### CHOICE HOTELS OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

**ARAMIS HILLARY • QB • Junior**  
Coastal Carolina • North Augusta, S.C.

Hillary was Coastal Carolina's leading rusher and passer in the Chanticleers' 30-23 season-opening win over Furman. He rushed 16 times for 61 yards with two scores, including the game-winner with 1:32 left, and completed 10-of-13 passes for 130 yards with no interceptions. Hillary gave Coastal a 7-0 lead in the first quarter as he directed a 15-play, 79-yard drive in which he had rushes of 5, 7, 4, 13 and 4 yards. With the game tied 16-16 in the third quarter, Hillary had a 39-yard completion to Matt Hazel that set up a Coastal touchdown two plays later. With the game tied yet again in the fourth quarter at 23-23, Hillary led the Chants on a nine-play, 71-yard touchdown drive to secure the win. He was 2-of-2 passing for 24 yards and capped the drive with the go-ahead 3-yard score.

### DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

**PACO VAROL • DL • R-Sophomore**  
Liberty • Hamburg, Germany

Varol, who entered the season with just one career tackle, finished as Liberty's defensive leader against N.C. State with a team-high seven stops (five solo and two assisted). He also recorded two tackles-for-loss (7 yards), one sack (5 yards) and a forced fumble against the Wolfpack. Varol's two stops behind the line came on third down plays, while another solo tackle went for no gain. His play helped Liberty hold N.C. State to 318 total offensive yards.

### SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

**RICKY RHODES • RS • R-Junior**  
Gardner-Webb • Richmond, Ky.

In his first game as Gardner-Webb's kick returner, Rhodes averaged 31.2 yards on his five kick returns against Brevard en route to 193 all-purpose yards. He finished the night with a national-best 40.5 yards on his two punt returns, which included a 22-yard return that led to GWU's first points of the game, and a 59-yard return late in the contest. Rhodes also brought back three kickoffs for 75 yards (25.0 average), and added 19 receiving yards and 18 rushing yards in the victory.

Austin was solid in his debut as Gardner-Webb's starting kicker as he made all six of his placekicks in the Runnin' Bulldogs' 34-17 win over Brevard. He connected on two field goals (30 and 33 yards) and all four PATs to finish the day with 10 points. Austin's 30-yarder late in the first quarter got Gardner-Webb on the board, and his 33-yarder with 18 seconds left before halftime gave GWU a 20-10 edge at intermission.

**FOR OPENERS**

Coastal Carolina and Gardner-Webb were victorious in their respective season openers this past Saturday. The Chanticleers won their season opener for the first time since 2005 (also defeating a SoCon team), while the Runnin' Bulldogs have now won three consecutive openers.

**MORE ON THE 1-0 TEAMS**

As mentioned above, Coastal Carolina is 1-0 first time since 2005 and the fourth time in the nine-year history of the program. That season was also the last time the Chanticleers opened 2-0. Gardner-Webb is 1-0 for the third-straight year and is looking to start 2-0 for the third consecutive time as well.

**VMI's RECORD SEASON-OPENING STREAK ENDS**

VMI's Big South-record for consecutive season-opening wins was snapped this past Saturday at six with the Keydets' 24-21 loss to Delaware State. The last time VMI lost its season opener prior to Saturday was in 2004.

**HOME SWEET HOME**

Liberty will make its home debut this Saturday, with Stony Brook's home opener set for Week 3. Charleston Southern opens its home slate on Sept. 24. Below is a look at the three teams' last home opening win and current home opening streaks.

**A VALIANT EFFORT**

Presbyterian College came back from 28-7 deficit against No. 8-ranked Wofford to tie the game in the fourth quarter with 5:32 remaining in the contest. Although the Terriers rallied for the seven-point win, it was the closest margin of victory in the series since Wofford's 21-20 win in 1995. The Blue Hose opened the game with a 7-0 lead, and later used a touchdown catch from **JOEY GILKEY** and rushing scores from **DEMARCUS ROUSE** and **LANCE BYRD** to knot the game at 28-28.

**AGENT P**

Gardner-Webb redshirt-senior WR **JAMES PERRY III** is third all-time in Big South history with 187 career receptions. He needs one catch to tie former Bulldog **DUVAUGHN FLAGLER** (2004-07) for second-place in League annals, and is 16 receptions away from breaking the Conference record of 202, which is held by former Charleston Southern WR **MAURICE PRICE** (2004-06). Perry, who is the active career receptions leader in FCS, is on pace to break Price's record on Oct. 1 at Samford.

**AIR MAIL**

Liberty QB **MIKE BROWN**, who was the first quarterback in Big South football history to pass for at least 200 yards in every game during the season in 2010, has now surpassed that yardage total in 12 consecutive games after passing for 279 yards in the season opener at North Carolina State. In just 13 career starts at quarterback, Brown has thrown for more than 200 yards in each contest, is 274-of-426 passing (=64.3 percent) for 3,477 yards and 25 touchdowns, in addition to being 9-4.

