BIG SOUTH BCS DOUBLE

The Big South scored two wins over BCS Conferences last week, beginning with Coastal Carolina's 71-63 home win over LSU on Tuesday. It was the Chanticleers' second-straight win over the Tigers, as CCU won at LSU in 2010. Presbyterian College grabbed the second big win of the week, as the Blue Hose rallied from 15 points to win at No. 20 Cincinnati, 56-54. Last season, PC won at both Auburn and Wake Forest. It is the fifth time in the last six seasons that a Big South member has defeated an SEC team, and it is the first time since 2006-07 that Big South teams have defeated SEC and Big East members in the same year.

GO FOUR IT

Coastal Carolina's 4-0 overall start is its best as Big South members. Meanwhile, Campbell has started 3-0 in its return to the Conference, and if the Camels can win at Chicago State on Nov. 21 to improve to 4-0, it would mark just the second time in Big South history that two teams opened a season 4-0. The previous time was in 1999-00, when Liberty and Winthrop both started the campaign with four-straight wins.

MARQUEE HOME OPPONENTS, ACT III

A Big South member will host another major Conference school in December when High Point entertains Wake Forest on Dec. 7, marking the third occasion of the 2011-12 season. UNC Asheville hosted No. 1 North Carolina on Nov. 13, and Coastal Carolina hosted LSU on Nov. 15.

LENDING A HELPING HAND

Liberty senior guard **JESSE SANDERS** became the 11th player in Big South history with 500 career assists when he reached the milestone against Eastern Kentucky on Nov. 18. He is now ninth all-time in Conference annals with 517, and needs four to move into eighth-place. Sanders is 88 helpers shy of breaking the Conference's all-time record of 604, which was established by Radford's **AMIR JOHNSON** from 2006-10. Meanwhile, UNC Asheville senior guard **J.P. PRIMM** is tied for 12th in League annals with 479 career assists and needs 21 handouts to be the 12th with 500.

GIVE-AND-TAKE

UNC Asheville senior guard **J.P. PRIMM** has 479 career assists and 192 career steals, and is on pace to become just the fifth player in Big South history with 500 assists and 200 steals. Primm is set to join Winthrop's **CHRIS GAYNOR** (567 AST, 259 STL), Campbell's **BRAD CHILDRESS** (543-243), Charleston Southern's **ED O'NEIL** (504-241) and Coastal Carolina's **ROBERT DOWDELL** (561-239) in the club. Meanwhile, Primm could become the first player in Big South history with 400 rebounds, 400 assists and 200 steals. He needs 42 boards for 400.

ELDER STATESMAN

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** is the eighth-winningest active coach with 618 Division I wins, and he enters this week four wins shy of 700 overall victories in his head coaching career. Ellis has directed four different Division I programs to at least two 20-win campaigns, and owns six seasons with at least 25 wins. He is now 618-384 at the Division I level following Coastal's 4-0 start to the 2011-12 campaign. Ellis stands 696-396 overall in 36 years as a head coach, including 84-47 (=64.1 percent) in five seasons at Coastal Carolina. He is 16 wins away from winning 100 games with his fourth different Division I program.

MY FAVORITE MARTIN

Charleston Southern senior forward **KELVIN MARTIN** grabbed his 700th career rebound on Nov. 15 against Bluefield College, becoming the 20th player in Big South history with 1,000 points (1,057) and 700 rebounds. He currently ranks 16th in League annals with 717 career boards. Martin is 40 steals shy of 200 in his career, which would make him just the third player with 1,000 points, 500 rebounds and 200 steals. In addition, he needs 18 blocks for 100 and could become one of three in Conference history with 1,000 points, 700 rebounds, 200 steals and 100 blocks. Stay tuned.

SAM I AM

Coastal Carolina redshirt-junior **SAM McLAURIN** is tied for 18th in Big South history with 125 career blocked shots. He needs 47 rebounds for 500 in his career, and once he reaches the benchmark, he will be the 15th player in the Big South record books with 500 rebounds and 100 blocked shots.

STEADY EDDIE

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** is the Big South's all-time winningest coach for overall wins (217) and Big South victories (128). Biedenbach is four wins shy of 250 in his head coaching career, as he is 246-285 in 18 years as a collegiate head coach.

