**MR. TRIPLE-DOUBLE**

Liberty senior guard **JESSE SANDERS** recorded his fourth career triple-double this past Saturday at High Point, becoming the first player in Division I history with a triple-double in four different years. He tallied 14 points, 13 assists and 10 rebounds against the Panthers, and owns four of the nine triple-doubles on record in Conference annals. Sanders recorded his first as a freshman against Presbyterian College on Feb. 9, 2009, his second during his sophomore year against Kentucky Christian on Dec. 12, 2009, and his third as a junior against Charleston Southern on Jan. 6, 2011.

**MY FAVORITE MARTIN**

Charleston Southern senior forward **KELVIN MARTIN** recorded his 200th career steal this past Saturday against Winthrop, becoming just the 14th player in Big South history to surpass the total. Martin is now one of three players in the Conference's record books with 1,000 career points (1,292), 800 career rebounds (871), 200 career steals (201) and 100 career blocked shots (104). The other two are Campbell's **JOE SPINKS** (1,711 - 954 - 220 - 155) and Coastal Carolina's **JOSEPH HARRIS** (1,444 - 1,152 - 205 - 142).

**THREE TEAMS ON CUSP OF 15 WINS**

UNC Asheville, Campbell and Coastal Carolina have all won 14 games thus far. The Bulldogs are one win away from their fifth consecutive 15-win season, which would be tied for the third-longest streak in Big South history. Coastal Carolina is one victory shy of its third-straight 15-win season -- which would be a first for the Chanticleers as Big South members. Campbell has not won 15 games in a campaign since 2009-10 when the Camels had 19 wins.

**TEN-TAMOUNT**

UNC Asheville needs one more Big South victory for its fifth consecutive 10-win Conference season, which would be the second-longest streak in League annals. It would be the Bulldogs' eighth season with at least 10 Big South wins, which would be tied for the second-most in Conference history.

**DOING THEIR HOMEWORK**

The home teams have claimed 34 of the 53 Big South games played this season (=64.2 percent). In recent seasons, the home teams won 62.2 percent of the time (56-34) in both 2010-11 and 2009-10. This season, the 34 home wins have been by an average of 10.2 points, while the 19 road victories have been by 5.95 points. Here is a look at each team's home and road record in Big South games, in current standings order:

**ASHEVILLE'S UNDEFEATED START TO LEAGUE PLAY ENDS AT 8-0**

UNC Asheville's undefeated start to the Conference season ended at 8-0 last week. The start matched its best-ever opening in Big South play that was first accomplished in 1997-98 -- **EDDIE BIEDENBACH**'s second season as head coach. Prior to this season, a total of seven teams started the Big South season at least 8-0 since 1985-86, and all seven of those squads won the regular-season crown. In addition, five teams that opened 8-0 went on to win the Conference Tournament title -- the last being Winthrop 2006-07, while the remaining two finished as Big South Tournament runner-up.

**CAUGHT IN A WEBB**

Gardner-Webb has seen all nine of its Big South games this season decided in the final possessions, as the Runnin' Bulldogs have won their four Conference games by 2, 6, 4 and 3 points (15 points combined, 3.8 average) while dropping their five League losses by 6, 4, 2, 6 and 2 points (20 points combined, 4.0 average).

**LINE LEADER**

High Point's **NICK BARBOUR**, who became the ninth player in Big South history to make 400 career free throws, now ranks eighth all-time with 416 and needs five freebies to move past Winthrop's **JAMES SHULER** (420 from 2002-06) for seventh-place in the Big South record book. Meanwhile, UNC Asheville's **MATT DICKEY** eclipsed 400 career free throws last week and is ninth in League history with 406. Teammate **J.P. PRIMM** is one free throw shy of the 400-free throw mark.

**BULLDOGS' CONFERENCE GAME WIN STREAK ENDS AT 11**

The UNC Asheville Bulldogs saw their 11-game Conference win streak snapped last Thursday by Charleston Southern. The streak, tied for the sixth-longest in Big South history, was the Bulldogs' longest Big South win streak since winning 12 across two seasons from Feb. 10, 1997 (4) to Jan. 31, 1998 (8).