**GROUND PACKAGE**

Liberty QB **MIKE BROWN** is the fifth player in Big South history with 1,000 career rushing yards at the quarterback position, as he surpassed the milestone this past Saturday at North Carolina State. In his time as Liberty's signal-caller, he has rushed 200 times for 1,019 yards (5.1 average) and 10 scores starting under center. Gardner-Webb's **NICK ROBERTS** (2002-05) is ahead of Brown on the all-time quarterback rushing list with 1,182 yards.

**POINT OF ORDER**

Liberty owns the Conference's active scoring streak at 64 games, which is the second-longest in League history. The record is 67 games by Coastal Carolina from 2003-08. Meanwhile, Presbyterian College has not been shutout in its last 53 games (35 as official Big South members), followed by Gardner-Webb (34) and Stony Brook (28).

**DOUBLE DOWN**

Stony Brook is the Big South's active leader for most consecutive games scoring in double figures at 28, the fourth-longest streak in Big South history. The Seawolves took over the top spot after Liberty's Big South-record of 45 consecutive games scoring double figures was snapped last season on Sept. 25 at James Madison, as the Flames managed just a field goal against the Dukes.

**BIG SOUTH'S NEWEST COACH GETS FIRST WIN**

New Gardner-Webb head coach **RON DICKERSON JR.** was victorious in his head coaching debut this past Saturday with the Runnin' Bulldogs' 34-17 win over Brevard. He is the fourth consecutive GWU coach to win his first game. Dickerson joins Coastal Carolina's **DAVID BENNETT** (2003), Liberty's **DANNY ROCCO** (2006) and VMI's **SPARKY WOODS** (2008) among the current Big South coaches who have won their coaching debut in the Conference.

**GETTING YOUR KICKS AT 50**

Liberty PK **MATT BEVINS** made a 50-yard field goal at North Carolina State in the season opener, his fourth career make from that distance -- extending his Big South record. Bevins booted a 50-yarder in his sophomore year and made a 52-yarder and 50-yarder as a junior last season.

**BIG DOGS**

Gardner-Webb RB **KENNY LITTLE**, who missed all but two series last season after suffering an injury in the 2010 season opener, rushed for a career-high 131 yards this past Saturday. Teammate **JUANNE BLOUNT** added 102 yards on 14 carries -- his third career 100-yard game, and it marked the first time since 2002 that GWU had two players rush for 100 yards in the same game. That season, **CHRIS FOSTER** (109) and **JEREMY MARTIN** (100) achieved the feat against Elon on Oct. 12.

**TOTAL RECALL**

Liberty QB **MIKE BROWN** collected 356 yards of total offense in the season opener at North Carolina State, his ninth career game with 300 total offensive yards. He is two away from tying the Big South mark of 11 that is held by Charleston Southern's **COLLIN DRAFTS** (2003-06). Brown also eclipsed 5,000 career total offense yards in the opener, and is the ninth player in Big South history to achieve the milestone. Brown's 5,202 career yards are 84 shy of eighth place (5,286 - VMI's **JONATHAN WILSON**).

**RIFLEMAN**

VMI QB **ERIC KORDENBROCK** was 22-of-43 passing for 227 yards against Delaware State in the season opener. It was the most passing yards by a VMI quarterback since **KYLE HUGHES** threw for 261 against Charleston Southern on Nov. 3, 2007. Kordenbrock's 43 attempts were the most by a Keydet QB since the Institute joined the Big South in 2003. In fact, his 43 attempts tied for fifth-most in a single-game in VMI history with **ROBBIE CHENAULT**, who had 43 attempts against Furman in 1997.

**CATCHING UP**

Liberty redshirt-senior **CHRIS SUMMERS** became the fourth Big South player with 20 career touchdown receptions when he reached the milestone with a 27-yard TD grab at North Carolina State this past Saturday. Summers also moved into the Conference's career top 10 in receptions and receiving yards during the contest, and is now 10th in League history with 129 career catches and 9th with 1,768 career yards.

**SOLO ARTIST**

Presbyterian College DB **JUSTIN BETHEL**, who is the Big South's all-time leader with six blocked kicks, is 7th in League history with 147 career solo tackles. He needs nine to crack the top five and 21 for second-place. Former Charleston Southern LB **JADA ROSS** holds the career record for most solo tackles with 195. Meanwhile, Bethel surpassed 200 career tackles in the season opener against Wofford and sits at 203.

**NORTH BY NORTHWEST**

Stony Brook RB **MIGUEL MAYSONET** recorded his fifth 100-yard rushing game as a member of the Seawolves with his 103-yard performance at UTEP this past Saturday. He is the first Big South player to rush for more than 100 yards against an FBS opponent since the 2009 season (VMI's **HOWARD ABEGESAH** and **CAMERON JONES** against Army). Maysonet needs one more 100-yard game to crack the League's all-time career top 10 in the category (several tied with six).

