STONY BROOK RALLIES FROM 18 DOWN TO DEFEAT ALBANY IN PLAYOFFS, 31-28

Big South champion Stony Brook rallied from a 28-10 deficit to defeat Albany in the first round of the FCS Playoffs with a 31-28 victory this past Saturday -- becoming the first Big South football program to win a playoff game and advance to the second round of the postseason. RB **BROCK JACKOLSKI** scored three-straight touchdowns to bring the Seawolves back from 18 points down.

SEAWOLVES TO FACE NO. 1 SAM HOUSTON STATE IN THE SECOND ROUND

Stony Brook will be the first Big South member to play in the month of December and 13 games in a season, as the Seawolves' next playoff opponent is the current No. 1-ranked team and overall No. 1 seed Sam Houston State Bearkats this Saturday at 3:00pm ET on ESPN3. It will be the second time the Big South will play the nation's No. 1 team in the playoffs, and the fifth time overall in League history. The Big South is 1-3 all-time against the No. 1 team in the country. Meanwhile, it will be the third time a Conference member will play Sam Houston State. Gardner-Webb owns the previous two meetings against the Bearkats, both losses.

CLASH OF RANKED TEAMS

Saturday's Stony Brook-Sam Houston State playoff game will be the eighth time in Conference history that a ranked Big South member will play a ranked non-Conference opponent. The Big South is 2-5 in the previous seven games, with the five losses being by an average of 8.8 points -- including the last three meetings decided by seven points-or-less.

SEA-ING IS BELIEVING

Stony Brooks enters the second round of the FCS Playoffs as the nation's No. 2 team in scoring offense with an average of 38.9 points per game. The Seawolves scored 40 points in a League record seven-straight games from Oct. 8 - Nov. 19, and is the first team in Conference annals with six-straight 40-point games in Big South contests. Meanwhile, Stony Brook's current streak of nine-straight games with 30 points matches the all-time Big South record first set by Liberty (Sept. 29, 2007 - Sept. 6, 2008).

WAS THAT A NINER I JUST HEARD?

Stony Brook's nine wins this season is a school record, and is tied for the second-most in a season in Big South history. The Seawolves have won their nine games all in succession, which is tied for the longest in-season win streak in Conference annals (Charleston Southern won nine-straight in 2006), as well as tied for the fourth overall win streak in the Big South record books.

TOP OF THE MORNING TO YA

The Seawolves' nine-game win streak is currently tied as the second-longest in FCS, and SBU is averaging 46.2 points in that span. Stony Brook is one of three undefeated Conference champions in the FCS Playoffs, along with Lehigh (5-0/Patriot) and Sam Houston State (7-0/Southland). The Big South entered the Nov. 19 season-finale as the only League with two undefeated teams in Conference play.

STONY BROOK CLAIMS OUTRIGHT BIG SOUTH CHAMPIONSHIP, AUTOMATIC BID

Stony Brook won its first outright Big South Championship and third consecutive Conference title with its 41-31 victory over Liberty in the season finale on Nov. 19 to become the first team in Big South history to go 6-0 in League play. Stony Brook is the Big South's first undefeated outright champion since 2008. The Seawolves are in the midst of their first-ever postseason appearance.

POLL POSITION

For the first time in school history, Stony Brook is a nationally-ranked program, as the Big South champion Seawolves are currently ranked No. 22 in the *Sports Network* poll and No. 24 in the FCS Coaches ranking. Meanwhile, Liberty is ranked No. 24 in the *Sports Network* poll and No. 23 in the Coaches poll, marking the second time in Big South history that two members were nationally-ranked in the same week. Coupled with Coastal Carolina's Top 25 ranking in the FCS Coaches poll the weeks of Oct. 3 and 10, it is the first time in Big South history that three members were ranked in the Top 25 in the same season.