**BARBOUR SHOP**

High Point senior guard **NICK BARBOUR** -- who has scored 33 points three times in his last four games -- is now ninth in Big South history with 1,891 career points, and needs three points to move into eighth-place. He is 109 points shy of becoming the seventh player in Conference annals with 2,000 points, and needs to average 10.9 points a game in the Panthers' 10 remaining games (nine regular-season and at least 1 Tournament contest) to reach the milestone. **THE BIG 5-0-0**

High Point's **COREY LAW** is seven rebounds away from becoming the fifth player this season and 65th in League history to reach 500 career rebounds in the Big South. Once he reaches the milestone, he will join VMI's **STAN OKOYE**, Coastal Carolina's **SAM McLAURIN**, Winthrop's **GEORGE VALENTINE** and PC's **AL'LONZO COLEMAN** among the 500-rebound club entrants this season.

**SAND CASTLE**

Liberty senior guard **JESSE SANDERS** became the Big South's all-time assist leader Jan. 7 at UNC Asheville when he handed out his 604th career helper. He enters this week with 642 after recording his fifth 10-assist game (13) this season at High Point this past Saturday. Sanders is averaging a League-best 8.10 assists per game this season, which is currently the second-highest assist average in a single-season in Big South history. The Conference record is 9.64, which was set by Charleston Southern's **TONY FAIRLEY** in 1986-87. Fairley also holds the Big South single-season assist record of 270 in '86-87, and Sanders is 100 assists shy of that total and would need to average 9.1 assists in Liberty's 11 remaining games to catch Fairley's record. Meanwhile, Sanders needs just 11 helpers to crack the League's single-season Top 10 chart.

**GRAB BAG**

UNC Asheville senior guard **J.P. PRIMM**, who is the only player in Big South history with 400 career rebounds, 500 career assists and 200 career steals, is tied for seventh in League annals with 552 assists and tied for eighth in Conference history with 223 steals. Already Asheville's career assist record holder, Primm is one steal away from becoming the school's all-time leader in that category as well. Four other Big South players recorded 500 assists and 200 steals in their respective careers -- Winthrop's **CHRIS GAYNOR** (567 AST, 259 STL), Campbell's **BRAD CHILDRESS** (543-243), Charleston Southern's **ED O'NEIL** (504-241) and Coastal Carolina's **ROBERT DOWDELL** (561-239).

**TREY-LINER**

Campbell freshman guard **TREY FREEMAN** is first in the Conference with an 85.0 free throw percentage, and is looking to become the first freshman to lead the Big South in free throw shooting since 1995-96 (UMBC's **ALHAMISI SIMMS**) and the fourth overall.

## FROM THE LAND OF THREE

VMI senior **KEITH GABRIEL** and High Point senior **NICK BARBOUR** are poised to join the Big South's 300 three-point field goal club, which currently stands at six members. Gabriel is 11th all-time in League history with 279 career threes, while Barbour is right him in 12th-place with 275 treys.

## 50-50 RAFFLE

Both Coastal Carolina (50.5) and Campbell (50.1) are making at least 50 percent of their field goals this season to rank among the national leaders. Coastal is third in the nation while the Camels are fifth. Just five teams in Big South history have ever finished a season with a field goal percentage above 50 percent -- and not in the same year. The last Big South team to make at least 50.0 percent from the field was Radford in 1993-94.

## BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

UNC Asheville's **CHRIS STEPHENSON** became the sixth player this season and 110th in Big South history to score 1,000 career points when he surpassed the milestone last Thursday against Charleston Southern. VMI's **MICHAEL SPARKS** is 26 points away from the scoring mark. Below is a look at the Big South's active 1,000-point scorers (currently 10), as well as those closing in on the milestone:

## SENIOR MOMENTS

UNC Asheville seniors **MATT DICKEY** and **J.P. PRIMM** have scored 15 points in the same game 25 times since arriving in Asheville in 2008-09, and the Bulldogs are 19-6 in those games. The duo has achieved this feat six times in 2011-12 (5-1 record) after reaching the total 14 times in 2010-11.

## DOUBLE TAKE

Campbell's **DARREN WHITE**, the Conference's last player to score double figures in every game since the start of the season, managed just six points at Winthrop Jan. 17 and had his double-figure scoring streak snapped at 19 games. Teammate **ERIC GRIFFIN** takes over as the Big South's active leader for consecutive double-figure scoring games with 13.