SPEAKING OF COACHING WINS...

Charleston Southern head coach **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH** is eight wins away from 100 in his career as a head coach, while VMI's **DUGGAR BAUCOM** is 10 wins away from 100 victories at the Institute.

THROWIN' THEM A BONE

The UNC Asheville Bulldogs tallied a school-record 38 assists in their 126-75 win over Mars Hill last week, the second-most assists in a single-game in Big South history. The record is 39 assists, which has been accomplished twice.

2,000-POINT ODYSSEY?

High Point senior guard **NICK BARBOUR** is the Conference's active leading career scorer with 1,535 points, which ranks 25th all-time in Big South history. He is 233 points away from cracking the League's Top 10, and 465 points shy of becoming the seventh player in Conference annals with 2,000 points. He would need to average 17.88 points a game in the Panthers' 26 remaining regular-season games to reach the milestone. Barbour entered the season with a career scoring average of 16.9 points.

BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

VMI junior **STAN OKOYE** is two points away from 1,000 in his career, as he has 998 points in 64 career games played (15.59 scoring average). He would become the 106th player on the Conference's all-time list. Below is a look at the Big South's active 1,000-point scorers, as well as those closing in on the milestone:

BEING THE LINE LEADER

Campbell freshman **TREY FREEMAN** has made all 22 of his free throw attempts to start his collegiate career, including a 12-of-12 performance in the Camels' win over East Carolina on Nov. 14. He is the 10th player in Big South history with a perfect free throw percentage in a game when making at least 12 from the charity stripe.

MR. TRIPLE-DOUBLE

Liberty senior guard **JESSE SANDERS**, who is the only player in Big South history with 600 career rebounds (613) and 500 assists (517), could become the first player in Division I history with a triple-double in four different years. He owns three of the eight triple-doubles on record in Conference annals. He recorded his first as a freshman against Presbyterian College on Feb. 9, 2009, his second during his sophomore year against Kentucky Christian on Dec. 12, 2009, and his third as a junior against Charleston Southern on Jan. 6, 2011.

THREE-FOR-ALL

VMI's **KEITH GABRIEL** has made 247 three-pointers in his career, good for 13th on the Conference's all-time list. He needs 37 treys to crack the career Top 10, and 53 threes to become the seventh player in Big South history with 300 career three-point field goals.

ROAD WORK AHEAD...

Coastal Carolina carries a school-record 10-consecutive Big South road game win streak into this season. The Conference record for most consecutive road League wins is 11, first set by Winthrop from 2004-06 and tied by Radford from 2008-10. The Chanticleers' first Big South road game this season is Dec. 31 at High Point.

CLASS ACT

Liberty senior guard **JESSE SANDERS** is one of 30 national candidates for the 2011-12 Lowe's Senior CLASS Award. To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence -- Community, Classroom, Character and Competition. The award focuses on the total student-athlete and encourages students to use their platform in athletics to make a positive impact as leaders in their communities. The 30 candidates will be narrowed to 10 finalists midway through the regular season, and those 10 names will be placed on the official ballot. Sanders is the Big South's first candidate since Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** in 2007-08.

CAMPBELL

Campbell hits the road for the first time this season and is looking to start 4-0 for the first time since 1987-88. If the Camels defeat Chicago State on Monday, it would mark the first time that CU has opened the year with four wins over Division I opponents ... **DARREN WHITE** set Gore Arena records for points scored in a game (33), in a half (22), field goals (13) and field goal attempts (21) while posting his second-straight double-double in Campbell's win over North Carolina A&T ... In front of the second-largest crowd in Gore Arena history, Campbell rallied from a 15-point deficit to defeat Conference USA member East Carolina last Monday, 76-74.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern has gone 2-0 after dropping its first two games of the season ... **KELVIN MARTIN** has set career marks during the win streak; he had 17 rebounds and five blocks against Bluefield College (surpassing previous bests that he set against Toccoa Falls last season). In the Bucs' most recent contest, Martin went for 23 points, seven rebounds, three assists and one block in the 89-59 win over Milligan College. In the two victories, Martin totaled 40 points, 24 rebounds and six blocks.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina knocked off LSU for the second-straight year, improving to 2-0 against the Tigers and 3-10 against current SEC opponents ... The Chanticleers out-rebounded the Tigers, 53-34, while holding them to just 35.4 percent shooting ... **ANTHONY RAFFA** recorded his first career double-double with a game-high 20 points and 10 rebounds ... **SAM McLAURIN** posted a career-high 16 rebounds while helping Coastal to its first 3-0 start since the 1992-93 season ... Coastal improved to 4-0 last Friday night with a 87-43 defeat of Spalding University, the best start since the 1981-82 season when the Chanticleers started 8-0.

