Jackolski set a Big South single-game record with five touchdowns and 30 points scored in Stony Brook's record-setting 76-28 win over Gardner-Webb. He rushed for four touchdowns -- tying a single-game League record, and caught a TD pass while amassing 192 all-purpose yards. Jackolski returned the opening kickoff 78 yards and later scored from 1-yard out to give the Seawolves an early 7-0 lead. He added an 18-yard scoring run and 7-yard touchdown catch in the second quarter, and capped his day with touchdown runs of 53 and 30 yards in the fourth quarter.

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

George had a career-high seven tackles in Coastal's 45-38 win at Charleston Southern, in addition to an interception, one quarterback sack and a forced fumble. After the Chanticleers threw an interception in the second quarter, George recorded a sack-fumble on the very next play that CCU recovered and returned to the 15-yard line. With less than a minute remaining and Coastal clinging to its seven-point lead, George picked off a pass at the Chants' 1-yard line and returned it 16 yards to seal the win over the Buccaneers.

NOV. 19 IS BIG SOUTH FOOTBALL CHAMPIONSHIP SATURDAY

This Saturday's season-finale between 5-0 Liberty and 5-0 Stony Brook will decide the Big South's automatic qualifier to the FCS playoffs. For the first time in League history, the Big South has two teams 5-0 in Conference play, and an undefeated, outright champion will be crowned for the first time since 2008 and seventh time in the 10-year history of Big South football. Liberty is going for its record fifth consecutive Big South title, while Stony Brook is looking to capture its third-straight League crown. The winner will also receive its first-ever playoff berth.

HIGH FIVE

Liberty is 5-0 in Big South play for the first time since 2009 and third time overall, as the Flames also finished 5-0 during its 2008 Big South Championship season. It is the fourth-straight season a Big South team has opened 5-0 in League play. Stony Brook is 5-0 for the second-straight year. Liberty or Stony Brook will be the first team in Conference annals with six Big South wins in a season.

TALE OF THE TAPE

Stony Brook and Liberty are currently the top two teams in scoring offense and scoring defense in Conference games. The Seawolves are averaging 50.4 points and holding League foes to 19.4 points, while the Flames are second in scoring offense with 40.0 points and tied at 19.4 points allowed. Stony Brook's average winning margin in Big South games is 31.0 points, while Liberty's margin in League wins is 20.6.

CHAMPIONSHIPS ARE WON IN NOVEMBER

Four-time Big South football champion Liberty is 21-8 (=72.4 percent) since 2002 during the month of November, while two-time champ Stony Brook is 7-3 in November since joining the Big South in 2008. Two-time champion Coastal Carolina is 21-6 (=77.8) in its history in regular-season games in November. In fact, the Chanticleers are the only Big South member to win a game in November every season since 2003.

BROCK OF AGES

Stony Brook's **BROCK JACKOLSKI** became the first player in League history to score five touchdowns in a game when he accomplished the feat this past Saturday at Gardner-Webb. Jackolski scored four rushing touchdowns and caught a TD pass in the win. He had SBU's third game with four rushing scores this season, which pushed his career total at Stony Brook to 21 -- now tied for 10th all-time in Big South history.

STONY BROOK SETS BIG SOUTH SINGLE-GAME SCORING RECORD

Stony Brook's 76 points at Gardner-Webb this past Saturday broke the Big South single-game scoring record of 73 points, which was established by Liberty in the Flames' 73-34 win over VMI on Nov. 10, 2007. The Seawolves are the third team to score 70 points in a Conference game in League history, joining Liberty (2007) and Coastal Carolina (2010). Stony Brook has scored at least 40 points in a Conference record six-straight games, and is the first team in League annals with five-straight 40-point games in Big South contests. The previous record in both categories was three games. In their past six games, the Seawolves are averaging 49.1 points (50.4 in Conference games).

2,000 RUSHING ODYSSEY

Stony Brook RB **MIGUEL MAYSONET** became the 10th player in Big South history with 2,000 career rushing yards when he surpassed the milestone in Week 9 against Coastal Carolina. Teammate **BROCK JACKOLSKI** became the 11th player to reach the benchmark in Week 10. Maysonet currently stands seventh at 2,455 and needs two rushing yards to pass VMI's **TIM MAYPRAY** (2,456 from 2006-09) for sixth-place, as well as 26 yards to crack the League's all-time Top 5. Jackolski is currently 11th with 2,137 and is 78 yards away from 10th place.

