GREAT STARTS

Coastal Carolina and Campbell have both started the season 8-1, each school's best start to a basketball season since joining the Division I ranks. Both squads opened the campaign 5-0 -- the first time in Big South history that two teams opened the season with five-straight wins in the same year. Meanwhile, each program has a chance to become the first Big South team to win 10 of their first 11 games. The current Conference record is 12 games, which has been accomplished four times in League history (UNC Greensboro in 1994-95, VMI in 2008-09, and Coastal Carolina in 2009-10 and 2010-11).

ELDER STATESMAN

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** won his 700th game as a collegiate head coach last week when the Chanticleers won 80-58 at The Citadel on Tuesday, Dec. 6. Now in his 37th year as a head coach, Ellis stands 700-398 overall, including 88-49 (=64.2 percent) in five seasons at Coastal Carolina. He is the eighth-winningest active head coach with 622 Division I wins (622-386 at the Division I level), has directed four different Division I programs to at least two 20-win campaigns, and owns six seasons with at least 25 wins. He is 12 wins away from winning 100 games with his fourth different Division I program.

SCOREBOARD WATCHING

Reigning five-time NCAA scoring champion VMI leads the Big South and Division I with 88.7 points per game. The Keydets are going for their unprecedented sixth-straight NCAA scoring title, and has vaulted back into the national lead after being No. 12 in scoring offense last week.

I LOVE THE '80s

Four Big South teams -- VMI (88.7), Campbell (84.0), UNC Asheville (81.7) and Coastal Carolina (80.6) -- are currently averaging at least 80.0 points a game, the most in Conference history. Just 10 teams in League annals have finished a season averaging 80 points game, with the most teams in one season being three in 1992-93. That year, Winthrop (83.6), UMBC (81.8) and Radford (81.3) were above the scoring mark.

STAN THE MAN

VMI junior **STAN OKOYE**, who became the 106th player in Big South history to score 1,000 points on Nov. 23 at Ohio State, grabbed his 500th career rebound this past Saturday in the Milligan game. He is now the 42nd player in the Conference record books with 1,000 career points and 500 career rebounds, and is the fourth Keydet to accomplish this feat since VMI joined the Big South in 2003-04.

SAM I AM

Coastal Carolina redshirt-junior **SAM McLAURIN** is 18th in Big South history with 131 career blocked shots. He needs 12 rebounds for 500 in his career, and once he reaches the milestone, he will be the 15th player in the Big South record books with 500 rebounds and 100 blocked shots.

DOUBLE TROUBLE

A total of six players have scored in double figures in every game thus far -- Campbell teammates **TREY FREEMAN** and **DARREN WHITE**, Coastal Carolina's **ANTHONY RAFFA**, High Point's **NICK BARBOUR**, UNC Asheville's **MATT DICKEY** and Winthrop's **ANDRE JONES**. Barbour owns the longest double-figure scoring streak in the Conference at 26 games, dating back to last season, followed by Raffa (18), Dickey (14) and Jones (11).

ANDRE THE GIANT

Winthrop's **ANDRE JONES** is third in the Big South with 18.7 points per game, the highest scoring average by a Winthrop Eagle since **FRED MCKINNON** averaged 21.1 points in 1985-86. Jones, who entered the season with a career scoring average of 8.5 points, has scored in double figures in every game and has poured in 20 points three times this season. His 168 points scored thus far is already 52.3 percent of his season-best scoring total of 321, which was set last year.

STEADY EDDIE

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** won his 250th career game with the Bulldogs' 88-81 win over USC Upstate on Dec. 4. He is the Big South's all-time winningest coach for overall wins (221) and Big South victories (129), and is now 250-287 in 18 years as a collegiate head coach. Biedenbach needs just two wins to tie **BOB HARTMAN** as the all-time victory leader at UNC Asheville.

SPEAKING OF COACHING WINS...