THIRD BROCK FROM THE SUN

Stony Brook RB **BROCK JACKOLSKI** has scored 19 touchdowns and 114 points this season, tying the Big South single-season records in both categories that was first set by Liberty's **RASHAD JENNINGS** in 2008. Jackolski has scored a touchdown in his last eight games (18 total), the longest consecutive streak in the Big South since Jennings scored a touchdown in nine-straight games in 2008. Jackolski has four-straight multi-touchdown games, the second-longest streak in League history.

DASH AND MASH

Stony Brook RBs **BROCK JACKOLSKI** and **MIGUEL MAYSONET** have scored touchdowns in the same game six times this season (all wins) and 11 times overall since joining the Seawolves in 2010. SBU is 10-1 in those games (9-0 in Big South contests), with the two combining for an astonishing 43 scores (Jackolski - 22, Maysonet - 21).

MIGUEL'S MAYSONRY

Stony Brook RB **MIGUEL MAYSONET** owns the Big South single-season rushing record, as his 1,560 rushing yards this season has broken the previous mark of 1,500 that was set by former Liberty RB **RASHAD JENNINGS** in 2008. Maysonet, who is just the third player in Conference history with consecutive 1,000-yard rushing seasons, is on his way to capturing back-to-back Big South rushing titles for the first time in the Conference since Liberty's **DRE BARNES** in 2002 and 2003. Meanwhile, Maysonet's and teammate **BROCK JACKOLSKI**'s 15 rushing touchdowns this season are two away from Jennings' single-season mark of 17 in '08.

GROUND CHUCK

Stony Brook RB duo **MIGUEL MAYSONET** (1,560) and **BROCK JACKOLSKI** (1,332) are the first set of teammates in Big South history to rush for 1,200 yards in the same season. It is the second-straight year the duo has rushed for 1,000 each, as Maysonet had 1,128 rushing yards in 2010 and Jackolski gained 1,029 last season. The tandem's combined rushing total of 2,892 this season is the most in League annals. The previous record for most rushing yards by two Big South teammates was 2,505, set by former SBU backs **EDWIN GOWINS** (1,310) and **CONTE CUTTINO** (1,195) in 2008.

FLOCK OF SEAWOLVES

Stony Brook held Albany to 82 net rushing yards this past Saturday, its eighth game this season holding opponents under 100 yards rushing and establishing a Big South single-season record. The Seawolves were tied with Gardner-Webb and Liberty, who both held seven opponents under 100 rushing yards in 2008. Stony Brook's rushing defense average of 94.25 ranks ninth in the nation and is pacing ahead of the Big South single-season record of 108.8, set by Charleston Southern in 2006.

JACK-OF-ALL-TRADES

Stony Brook RB/KR **BROCK JACKOLSKI** is the Big South's single-season record holder for all-purpose yards with 2,286 this season. He is the first to amass more than 2,000 yards in a campaign, and in the Nov. 19 regular-season finale broke the previous mark of 1,975 that was set by VMI's **TIM MAYPRAY** in 2007. Jackolski's current per-game average of 190.5 yards is pacing ahead of Maypray's single-season mark of 179.5 in '07. Meanwhile, Jackolski is the fifth player in Big South history to surpass 4,000 career all-purpose yards, as he is fourth in League annals with 4,252. His seven career 200-yard all-purpose games are second-most on the Conference's all-time list.

2,000 RUSHING ODYSSEY

Stony Brook RB **MIGUEL MAYSONET** became the 10th player in Big South history with 2,000 career rushing yards when he surpassed the milestone in Week 9 against Coastal Carolina. Teammate **BROCK JACKOLSKI** became the 11th player to reach the benchmark in Week 10. Maysonet currently stands fifth at 2,688 and needs 173 rushing yards to pass VMI's **HOWARD ABEGESAH** (2,860 from 2006-09) for fourth-place. Jackolski is currently eighth with 2,361 and is 96 yards away from seventh-place.

