Jones averaged 24.5 points, was 19-of-29 from the field ( =65.5 percent) and 7-of-10 from three-point range (=70.0) in two games last week for the Eagles. He scored 24 points in a win at Presbyterian College, including what proved to be the game-winning three-pointer with 51 seconds left in the contest. Jones followed that performance with a 25-point effort Saturday at Gardner-Webb. He connected on 10-of-14 field goals and was 4-of-6 from long distance. Jones also averaged 2.5 rebounds, 2.5 steals, 2.0 assists and 1.0 blocks in the two

In Saturday's win over VMI, Nimley poured in 24 points and was 5-of-7 from three-point range and 8-of-12 overall from the field. For the week, Nimley was 15-of-27 from the floor (=55.6 percent), 8-of-14 from beyond the arc (=57.1) and made 8-of-10 free throws (=80.0).

#### HELLO 2-0

With the first set of Big South games concluding this past Saturday, Campbell, Charleston Southern and Coastal Carolina emerged from the pack with 2-0 League records to sit in a three-way tie for first-place in the Conference standings. Campbell is 2-0 in the Big South for the first time since opening the 1993-94 League season at 4-0. The Buccaneers have won their first two League games for the first time since starting 4-0 in Big South play in 2004-05. Coastal Carolina is 2-0 in Conference action for the third consecutive year. The Conference season will resume Dec. 31.

## HOME FOR THE HOLIDAYS

The home teams claimed eight of the first 10 Big South games played over the first Conference weekend (=80.0 percent), an improvement over last season's opening weekend that had five home wins in the first nine League games. The home teams won 62.2 percent of the time (56-34) in both 2010-11 and 2009-10.

## BOTH ENDS OF THE SPECTRUM

Half of the 10 Big South games played the opening weekend of Conference play had winning margins of less than 10 points, with the average margin of victory in those five games being 5.6 points. The other five that were decided by at least 10 points had an average winning margin of 15.4 points. Overall, the first 10 Conference games of the 2011-12 season had an average margin of victory of 10.5 points. Last year, the overall margin of victory in League play was 10.48, while the 2009-10 average margin was 10.51 points and the 2008-09 League season was 8.96 points.

## **GREAT STARTS**

Coastal Carolina and Campbell have both started the season 7-1, each school's best start to a basket-ball season since joining the Division I ranks. Both squads opened the campaign 5-0 -- the first time in Big South history that two teams opened the season with five-straight wins in the same year. It also is the third time since 2007-08 that a Big South member opened the season at 5-0.

#### DO THE CHARLESTON

Charleston Southern has won five consecutive games for the first time under head coach **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH** and for the first time since winning five-straight in 2004-05. The Buccaneers scored their most points in a Big South game with their 114 against VMI this past Saturday, which is the sixth-highest point total in a Conference game in League history.

## ANDRE THE GIANT

Winthrop's **ANDRE JONES** is second in the Big South with 18.6 points per game, the highest scoring average by a Winthrop Eagle since **FRED McKINNON** averaged 21.1 points in 1985-86. Jones, who entered the season with a career scoring average of **8.5** points, has scored in double figures in every game and has poured in 20 points three times this season. His 149 points scored thus far is already 46.4 percent of his season-best scoring total of 321, which was set last year.

## MARQUEE HOME OPPONENTS, ACT III

A Big South member will host another major Conference school this season when High Point entertains Wake Forest on Wednesday, Dec. 7, marking the third occasion of the 2011-12 season. UNC Asheville hosted then-No. 1 North Carolina on Nov. 13, and Coastal Carolina hosted LSU on Nov. 15.

## **ELDER STATESMAN**

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** is the eighth-winningest active head coach with 621 Divison I wins, and he enters this week one win shy of 700 overall victories in his head coaching career. Ellis has directed four different Division I programs to at least *two* 20-win campaigns, and owns six seasons with at least 25 wins. He is now 621-386 at the Division I level following Coastal's 7-1 start to the 2011-12 campaign. Ellis stands 699-398 overall in 37 years as a head coach, including 87-49 (=64.4 percent) in five seasons at Coastal Carolina. He is 13 wins away from winning 100 games with his fourth different Division I program.

### STEADY EDDIE

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** won his 250th career game with the Bulldogs' 88-81 win over USC Upstate on Sunday. He is the Big South's all-time winningest coach for overall wins (221) and Big South victories (129), and is now 250-287 in 18 years as a collegiate head coach.

## SPEAKING OF COACHING WINS...

Charleston Southern head coach **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH** is fives wins away from 100 in his career as a head coach, while VMI's **DUGGAR BAUCOM** is 10 wins away from 100 victories at the Institute.