**THANK HEAVENS FOR BEVINS**

Liberty senior PK **MATT BEVINS** is the Conference's all-time leader with 56 career field goals (56-of-71, =78.9 percent) and ranks second in Big South history with 275 career points kicking as well as fourth in overall scoring. He needs 23 points to break the Big South career kick scoring record of 297 points, which is held by Coastal Carolina's **JOSH HOKE** (2003-06). Bevins' 11 career 10-point kicking games is most in League history.

**DID YOU KNOW...**

... that Coastal Carolina TE **DAVID DURAN** is seven receptions away from becoming the first tight end in Big South history with 60 career receptions? Duran has 53 career catches, just six shy of former Gardner-Webb TE **JOSH MILLER**'s Conference record of 59 from 2007-10.

**KEEP UP THE GOOD WORK**

Charleston Southern DB **CHRIS KUZDALE** is among the national nominees for the Allstate AFCA Good Works Teams -- college football's preeminent community service award. Kuzdale is the lone representative from the Big South Conference, and is the League's third-ever nominee. Kuzdale's former teammate **JORDAN LANCASTER** was named to the team last year -- the only Big South Conference student-athlete to be recognized with this achievement.

**RHODES TRIP**

Gardner-Webb redshirt-junior **RICKY RHODES** averaged 40.5 yards on his two punt returns in the season opener against Brevard -- the fourth-highest single-game average in Big South history. He also returned three kickoffs for 75 yards to finish the day with 156 kick return yards.

**THE IGNITOR**

Liberty QB **MIKE BROWN** is the only player in Big South history with 1,000 career rushing, passing and receiving yards. He currently stands at 1,515 career rushing yards, 3,687 career passing yards and 1,049 career receiving yards.

**300-TACKLE CLUB**

Three Big South players have a chance to enter the Conference's 300-career tackle club this season, which currently has eight members. VMI linebacker **A.J. GROSS** is the League's active leader with 272 career stops, ahead of teammate **BYRON ALLEN** (238). Gardner-Webb's **MARTY PATTERSON** (221) returns after missing all of last year with an injury and is looking to become the fourth Runnin' Bulldog on the Big South's 300-tackle list.

**FB-YES**

For the second consecutive year, the Big South will play a League-record 10 games against FBS opponents this season. In 2010, the Conference picked up its first-ever wins against FBS members, **and did so on the same day** when Gardner-Webb and Liberty defeated MAC teams on Sept. 11. The Runnin' Bulldogs were the first to claim victory with its 38-37 overtime triumph at Akron at 3:15pm. Less than seven hours later, Liberty emerged with a 27-23 win at Ball State at 9:55pm. The Big South was the only FCS AQ Conference with two FBS wins in 2010.

**SPEAKING OF FBS...**

Stony Brook was close to picking up the Big South's third FBS win this past Saturday, as the Seawolves led UTEP, 24-10, before a late surge by the Miners forced overtime and claimed victory in the extra session. Meanwhile, Liberty extended its streak of 20-point games against FBS opponents to four this past weekend. In its last four FBS match-ups, Liberty scored 34 points at Toledo (2007), 20 points at West Virginia (2009), 27 points in a win at Ball State (2010), and 21 points at North Carolina State (2011 season opener).

**TREND-SETTERS**

Charleston Southern will play its 10th FBS opponent under head coach **JAY MILLS** when the Buccaneers travel to No. 6 Florida State this week. In fact, eight of the Bucs' previous nine FBS games have occurred since 2007 -- the most of any Big South member. It will be the squad's first-ever meeting with the Seminoles and second match-up against an ACC member, as well as the sixth against a Florida-based institution. Since 2003, Charleston Southern has played South Florida (2003, 2009), Hawai'i (2007, 2010), Miami-FL (2008), Miami-OH (2008), Florida (2009), Kentucky (2010) and UCF (2010).

**BIG SOUTH HAS TWO WALTER PAYTON CANDIDATES**

For the first time in Big South history, the Conference has two candidates on the Walter Payton Award Watch List in the same season. Liberty QB **MIKE BROWN**, who was a finalist last year and finished 11th in the voting, made the 2011 list, as did teammate WR **CHRIS SUMMERS**. This marks the fifth time since 2006 that the Big South has had official candidates for the top offensive individual honor in FCS.

**"I'LL TAKE FOOTBALL GAMES FOR 100 PLEASE, ALEX"**

Coastal Carolina and head coach **DAVID BENNETT** will play the 100th game in program history this year when the Chanticleers host Presbyterian College in the ninth game of the season on Nov. 5. In addition, Charleston Southern head coach **JAY MILLS** will coach his 100th game at the helm of the Buccaneers when CSU faces PC in the season finale on Nov. 19. Meanwhile, VMI will play its 100th game as Big South members this year when the Keydets face Gardner-Webb on Nov. 19.