SKIFF AND WESSON

Stony Brook PK **WESLEY SKIFFINGTON** has made a Big South single-season record 57 PATs this season, breaking the old mark of 56 that was set by Liberty's **NOAH GREENBAUM** in 2007. Skiffington, who tied the Big South single-game record with 10-of-10 PATs in Week 11 at Gardner-Webb, is fifth all-time on the Conference's career kick scoring list with 220 points. His 127 career PATs is tied for third on the Big South's career chart, and he is sixth with 31 career field goals.

30 BROCK

Stony Brook RB/KR **BROCK JACKOLSKI** is the second player in Big South history with 2,000 career rushing yards (2,361) and 1,500 career kickoff return yards (1,573). He joins VMI's **TIM MAYPRAY**, who had 2,456 rushing yards and 2,181 kickoff return yards from 2006-09. Jackolski is fourth all-time in career kickoff return yardage.

RUNNING IN THE QUAD

Stony Brook RB **MIGUEL MAYSONET** recorded his second 4-touchdown game of the season with his four rushing scores at Charleston Southern in Week 10. He is the first player in Big South history with two 4-touchdown games in a season, and now owns a League-record three 4-TD games in his career. Maysonet's five career games with at least three touchdowns in a game is second-most in Conference annals and two away from tying the mark of seven, which is held by Liberty's **RASHAD JENNINGS**.

BROCK OF AGES

Stony Brook's **BROCK JACKOLSKI** became the first player in League history to score five touchdowns in a game when he accomplished the feat in Week 11 at Gardner-Webb. Jackolski scored four rushing touchdowns and caught a TD pass in the win. He had SBU's third game with four rushing scores this season.

NEW YORK STATE OF MIND

Big South Champion Stony Brook is the first team in Big South history to score 40 points in every Conference game, and the Seawolves' average of 48.8 points in its six Conference games this season is the highest scoring average against Big South competition in League annals. The previous record was 47.8 points, set by Liberty in 2007 during a four-game Conference slate. Stony Brook's 293 points in Big South games this season is also an all-time high, surpassing Liberty's record of 271 points in six League contests in 2009. The Seawolves' final average winning margin in Big South games was 27.5 points.

BIG SOUTH BICENTENNIALS

Stony Brook's tandem of **MIGUEL MAYSONET** and **BROCK JACKOLSKI** has rushed for 100 yards in four contests this year and a total of seven times since 2010. This season, Big South teammates rushed for 100 yards in the same game nine times -- a Conference single-season record. Stony Brook has the most with four, followed by Presbyterian College and Gardner-Webb with two, and Charleston Southern with one. The previous record for most times teammates rushed for 100 yards in a game was six games in 2004 and 2008.

SEAWOLVES ALLOW FEWEST NET RUSHING YARDS IN CONFERENCE GAME

One week after allowing the fewest total offensive yards in a Big South game (73 to Coastal Carolina in Week 9), the Stony Brook Seawolves set the League record for lowest net rushing yards allowed in a Conference contest in Week 10 after holding Charleston Southern to minus-7 yards on the ground on 32 carries. The previous low was minus-1 yard, which was established by Liberty against the Buccaneers on Nov. 1, 2003.

STONY BROOK SETS BIG SOUTH SINGLE-GAME SCORING RECORD

Stony Brook's 76 points at Gardner-Webb in Week 11 broke the Big South single-game scoring record of 73 points, which was established by Liberty in the Flames' 73-34 win over VMI on Nov. 10, 2007. The Seawolves are the third team to score 70 points in a Conference game in League history, joining Liberty (2007) and Coastal Carolina (2010).

SEVENTH HEAVEN

For the first time in the Big South's 10-year football history, three teams won at least seven games in the same season. Stony Brook has nine wins in 2011, followed by Liberty and Coastal Carolina with seven victories each.