### **SAMIAM**

Coastal Carolina redshirt-junior **SAM McLAURIN** is 18th in Big South history with 131 career blocked shots. He needs 16 rebounds for 500 in his career, and once he reaches the benchmark, he will be the 15th player in the Big South record books with 500 rebounds and 100 blocked shots.

#### MR. SANDMAN

Liberty senior guard **JESSE SANDERS** is averaging 7.56 assists per game this season, which includes two games with 10 helpers. It is currently the second-highest assist average in a single-season in Big South history, behind the Conference record of 9.64 that was established by Charleston Southern's **TONY FAIRLEY** in 1986-87. Sanders is the first Big South player to average at least 7.0 assists since former Flame **TEEJAY BANNISTER** in 2007-08 (7.23), and is looking to become just the fifth overall player to average 7.0 assists in a season.

#### **TREY-LINER**

Campbell freshman guard **TREY FREEMAN** is averaging 17.0 points this season, tied for sixth in the Big South. It is the highest scoring average for a Big South frosh since former Liberty guard **SETH CURRY** averaged a Big South freshman record 20.2 points in 2008-09. Meanwhile, Freeman has made a League-leading 91.8 percent of his free throws (45-of-49) through his first eight collegiate games, and could become the first freshman to lead the Conference in free throw percentage since 1995-96 (UMBC's **ALHAMISI SIMMS**) and the fourth overall.

#### **GIVE-AND-TAKE**

UNC Asheville senior guard **J.P. PRIMM** has 507 career assists and 199 career steals, and is on the cusp of becoming just the fifth player in Big South history with 500 assists and 200 steals. Primm is set to join Winthrop's **CHRIS GAYNOR** (567 AST, 259 STL), Campbell's **BRAD CHILDRESS** (543-243), Charleston Southern's **ED O'NEIL** (504-241) and Coastal Carolina's **ROBERT DOWDELL** (561-239) in the club. Meanwhile, Primm could become the first player in Big South history with 400 rebounds, 400 assists and 200 steals. He needs 26 boards for 400 in his career.

#### **LENDING A HELPING HAND**

Liberty's **JESSE SANDERS** (11th) and UNC Asheville's **J.P. PRIMM** (12th) each eclipsed 500 career assists earlier this season. Sanders reached the milestone first on Nov. 18, with Primm joining the club on Nov. 26. Sanders is currently eighth in Big South history with 539, and needs five handouts for seventh. He is also 66 helpers shy of breaking the Conference's all-time record of 604, which was established by Radford's **AMIR JOHNSON** from 2006-10. Primm is currently 11th with 507 and needs four to move into the Top 10.

## MY FAVORITE MARTIN

Charleston Southern senior forward **KELVIN MARTIN**, who grabbed his 700th career rebound on Nov. 15 against Bluefield College to become the 20th player in Big South history with 1,000 points and 700 rebounds, is currently 13th in League annals with 743 career boards and needs 41 caroms to move into the all-time Top 10 rebounders. He is 57 rebounds away from becoming the ninth player with 800 rebounds. Meanwhile, Martin is 28 steals shy of 200 in his career, which would make him just the third player with 1,000 points, 500 rebounds and 200 steals. In addition, he needs 13 blocks for 100 and could eventually become one of three in Conference history with 1,000 points, 700 rebounds, 200 steals and 100 blocks. Stay tuned.

## **SAND BAR**

Liberty guard **JESSE SANDERS** is 63 points away from 1,000 in his career, and he would be the 28th player in Big South history with 1,000 points and 600 rebounds. He would also be the first in the 1,000/600 club with 500 assists.

## SENIOR MOMENTS

UNC Asheville seniors **MATT DICKEY** and **J.P. PRIMM** have scored 15 points in the same game 20 times since arriving in Asheville in 2008-09, and the Bulldogs are 15-5 in those games. The duo had its first such game of 2011-12 in the Bulldogs' win over Utah on Nov. 26 after reaching the total 14 times in 2010-11.

### THREE-FOR-ALL

VMI's **KEITH GABRIEL** has made 251 three-pointers in his career, good for 13th on the Conference's all-time list. He is four away from surpassing Winthrop's **LaSHAWN COULTER** (254 from 1990-95) for 12th-place. Gabriel needs 33 treys to crack the Big South's career Top 10, and 49 threes to become the seventh player in Big South history with 300 career three-point field goals.

## **BAND OF BROTHERS**

Liberty sophomore **JOHN CALEB SANDERS** has scored 101 points through nine contests this season. He scored 126 points in 32 appearances with the Flames last year. Along with his teammate and brother **JESSE**, the two have combined to score 1,164 points for Liberty.