Charleston Southern head coach **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH** is five wins away from 100 in his career as a head coach, while VMI's **DUGGAR BAUCOM** is eight wins away from 100 victories at the Institute.

MR. SANDMAN

Liberty senior guard **JESSE SANDERS** is the only player in the nation averaging 8.0 rebounds (8.4) and 7.0 assists (7.6). His average of 7.64 assists per game this season -- which includes two games with 10 helpers -- is currently the second-highest assist average in a single-season in Big South history, behind the Conference record of 9.64 that was established by Charleston Southern's **TONY FAIRLEY** in 1986-87. Sanders is the first Big South player to average at least 7.0 assists since former Flame **TEEJAY BANNISTER** in 2007-08 (7.23), and is looking to become just the fifth overall player to average 7.0 assists in a season.

BARBOUR SHOP

High Point senior guard **NICK BARBOUR** is averaging 3.67 three-pointers per game this season, the highest in the Big South since former VMI Keydet **AUSTIN KENON** averaged 3.72 threes in 2008-09. Barbour has made at least three treys in his last 10 games played (dating back to last season), the longest such streak by a Big South player since Kenon buried three-plus 3FG in 11-straight games during the '08-09 campaign. Barbour's three-point prowess has pushed his career total to 239, which is currently 15th all-time in Conference history. He needs 11 triples to become the 14th player with 250, and is on pace to join the League's 300 3FG club, which stands at six members.

TREY-LINER

Campbell freshman guard **TREY FREEMAN** is averaging 16.9 points this season, seventh in the Big South. It is the highest scoring average for a Big South frosh since former Liberty guard **SETH CURRY** averaged a Big South freshman record 20.2 points in 2008-09. Meanwhile, Freeman has made a League-leading 92.6 percent of his free throws (50-of-54) through his first nine collegiate games, and could become the first freshman to lead the Conference in free throw percentage since 1995-96 (UMBC's **ALHAMISI SIMMS**) and the fourth overall.

GIVE-AND-TAKE

UNC Asheville senior guard **J.P. PRIMM** has 507 career assists and 199 career steals, and is on the cusp of becoming just the fifth player in Big South history with 500 assists and 200 steals. Primm is set to join Winthrop's **CHRIS GAYNOR** (567 AST, 259 STL), Campbell's **BRAD CHILDRESS** (543-243), Charleston Southern's **ED O'NEIL** (504-241) and Coastal Carolina's **ROBERT DOWDELL** (561-239) in the club. Meanwhile, Primm could become the first player in Big South history with 400 rebounds, 400 assists and 200 steals. He needs 26 boards for 400 in his career.

LENDING A HELPING HAND

Liberty's **JESSE SANDERS** and UNC Asheville's **J.P. PRIMM** became the 11th and 12th players, respectively, in Big South history to eclipse 500 career assists when they did so earlier this season. Sanders reached the milestone on Nov. 18, with Primm joining the club on Nov. 26. Sanders is currently sixth with 555, and needs five handouts for fifth all-time. He is also 50 helpers shy of breaking the Conference's all-time record of 604, which was established by Radford's **AMIR JOHNSON** from 2006-10. Primm is currently 11th with 507 and needs four to move into the Top 10.

MY FAVORITE MARTIN

Charleston Southern senior forward **KELVIN MARTIN**, who grabbed his 700th career rebound on Nov. 15 against Bluefield College to become the 20th player in Big South history with 1,000 points and 700 rebounds, is currently 12th in League annals with 751 career boards and needs 33 caroms to move into the all-time Top 10 rebounders. He is 49 rebounds away from becoming the ninth player with 800 rebounds. Meanwhile, Martin is 26 steals shy of 200 in his career, which would make him just the third player with 1,000 points, 500 rebounds and 200 steals. In addition, he needs 13 blocks for 100 and could eventually become one of three in Conference history with 1,000 points, 700 rebounds, 200 steals and 100 blocks. Stay tuned.

