HIGH FIVE

Liberty is 4-0 in Big South play for the fifth consecutive season, becoming the first program in League history to open Conference action 4-0 five-straight years. The Flames are looking for their third overall 5-0 start this weekend, and first since 2009. Liberty also finished 5-0 during its 2008 Big South Championship season. The Big South has had a team open 5-0 in League play each of the past three seasons -- Liberty in 2008 and 2009, and Stony Brook last season. Meanwhile, the Seawolves are 3-0 for the third-straight year and are looking to start 4-0 for the third consecutive season.

CHAMPIONSHIPS ARE WON IN NOVEMBER

As the calendar turns to November this week, four-time Big South football champion Liberty is 20-8 (=71.4 percent) since 2002 during the final month of the regular-season, while two-time champ Stony Brook is 5-3 in November since joining the Big South in 2008. Two-time champion Coastal Carolina is 19-6 (=76.0) in its history in regular-season games in November. In fact, the Chanticleers are the only Big South member to win a game in November every season since 2003.

STONY BROOK SETS BIG SOUTH RECORD FOR CONSECUTIVE 40 POINT GAMES

Stony Brook has scored at least 40 points in four-straight games, becoming the first team in Big South history to score 40 points in four consecutive contests. In their past four games, the Seawolves are averaging 45.25 points -- and have tied the Conference record with three-straight 40-point games in Big South contests. SBU is the sixth team to accomplish this feat against League foes, the last being by Liberty from Oct. 2-16, 2010.

2,000 RUSHING ODYSSEY

Stony Brook RB **MIGUEL MAYSONET** became the 10th player in Big South history with 2,000 career rushing yards when he surpassed the milestone this past weekend against Coastal Carolina. Maysonet currently stands at 2,124 and needs 91 rushing yards to pass Coastal Carolina's **PATRICK HALL** for ninth-place. Hall rushed for 2,214 yards for the Chanticleers from 2003-05. Maysonet also cracked the League's Top 10 for career rushing touchdowns this past weekend (now at 21) and tallied his fourth career 3-touchdown game -- second-most in Big South history.

"I'LL TAKE FOOTBALL GAMES FOR 100 PLEASE, ALEX"

Coastal Carolina and head coach **DAVID BENNETT** will play the 100th game in program history this weekend when the Chanticleers host Presbyterian College. Meanwhile, Charleston Southern head coach **JAY MILLS** will coach his 100th game at the helm of the Buccaneers when CSU faces PC in the season finale on Nov. 19. In addition, VMI will play its 100th game as Big South members this year when the Keydets host Gardner-Webb on Nov. 19.

MIGUEL'S MAYSONRY

Stony Brook RB **MIGUEL MAYSONET** is four rushing yards away from becoming just the third player in Conference history with consecutive 1,000-yard rushing seasons. Currently at 996 this season, he will join Liberty backs **DRE BARNES** (2002-03) and **RASHAD JENNINGS** (2006-07-08) on the list. Maysonet would also become the fourth Big South player with two 1,000-yard rushing seasons, as VMI's **SEAN MIZZER** eclipsed the benchmark in 2003 and 2006.

BURNING UP THE HOUSE

Liberty is in the midst of a Big South-record 14-game home Conference win streak. During this stretch, the Flames have scored 644 points (46.0 points per game), scored more than 30 points in 13 contests, and has held its League brethren to 243 points (17.4). The last Big South team to defeat Liberty inside Williams Stadium was Gardner-Webb on Oct. 21, 2006 (27-24).

WOLF DEN

Stony Brook has won nine consecutive home Big South games -- the second-longest streak in Conference history and trailing Liberty's current 14-game span. The Seawolves have scored 351 points during their string (39.0 points per game), has scored more than 30 points in seven contests -- including the last four over 40, and has held the Conference membership to 140 points (15.6). The last Big South team to defeat Stony Brook inside LaValle Stadium was Gardner-Webb on Nov. 1, 2008 (34-33).

DASH AND MASH

Stony Brook RBs **BROCK JACKOLSKI** and **MIGUEL MAYSONET** have scored touchdowns in the same game three times this season (all wins) and eight times overall since joining the Seawolves in 2010. SBU is 7-1 in those games (6-0 in Big South contests), with the two combining for 28 scores (Maysonet - 14, Jackolski - 13).

ON THE PROWL

Stony Brook rushed for 446 yards this past Saturday against Coastal Carolina, the second-highest rushing total in a Big South game in League history. The Seawolves fell one yard shy of the record 447 yards the 2008 Stony Brook squad rushed against VMI on Nov. 15, 2008. Meanwhile, Stony Brook held Coastal Carolina to 73 yards of offense this past weekend -- a record-low total in a Big South game.

THURSDAY NIGHT FOOTBALL

Gardner-Webb is playing the eighth Thursday night football game in Big South history this week when the Runnin' Bulldogs host Virginia State. GWU will be the second Conference member to host a Thursday night affair, as Liberty was the first in 2006. It will be the Runnin' Bulldogs' second Thursday night game, as the program opened the 2008 season on a Thursday night at Tennessee Tech. Meanwhile, it is the fourth consecutive season a Conference member is playing on Thursday night, and just the third non-season opening Thursday contest in League annals. In 2002, Charleston Southern played The Citadel on Thursday, Nov. 21, and in 2003, Coastal Carolina faced North Greenville on Thursday, Sept. 25.

POINT OF ORDER

Liberty holds the Big South record for most consecutive games with a point scored at 72, having broken the old mark of 67 earlier this year that was first established by Coastal Carolina from 2003-08. Meanwhile, Presbyterian College has not been shutout in its last 60 games (42 as official Big South members), followed by Gardner-Webb (41), Stony Brook (35) and VMI (16).

GROUND CHUCK

Stony Brook RB duo **BROCK JACKOLSKI** (193) and **MIGUEL MAYSONET** (191) combined for 384 rushing yards against Coastal Carolina this past Saturday, the fifth-highest combined total in a single-game in Big South history. It was the highest total for two Big South teammates in a game since VMI's **TIM MAYPRAY** (235) and **HOWARD ABEGESAH** (151) combined for 386 yards against Presbyterian on Nov. 22, 2008.

TENS AND TWENTIES

Gardner-Webb LB **MARTY PATTERSON** recorded a career-high 20 tackles this past Saturday against Charleston Southern. It was the first 20-tackle game in the Big South since former Coastal Carolina safety **DOMINIQUE DAVENPORT** had 20 stops against Colgate on Sept. 7, 2008. It was the seventh 20-tackle game in League annals, with Patterson being the sixth different player to reach the mark.

BIG SOUTH'S 300-30 TACKLE CLUB TO GET NEW MEMBER

Gardner-Webb LB **MARTY PATTERSON** is seven tackles shy of 300 in his career, and with 33.0 career TFL, he will become just the third player in Big South history with 300 tackles and 30 TFL. Patterson, who will become the fourth Runnin' Bulldog on the Conference's 300-tackle list and 10th overall, is set to join Charleston Southern LB **JADA ROSS** (2004-07), who had a Big South career record 454 stops in addition to 32.5 tackles-for-loss, and VMI's **A.J. GROSS**, who is fifth all-time in League annals with 317 tackles to go along with his 33.0 TFL.

OH, THERE YOU ARE PERRY

Gardner-Webb redshirt-senior WR **JAMES PERRY III** is the Big South's all-time receptions leader with 214 career catches. He is third among active players in career receptions in the Football Championship Subdivision. Perry, who broke the League's receptions record in Week 6 against Liberty, is now second in League history with 2,558 career receiving yards, and he needs 163 to break the Big South career record in that category. The current record is 2,720 yards set by former Coastal Carolina WR **JEROME SIMPSON** from 2004-07.

EASY DOZEN IT

Eight of the first 12 Big South Conference games this season have been decided by double figures, including six by at least 20 points, and the average winning margin currently sits at 19.7 points. Last year, the 21 Conference football games were decided by 20.8 points.

DOUBLED UP

Liberty owns the Conference record for most consecutive Big South games scoring in double figures at 32. Stony Brook has the next-longest active streak at 19 games. Meanwhile, the Flames have scored in all 44 of their Conference games since 2002, while VMI has tallied points in all 40 of its League contests since joining the Big South in 2003. Presbyterian College is the final Conference member to have not been shut out in a League contest (15 games).

ON TOP OF LIBERTY MOUNTAIN

Liberty leads the Big South in both scoring offense (36.3) and is tied for first in scoring defense (18.9), a feat they accomplished in 2007, 2009 and 2010. The Flames are looking to become the first team in Big South history to lead in scoring offense three consecutive seasons, while their defensive prowess has them on track to have the Conference's top scoring defense for an unprecedented sixth-straight campaign.

LIBERTY MOVES UP IN BOTH MAJOR TOP 25 NATIONAL POLLS

Liberty is ranked No. 22 in both the *Sports Network* and FCS Coaches poll this week, up from last week's No. 23 and No. 24 ranking, respectively. The Big South has had a team ranked eight out of 10 weeks this season, and has had two different teams nationally-ranked this year (Liberty and Coastal Carolina), the second time in League history two Big South teams were ranked in the same season.

PRESBYTERIAN ENDS LIBERTY'S RECORD 30-POINT STREAK

Presbyterian College held Liberty to 27 points in this past weekend's double overtime contest, ending the Flames' Conference record 13-game streak of consecutive Big South games with 30 points.

FLOCK OF SEAWOLVES

Stony Brook has held six of its eight opponents under 100 rushing yards, the second-highest total in Big South history. The record is seven games, established by both Gardner-Webb and Liberty in 2008. Stony Brook's rushing defense average of 88.4 ranks seventh in the nation and is pacing way ahead of the Big South single-season record of 108.8, set by Charleston Southern in 2006.

SOLO ARTISTS

Presbyterian College DB **JUSTIN BETHEL**, the Big South's all-time leader with nine blocked kicks, is second in Big South history with 188 career solo tackles, and is seven solo stops away from tying the Conference's career record of 195 established by Charleston Southern LB **JADA ROSS** from 2004-07. Meanwhile, Gardner-Webb LB **MARTY PATTERSON** moved into the career Top 10 in Week 7 and is now fifth in League history with 164 career solo tackles.

RUSHING UPDATE

Stony Brook RB **BROCK JACKOLSKI** is 144 rushing yards away from becoming the 11th Big South player with 2,000 in a career. Meanwhile, Liberty RB **ALDREAKIS ALLEN** is 12 rushing yards away from 1,000 in his career, while Gardner-Webb's **KENNY LITTLE** is 67 yards away from the milestone. Below is a look at the Big South Conference's active career 1,000-yard rushers and where they rank in League history.

MASTRO OF THE UNIVERSE

Coastal Carolina sophomore **NICCOLO MASTROMATTEO** is tied with Liberty's **WYNTON JACKSON** (2003-07) as the Big South's all-time leader with 43 career punt returns. Mastromatteo is fourth in League annals with 323 career punt return yards, 202 yards away from Jackson's Big South mark of 525. Meanwhile, Mastromatteo is fifth in Big South history with 85 combined kick returns in his brief career (42 KR, 43 PR). Former Gardner-Webb WR **TYSON PETTY** (2007-10) is fourth with 89.

CATCHING UP

Liberty redshirt-senior **CHRIS SUMMERS** is third in Big South history with 25 career touchdown receptions, and is five TD grabs shy of becoming the third player with 30. Summers is currently fourth in League history with 170 career catches and needs 18 receptions for the third spot. He became the sixth player in Big South history with 2,000 career receiving yards when he surpassed the milestone in Week 4 (now fifth at 2,388), and is 42 yards from moving into fourth all-time. Since the start of the 2010 season, Summers has 122 receptions, 1,771 yards and 21 touchdowns in 19 games played.

THAT'S A FACT, JACK

Stony Brook RB/KR **BROCK JACKOLSKI** is eighth in Big South history with 3,401 career all-purpose yards and is 194 away from seventh-place. Jackolski's per game average of 179.4 this season is pacing just behind the Big South single-season record of 179.5 (VMI's **TIM MAYPRAY** in 2007). Jackolski needs to average 180.0 all-purpose yards over the final three games to break Maypray's Big South single-season record of 1,975 yards.

LIBERTY'S 4x1,000-YARD RELAY TEAM

Liberty WR **PAT KELLY** surpassed 1,000 career receiving yards at Charleston Southern in Week 8, making Liberty the lone FCS program in the nation with four active players with 1,000 career receiving yards. The quartet is comprised of **CHRIS SUMMERS** (2,388), **B.J. HAYES** (1,091), Kelly (1,075) and **MIKE BROWN** (1,054).

GO LONG

Five of Liberty WR **PAT KELLY**'s seven career touchdown receptions have gone for 50-yards or longer. He had three last season (79 and 65 yards vs. Stony Brook on Nov. 20, and a 75-yarder vs. St. Francis, Pa., on Sept., 4), and has two this year (50-yarder vs. Coastal Carolina in Week 7 and 52 yards at Charleston Southern in Week 8).

BLUE HAZE

Presbyterian College rushed for a season-high 287 yards this past Saturday at Liberty, its highest rushing total in a Big South game since becoming official Conference opponents in 2009. It was the most rushing yards allowed by the Flames since James Madison rushed for 301 yards in 2009. PC RB **LANCE BYRD** gained 111 yards and QB **RYAN SINGER** had 108, marking the first time Liberty allowed two 100-yard rushers in a Big South game. The last time a pair of teammates rushed for 100 yards in the same game was in 2002, when VMI's **T.J. SNELLING** (125) and **SEAN MIZZER** (121) did so on Oct. 26, 2002 -- VMI's final season in the SoCon.

RHODIE

Gardner-Webb RB **RICKY RHODES** has thrown two touchdown passes this season out of the Wildcat formation. He is the Big South's first non-quarterback with two TD throws in a campaign since former Charleston Southern WR **GERALD STEVENSON** tossed two touchdown passes in 2010.

SKIFF AND WESSON

Stony Brook PK **WESLEY SKIFFINGTON**, who became the school's all-time kick scoring leader in Week 4, ranks seventh in Big South history with 186 career points kicking. He is 12 points away from sixth-place. Skiffington is the sixth kicker in League annals with 100 career PATs (102) and needs two field goals to become the sixth Big South kicker with 30 in a career.

TOTAL RECALL

Liberty QB **MIKE BROWN**, who has a Big South-record 13 career 300-total offense games, is now fourth in League history with 7,245 career yards of total offense after surpassing Coastal Carolina's **ZACH MACDOWALL** (7,139) and Liberty's **BROCK SMITH** (7,189) over the weekend. Brown is 627 yards away from third-place, which is held by Gardner-Webb's **NICK ROBERTS** (7,872 yards from 2002-05). Meanwhile, Brown's five 300-yard offensive games this year is fourth-most in a single-season in Big South history.

BIG BROWN

In his 20 career starts at quarterback, Brown has thrown for more than 200 yards a total of 19 times -- including 17 consecutive contests at one point. He is 401-of-616 passing (=65.1 percent) for 5,215 yards and 39 touchdowns, in addition to being 14-6.

BROWN DELIVERING TOUCHDOWN PASSES

Liberty QB **MIKE BROWN**, who became the sixth player in Big South history with 40 career touchdown passes when he eclipsed the milestone in Week 8, had his streak of consecutive games with at least two touchdown passes snapped at six this past weekend. That effort is tied for the top spot in Big South history. Brown has thrown a TD pass in each of his eight games played this season, and his personal streak of consecutive games with a touchdown pass now stands at 11. The last Big South QB with 11-straight games with a TD pass was Coastal Carolina's **TYLER THIGPEN**, who threw a touchdown pass in all 12 games of the 2006 season.

GROUND PACKAGE

Liberty QB **MIKE BROWN** remains fifth all-time in Big South history with 26 career rushing touchdowns and needs one to tie former Gardner-Webb rusher **PATRICK HALL**, who had 27 from 2007-10, for fourth-place. Brown's six rushing touchdowns this season are the fifth-most by a Big South quarterback in a single-season, and three away from matching his total from last year. The fifth player in Big South history with 1,000 career rushing yards at the quarterback position, Brown has rushed 286 times for 1,324 yards (4.63 average) and 16 scores starting under center. He is the Big South's third-leading all-time rusher among quarterbacks, and he is three rushing touchdowns away from tying the Conference's all-time mark for a QB (19 - Gardner-Webb's **NICK ROBERTS**, 2002-05).

YOU COMPLETE ME

Liberty QB **MIKE BROWN** is the Big South's all-time career leader for completion percentage at 64.7 percent (422-of-652). He recorded his fourth career 300-yard passing game in Week 6 at Gardner-Webb, the third-most in League history. Brown also threw three touchdown passes against the Runnin' Bulldogs, marking the fifth time in his career he has achieved the feat -- the fourth-most 3-TD pass games in Conference annals.

HEY NORM!

Coastal Carolina DB **JOSH NORMAN**, who became the Big South's all-time leader in career pass break-ups in Week 7, owns a record career total of 34. Norman remains second to former Chanticleer safety **QUINTON TEAL** (2003-06) in Conference annals with 46 passes defensed and 12 interceptions, as Teal holds the all-time marks of 48 PD and 17 INT.

THE IGNITOR

Liberty QB **MIKE BROWN** is the only player in Big South history with 1,000 career rushing yards (1,820), 1,000 career passing yards (5,425) and 1,000 career receiving yards (1,054).

HOW FAR DID IT FLY?

Gardner-Webb P **GRAHAM PURVIS** boomed an 85-yard punt this past weekend against Charleston Southern, the longest punt in Big South history and 12 yards longer than the previous record of 73 (GWU's **GRAHAM WHITLOCK** in 2002). Late in the fourth quarter, Purvis punted from his 15-yard line, and with the wind at his back, the kick sailed over CSU's returner and rolled into the end zone for a touchback. Purvis, who also had a 67-yard punt in the game, which is the sixth-longest punt in Conference history, finished the day with 11 punts for a Big South single-game record 497 yards -- a 45.2 yard average.

SINGING IN THE RAIN

Presbyterian College QB **RYAN SINGER** scored a 74-yard rushing touchdown at Liberty this past weekend, his second career rushing score of at least 70 yards -- with both coming against the Flames. Singer is the second quarterback in Big South history with two runs of 70 yards-or-longer, joining former Coastal Carolina QB **TYLER THIGPEN**, who had a 77-yarder for a score against VMI in 2005 and a 76-yard rush at Gardner-Webb in 2006. Meanwhile, Singer became the seventh different quarterback in Big South history with 100 passing yards and 100 rushing yards in the same game with his 114 passing, 108 rushing performance this past Saturday at Liberty.

30 BROCK

Stony Brook RB/KR **BROCK JACKOLSKI** is the second player in Big South history with 1,000 career rushing yards (1,856) and 1,000 career kickoff return yards (1,314). He joins VMI's **TIM MAYPRAY**, who had 2,456 rushing yards and 2,181 kickoff return yards from 2006-09. Jackolski, who is also one of three players in League annals with two 90-yard kickoff returns, is fifth on the Big South's career kickoff return yards list.

HIGH DENSITY FOGG

Liberty kick returner **KEVIN FOGG** returned his second kickoff for a touchdown this season in Week 8, becoming the fourth player in Big South history with two kickoff return touchdowns in one season. Fogg is averaging 34.0 yards on his kickoff returns, which is 2.0 yards ahead of the Big South single-season record of 32.0, which was set by Liberty's **DOMINIC BOLDEN** in 2007.

PICK 12

Liberty returned two interceptions for touchdowns at Charleston Southern in Week 8, a first in Big South history. **KAJUAN LEE** had the Flames' first pick six with a 100-yard interception return for a score in the second quarter -- the second 100-yard INT return in Conference history. A few minutes later, **SCOTT HYLAND** notched a 22-yard interception return for a touchdown. Liberty finished the day with four interceptions for a Big South single-game record 158 return yards.

BEVINS IS THE BIG SOUTH'S CAREER SCORING LEADER

Liberty All-American PK **MATT BEVINS** made 5-of-5 PATs and 1-of-1 FG at Charleston Southern in Week 8 to push his career scoring total to 305 points -- becoming the all-time scoring leader in Big South history. Bevins entered the game tied with former Coastal Carolina kicker **JOSH HOKE** (2003-06) with 297 points. Meanwhile, Bevins remains second among active FCS kickers in career field goals with a Big South-record 58 -- two away from becoming just the 12th kicker in the classification's history with 60 career field goals. Bevins, whose 11 career 10-point kicking games is most in League history, is second in Big South history with 131 career PATs.

TAKING ATTENDANCE

Through 27 home dates, the Big South's seven football playing members are averaging a combined 7,478 fans per game, which is pacing just behind the Conference's record attendance average of 7,488 in 2007. Liberty leads the Big South with its 16,250 per game average, and Coastal Carolina, Gardner-Webb and Presbyterian College are all posting average attendance gains over last season. The Conference needs to draw 59,106 during its remaining 10 home dates (=5,911 average) to break the all-time combined total home attendance record of 260,998 that was established in 2008.

RIGHT OF PASSAGE

Gardner-Webb freshman kicker **TREVER AUSTIN** tied a Big South single-game record in Week 8 with four field goals -- including a game-winning 31-yarder, at Coastal Carolina. Austin is the fourth freshman (true or redshirt) in Big South history to kick four field goals in a game, which has now been accomplished 11 times by seven different kickers.

MEET THE CANDIDATES

The Big South currently has two candidates for the top individual awards in FCS. Liberty QB **MIKE BROWN** is a candidate for the Walter Payton Award (offense), while Presbyterian College DB **JUSTIN BETHEL** was a midseason addition to the Buck Buchanan Award (defense) on Oct. 4. A national panel of sports information and media relations directors, broadcasters, writers and other dignitaries will vote on the Payton and Buchanan awards after the regular season, beginning Nov. 21.

* Charleston Southern meets Stony Brook for the fourth time on Saturday. The Seawolves lead the series, 2-1.

* The Buccaneers last defeated Stony Brook in 2009, a 30-27 overtime win at home on Nov. 14.

* Charleston Southern has not scored in the first quarter in its last nine games, dating back to last season.

* Conversely, the Bucs have scored 73.8 percent of their points this season (76 of 103) in the second half.

* The Buccaneers' 7-0 second quarter lead over Gardner-Webb was their first lead of the season.

* The CSU defense allowed a season-low 237 yards of offense at Gardner-Webb, despite losing leading tackler **CHRIS KUZDALE** in the first half. They also allowed just 84 rushing yards, marking another season low.

* QB **RICHARD MOUNCE** had a season-high 28 rushing attempts and season-high 39 pass attempts at Gardner-Webb. The 28 rushing attempts is the second-most in a single-game in school and Big South history.

* **MIKE DAVIS** has caught a touchdown pass in back-to-back games and is now tied for the team lead with two TD receptions.

* Freshman **JAMES SMITH** tallied a career-high five tackles at Gardner-Webb and also led the team with 2.5 TFL of 12 yards.

* Coastal Carolina meets Presbyterian for the fifth time on Saturday. The Chanticleers lead the series, 3-1.

* The Chants are looking to avoid their first four-loss Big South season since 2008, and second overall.

* Coastal Carolina has lost three-straight games for just the third time in the program's nine-year history. The Chanticleers have never lost four consecutive games in a single-season.

* Coastal is now 4-15 all-time when playing on artificial surfaces and below .500 (24-25) when playing on the road.

* Stony Brook's 446 rushing yards was the second-most allowed by Coastal in school history.

* CCU's 73 yards of total offense at Stony Brook was the lowest in school history and the first time Coastal had been held below 100 yards of offense.

* Coastal Carolina gained 64 yards (on 16 plays) on its opening drive, then gained no more than five yards on any ensuing drive.

* Due to the adverse weather conditions -- 37 degrees, swirling winds, rain and snow -- neither team threw for a first down, a first for either side of the ball for Coastal.

* RB **TRAVIS SMALL** accounted for more than half of Coastal's 73 yards of offense at SBU, as he rushed for 41 yards and had five receiving yards. Small has been the Chanticleers' leading rusher the past three games.