WOLF DEN

Stony Brook has won 10 consecutive home Big South games -- the second-longest streak in Conference history and trailing Liberty's current 15-game span. The Seawolves have scored 392 points during their string (39.2 points per game), have scored more than 30 points in eight contests -- including the last five over 40, and have held the Conference membership to 171 points (17.1). The last Big South team to defeat Stony Brook inside LaValle Stadium was Gardner-Webb on Nov. 1, 2008 (34-33).

BIG TIME RUSH

Stony Brook (315) and Gardner-Webb (248) combined for 563 rushing yards in Week 11, the most in a Conference game since Stony Brook and VMI combined for 811 rushing yards on Nov. 15, 2008. That day, the Seawolves rushed for 447 yards while the Keydets amassed 364 yards on the ground.

LIGHTING UP THE SCOREBOARD

Stony Brook (76) and Gardner-Webb (28) combined for 104 points in Week 11, the second-most combined points in a game in Big South history. The record is 107, which has been accomplished twice -- first by Gardner-Webb (55) and VMI (52) on Oct. 22, 2005, and matched by Liberty (73) and VMI (34) on Nov. 10, 2007.

HIGH RATE OF RETURN

Liberty kick returner **KEVIN FOGG** tied a Big South single-season record with three kickoff return touchdowns in 2011, matching the mark set by Charleston Southern's **GERALD STEVENSON** in 2010. Fogg is the nation's leading kickoff returner with a 33.5 return average, which is 1.5 yards ahead of the Big South single-season record of 32.0, which was set by Liberty's **DOMINIC BOLDEN** in 2007. Stony Brook's **BROCK JACKOLSKI** is also returning kicks at a higher average than Bolden, as Jackolski enters the second round of the FCS Playoffs with a 31.4 kickoff return average. It would be the first time in Big South history that two players averaged 30.0 yards on kickoff returns in the same season.

CHAMPIONSHIPS ARE WON IN NOVEMBER

Three-time Big South football champion Stony Brook is 8-3 (=72.7 percent) in November regular-season games since joining the Big South in 2008. Four-time champ Liberty is 21-9 (=70.0 percent) since 2002 during the month of November, while two-time champion Coastal Carolina is 22-6 (=78.6) in its history in regular-season games in November. In fact, the Chanticleers are the only Big South member to win a game in November every season since 2003.

LITTLE BIG MAN

Gardner-Webb RB **KENNY LITTLE** finished the season with 1,042 rushing yards, becoming the first GWU back to rush for 1,000 yards in a season since **JUSTIN RICHARDSON** gained 1,110 yards in 2000. Little completed his campaign with three-straight 100-yard rushing efforts and six overall.

SUMMERS TIME FUN

Liberty WR **CHRIS SUMMERS** set a Big South single-game record with 240 receiving yards in the Nov. 19 season finale at Stony Brook. He bettered the old mark of 235 yards, which was established by teammate **PATRICK KELLY** last season against the Seawolves. Summers had 205 receiving yards at Lehigh in Week 4, and is now the only player in Conference annals with two 200-yard receiving games in one season. Summers' yardage also pushed his season total to 1,014, making him the first Big South player with two 1,000-yard receiving seasons -- back-to-back no less.

SOLO ARTISTS

Presbyterian College DB **JUSTIN BETHEL**, the Big South's all-time leader with nine blocked kicks, departs the Big South as the Conference's all-time leader with 199 solo tackles. Meanwhile, Gardner-Webb LB **MARTY PATTERSON** ends his career third in Big South history with 176 career solo tackles.

OH, THERE YOU ARE PERRY

Gardner-Webb redshirt-senior WR **JAMES PERRY III** departs as the Big South's all-time receptions leader with 223 career catches. Perry, who broke the League's receptions record in Week 6 against Liberty, ends his career third in League history with 2,673 career receiving yards.

HE CAUGHT UP NICELY

Liberty redshirt-senior **CHRIS SUMMERS** finishes his career second in Big South history with 2,712 career receiving yards, third with 26 career touchdown receptions and tied for third with 188 career receptions. Since the start of the 2010 season, Summers had 140 receptions, 2,095 yards and 22 touchdowns in 21 games played.