MIGUEL'S MAYSONRY

Stony Brook RB **MIGUEL MAYSONET** is the Big South's leading rusher with 1,327 yards -- third-most in a single-season in Big South history. He needs 21 yards for second and is 174 away from breaking the single-season record of 1,500 that was set by Liberty's **RASHAD JENNINGS** in 2008. Maysonet, who is just the third player in Conference history with consecutive 1,000-yard rushing seasons, is looking to win back-to-back Big South rushing titles for the first time in the Conference since Liberty's **DRE BARNES** in 2002 and 2003. Meanwhile, Maysonet's 14 rushing touchdowns this season are three away from Jennings' single-season mark of 17 in '08.

RUNNING IN THE QUAD

Stony Brook RB **MIGUEL MAYSONET** recorded his second 4-touchdown game of the season with his four rushing scores at Charleston Southern in Week 10. He is the first player in Big South history with two 4-touchdown games in a season, and now owns a League-record three 4-TD games in his career. Maysonet's five career games with at least three touchdowns in a game is second-most in Conference annals and two away from tying the mark of seven, which is held by Liberty's **RASHAD JENNINGS**.

“I’LL TAKE FOOTBALL GAMES FOR 100 PLEASE, ALEX”

Charleston Southern head coach **JAY MILLS** will coach his 100th game at the helm of the Buccaneers this Saturday when CSU faces Presbyterian College in the season finale. In addition, VMI will play its 100th game as Big South members this weekend when the Keydets host Gardner-Webb Saturday afternoon. In Week 10, Coastal Carolina and head coach **DAVID BENNETT** played the 100th game in program history, and the Chanticleers were victorious in the milestone contest with their 15-8 win over Presbyterian College.

WOLF DEN

Stony Brook has won nine consecutive home Big South games -- the second-longest streak in Conference history and trailing Liberty’s current 15-game span. The Seawolves have scored 351 points during their string (39.0 points per game), have scored more than 30 points in seven contests -- including the last four over 40, and have held the Conference membership to 140 points (15.6). The last Big South team to defeat Stony Brook inside LaValle Stadium was Gardner-Webb on Nov. 1, 2008 (34-33).

BURNING UP THE HOUSE

Liberty owns a Big South-record 15-game home Conference win streak, and has swept its home Big South schedule for the fifth consecutive season. During this stretch, the Flames have scored 681 points (45.4 points per game), scored more than 30 points in 14 contests, and has held its League brethren to 274 points (18.2). The last Big South team to defeat Liberty inside Williams Stadium was Gardner-Webb on Oct. 21, 2006 (27-24).

BROCK ALLEN

Stony Brook RB **BROCK JACKOLSKI** has scored a touchdown in his last six games (13 total), the longest consecutive streak in the Big South since former Coastal Carolina QB **ZACH MacDOWALL** rushed for a touchdown in the final six games of the 2010 regular-season. Meanwhile, Liberty RB **ALDREAKIS ALLEN** has scored a touchdown in his last five games, crossing the goal line seven times in that span.

POLL POSITION

Liberty is ranked No. 16 this week in both the FCS Coaches poll and *Sports Network* rankings. The Big South has had a team ranked 10 out of 12 weeks this season, and has had two different teams nationally-ranked this year (Liberty and Coastal Carolina), the second time in League history two Big South teams were ranked in the same season.

DASH AND MASH

Stony Brook RBs **BROCK JACKOLSKI** and **MIGUEL MAYSONET** have scored touchdowns in the same game five times this season (all wins) and 10 times overall since joining the Seawolves in 2010. SBU is 9-1 in those games (8-0 in Big South contests), with the two combining for an astonishing 40 scores (Maysonet - 20, Jackolski - 20).

BIG TIME RUSH

Stony Brook (315) and Gardner-Webb (248) combined for 563 rushing yards this past Saturday, the most in a Conference game since Stony Brook and VMI combined for 811 rushing yards on Nov. 15, 2008. That day, the Seawolves rushed for 447 yards while the Keydets amassed 364 yards on the ground.

LIGHTING UP THE SCOREBOARD

Stony Brook (76) and Gardner-Webb (28) combined for 104 points this past Saturday, the second-most combined points in a game in Big South history. The record is 107, which has been accomplished twice -- first by Gardner-Webb (55) and VMI (52) on Oct. 22, 2005, and matched by Liberty (73) and VMI (34) on Nov. 10, 2007.