#### STAN THE MAN

VMI junior **STAN OKOYE**, who became the 106th player n Big South history to score 1,000 points, is 21 rebounds away from becoming the 42nd player in Conference annals with 1,000 career points and 500 career rebounds. He would be the fourth Keydet to join the list since VMI joined the Big South in 2003-04.

## 2,000-POINT ODYSSEY?

High Point senior guard **NICK BARBOUR** is the Conference's active leading career scorer with 1,601 points, which ranks tied for 21st all-time in Big South history. He is 167 points away from cracking the League's Top 10, and 399 points shy of becoming the seventh player in Conference annals with 2,000 points. He would need to average 18.14 points a game in the Panthers' 22 remaining regular-season games to reach the milestone. Barbour entered the season with a career scoring average of 16.9 points.

## **BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB**

## TOAST TO THE COAST

Seven days after defeating LSU, Coastal Carolina won 60-59 at Clemson on Nov. 22, marking the second-straight year that a Big South member has defeated an SEC team and ACC team in the same season. Presbyterian College did it last year in back-to-back games, as the Blue Hose won at Auburn on Dec. 18 and followed with a win at Wake Forest on Dec. 20. The Chanticleers are now the third Big South team in Conference history with SEC-ACC wins in the same campaign. The first was Campbell in 1993-94 when the Camels defeated North Carolina State and South Carolina.

## **BACK TO THE FUTURE**

The Big South has recorded wins over the SEC, Big East and ACC this season, an accomplishment that occurred just once previously in League history. The 1993-94 season was the first time the Big South Conference defeated an SEC, Big East and ACC team in the same year. Meanwhile, the Big South has now collected an SEC win five out of the last six seasons, an ACC win four out of the last five seasons, and a Big East win four out of the last eight seasons.

## **BUT WAIT, THERE'S MORE**

This is the first time the Big South has ever posted wins over five of the six "BCS" Conferences in a single-season, as Campbell's win at Iowa on Nov. 23 and UNC Asheville's victory over Utah on Nov. 26 gave the Big South victories against Big Ten and Pac-12 members. It was the Big South's first-ever win over a Big Ten team, and the Conference's first win against a Pac-12 member since 1996-97.

### UNBALANCING ACT

While the Big South has 11 men's basketball members for the first time, the Conference will still utilize an 18-game League schedule in 2011-12. Therefore, each team will play eight teams twice and two teams once. A new tiebreaker procedure to address this unbalanced schedule has been determined and will be posted in the Big South weekly report beginning Jan. 2, 2012.

#### **CAMPBELL**

Leading scorer and rebounder **ERIC GRIFFIN** was limited to just 23 minutes due to foul trouble against Liberty, but **TREY FREEMAN** (28), **DARREN WHITE** (20) and **RICO FERGUSON** (19) combined for 67 points in a 96-82 win over the Flames ... In the first half of Saturday's game against High Point, Griffin suffered a gash on his right hand that required 14 stitches. He missed the final 24:56 of the contest, but White scored 18 of his game-high 28 points after halftime ... The Camels still rank 2nd in the country in team field goal percentage (53.2) and also continue to lead the League in 3-point FG% (45.7) and FT% (73.9)... Campbell is off until Saturday's home game against Division III Methodist due to final exams.

#### CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

CSU made it five wins in a row at home and overall with victories over Radford and VMI ... The Buccaneers held the Keydets to just 20.8% from three point range (5-24), including 0-10 in the second half ... The 114 points scored by CSU was the most for the Bucs since Jan. 5, 2008, when the Bucs scored 115 against Ohio Christian ... SAAH NIMLEY led the Buccaneer attack last week, totaling 46 points while shooting 56% from the floor (15-of-27) ... KELVIN MARTIN totaled 32 points, 16 rebounds, four blocks, five steals and three assists.

#### COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina is 2-0 in the Big South for the third consecutive year ... Coastal had a total of seven players score in double-figures against VMI (4) and Liberty (3) ... Coastal held the Big South's leading offense (VMI) to just 26 first half points ... Coastal has now won seven-straight against VMI ... SAM McLAURIN had a career-high 19 points on 8-of-11 from the field while grabbing a game-high 15 rebounds vs. the Keydets ... ANTHONY RAFFA has now scored in double-digits in 17 consecutive games dating back to last season. Raffa ranks third in the Conference with a team leading 17.8 points per game and tied for first in the Big South with 18 steals.