SAND BAR

Liberty guard **JESSE SANDERS** is 32 points away from 1,000 in his career, and he would be the 28th player in Big South history with 1,000 points and 600 rebounds. He would also be the first in the 1,000/600 club with 500 assists.

THREE-FOR-ALL

VMI's **KEITH GABRIEL** has made 251 three-pointers in his career, good for 13th on the Conference's all-time list. He is four away from surpassing Winthrop's **LaSHAWN COULTER** (254 from 1990-95) for 12th-place. Gabriel needs 33 treys to crack the Big South's career Top 10, and 49 threes to become the seventh player in Big South history with 300 career three-point field goals. Meanwhile, teammate **MICHAEL SPARKS** is five threes away from 200 3FG in his career.

2,000-POINT ODYSSEY?

High Point senior guard **NICK BARBOUR** is the Conference's active leading career scorer with 1,650 points, which ranks 18th all-time in Big South history. He is 118 points away from cracking the League's Top 10, and 350 points shy of becoming the seventh player in Conference annals with 2,000 points. He would need to average 17.5 points a game in the Panthers' 20 remaining regular-season games to reach the milestone. Barbour entered the season with a career scoring average of 16.9 points.

BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

Liberty's **JESSE SANDERS** needs 32 points to become the 107th player in Big South history with 1,000 career points. Below is a look at the Big South's active 1,000-point scorers, as well as those closing in on the milestone:

BAND OF BROTHERS

Liberty sophomore **JOHN CALEB SANDERS** has scored 124 points through 11 contests this season. He scored 126 points in 32 appearances with the Flames last year. Along with his teammate and brother **JESSE**, the two have combined to score 1,218 points for Liberty.

HELLO 2-0

With the first set of Big South games concluding the first weekend of December, Campbell, Charleston Southern and Coastal Carolina emerged from the pack with 2-0 League records to sit in a three-way tie for first-place in the Conference standings. Campbell is 2-0 in the Big South for the first time since opening the 1993-94 League season at 4-0. The Buccaneers have won their first two League games for the first time since starting 4-0 in Big South play in 2004-05. Coastal Carolina is 2-0 in Conference action for the third consecutive year. The Conference season will resume Dec. 31.

HOME FOR THE HOLIDAYS

The home teams claimed eight of the first 10 Big South games played during the first Conference weekend (=80.0 percent), an improvement over last season's opening weekend that had five home wins in the first nine League games. The home teams won 62.2 percent of the time (56-34) in both 2010-11 and 2009-10.

TOAST TO THE COAST

Seven days after defeating LSU, Coastal Carolina won 60-59 at Clemson on Nov. 22, marking the second-straight year that a Big South member has defeated an SEC team and ACC team in the same season. Presbyterian College did it last year in back-to-back games, as the Blue Hose won at Auburn on Dec. 18 and followed with a win at Wake Forest on Dec. 20. The Chanticleers are now the third Big South team in Conference history with SEC-ACC wins in the same campaign. The first was Campbell in 1993-94 when the Camels defeated North Carolina State and South Carolina.

BACK TO THE FUTURE

The Big South has recorded wins over the SEC, Big East and ACC this season, an accomplishment that occurred just once previously in League history. The 1993-94 season was the first time the Big South Conference defeated an SEC, Big East and ACC team in the same year. Meanwhile, the Big South has now collected an SEC win five out of the last six seasons, an ACC win four out of the last five seasons, and a Big East win four out of the last eight seasons.

BUT WAIT, THERE'S MORE

This is the first time the Big South has ever posted wins over five of the six "BCS" Conferences in a single-season, as Campbell's win at Iowa on Nov. 23 and UNC Asheville's victory over Utah on Nov. 26 gave the Big South victories against Big Ten and Pac-12 members. It was the Big South's first-ever win over a Big Ten team, and the Conference's first win against a Pac-12 member since 1996-97.