BIG SOUTH'S 300-30 TACKLE CLUB

VMI LB **A.J. GROSS** ends his career as the Big South's third all-time leading tackler with 353 career stops. Gross also recorded 36.0 career TFL, which ranks No. 3 all-time in League annals. Meanwhile, Gardner-Webb LB **MARTY PATTERSON** closes his career with 323 tackles -- which ranks sixth in Big South history, and he is one of four Runnin' Bulldogs on the Conference's 300-tackle list. Patterson departs as the League's second-leading tackler behind the line of scrimmage with 38.0 career TFL. Gross and Patterson are two of three players in Big South history with 300 career tackles and 30 career TFL. Charleston Southern's **JADA ROSS** was the first with 454 stops and 32.5 TFL from 2004-07.

MASTRO OF THE UNIVERSE

Coastal Carolina sophomore **NICCOLO MASTROMATTEO** is already the Big South's career leader for punt returns with 47. The previous career mark was 43, set by Liberty's **WYNTON JACKSON** (2003-07). Mastromatteo is third in League annals with 379 career punt return yards, 146 yards away from Jackson's Big South mark of 525. Meanwhile, Mastromatteo is tied for third in Big South history with 94 combined kick returns in his brief career (47 KR, 47 PR).

DEJA VU ALL OVER AGAIN

One week after Charleston Southern WR **NATHAN PERERA** had 232 receiving yards on 10 catches against Stony Brook in Week 10, teammate **CORVAUGHN ARCHIE** amassed 204 receiving yards on 11 receptions against Coastal Carolina in Week 11. With that, the Buccaneers were the first Big South team in League history to have two players with 200 receiving yards in a game in the same season.

TOTAL RECALL

Liberty QB **MIKE BROWN** finishes his career third in Big South history with 7,947 career yards of total offense. He departs with a Big South-record 15 career 300-total offense games, while his seven 300-yard offensive games this year is tied for second-most in a single-season in Big South history.

BIG BROWN

In his 22 career starts at quarterback, Liberty's **MIKE BROWN** threw for more than 200 yards a total of 21 times -- including a string of 17 consecutive contests. He went 448-of-686 passing (=65.3 percent) for 5,862 yards (266.5 per start) and 42 touchdowns as a starter, in addition to being 15-7.

YOU COMPLETE ME

Liberty QB **MIKE BROWN** ends his career as the Big South's all-time career leader for completion percentage at 65.0 percent (469-of-722). He recorded his fifth career 300-yard passing game in the season finale at Stony Brook, tied for second-most in League history. Brown also is the only player in Big South history with 1,000 career rushing yards (1,875), 1,000 career passing yards (6,072) and 1,000 career receiving yards (1,054).

STRONG FINISHES

Stony Brook closed out the regular-season with eight consecutive wins, continuing a streak in the Big South that has occurred every year since the League's first season in 2002. Last season, Coastal Carolina rolled off four-straight wins to end the regular-season. Prior to that, it was Charleston Southern in 2008 and 2009 (four consecutive wins); Liberty in 2007 (five); Coastal Carolina in 2006 (eight); Charleston Southern in 2005 (five); Coastal Carolina (eight) and Liberty (four) in 2004; Liberty in 2003 (four); and Gardner-Webb in 2002 (eight).

RUSHING UPDATE

HIGH TIDE

One week after Coastal Carolina RB **MARCUS WHITENER** rushed for 106 yards at Charleston Southern in Week 11, **TRAVIS SMALL** rushed for a career-high 109 yards in the Chanticleers' season-finale win at Western Carolina. It was the first time Coastal Carolina had back-to-back 100-yard rushers since 2007, when **JAMIE FORDHAM** rushed for 133 yards against PC on Oct. 20 and **MIKE TOLBERT** rushed for 244 yards against VMI.