NEW YORK STATE OF MIND

Stony Brook enters the season-finale averaging 50.4 points in Conference games, the highest scoring average against Big South competition in League history. The current record is 47.8 points, set by Liberty in 2007 during a four-game Conference slate. Stony Brook’s 252 points in Big South games this season is the second-most scored in a campaign, trailing Liberty’s record 271 in six League contests in 2009.

BIG SOUTH BICENTENNIALS

Big South teammates have rushed for 100 yards in the same game eight times this year -- a Conference single-season record. Stony Brook has done so three times, while Presbyterian College and Gardner-Webb have two such games to their credit, followed by Charleston Southern. The previous record for most times teammates rushed for 100 yards in a game was six games in 2004 and 2008. Meanwhile, Stony Brook’s tandem of **MIGUEL MAYSONET** and **BROCK JACKOLSKI** have rushed for 100 yards in the same game a total of six times since 2010.

SOLO ARTISTS

Presbyterian College DB **JUSTIN BETHEL**, the Big South's all-time leader with nine blocked kicks, collected his second Big South career record this past weekend as he broke the all-time mark for solo tackles. Bethel's career total of 196 surpassed the previous record of 195 that was established by Charleston Southern LB **JADA ROSS** from 2004-07. Meanwhile, Gardner-Webb LB **MARTY PATTERSON**, who moved into the career Top 10 in Week 7, is third in League history with 171 career solo tackles.

SINGING IN THE RAIN

Presbyterian College QB **RYAN SINGER** posted his second game this season with 100 passing yards and 100 rushing yards, as he totaled 182 yards through the air and 106 on the ground in PC's win over VMI this past Saturday. He is just the second QB in Big South history to accomplish this feat twice in a season, joining Liberty's **MIKE BROWN**, who did so twice in 2010. Singer is now the fourth different quarterback with two career games with at least 100 yards rushing and 100 yards passing.

BIG SOUTH'S 300-30 TACKLE CLUB

Gardner-Webb LB **MARTY PATTERSON** became the third player in Big South history with 300 career tackles and 30 career TFL when he surpassed the total tackle milestone in Week 10. Patterson, who is the fourth Runnin' Bulldog on the Conference's 300-tackle list and 10th overall, enters the season finale with 312 career stops and 35.0 TFL. His fellow club members are Charleston Southern LB **JADA ROSS** (2004-07), who had a Big South career record 454 stops in addition to 32.5 tackles-for-loss, and VMI's **A.J. GROSS**, who is fifth all-time in League annals with 341 tackles to go along with his 34.5 TFL. Gross needs eight tackles in the season-finale against Gardner-Webb to end his career as the Big South's third-leading all-time tackler.

GROUND CHUCK

Stony Brook RB duo **MIGUEL MAYSONET** (1,327) and **BROCK JACKOLSKI** (1,108) are the first set of teammates in Big South history to rush for 1,000 yards in back-to-back seasons. In 2010, Maysonet had 1,128 and Jackolski gained 1,029. The tandem has combined for 2,435 rushing yards this season – second-most in League annals. The most rushing yards by two teammates in Big South history is 2,505, set by former SBU backs **EDWIN GOWINS** (1,310) and **CONTE CUTTINO** (1,195) in 2008.

FLOCK OF SEAWOLVES

Stony Brook has tied the Big South single-season record by holding seven opponents under 100 yards rushing in a contest. The Seawolves join Gardner-Webb and Liberty, who both accomplished the feat in 2008. Stony Brook's rushing defense average of 94.8 ranks eighth in the nation and is pacing ahead of the Big South single-season record of 108.8, set by Charleston Southern in 2006.

HIGH DENSITY FOGG

Liberty kick returner **KEVIN FOGG** returned his third kickoff for a touchdown in Week 10, tying the Big South single-season record first established by Charleston Southern's **GERALD STEVENSON** in 2010. Fogg is averaging a national-best 34.9 yards on his kickoff returns, which is 2.9 yards ahead of the Big South single-season record of 32.0, which was set by Liberty's **DOMINIC BOLDEN** in 2007.