## SAND BAR

Liberty guard **JESSE SANDERS** is the only player in Big South history with 1,000 career points (1,101), 700 career rebounds (733) and 600 career assists (642). He is one of 21 players with 1,000 points and 700 boards, and ranks 14th all-time in career rebounds -- needing 53 boards to move into the Big South's all-time Top 10. Meanwhile, Sanders is the only player in the nation averaging 8.0 rebounds (8.0) and 8.0 assists (8.1), and would become the first player in Big South history to do so in the same season.

## SCOREBOARD WATCHING

Reigning five-time NCAA scoring champion VMI leads the Big South and is third in Division I with 84.2 points per game -- just 0.9 behind North Carolina's national-leading 85.1 average. The Keydets are attempting to claim their unprecedented sixth-straight NCAA scoring title, and vaulted back into the national lead the week of Dec. 4 after being No. 12 in scoring offense the week prior. The Keydets held the top spot for four weeks before dropping to second the week of Jan. 2.

## BAND OF BROTHERS

Liberty brothers **JESSE** and **JOHN CALEB SANDERS** have combined to score 1,478 points during their respective careers with the Flames. Jesse has 1,101 of the total, while John Caleb is at 377.

**DO THE CHARLESTON**

Charleston Southern's 13-7 start is its best after 20 games since the 1986-87 squad also opened 13-7. Earlier this season, the Bucs won 10 of its first 15 games, the fastest CSU reached 10 victories in a season since 1969-70, when Charleston Southern opened 10-4 that season. The 2011-12 squad needs two Big South wins to match last season's total of nine, and three wins to equal last year's overall win total of 16.

**MOUNTAIN TOP**

League-leading UNC Asheville saw its school-record streak of consecutive Conference games scoring at least 80 points snapped at six games, as the Bulldogs finished with 66 points at Presbyterian this past Saturday. During the streak from Jan. 5-19, Asheville averaged 90.5 points, and scored 90 points in back-to-back Conference games for the first-time ever.

**THE 411 ON THE 225**

Since Conference play resumed Dec. 31, six League games have gone to overtime, including two on the same night twice (Dec. 31, Jan. 7). The site victor is split down the middle at three home wins and three road wins. Of the six, Winthrop and Coastal Carolina have played two OT games each. Last season, eight Big South games went into overtime, with the road squads winning five times.

**ANDRE THE GIANT**

Winthrop's **ANDRE JONES** is fourth in the Big South with 18.0 points per game, the highest scoring average by a Winthrop Eagle since **FRED MCKINNON** averaged 21.1 points in 1985-86. Jones, who entered the season with a career scoring average of 8.5 points, has scored in double figures in 19 of 21 games this year -- including the first 16 contests, and has poured in 20 points seven times this season -- including six games with 25+. He has led Winthrop in scoring 13 times this season, and his 378 points scored already surpasses his previous season-high of 321, which was set in 30 games last year.

**SAMSONITE**

Coastal Carolina redshirt-junior **SAM McLAURIN** is currently 15th in Big South history with a school-record 143 career blocked shots. He is one of 16 players in League annals with 500 rebounds (568) and 100 career blocks. McLaurin is 32 rebounds away from becoming the sixth Coastal Carolina Chanticleers to enter the Big South's 600 rebound club, which currently has 36 members.

**BOTH ENDS OF THE SPECTRUM**

Of the 53 Big South games played this season, 35 had winning margins of less than 10 points (=66.0 percent), with the average margin of victory in those 35 games being 5.4 points. The remaining 18 games that have decided by at least 10 points had an average winning margin of 14.9 points. Overall, the 53 Conference games played thus far in 2011-12 have had an average margin of victory of 8.66 points. Last year, the overall margin of victory in League play was 10.48, while the 2009-10 average margin was 10.51 points and the 2008-09 League season was 8.96 points.

**3-0 STARTS**

For the first time in League history, four Big South teams started Conference play 3-0 in the same season. Asheville started 3-0 for the seventh time -- all under head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH**. Coastal Carolina opened 3-0 in League action for the third consecutive year, marking the second time the Chanticleers have achieved this three-peat and the first Big South team to open 3-0 in back-to-back-to-back seasons since UNC Asheville in 1996-97, 1997-98 and 1998-99. Charleston Southern started 3-0 in the Big South for the first time since 2004-05. Campbell opened Big South play 3-0 for the first time since 1993-94 when the Camels opened 4-0.