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb saw its top four guards -- **JASON DAWSON**, **MAX LANDIS**, **TYLER STRANGE** and **LARON BUGGS** -- combine for 21 assists and just one turnover in a 91-61 win over Lees-McRae on Nov. 16 ... Dawson is averaging 14.0 ppg and Landis 13.7 ppg over the team's last three games (2-1 record) ... Gardner-Webb has seen true freshmen guards Landis and Strange combine for five total starts through four games ... GWU averaged 79.5 points per game in its two games last week ... The 'Dogs fell victim to a 20-point deficit in free throw scoring in its loss at South Carolina State, as the host Bulldogs made 28-of-42 chances, compared to Gardner-Webb's 8-of-16.

HIGH POINT

High Point hosts two consecutive non-Conference Division I opponents this week for the first time since December of 2008. The Panthers' four non-Conference home games against Division I foes are the team's most since 2001-02, when HPU hosted six ... HPU's 67-65 loss at Purdue last Monday was the closest loss to a BCS opponent in program history. The previous closest score was four points in a 63-59 loss at Auburn on Nov. 16, 2001 ... **SHAY SHINE** posted his first double-double as a Panther with 15 points and 10 rebounds at UCF last Friday ... **NICK BARBOUR** led High Point in scoring in both games last week, and has led HPU in scoring 55 times in his 91 career games.

LIBERTY

JESSE SANDERS achieved three career milestones last week, reaching 900 points, 600 rebounds and 500 assists, making him the only player in school and Big South history to accomplish the feat. Sanders concluded the week as a member of the 2K Sports Classic All-Tournament team ... Through the first six games, **ANTWAN BURRUS** is averaging 10.3 points and 7.5 rebounds per contest, an improvement over last year in the same span (7.7 points, 5.0 rebounds).

PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE

PC is 3-2 after defeating No. 20 Cincinnati this past Saturday ... **KHALID MUTAKABBIR** hit a three-pointer, one of his three on the afternoon, with 7.6 seconds remaining to give the Blue Hose the 56-54 upset win ... Arguably one of the biggest wins in school history, it marked the first win over a nationally-ranked opponent in PC's Division I history ... Mutakabbir led all scorers with a career-high tying 25 points.

RADFORD

Radford has opened the season 3-3 and will conclude its stretch of seven games in 13 days to begin the 2011-12 season at No. 2 Kentucky Wednesday. The Highlanders' game at Kentucky will conclude the inaugural Basketball Hall of Fame Tip-off ... Last season, the Highlanders didn't win their third contest until Dec. 29, 2010 ... Radford's meeting with the Wildcats will be its 14th all-time against a team ranked inside the AP Top 25.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville picked up its first win of the season last Wednesday when the Bulldogs downed Mars Hill, 126-75. The 126 points was the second-most in school history and Asheville set a school record with 38 assists in the win. ... The Bulldogs had seven players in double figures, led by freshman **KEITH HORNSBY**'s 21 ... The Bulldogs have a busy week as they host Brevard Monday and then travel to the Bahamas to compete in the Battle "4" Atlantis from Thursday through Saturday.

VMI

STAN OKOYE scored eight-straight points and had two steals in a key second half stretch that rallied VMI to the win over UMBC Saturday. Okoye and **KEITH GABRIEL** each scored 24 points in the victory.

WINTHROP

Winthrop is making its third appearance in eight years in the U.S. Virgin Islands Paradise Jam. In its Nov. 18 game against No. 19 Marquette, **ANDRE JONES** scored a career-high 29 points in a losing effort. He scored 17 in the first half and connected on four 3-pointers in the game ... A night later against Drake, **REGGIE MIDDLETON** tied a career-high with 26 points ... Winthrop closes out its tournament appearance against Drexel on Monday afternoon in the 7th/8th place game.
