15-FOOTERS

With their respective wins last Thursday, Jan. 26, UNC Asheville and Coastal Carolina have each extended streaks of consecutive 15-win seasons. The Bulldogs have now won at least 15 games in five consecutive seasons, tied for the third-longest streak in Big South history. It is also their 14th 15-win season since the Conference was formed, which ranks as the third-most in League history. Coastal Carolina has now won at least 15 games in three consecutive years, which is a first for the Chanticleers as Big South members.

TEN-TAMOUNT

UNC Asheville has also recorded its fifth consecutive 10-win Conference season, which is the second-longest streak in League annals. The record is nine by Winthrop from 1999-08. It is the Bulldogs' eighth season with at least 10 Big South wins, tied for the second-most in Conference history. Meanwhile, Coastal Carolina is one Conference victory away from its third-straight season with at least 10 Big South wins, which would be a first for the Chanticleer program.

TWO TV GAMES ON THIS WEEK'S SLATE

The "BB&T Big South Game of the Week" television package continues this week with two games on MASN. First up is Thursday's Presbyterian College at High Point game at 7:00pm, followed by Saturday's Charleston Southern at Coastal Carolina contest at 2:00pm. The CSU-CCU match-up will also be simulcast on WMBF News in Conway/Myrtle Beach. **MATT HOGUE** (play-by-play) and **NATE ROSS** (analyst) will call both games.

LIKE BROTHERS

UNC Asheville senior guards **MATT DICKEY** (1,613) and **J.P. PRIMM** (1,539) are just the second pair of four-year teammates in Big South history to each score more than 1,500 career points. The backcourt tandem join twin brothers **CHAVIS HOLMES** (2,065) and **TRAVIS HOLMES** (1,733) in this elite group. The Brothers Holmes played together at VMI from 2005-09.

HEIR APPARENTS?

As UNC Asheville's **MATT DICKEY** and **J.P. PRIMM** conclude their collegiate careers this season, Charleston Southern's freshmen backcourt of **SAAH NIMLEY** and **ARLON HARPER** are ready to replace the soon-to-be-departing Bulldogs as the Big South's top guard tandem. Nimley is averaging a team-high 14.7 points, while Harper is contributing 12.9 points a game this season. By comparison, Dickey averaged 10.9 points and Primm scored 9.0 a game as freshmen in 2008-09.

DOING THEIR HOMEWORK

The home teams have claimed 38 of the 63 Big South games played this season (=60.3 percent). In recent seasons, the home teams won 62.2 percent of the time (56-34) in both 2010-11 and 2009-10. This season, the 38 home wins have been by an average of 10.13 points, while the 25 road victories have been by 6.12 points. LINE LEADERS

UNC Asheville's **J.P. PRIMM** became the 11th player in Big South history and third this season to surpass 400 career free throws when he eclipsed the mark Jan. 26 against High Point. He enters this week at 411. High Point's **NICK BARBOUR** was the first this season to surpass 400 made free throws and is now seventh all-time with 425. Primm's teammate **MATT DICKEY** followed Barbour into the club and sits one back in eighth-place at 424. Barbour is seven free throws away from sixth-place (VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES**, 431 from 2005-09).

CAUGHT IN A WEBB

Gardner-Webb's first 10 Big South games this season were decided in the final possessions, as the Runnin' Bulldogs won five of those Conference games by 2, 6, 4, 3 and 6 points (21 points combined, 4.2 average) while dropping five contests by 6, 4, 2, 6 and 2 points (20 points combined, 4.0 average). GWU's under-6 points streak ended with a 16-point loss to Coastal Carolina on Jan. 28.

CONFERENCE TOURNAMENT APPROACHING

The 2012 Advance Auto Parts Big South Men's Basketball Championship Tournament will commence on Monday, Feb. 27 with first round games at the home sites of the No. 7 and No. 8 seeds. The winners will advance to the quarterfinals that will be contested Wednesday, Feb. 29 at the No. 1 seed -- which will again have the chance to host throughout the Tournament.

For the seventh consecutive season, the semifinals will be contested at the site of the No. 1 seed and will be broadcast live on ESPNU on Thursday, March 1. The highest remaining seed will host the Championship game on its home floor Saturday, March 3 at 12:00pm live on ESPN or ESPN2.