**COASTAL CAROLINA TIES BIG SOUTH RECORD FOR CONSECUTIVE LEAGUE ROAD WINS**

Coastal Carolina's school-record 11-consecutive Big South road wins -- tied for the longest in Big South history, was snapped Monday, Jan. 2 at Campbell as the Camels claimed a 70-65 home win in overtime. The Chants had tied the mark that was first established by Winthrop from 2004-06 and matched by Radford from 2008-10. The Conference's active streak now belongs to UNC Asheville at seven.

**CLASS ACT**

Liberty senior guard **JESSE SANDERS** is one of 30 national candidates for the 2011-12 Lowe's Senior CLASS Award. To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence -- Community, Classroom, Character and Competition. The award focuses on the total student-athlete and encourages students to use their platform in athletics to make a positive impact as leaders in their communities. The 30 candidates will be narrowed to 10 finalists midway through the regular season, and those 10 names will be placed on the official ballot. Sanders is the Big South's first candidate since Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** in 2007-08.

**ALL IN**

The Big South Conference will utilize a new format for its postseason men's basketball Conference Tournament in 2012, as the 2012 Advance Auto Parts Men's Basketball Championship will feature all 10 eligible teams in the field as well as the quarterfinals and semifinals contested at the No. 1 seed -- the first single-site for both rounds since 2002. The 10-team field will be the largest in the event's history, and first round games will be contested for just the second time -- the last occurring in 1993. The Tournament will begin with two first round contests on Monday night, Feb. 27, with the No. 7 seed hosting the No. 10 seed, and the No. 8 seed hosting the No. 9 seed. The winners advance into the quarterfinals on Wednesday, Feb. 29 at the home arena of the No. 1 seed. The No. 7-10 winner will play the No. 2 seed and the No. 8-9 winner will face the No. 1 seed. The bracket appears on page 10 of this report.

**ELDER STATESMAN**

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** won his 700th game as a collegiate head coach on Dec. 6 when the Chanticleers won 80-58 at The Citadel. Now in his 37th year as a head coach, Ellis stands 706-402 overall, including 94-53 ( =63.9 percent) in five seasons at Coastal Carolina. He is the eighth-winningest active head coach with 628 Division I wins (628-390 at the Division I level) and is 34th on the all-time Division I wins list -- five away from tying **HUGH DURHAM** for 33rd-place with 633. In addition, Ellis has directed four different Division I programs to at least two 20-win campaigns, and owns six seasons with at least 25 wins. He is six wins away from winning 100 games with his fourth different Division I program.

**STEADY EDDIE**

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** became the school's all-time victory leader on Jan. 2 with his 224th win at the helm of the Bulldogs, passing **BOB HARTMAN** for the career record. Biedenbach, who won his 250th career game with the Bulldogs' 88-81 win over USC Upstate on Dec. 4, is the Big South's all-time winningest coach for overall wins (230) and Big South victories (137), and is now 259-290 in 18 years as a collegiate head coach.

**RADEBAUGH AND PEELE GET MILESTONE WINS ON THE SAME NIGHT**

Charleston Southern head coach **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH** collected his 100th career head coaching win with the Buccaneers' 91-73 victory over Campbell on Jan. 5. That same night, Winthrop's **RANDY PEELE** notched his 100th win as a Big South head coach. Radebaugh's career total includes 82 wins at CSU and 21 at Queen's University. Peele has now won 103 games as a Big South head coach -- 73 at Winthrop and 30 during UNC Greensboro's membership in the Conference.

**CENTURY MARK IN THEIR SIGHTS**

Campbell head coach **ROBBIE LAING** needs two wins for 100 in his collegiate head coaching career, and VMI head coach **DUGGAR BAUCOM** is three wins away from 100 victories at the Institute.

**BIG SOUTH TIEBREAKING PROCEDURE**

While the Big South has 11 men's basketball members for the first time, the Conference is still utilizing an 18-game League schedule in 2011-12. Each team will play eight teams twice and two teams once.

A new tiebreaker procedure to address this unbalanced schedule is below and will be used to determine the seeding of teams for the Big South Tournament, if necessary.

**TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURE FOR SEEDING TWO-TEAM TIE**

(1) *Regular-season head-to-head results. If the tied teams split their two games, then proceed to Step 2 below.*

(2) *Win-loss record vs. Conference opponents occupying the highest position in the final regular-season standings in which the tied teams played an equal amount of times. Continue down through the standings until one team gains an advantage. If an advantage is not determined, proceed to Step 3.*

(3) *The team with the highest ranking on the most recent College Basketball RPI Report (or the NCAA's RPI listing). Note - the Conference office will research to determine which rating is most accurate/current.*

**TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURE FOR SEEDING MULTI-TEAM TIE**

(1) *Regular-season head-to-head results. If the tied teams split their two games, then proceed to Step 2 below.*

(2) *Win-loss record vs. Conference opponents occupying the highest position in the final regular-season standings in which the tied teams played an equal amount of times. Continue down through the standings until one team gains an advantage. If an advantage is not determined, proceed to Step 3.*

(3) *The team with the highest ranking on the most recent College Basketball RPI Report (or the NCAA's RPI listing). Note - the Conference office will research to determine which rating is most accurate/current.*

**BIG SOUTH ANNOUNCES ADDITION OF LONGWOOD UNIVERSITY**

The Big South Conference announced on Monday, Jan. 23 that it has added Longwood University as its 12th member effective with the 2012-13 academic year. The addition increases the League's membership to an all-time high of 12. The Lancers have been a full-fledged member of NCAA Division I since 2007 and have been playing as an Independent.

**BIG SOUTH TO MAKE SEVENTH APPEARANCE IN ESPN'S BRACKETBUSTERS EVENT**

The Big South Conference will again participate in the SEARS BracketBusters event this season during the weekend of February 17-19, with a League-record 11 teams among the field of 142 -- the event's largest pool ever. All of the Big South's men's basketball programs are participating in the same year for the first time, and the Conference has the second-most members competing of the 16 Leagues involved this season. Five Big South teams will host a game while the remaining six members will play on the road. The Conference is 8-16 all-time in the BracketBusters, including two wins in 2006, 2007 and 2010. The Big South has also been selected for national television appearances four times in the past five years: 2007 (ESPN2), 2008 (ESPN2), 2009 (ESPNU) and 2011 (ESPNU).

**MID-MAJOR MANIA**

For the eighth consecutive season, the Big South has had a member ranked in the *Collegeinsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 poll, as Campbell was ranked No. 25 the week of Dec. 12 and Coastal Carolina was ranked No. 25 the week of Dec. 19. It was the Camels' first appearance in the 13-year-old ranking, and the third-straight season the Chanticleers were ranked in the poll. **TOAST TO THE COAST**

Seven days after defeating LSU, Coastal Carolina won 60-59 at Clemson on Nov. 22, marking the second-straight year that a Big South member has defeated an SEC team and ACC team in the same season. Presbyterian College did it last year in back-to-back games, as the Blue Hose won at Auburn on Dec. 18 and followed with a win at Wake Forest on Dec. 20. The Chanticleers are now the third Big South team in Conference history with SEC-ACC wins in the same campaign. The first was Campbell in 1993-94 when the Camels defeated North Carolina State and South Carolina.

**BACK TO THE FUTURE**

The Big South has recorded wins over the SEC, Big East and ACC this season, an accomplishment that occurred just once previously in League history. The 1993-94 season was the first time the Big South Conference defeated an SEC, Big East and ACC team in the same year. Meanwhile, the Big South has now collected an SEC win five out of the last six seasons, an ACC win four out of the last five seasons, and a Big East win four out of the last eight seasons.

**BUT WAIT, THERE'S MORE**

This is the first time the Big South has ever posted wins over five of the six "BCS" Conferences in a single-season, as Campbell's win at Iowa on Nov. 23 and UNC Asheville's victory over Utah on Nov. 26 gave the Big South victories against Big Ten and Pac-12 members. It was the Big South's first-ever win over a Big Ten team, and the Conference's first win against a Pac-12 member since 1996-97.

Campbell extended its win streak to four games (the longest current stretch in the Big South and CU's best since opening the year with 5-straight victories) ... CU finished 4-1 in its 5-games-in-10-days stretch by winning its last four, including three on the road... **ERIC GRIFFIN** averaged 18 points, 10.7 rebounds and 3.3 blocks while shooting 58.5% from the field last week and had 3-straight double-doubles ... **DARREN WHITE** grabbed a career-high 16 rebounds, scored 22 points on 10-of-12 shooting and dealt eight assists in Saturday's win over VMI.