IT'S ACADEMIC

For the fifth time in the Big South's 10-year football history, the Conference has at least four players named to the CoSIDA Academic All-District Team. Liberty teammates **PATRICK KELLY** and **MATT BEVINS** were honored in District III, while Coastal Carolina's **MARCUS LOTT** and Charleston Southern's **KIRBY BROOME** were honored in District IV. All four student-athletes move onto the national ballot for Academic All-America.

BROWN DELIVERED

Liberty QB **MIKE BROWN**, who became the sixth player in Big South history with 40 career touchdown passes when he eclipsed the milestone in Week 8, ends his career tied for fifth in Big South history with 45 career TD passes. He threw a touchdown pass in each of his 10 games played this season, and his personal streak of consecutive games with a touchdown pass concluded at 13. The last Big South QB with 13-straight games with a TD pass was Charleston Southern's **COLLIN DRAFTS**, who threw a touchdown pass in a Big South-record 18-straight games played from 2005-06.

GROUND PACKAGE

Liberty QB **MIKE BROWN** concludes his career tied for the most rushing touchdowns by a quarterback with 19, matching the record set by former Gardner-Webb QB **NICK ROBERTS** from 2002-05. Brown ends his time in Lynchburg with 310 rushes, 1,379 yards (4.45 average) and 19 scores starting under center, as well as tied for third all-time in Big South history with 29 career rushing touchdowns. Brown's nine rushing touchdowns this season are the tied for the second-most by a Big South quarterback in a single-season, and matches his total from last year.

HEY NORM!

Coastal Carolina DB **JOSH NORMAN** departs as the Big South's all-time leader with passes defensed (48 - tied) and pass break-ups (35), and second in career interceptions with 13.

BEVINS DEPARTS AS THE BIG SOUTH'S CAREER SCORING LEADER

Liberty senior All-American PK **MATT BEVINS** is the Big South's all-time scoring leader with 309 points, as well as the career record-holder with 58 field goals and second with 135 PATs. Bevins missed considerable time this season with a leg injury.

"I'LL TAKE FOOTBALL GAMES FOR 100 PLEASE, ALEX"

VMI played its 100th game as Big South members when the Keydets hosted Gardner-Webb this past Saturday, and turned in a 31-24 victory in the milestone game. In addition, Charleston Southern head coach **JAY MILLS** coached his 100th game at the helm of the Buccaneers when CSU faced Presbyterian College in the season finale. In Week 10, Coastal Carolina and head coach **DAVID BENNETT** played the 100th game in program history, and the Chanticleers were victorious in the milestone contest with their 15-8 win over Presbyterian College.

The NCAA does not list reclassifying teams in its overall statistics listings, therefore, Presbyterian College will not be ranked in the NCAA statistics again this season.

MEET THE CANDIDATES

The Big South has four individuals among the official candidates for the major FCS awards -- the most for the Conference in one season. Stony Brook head coach **CHUCK PRIORE** is one of 20 finalists for the Eddie Robinson Coach of the Year award. Coastal Carolina CB **JOSH NORMAN** was added as a candidate for the Buck Buchanan Award on Nov. 7, becoming the second Big South player in contention this season for the top defensive award in FCS. Presbyterian College's **JUSTIN BETHEL** was named a candidate on Oct. 4, and it is the first time the Big South has had two official candidates for the Buchanan Award in the same year. Meanwhile, Liberty QB **MIKE BROWN** is a candidate for the Walter Payton Award as the top offensive player in FCS. Voting for the awards has begun and the results will be announced soon.

TAKING ATTENDANCE

The Big South's seven football playing members drew a combined 269,320 fans in 38 home dates, a Conference record for highest total attendance in League history. The old mark was 260,998 in 2008. This season's average of 7,087 is the second-highest in the Big South's 10 seasons, and the highest average in the four years that the Conference has had seven football members.