BARBOUR SHOP

High Point senior guard **NICK BARBOUR** is now eighth in Big South history with 1,916 career points, and needs 53 points to move into seventh-place. He is 84 points shy of becoming the seventh player in Conference annals with 2,000 points, and needs to average 10.5 points a game in the Panthers' eight remaining games (7 regular-season and at least 1 Tournament contest) to reach the milestone. BE MY VALENTINE

Winthrop redshirt-senior **GEORGE VALENTINE** became the 37th player in Big South history with 600 career rebounds when he eclipsed the milestone this past Saturday against High Point. He is the sixth Winthrop Eagle among the Conference's all-time rebounders with at least 600, and is 12 blocked shots away from becoming the 13th player in League history with 600 rebounds and 100 blocks. Meanwhile, Coastal Carolina's **SAM McLAURIN** is 14 rebounds away from the 600 rebound-100 block club. He currently owns 586 boards and 147 rejections.

WELCOME MATT

UNC Asheville's **MATT DICKEY** needs five assists to become the 20th player in Big South history with 400 career helpers. Once he reaches that milestone, he would also become just the fifth player in League annals with 400 assists and 400 rebounds. The others in that group are Liberty's **JESSE SANDERS** (748 REB, 658 AST), Radford's **AMIR JOHNSON** (477 REB, 604 AST), UNC Asheville's **K.J. GARLAND** (428 REB, 520 AST) and **J.P. PRIMM** (423 REB, 562 AST).

MY FAVORITE MARTIN

Charleston Southern senior forward **KELVIN MARTIN** one of three players in the Conference's record books with 1,000 career points (1,306), 800 career rebounds (875), 200 career steals (203) and 100 career blocked shots (106). The other two are Campbell's **JOE SPINKS** (1,711 - 954 - 220 - 155) and Coastal Carolina's **JOSEPH HARRIS** (1,444 - 1,152 - 205 - 142).

Charleston Southern's **KELVIN MARTIN** is fourth all-time in League history with 875 career rebounds, and is 25 away from becoming the fourth player with 900. Below are the Big South's all-time leading rebounders:

BIG SOUTH'S BRACKETBUSTERS OPPONENTS TO BE UNVEILED JAN. 30

ESPN will formerly announce the 2012 SEARS BracketBusters pairings on Monday evening, Jan. 30, beginning at 6:30pm with a Selection Show on ESPNU to announce the TV match-ups. At 7:00pm, the non-TV games will be released. The Big South is participating in the annual event for the seventh consecutive season, with a League-record 11 teams among the field of 142 -- the event's largest pool ever. All of the Big South's men's basketball programs are participating in the same year for the first time, and the Conference has the second-most members competing of the 16 Leagues involved this season. Five Big South teams will host a game while the remaining six members will play on the road. The Conference is 8-16 all-time in the BracketBusters, including two wins in 2006, 2007 and 2010. The Big South has also been selected for national television appearances four times in the past five years: 2007 (ESPN2), 2008 (ESPN2), 2009 (ESPNU) and 2011 (ESPNU).

FROM THE LAND OF THREE

VMI senior **KEITH GABRIEL** and High Point senior **NICK BARBOUR** are poised to join the Big South's 300 three-point field goal club, which currently stands at six members. Gabriel is 11th all-time in League history with 280 career threes, while Barbour is right him in 12th-place with 279 treys. Meanwhile, UNC Asheville's **J.P. PRIMM** is 11 three-pointers away from 200, which would make him the 30th player in Big South history with 200 career treys. VMI's **MICHAEL SPARKS** surpassed the mark earlier this season as the 29th player to accomplish this feat.

50-50 RAFFLE

Both Campbell (50.2) and Coastal Carolina (50.0) are making at least 50 percent of their field goals this season to rank among the national leaders. Campbell is second in the nation while the Chanticleers are fourth. Just five teams in Big South history have ever finished a season with a field goal percentage at or above 50 percent -- and not in the same year. The last Big South team to make at least 50.0 percent from the field in a season was Radford in 1993-94.

BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

Presbyterian College's **AL'LONZO COLEMAN** is five points away from becoming the seventh player this season and 111th in League history to score 1,000 career points in the Big South. VMI's **MICHAEL SPARKS** is 17 points away from the scoring mark. Below is a look at the Big South's active 1,000-point scorers (currently 10), as well as those closing in on the milestone:

SENIOR MOMENTS

UNC Asheville seniors **MATT DICKEY** and **J.P. PRIMM** have scored 15 points in the same game 26 times since arriving in Asheville in 2008-09, and the Bulldogs are 20-6 in those games. The duo has achieved this feat seven times in 2011-12 (6-1 record) after reaching the total 14 times in 2010-11.

DISCOUNT DOUBLE CHECK

Campbell's **ERIC GRIFFIN** owns the Big South's longest active consecutive double-figure scoring streak at 15 games. Gardner-Webb's **TASHAN NEWSOME** is second to Griffin at 11-straight games scoring in double figures.

SAND BAR

Liberty guard **JESSE SANDERS** is the only player in Big South history with 1,000 career points (1,122), 700 career rebounds (748) and 600 career assists (658). He is one of 21 players with 1,000 points and 700 boards, and ranks 13th all-time in career rebounds -- needing 38 boards to move into the Big South's all-time Top 10. Meanwhile, Sanders is the only player in the nation averaging 7.0 rebounds (7.9) and 8.0 assists (8.1), and would become the first player in Big South history to do so in the same season.

BAND OF BROTHERS

Liberty brothers **JESSE** and **JOHN CALEB SANDERS** have combined to score 1,518 points during their respective careers with the Flames. Jesse has 1,122 of the total, while John Caleb is at 396.

GREEN MACHINE

Radford freshman forward **JAVONTE GREEN** is the top freshman rebounder in the Big South with 6.8 to rank 10th in the Conference. Since Jan. 12, Green is averaging 17.0 points and 8.7 rebounds in the seven-game span, and has made 42-of-77 from the field (=54.5 percent). Included in this stretch are three 20-point games, three double-doubles and two games with 20 points and 10 rebounds.

PRIMM AND PROPER

In his last nine games, UNC Asheville guard **J.P. PRIMM** is averaging 21.6 points, 4.6 assists and 2.0 steals, and has made exactly 50.0 percent of his three-point field goal attempts (35-of-70) in that span. He has also gone 45-of-53 at the line (=84.9 percent). In the nine-game span, Primm has posted six 20-point games and is shooting 54.8 percent overall from the floor (57-of-104).

MOUNTAIN TOP

League-leading UNC Asheville has scored at least 80 points in a game 13 times this season, the most by the Bulldogs since 13 times in 2007-08 -- the last time Asheville won the Big South regular-season championship. Earlier this month from Jan. 5-19, Asheville scored at least 80 points in six-straight Conference games, a first for the program. During that streak, the Bulldogs averaged 90.5 points, and scored 90 points in back-to-back Conference games for the first-time ever.

MR. TRIPLE-DOUBLE

Liberty senior guard **JESSE SANDERS** recorded his fourth career triple-double Jan. 21 at High Point, becoming the first player in Division I history with a triple-double in four different years. He tallied 14 points, 13 assists and 10 rebounds against the Panthers, and owns four of the nine triple-doubles on record in Conference annals. Sanders recorded his first as a freshman against Presbyterian College on Feb. 9, 2009, his second during his sophomore year against Kentucky Christian on Dec. 12, 2009, and his third as a junior against Charleston Southern on Jan. 6, 2011.

SAND CASTLE

Liberty senior guard **JESSE SANDERS**, who became the Big South's all-time assist leader Jan. 7 at UNC Asheville when he handed out his 604th career helper, enters this week with 658 after recording his sixth 10-assist game (10) this season at Winthrop last Thursday. Sanders has 186 dimes this year, which is the eighth-most in a single-season in Big South history. He is 14 away from having the seventh 200-assist campaign in League annals. Sanders's League-leading 8.09 assists this season is currently the second-highest assist average in a single-season in Big South history. The Conference record is 9.64, which was set by Charleston Southern's **TONY FAIRLEY** in 1986-87. Fairley also holds the Big South single-season assist record of 270 in '86-87, and Sanders is 84 assists shy of that total and would need to average 9.3 assists in Liberty's nine remaining games to catch Fairley's record.

