MIKE BROWN**, who was a finalist last year and finished 11th in the voting, made the initial 2011 list, as did teammate WR **CHRIS SUMMERS**. This marks the fifth time since 2006 that the Big South has had official candidates for the top offensive individual honor in FCS. Brown remains an official candidate for the Payton Award following the midseason update.

THE BUCK STOPS HERE

Presbyterian College DB **JUSTIN BETHEL** was added to the Buck Buchanan Award Watch List on Oct. 4, the Big South's first official candidate for the FCS national defensive player of the year since 2009 and the fifth overall. A national panel of sports information and media relations directors, broadcasters, writers and other dignitaries will vote on the Payton and Buchanan awards after the regular season, beginning Nov. 21.