MASTRO OF THE UNIVERSE

Coastal Carolina sophomore **NICCOLO MASTROMATTEO** became the Big South's all-time leader for punt returns this past weekend, as his two returns at Charleston Southern pushed his career total to 45, breaking the old mark of 43 that was set by Liberty's **WYNTON JACKSON** (2003-07). Mastromatteo is fourth in League annals with 333 career punt return yards, 192 yards away from Jackson's Big South mark of 525. Meanwhile, Mastromatteo is fourth in Big South history with 91 combined kick returns in his brief career (46 KR, 45 PR). Former Liberty Flame **ADRIAN HALL** (2002-04) is third with 94.

CATCHING UP

Liberty redshirt-senior **CHRIS SUMMERS** is third in Big South history with 26 career touchdown receptions, and is four TD grabs shy of becoming the third player with 30. Summers is currently fourth in League history with 178 career catches and needs 10 receptions for the third spot. He became the sixth player in Big South history with 2,000 career receiving yards when he surpassed the milestone in Week 4 (now fourth at 2,472), and is 81 yards from moving into third all-time. Since the start of the 2010 season, Summers has 130 receptions, 1,855 yards and 22 touchdowns in 20 games played.

THAT'S A FACT, JACK

Stony Brook RB/KR **BROCK JACKOLSKI** needs 164 all-purpose yards in the season finale against Liberty to break the Big South single-season record of 1,975, which was set by VMI's **TIM MAYPRAY** in 2007. Jackolski's current per-game average of 181.2 yards is pacing ahead of Maypray's single-season mark of 179.5 in that same season. Meanwhile, Jackolski is sixth in Big South history with 3,778 career all-purpose yards and is five away from fifth-place. He is 222 yards shy of becoming the fifth player in League annals with 4,000 all-purpose yards.

DEJA VU ALL OVER AGAIN

One week after Charleston Southern WR **NATHAN PERERA** had 232 receiving yards on 10 catches against Stony Brook, teammate **CORVAUGHN ARCHIE** amassed 204 receiving yards on 11 receptions this past weekend against Coastal Carolina. With that, the Buccaneers are the first Big South team in League history to have two players with 200 receiving yards in a game in the same season. Archie's effort marks just the seventh 200 receiving yard game in Conference annals.

MOUNCE BY MOUNCE

Charleston Southern QB **RICHARD MOUNCE** amassed 432 yards of total offense this past Saturday against Coastal Carolina, tied for the fifth-highest single-game total in Big South history. It was the Conference's first game 400-yard total offense game this season, and the 10th overall in League annals. Mounce threw for career-highs for the second consecutive week with 397 passing yards and four touchdown passes against the Chanticleers -- the fourth-highest single-game passing yardage in the Big South record books. Since replacing injured starting quarterback **MALCOLM DIXON** in the Liberty game four games ago, Mounce has 74 pass completions for 1,101 yards (=14.88 yards per completion) with 10 touchdown passes in that span, in addition to averaging 305.3 yards of total offense.

OH, THERE YOU ARE PERRY

Gardner-Webb redshirt-senior WR **JAMES PERRY III** is the Big South's all-time receptions leader with 220 career catches. He is fourth among active players in career receptions in the Football Championship Subdivision. Perry, who broke the League's receptions record in Week 6 against Liberty, is second in League history with 2,629 career receiving yards, and he needs 92 to break the Big South career record in that category. The current record is 2,720 yards set by former Coastal Carolina WR **JEROME SIMPSON** from 2004-07.

BACK TO THE FUTURE

Coastal Carolina enters the season finale with a chance for its best overall record since its 2006 playoff season. A win Saturday at Western Carolina would give the Chanticleers a 7-4 overall record this year, which would be their best finish since going 9-3 five years ago. It would also be the program's fourth seven-win season.

SKIFF AND WESSON

Stony Brook PK **WESLEY SKIFFINGTON** was 10-of-10 on his PAT attempts this past Saturday at Gardner-Webb, tying the Big South single-game record for most PATs and becoming the third kicker in League history to make 10-of-10 PATs in a game. The effort pushed Skiffington's career scoring total to 202 points, good for sixth-place on the Conference's all-time kick scoring list. His 118 career PATs is tied for fourth on the Big South's career chart.