FIVE-AND-DIME STORE

UNC Asheville senior guard **J.P. PRIMM**, who is the only player in Big South history with 400 career rebounds, 500 career assists and 200 career steals, is fifth in League annals with a school-record 562 assists and seventh in Conference history with a school-record 229 steals. He is 13 steals shy of moving into fifth-place on the Big South's all-time steals chart, and needs six dimes to jump into the third spot in League history.

DO THE CHARLESTON

Charleston Southern's 13-7 start after 20 games was its best 20-game start since the 1986-87 squad also opened 13-7. Earlier this year, the Bucs won 10 of their first 15 games, the fastest CSU reached 10 victories in a season since 1969-70, when Charleston Southern opened 10-4 that season. The 2011-12 squad needs just one Big South win to match last season's total of nine, and two wins to equal last year's overall win total of 16.

BOTH ENDS OF THE SPECTRUM

Of the 63 Big South games played this season, 41 had winning margins of *less than* 10 points (=65.1 percent), with the average margin of victory in those 41 games being 5.2 points. The remaining 22 games that have been decided by at least 10 points had an average winning margin of 14.77 points. Overall, the 63 Conference games played thus far in 2011-12 have had an average margin of victory of 8.54 points. Last year, the overall margin of victory in League play was 10.48, while the 2009-10 average margin was 10.51 points and the 2008-09 League season was 8.96 points.

COASTAL CAROLINA TIES BIG SOUTH RECORD FOR CONSECUTIVE LEAGUE ROAD WINS

Coastal Carolina's school-record 11-consecutive Big South road wins -- tied for the longest in Big South history, was snapped Monday, Jan. 2 at Campbell as the Camels claimed a 70-65 home win in overtime. The Chants had tied the mark that was first established by Winthrop from 2004-06 and matched by Radford from 2008-10. The Conference's active streak now belongs to UNC Asheville at seven.

ALL IN

The Big South Conference will utilize a new format for its postseason men's basketball Conference Tournament in 2012, as the 2012 Advance Auto Parts Men's Basketball Championship will feature all 10 eligible teams in the field as well as the quarterfinals and semifinals contested at the No. 1 seed -- the first single-site for both rounds since 2002. The 10-team field will be the largest in the event's history, and first round games will be contested for just the second time -- the last occurring in 1993. The Tournament will begin with two first round contests on Monday night, Feb. 27, with the No. 7 seed hosting the No. 10 seed, and the No. 8 seed hosting the No. 9 seed. The winners advance into the quarterfinals on Wednesday, Feb. 29 at the home arena of the No. 1 seed. The No. 7-10 winner will play the No. 2 seed and the No. 8-9 winner will face the No. 1 seed. The bracket appears on page 10 of this report.

ELDER STATESMAN

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** won his 700th game as a collegiate head coach on Dec. 6 when the Chanticleers won 80-58 at The Citadel. Now in his 37th year as a head coach, Ellis stands 708-402 overall, including 96-53 (=64.4 percent) in five seasons at Coastal Carolina. He is the eighth-winningest active head coach with 630 Division I wins (630-390 at the Division I level) and is 34th on the all-time Division I wins list -- three away from tying **HUGH DURHAM** for 33rd-place with 633. In addition, Ellis has directed four different Division I programs to at least two 20-win campaigns, and owns six seasons with at least 25 wins. He is four wins away from winning 100 games with his fourth different Division I program.

STEADY EDDIE

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** became the school's all-time victory leader on Jan. 2 with his 224th win at the helm of the Bulldogs, passing **BOB HARTMAN** for the career record. Biedenbach, who won his 250th career game with the Bulldogs' 88-81 win over USC Upstate on Dec. 4, is the Big South's all-time winningest coach for overall wins (232) and Big South victories (139), and is now 261-290 in 18 years as a collegiate head coach.