MR. TRIPLE-DOUBLE

Liberty senior guard **JESSE SANDERS**, who is the only player in Big South history with 600 career rebounds (658) and 500 assists (555), could become the first player in Division I history with a triple-double in four different years. He owns three of the eight triple-doubles on record in Conference annals. He recorded his first as a freshman against Presbyterian College on Feb. 9, 2009, his second during his sophomore year against Kentucky Christian on Dec. 12, 2009, and his third as a junior against Charleston Southern on Jan. 6, 2011.

MID-MAJOR MANIA??

Despite the League's notable non-Conference victories this season, a Big South member has yet to crack the *Collegeinsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 rankings. The Big South has had a team ranked in the 13-year old Mid-Major Top 25 poll for seven consecutive seasons prior to 2011-12, and there is plenty of time to make it eight-straight. ROAD WORK AHEAD...

Coastal Carolina carries a school-record 10-consecutive Big South road game win streak into this season. The Conference record for most consecutive road League wins is 11, first set by Winthrop from 2004-06 and tied by Radford from 2008-10. The Chanticleers' first Big South road game this season is Dec. 31 at High Point.

SENIOR MOMENTS

UNC Asheville seniors **MATT DICKEY** and **J.P. PRIMM** have scored 15 points in the same game 20 times since arriving in Asheville in 2008-09, and the Bulldogs are 15-5 in those games. The duo had its first such game of 2011-12 in the Bulldogs' win over Utah on Nov. 26 after reaching the total 14 times in 2010-11.

BOTH ENDS OF THE SPECTRUM

Half of the 10 Big South games played the opening weekend of Conference play had winning margins of less than 10 points, with the average margin of victory in those five games being 5.6 points. The other five that were decided by at least 10 points had an average winning margin of 15.4 points. Overall, the first 10 Conference games of the 2011-12 season had an average margin of victory of 10.5 points. Last year, the overall margin of victory in League play was 10.48, while the 2009-10 average margin was 10.51 points and the 2008-09 League season was 8.96 points.

CLASS ACT

Liberty senior guard **JESSE SANDERS** is one of 30 national candidates for the 2011-12 Lowe's Senior CLASS Award. To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence -- Community, Classroom, Character and Competition. The award focuses on the total student-athlete and encourages students to use their platform in athletics to make a positive impact as leaders in their communities. The 30 candidates will be narrowed to 10 finalists midway through the regular season, and those 10 names will be placed on the official ballot. Sanders is the Big South's first candidate since Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** in 2007-08.

BIG SOUTH TO MAKE SEVENTH APPEARANCE IN ESPN'S BRACKETBUSTERS EVENT

The Big South Conference will again participate in the SEARS BracketBusters event this season during the weekend of February 17-19, with a League-record 11 teams among the field of 142 -- the event's largest pool ever. All of the Big South's men's basketball programs are participating in the same year for the first time, and the Conference has the second-most members competing of the 16 Leagues involved this season. Five Big South teams will host a game while the remaining six members will play on the road. The Conference is 8-16 all-time in the BracketBusters, including two wins in 2006, 2007 and 2010. The Big South has also been selected for national television appearances four times in the past five years: 2007 (ESPN2), 2008 (ESPN2), 2009 (ESPNU) and 2011 (ESPNU).