50-50 PROPOSITION

With 64 pass receptions this year, Liberty WR **CHRIS SUMMERS** is the third player in Big South history with two 60-catch seasons, joining Charleston Southern's **MAURICE PRICE** and Gardner-Webb's **JAMES PERRY III**. Summers is the first Liberty player to lead the Big South in receptions and receiving yards in back-to-back seasons.

SINGING IN THE RAIN

Presbyterian College QB **RYAN SINGER** posted two games this season with 100 passing yards and 100 rushing yards. He is just the second QB in Big South history to accomplish this feat twice in a season, joining Liberty's **MIKE BROWN**, who did so twice in 2010. Singer is the fourth different quarterback with two career games with at least 100 yards rushing and 100 yards passing.

BURNING UP THE HOUSE

Liberty owns a Big South-record 15-game home Conference win streak, and swept its home Big South schedule for the fifth consecutive season. During this stretch, the Flames have scored 681 points (45.4 points per game), scored more than 30 points in 14 contests, and has held its League brethren to 274 points (18.2). The last Big South team to defeat Liberty inside Williams Stadium was Gardner-Webb on Oct. 21, 2006 (27-24).

POINT OF ORDER

Liberty holds the Big South record for most consecutive games with a point scored at 74, having broken the old mark of 67 earlier this year that was first established by Coastal Carolina from 2003-08. Meanwhile, Presbyterian College has not been shutout in its last 63 games (45 as official Big South members), followed by Gardner-Webb (44), Stony Brook (39) and VMI (19).

DOUBLED UP

Liberty owns the Conference record for most consecutive Big South games scoring in double figures at 34. Stony Brook has the next-longest active streak at 22 games. Meanwhile, the Flames have scored in all 46 of their Conference games since 2002, while VMI has tallied points in all 43 of its League contests since joining the Big South in 2003. Presbyterian College is the final Conference member to have not been shut out in a League contest (18 games).

MARGINAL NOTE

Thirteen of the 21 Big South Conference games this season were decided by double figures (=61.9 percent), including nine by at least 20 points, and the average winning margin was 19.2 points. Last year, the 21 Conference football games were decided by 20.8 points.

FLIP THIS HOUSE

For the first time in the Big South's 10-year football history, the Conference did not have a member finish undefeated in home games this season. Stony Brook was 6-1 in home games this year, followed by Liberty at 5-1 and Coastal Carolina and Presbyterian College at 4-1 each.

BENNETT TO COACH IN FCS ALL-STAR GAME

Coastal Carolina head coach **DAVID BENNETT** will serve as the head coach of the South squad in the second annual FCS Senior Scout Bowl, it was announced Nov. 7. The game will be held Dec. 17 at Doug Show Memorial Stadium in Myrtle Beach, S.C. Bennett is the first Big South coach to be selected as a coach for a postseason All-Star game.

BIG SOUTH FCS PLAYOFF HISTORY

The Big South Conference is making its third appearance in the FCS Playoffs this season and the second-straight as an automatic qualifier Conference. The Big South is 1-2 following Stony Brook's first round win over Albany last week. Here is a look at the Conference's all-time playoff history:

* Sophomore QB **ERIC KORDENBROCK** closed out the season by completing 24-of-37 passes for 278 yards and three touchdowns with no interceptions. Kordenbrock completed an 83-yard pass play for a score to **AARON LEWIS**, which is the seventh-longest pass play in VMI history.

* Kordenbrock ended the year with 170 completions and 336 pass attempts, which rank fifth and third, respectively, on the VMI single-season list.

* LB **A.J. GROSS** tallied 27 total tackles in the final two games of the year to push his career total to 353, which ranks 10th all-time in VMI history.

* Redshirt-senior WR **TRACY HAIRSTON** led the team in receiving with 40 catches for 521 yards and three touchdowns, and logged the most receptions in a season by a VMI receiver since 2005 when **ZOHN BURDEN** had 58 catches.

* DB **BYRON ALLEN** finished his career with an 11-tackle performance against Gardner-Webb with four solos, seven assisted, a pass break-up and game-clinching interception.