**CHARLESTON SOUTHERN**

CSU matched its road win total from a year ago with its 93-88 victory at UNC Asheville ... CSU is now 4-0 this season when scoring 90 or more points ... CSU's 58.9% field goal mark against Asheville marked the third time this season that the Bucs have shot 58% or better from the field ... CSU assisted on 24 of its 33 made field goals against the Bulldogs, also a season-high ... CSU's 31 free-throw attempts against Winthrop were a season-high, while the 24 makes were the second-most.

**COASTAL CAROLINA**

Coastal went 1-1 last week, falling on the road to Asheville on Tuesday and defeating Radford at home on Saturday ... The loss to Asheville was Coastal's third-straight in the series. Against the Bulldogs, Coastal had six players score double-digits for the first time all season. Individually, **SAM McLAURIN** set Coastal's career blocked shot mark with his 143rd career block in the game ... The Chants shot 29-of-44 (65.9%) from the field against Radford for their best mark in Big South play. **ANTHONY RAFFA** tied a career-high with 28 points on 10-of-13 from the field.

**GARDNER-WEBB**

Gardner-Webb played just once last week, a two-point loss in the final seconds at Winthrop ... Freshman **MAX LANDIS** is averaging 15.3 points in his last four outings.

**HIGH POINT**

**NICK BARBOUR** moved up to No. 3 at HPU in career scoring with his current total of 1,891 points. Only **EUGENE LITTLES** (2,398) and **ARIZONA REID** (2,069) rank ahead of Barbour at High Point. Barbour has scored 33 points in three of the last four games, leading HPU in scoring each time. He averaged 28.5 points over those four games ... **SHAY SHINE** led High Point with 23 points at VMI last Thursday, the seventh time this season he led the Panthers in scoring ... **JUSTIN CHEEK** earned his second career start and played a career-high 29 minutes at VMI, scoring six points with three assists ... **XAVIER MARTIN** had a career-high seven assists at Radford last Tuesday, then tied it with seven against Liberty on Saturday.

**LIBERTY**

Liberty's victory inside the Millis Center this past Saturday marked the Flames' first Conference road win of the season, and the fifth against High Point since the series began during the 1998-99 season. Liberty now leads the all-time series, 18-11 ... **JESSE SANDERS** (642) needs seven more assists to surpass **KARL HESS** (1977-80, 648) as Liberty's all-time assist leader ... **PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE**

UNC Asheville concluded a grueling stretch of playing five games in 10 days with a 4-1 record ... Asheville's seven-game winning streak came to an end with a 93-88 home loss to Charleston Southern last Thursday. The loss also broke a seven-game homecourt winning streak at Kimmel Arena ... In the Coastal Carolina win last Tuesday, Asheville shot the second-highest free throw percentage in school history by going 31-of-33 for 93.9 percent. **MATT DICKEY** missed his first free throw and then made his next 12 en route to his current streak of 18-straight ... **CHRIS STEPHENSON** became the 28th player in school history to reach 1,000 career points ... Dickey moved into fourth-place on the school's all-time career scoring list with 1,568 points. In addition, he became the school's all-time leader in free throws made. He has 406.

**KEITH GABRIEL** averaged 31.0 points and 5.5 points with 81.2% free throw shooting (13-16) in two games last week that VMI split, including 33 points at Campbell. The 33 points was second only to his career-high mark of 34 points set three times previously. Over the last three games, Gabriel is averaging 30.0 points and 6.3 rebounds while shooting 52% from the floor and hitting 19-of-24 from the free throw line for 79.2% ... **STAN OKOYE** averaged a double-double last week with 19.0 points and 13.5 rebounds in two games. Okoye pulled down a career-high 18 rebounds at Campbell Jan. 21 ... VMI is the lone team of 344 Division I schools to be undefeated at home (9-0) and winless on opponent floors (0-10) ... VMI blocked a season-high eight shots in the loss at Campbell.

That loss followed a 56-54 home win over Gardner-Webb on Thursday and a 54-51 home defeat against Campbell on Jan. 17 ... The fewest assists in a game for Winthrop this year had been five ... **ANDRE JONES** connected on a career-high 11 field goals against the Bucs and finished the game with 26 points ... **GEORGE VALENTINE** moved into 7th-place on Winthrop's career rebound list with 579 ...