Campbell set a team record for wins prior to Christmas with its eighth of the season, breaking the mark of seven set by the 2010-11 club ... The Camels set Gore Arena records for points scored in a game (103) and in a half (58), victory margin (48) and tying the mark for fewest turnovers (6) in their 103-55 win over Methodist last Saturday. **DARREN WHITE** tied his Gore Arena record and career-high with 33 points in the win ... CU improved to 6-0 at home this year and 35-14 (.714) all-time in four seasons at Gore Arena ... CU's 8-1 overall start is the program's best since joining NCAA Division I in 1977-78 and the best since the 1975-76 team opened with 13-straight wins.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Bucs currently lead the Big South in steals with 10.5 steals per game. They are also second in 3-point field goal percentage at 37.1 ... **KELVIN MARTIN** ranks in the top 15 of the League with 13.5 ppg (14th) and 8.0 rpg (5th) ... Freshman **SAAH NIMLEY** ranks in the top 15 in scoring as well, coming in 13th with 13.9 ppg. He also ranks 10th with 3.3 assists per game ... They each scored 13 points to lead the team in scoring at Florida State last Monday.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal played one game last week, defeating The Citadel in Charleston, 80-58 on Tuesday night improving to 8-1 on the season ... Entering the week ranked fourth in the nation in field goal percentage (52.5) the Chanticleers shot 62.5 percent in the first half and finished 34-of-60 (56.7) for the game ... Despite Coastal's leading rebounder, **SAM McLAURIN** playing just 14 minutes due to foul trouble, the Chanticleers out-rebounded the Bulldogs, 37-27 ... Coastal held the second-highest rebounding margin (+12.5) going into last week's contest.

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb posted identical 87-57 wins over Alice Lloyd and South Carolina State last week, the first time the Runnin' Bulldogs topped 85 points in consecutive games since the 2007-08 season ... The Runnin' Bulldogs dished off a combined 52 assists in the two games, including a season-high 28 assists in the win over ALC ... True freshman wing **DONTA HARPER** registered a career-high 12 points in the win over South Carolina State, his second double figures scoring game of the season ... **STEFON JOHNSON** scored nine of Gardner-Webb's first 14 points vs. SCSU, helping GWU avenge an earlier 73-68 loss at SCSU in November.

HIGH POINT

NICK BARBOUR moved up to fifth all-time in scoring at HPU. He now has 1,650 career points and surpassed **DANNY WITT**, who scored 1,648 from 1966-70. Barbour's season-high 35 points against Wake Forest marked the seventh time in his career he has scored at least 30 points in a game ... **SHAY SHINE** scored 19 points in back-to-back games last week and had a career-high eight assists against Wake Forest ... **COREY LAW** got his fourth double-double of the season and 12th of his career with 14 points and 12 rebounds against Averett ... High Point hosted an ACC opponent for the first time when Wake Forest visited the Millis Center last Wednesday, drawing a standing-room only crowd of 1,801 for the game.

LIBERTY

JESSE SANDERS is fourth in the country in assists with 7.6 apg. He is the only player in the country to average at least 7.0 rebounds and 7.0 assists per game. He needs 32 points to become the 22nd member of Liberty's 1,000-point club ... Sanders nearly missed a fourth career-triple double, finishing Saturday's Virginia Intermont contest one rebound shy. PRIMM** is second all-time at Asheville in career assists and steals and is closing in on the all-time school record for each category ... **JEREMY ATKINSON** has scored in double figures in three-straight games and four of the last five contests ... Asheville's next road game is at Tennessee on Dec. 20 and that game will start a four-game road trip for the Bulldogs.

VMI

VMI will wrap up a six-game, 12-day stretch Monday night when it travels to Longwood. The Keydets will break for exams after the game and will play just one contest the next 19 days when they visit Old Dominion on Dec. 22 ... Monday's VMI-Longwood game will be the Keydets' first visit to Longwood since 2004-05 ... VMI has now gone over the century mark in points in four games this season after breaking the 100-point mark in both the Central Penn and Milligan contests ... The 12 three-pointers made against Milligan was the first time in seven games that the Keydets had drained 10 or more treys in a game this season.

WINTHROP

Winthrop took a break from final exams to play its second and final non-Division I game on Sunday and came away with a hard-fought 79-70 win over Virginia-Wise. The Eagles places four players in double figures, led by **ANDRE JONES'** 19 and 17 by **GIDEON GAMBLE** ... Gamble scored all 17 of his points in the first half as he played 12 minutes in a reserve role. He played just two minutes in the second half ... The win over Wise extends Winthrop's winning streak over non-Division I schools to 28 games, dating back to the 1998-99 season ...