RADEBAUGH AND PEELE GET MILESTONE WINS ON THE SAME NIGHT

Charleston Southern head coach **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH** collected his 100th career head coaching win with the Buccaneers' 91-73 victory over Campbell on Jan. 5. That same night, Winthrop's **RANDY PEELE** notched his 100th win as a Big South head coach. Radebaugh's career total includes 83 wins at CSU and 21 at Queen's University. Peele has now won 104 games as a Big South head coach -- 74 at Winthrop and 30 during UNC Greensboro's membership in the Conference.

CENTURY MARK IN THEIR SIGHTS

Campbell head coach **ROBBIE LAING** needs two wins for 100 in his collegiate head coaching career, and VMI head coach **DUGGAR BAUCOM** is two wins away from 100 victories at the Institute.

3-0 STARTS

For the first time in League history, four Big South teams started Conference play 3-0 in the same season. Asheville started 3-0 for the seventh time -- all under head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH**. Coastal Carolina opened 3-0 in League action for the third consecutive year, marking the second time the Chanticleers have achieved this three-peat and the first Big South team to open 3-0 in back-to-back-to-back seasons since UNC Asheville in 1996-97, 1997-98 and 1998-99. Charleston Southern started 3-0 in the Big South for the first time since 2004-05. Campbell opened Big South play 3-0 for the first time since 1993-94 when the Camels opened 4-0.

BIG SOUTH TIEBREAKING PROCEDURE

While the Big South has 11 men's basketball members for the first time, the Conference is still utilizing an 18-game League schedule in 2011-12. Each team will play eight teams twice and two teams once.

A new tiebreaker procedure to address this unbalanced schedule is below and will be used to determine the seeding of teams for the Big South Tournament, if necessary.

TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURE FOR SEEDING**TWO-TEAM TIE**

(1) *Regular-season head-to-head results. If the tied teams split their two games, then proceed to Step 2 below.*

(2) *Win-loss record vs. Conference opponents occupying the highest position in the final regular-season standings in which the tied teams played an equal amount of times. Continue down through the standings until one team gains an advantage. If an advantage is not determined, proceed to Step 3.*

(3) *The team with the highest ranking on the most recent College Basketball RPI Report (or the NCAA's RPI listing). Note - the Conference office will research to determine which rating is most accurate/current.*

(1) *Regular-season head-to-head results. If the tied teams split their two games, then proceed to Step 2 below.*

TREY-LINER

Campbell freshman guard **TREY FREEMAN** is first in the Conference with an 85.7 free throw percentage, and is looking to become the first freshman to lead the Big South in free throw shooting since 1995-96 (UMBC's **ALHAMISI SIMMS**) and the fourth overall.

BIG SOUTH ANNOUNCES ADDITION OF LONGWOOD UNIVERSITY

The Big South Conference announced on Monday, Jan. 23 that it has added Longwood University as its 12th member effective with the 2012-13 academic year. The addition increases the League's membership to an all-time high of 12. The Lancers have been a full-fledged member of NCAA Division I since 2007 and have been playing as an Independent.

WILL ASHEVILLE'S 8-0 BIG SOUTH START FOLLOW PAST HISTORY?

UNC Asheville's 8-0 Big South start matched its best-ever opening in League play that was first accomplished in 1997-98 -- **EDDIE BIEDENBACH**'s second season as head coach. Prior to this season, a total of seven teams started the Big South season at least 8-0 since 1985-86, and all seven of those squads won the regular-season crown. In addition, five teams that opened 8-0 went on to win the Conference Tournament title -- the last being Winthrop 2006-07, while the remaining two finished as Big South Tournament runner-up.

MID-MAJOR MANIA

For the eighth consecutive season, the Big South has had a member ranked in the *Collegeinsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 poll, as Campbell was ranked No. 25 the week of Dec. 12 and Coastal Carolina was ranked No. 25 the week of Dec. 19. It was the Camels' first appearance in the 13-year-old ranking, and the third-straight season the Chanticleers were ranked in the poll. TOAST TO THE COAST

Seven days after defeating LSU, Coastal Carolina won 60-59 at Clemson on Nov. 22, marking the second-straight year that a Big South member has defeated an SEC team and ACC team in the same season. Presbyterian College did it last year in back-to-back games, as the Blue Hose won at Auburn on Dec. 18 and followed with a win at Wake Forest on Dec. 20. The Chanticleers are now the third Big South team in Conference history with SEC-ACC wins in the same campaign. The first was Campbell in 1993-94 when the Camels defeated North Carolina State and South Carolina.