MIKE BROWN, WE SALUTE YOU

Liberty QB **MIKE BROWN** will play the final Big South game of his stellar career this Saturday when the Flames meet Stony Brook. Here is a look at Brown's performance in 22 games against the Conference since 2008, in which he helped Liberty to a 20-2 record in that span:

LITTLE BIG MAN

Gardner-Webb RB **KENNY LITTLE** needs exactly 100 yards for 1,000 rushing yards this season, which would make him the first GWU back to rush for 1,000 yards as Big South members. The last Runnin' Bulldog to rush for 1,000 yards in a campaign was **JUSTIN RICHARDSON** in 2000.

TOTAL RECALL

Liberty QB **MIKE BROWN**, who has a Big South-record 14 career 300-total offense games, is fourth in League history with 7,564 career yards of total offense. He is 309 yards away from third-place, which is held by Gardner-Webb's **NICK ROBERTS** (7,872 yards from 2002-05). Meanwhile, Brown's six 300-yard offensive games this year is tied for third-most in a single-season in Big South history.

BIG BROWN

In his 21 career starts at quarterback, Liberty's **MIKE BROWN** has thrown for more than 200 yards a total of 20 times -- including a string of 17 consecutive contests. He is 425-of-650 passing (=65.4 percent) for 5,501 yards (262.0 per start) and 41 touchdowns as a starter, in addition to being 15-6.

HIGH TIDE

Coastal Carolina RB **MARCUS WHITENER** rushed for 106 yards at Charleston Southern this past Saturday, the first Chanticleer running back with a 100-yard rushing game since **ERIC O'NEAL** rushed for 102 yards against Liberty last season on Nov. 13. It was Coastal's second 100-yard rushing game of the season, as QB **ARAMIS HILLARY** rushed for 114 yards against VMI on Oct. 8.

IT'S ACADEMIC

For the fifth time in the Big South's 10-year football history, the Conference has at least four players named to the CoSIDA Academic All-District Team. Liberty teammates **PATRICK KELLY** and **MATT BEVINS** were honored in District III, while Coastal Carolina's **MARCUS LOTT** and Charleston Southern's **KIRBY BROOME** were honored in District IV. All four student-athletes move onto the national ballot for Academic All-America.

BROWN DELIVERING TOUCHDOWN PASSES

Liberty QB **MIKE BROWN**, who became the sixth player in Big South history with 40 career touchdown passes when he eclipsed the milestone in Week 8, has thrown a TD pass in each of his nine games played this season, and his personal streak of consecutive games with a touchdown pass now stands at 12. The last Big South QB with 12-straight games with a TD pass was Coastal Carolina's **TYLER THIGPEN**, who threw a touchdown pass in all 12 games of the 2006 season. Brown's streak of consecutive games with at least two touchdown passes was snapped at six in Week 9, and that effort is tied for the top spot in Big South history.

GROUND PACKAGE

Liberty QB **MIKE BROWN** is tied for fourth all-time in Big South history with 27 career rushing touchdowns. Brown's seven rushing touchdowns this season are the fourth-most by a Big South quarterback in a single-season, and two away from matching his total from last year. The fifth player in Big South history with 1,000 career rushing yards at the quarterback position, Brown has rushed 298 times for 1,357 yards (4.55 average) and 17 scores starting under center. He is the Big South's third-leading all-time rusher among quarterbacks, and he is two rushing touchdowns away from tying the Conference's all-time mark for a QB (19 - Gardner-Webb's **NICK ROBERTS**, 2002-05).

YOU COMPLETE ME

Liberty QB **MIKE BROWN** is the Big South's all-time career leader for completion percentage at 65.0 percent (446-of-686). He recorded his fourth career 300-yard passing game in Week 6 at Gardner-Webb, the third-most in League history. Brown also threw three touchdown passes against the Runnin' Bulldogs, marking the fifth time in his career he has achieved the feat -- the fourth-most 3-TD pass games in Conference annals.

HEY NORM!

Coastal Carolina DB **JOSH NORMAN** collected his second career defensive record this past weekend, as he is now tied with former Chanticleer safety **QUINTON TEAL** (2003-06) as the Big South's all-time leader with 48 career passes defended. Norman became the Big South's career record holder for career pass break-ups in Week 7, and now owns 35 deflections and 13 career interceptions. Teal holds the all-time record for interceptions with 17.

THE IGNITOR

Liberty QB **MIKE BROWN** is the only player in Big South history with 1,000 career rushing yards (1,853), 1,000 career passing yards (5,711) and 1,000 career receiving yards (1,054).

The NCAA does not list reclassifying teams in its overall statistics listings, therefore, Presbyterian College will not be ranked in the NCAA statistics again this season.

50-50 PROPOSITION

With 54 pass receptions this year, Liberty WR **CHRIS SUMMERS** is the seventh player in Big South history with two 50-catch seasons. He needs six receptions to become just the third player in League annals with two 60-reception campaigns. Meanwhile, Gardner-Webb WR **JAMES PERRY III** needs 11 catches to become the first player in Conference history with four 50-reception seasons.

BEVINS IS THE BIG SOUTH'S CAREER SCORING LEADER

Liberty All-American PK **MATT BEVINS** is the Big South's all-time scoring leader with 305 points. Despite missing considerable time this season with an injury, he remains second among active FCS kickers in career field goals with a Big South-record 58 -- two away from becoming just the 12th kicker in the classification's history with 60 career field goals.

POINT OF ORDER

Liberty holds the Big South record for most consecutive games with a point scored at 73, having broken the old mark of 67 earlier this year that was first established by Coastal Carolina from 2003-08. Meanwhile, Presbyterian College has not been shutout in its last 62 games (44 as official Big South members), followed by Gardner-Webb (43), Stony Brook (37) and VMI (18).

DOUBLED UP

Liberty owns the Conference record for most consecutive Big South games scoring in double figures at 33. Stony Brook has the next-longest active streak at 21 games. Meanwhile, the Flames have scored in all 45 of their Conference games since 2002, while VMI has tallied points in all 42 of its League contests since joining the Big South in 2003. Presbyterian College is the final Conference member to have not been shut out in a League contest (17 games).

MARGINAL NOTE

Eleven of the 18 Big South Conference games this season have been decided by double figures (=61.1 percent), including eight by at least 20 points, and the average winning margin currently sits at 19.7 points. Last year, the 21 Conference football games were decided by 20.8 points.

LIBERTY'S 4x1,000-YARD RELAY TEAM

Liberty WR **PAT KELLY** surpassed 1,000 career receiving yards at Charleston Southern in Week 8, making Liberty the lone FCS program in the nation with four active players with 1,000 career receiving yards. The quartet is comprised of **CHRIS SUMMERS** (2,472), **B.J. HAYES** (1,131), **Kelly** (1,180) and **MIKE BROWN** (1,054).

GO LONG

Five of Liberty WR **PAT KELLY**'s seven career touchdown receptions have gone for 50-yards or longer. He had three last season (79 and 65 yards vs. Stony Brook on Nov. 20, and a 75-yarder vs. St. Francis, Pa., on Sept., 4), and has two this year (50-yarder vs. Coastal Carolina in Week 7 and 52 yards at Charleston Southern in Week 8).

BENNETT TO COACH IN FCS ALL-STAR GAME

Coastal Carolina head coach **DAVID BENNETT** will serve as the head coach of the South squad in the second annual FCS Senior Scout Bowl, it was announced Nov. 7. The game will be held Dec. 17 at Doug Show Memorial Stadium in Myrtle Beach, S.C. Bennett is the first Big South coach to be selected as a coach for a postseason All-Star game.

RUNNIN' BULLDOGS ALLOW FEWEST NET RUSHING YARDS IN SINGLE-GAME

Gardner-Webb limited Virginia State to minus-25 net rushing yards in Week 10, a Big South single-game record for fewest net rushing yards allowed in a contest. The previous record was minus-20, which was established by Liberty against Kentucky Wesleyan on Sept. 20, 2003.

SEAWOLVES ALLOW FEWEST NET RUSHING YARDS IN CONFERENCE GAME

One week after allowing the fewest total offensive yards in a Big South game (73 to Coastal Carolina in Week 9), the Stony Brook Seawolves set the League record for lowest net rushing yards allowed in a Conference contest in Week 10 after holding Charleston Southern to minus-7 yards on the ground on 32 carries. The previous low was minus-1 yard, which was established by Liberty against the Buccaneers on Nov. 1, 2003.

MEET THE CANDIDATES

The Big South currently has two candidates for the top individual awards in FCS. Liberty QB **MIKE BROWN** is a candidate for the Walter Payton Award (offense), while Presbyterian College DB **JUSTIN BETHEL** was a midseason addition to the Buck Buchanan Award (defense) on Oct. 4. A national panel of sports information and media relations directors, broadcasters, writers and other dignitaries will vote on the Payton and Buchanan awards after the regular season, beginning Nov. 21.