#### GARDNER-WEBB

The Runnin' Bulldogs snapped a five-game losing streak to Winthrop it their 62-60 win over the Eagles this past Saturday. Guard **JASON DAWSON** led GWU with 16 points in the win.

### HIGH POINT

High Point hosts an ACC opponent for the first time when Wake Forest comes to the Millis Center on Wednesday. HPU has faced Wake Forest 10 times since 1927-28 and has won once, back in 1934-35 ... The Panthers are 0-4 in road games for the first time since 2006-07. High Point is 2-1 at home, most recently getting an 80-72 overtime win over The Citadel on Nov. 26 ... With his 15 points at Campbell on Saturday, **NICK BARBOUR** moved up to sixth on HPU's all-time scoring list with 1,601 points, passing current Minnesota head coach **ORLANDO "TUBBY" SMITH**, who had 1,589 from 1969-73 ... The Wake Forest game has been designated "Tubby Smith Night" and the University will honor Smith at halftime.

#### LIBERTY

The Flames have committed more than 12 turnovers in only one game this season, giving up 17 turnovers against Randolph College on Nov. 11 ... The Flames enter this week with a balanced offensive attack, with 12 points separating Liberty's top four scorers ... Brothers **JESSE** and **JOHN CALEB SANDERS** have identical point totals on the season (101 points, 11.2 ppg) ... The last time Liberty began the season 2-7 was during the 2001-02 campaign ... Jesse Sanders is the only player in the country averaging at least seven rebounds (7.4) and seven assists (7.6) per game ... In Liberty's Dec. 1 game at Campbell, **JOEL VANDER POL** set career-highs with 20 points, 9 rebounds and 10 free throws.

## PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE

JOSH JOHNSON, with his 749 points, is just 251 points away from 1,000, while KHALID MUTAKABBIR is just 205 away from the milestone ... If PIERRE MILLER can post 242 more points, he'll reach the 1,000-point mark as well ... The Blue Hose bench has accounted for double-digit points in all but two games this season ... Of PC's 547 total points, 256 of them have been inside the paint ... After a break for exams, the Blue Hose step out of Conference and travel to South Carolina on Dec. 13 ... The Gamecocks own a 30-7 mark over the Blue Hose and have won the last seven of eight. The last PC win in the series came back in 1943 (64-51 win).

### RADFORD

Radford's 11 three-point field goals at Charleston Southern last Thursday were the most since Feb. 28, 2006 (11 vs. High Point) ... It was also just the third time in the last five years Radford has made 10-or-more 3-pointers in a game ... Radford is averaging 4.3 more offensive rebounds per game than its opponent ... The Highlanders have dropped 21-straight road games and 23 consecutive away from home ... The Highlanders traveled close to 4,000 miles during the first three weeks of the season.

### **UNC ASHEVILLE**

The Bulldogs opened Big South Conference play with a 66-60 victory at Gardner-Webb -- moving to 15-1 in League openers under **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** -- and then finished the week with an **88-81** victory over **USC Upstate**. Both games featured comebacks by Asheville. The Bulldogs trailed 14-1 at Gardner-Webb and by four midway through the second half before taking the lead and holding on for the win ... On Sunday, Asheville trailed 81-72 with 3:30 left but scored the final **16** points of the game to pull out the win ... **JARON LANE** came off the bench to spark the comeback against Gardner-Webb with 15 points ... The Bulldogs are off until Dec. 15. due to exams.

### VMI

**RON BURKS** has scored in double figures for three consecutive games and has averaged 14.7 points over that span, including a season-high 19 points at Ohio State on Nov. 23 ... **STAN OKOYE** scored 21 points in the second half on his way to a season-high 25 points at Coastal Carolina, Dec. 1 ... **D.J. COVINGTON**, hampered by back issues, returned to limited action last week. He played a total of nine minutes in two games, but managed four points at CSU ... VMI is in the middle of a six-game stretch over 12 days, and will wrap up a four-game road swing at Pittsburgh on Tuesday before returning home for a pair of home games on Thursday and Saturday.

## WINTHROP

Winthrop and PC had another down-to-the-wire battle as the Eagles came out on top of a 59-56 win in the Big South opener for both teams ... **ANDRE JONES** almost carried the Eagles to a win at Gardner-Webb as he scored 25 points, but the Eagles fell to the Runnin' Bulldogs, 62-60. It marked WU's first loss in Paul Porter Arena since the 1982-83 season ... Jones is on pace to become Winthrop's single season Division I scoring leader. That distinction is now held by **TED HOUPT**, who averaged 17.6 points during the 1986-87 season -- Winthrop's first as a NCAA Division I member ... The Eagles will play just one game over the next 10 days as they begin final exams this week.