BACK TO THE FUTURE

The Big South has recorded wins over the SEC, Big East and ACC this season, an accomplishment that occurred just once previously in League history. The 1993-94 season was the first time the Big South Conference defeated an SEC, Big East and ACC team in the same year. Meanwhile, the Big South has now collected an SEC win five out of the last six seasons, an ACC win four out of the last five seasons, and a Big East win four out of the last eight seasons.

BUT WAIT, THERE'S MORE

This is the first time the Big South has ever posted wins over five of the six "BCS" Conferences in a single-season, as Campbell's win at Iowa on Nov. 23 and UNC Asheville's victory over Utah on Nov. 26 gave the Big South victories against Big Ten and Pac-12 members. It was the Big South's first-ever win over a Big Ten team, and the Conference's first win against a Pac-12 member since 1996-97.

CAMPBELL

Campbell returns to Gore Arena for three of its next four games, including a pair this week. The Camels are 9-1 at home this year -- the only setback coming Jan. 12 against Big South leader UNC Asheville ... After missing three games (concussion), **TREY FREEMAN** returned to action Saturday and scored 13 points while dealing four assists at Asheville ... **LORNE MERTHIE** scored a season-high 22 points (6-10 threes) at Asheville ... **ERIC GRIFFIN** has produced four double-doubles in the last five games. In that span he is averaging 16.8 points and 10.2 rebounds, plus 2.4 blocks while shooting 62.5% from the field. Merthie is averaging 15.2 points and hitting 51.4% (19-37) from 3-point distance over the same stretch.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

CSU's win over Presbyterian gave the Bucs their second four-game winning streak of the season ... It was the fourth time CSU overcame a halftime deficit to win, making them 4-6 in those contests this season ... CSU has surpassed its overall road win total (4) from a year ago, as well as its Big South road win total (2) ... CSU's 85.7 accuracy at the free-throw line against Presbyterian was its best clip of the season.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal moved into sole possession of second-place in the Big South with road wins at Presbyterian College and Gardner-Webb ... Coastal has now won six of its last seven after previously dropping three of four games ... Coastal overcame a nine-point second half deficit to hand Gardner-Webb a 14-point home loss ... Coastal held last week's opponents to 32.1 percent shooting ... **ANTHONY RAFFA** accounted for 42 percent of the Chanticleer offense ... **KIERRE GREENWOOD** set a career-high with 10 assists in the GWU win. With 313 career assists, Greenwood now ranks eighth on the all-time CCU assists list.

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb lost by more than six points (two possessions) in a Big South game for the first time on Jan. 28, as Coastal pulled away for a 70-56 win. The loss was just GWU's second at home in nine games this season ... **TASHAN NEWSOME** had his second double-double of the season, totaling a career-high 15 rebounds to go with 13 points against Coastal ... **JASON DAWSON** returned from an ankle injury to score a career-high 19 points in a 78-72 win over Campbell on Thursday night ... Gardner-Webb is winless at Liberty since joining the Big South in men's hoops, going 0-4 at the Vines Center.

HIGH POINT

NICK BARBOUR, who scored his 1,900th point against UNC Asheville on Thursday, ranks third in HPU history with 1,916. Barbour is just four three-pointers away from **EUGENE HARRIS**'s HPU record of 283 ... **COREY LAW** grabbed his 500th rebound against UNC Asheville. He had 14 rebounds in that game and nine against Winthrop on Saturday ... **XAVIER MARTIN** led HPU in scoring for the second time with 14 points at UNC Asheville ... High Point ended a five-game losing streak, its longest of the season, with a 52-47 win over Winthrop on Saturday. High Point has beaten Winthrop three times in a row and swept the regular season for just the second time ever (2008-09 was the first time).

LIBERTY

Sanders needs just eight rebounds to surpass **MIKE COLEMAN** (1989-92) for fifth all-time on Liberty's career rebounding list. Sanders is also two double-doubles from having the fifth-most in program history.

PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE
