DEFENDING BIG SOUTH TOURNAMENT CHAMPION UNC ASHEVILLE TABBED FAVORITE IN 2011-12
 UNC Asheville, last year's Big South Tournament champion, has been voted as the favorite to win the Conference in 2011-12 by the League's head coaches and media panel in the annual preseason poll. It is the first time since 2002-03 and fourth time overall that the Bulldogs are the Big South's preseason No. 1, and they enter the season with four starters returning from last year's NCAA Tournament squad. Coastal Carolina, the defending two-time Big South regular-season champion, finds itself as the preseason No. 2 this season, which included five first-place votes. VMI was third in the voting and received one first-place vote. High Point received the remaining first-place vote and finished sixth in the poll.

ASHEVILLE'S DICKEY VOTED PRESEASON PLAYER OF THE YEAR

Reigning Big South Tournament MVP **MATT DICKEY** is the 2011-12 Big South Conference Preseason Men's Basketball Player of the Year. He is the first UNC Asheville player to be voted Preseason Player of the Year since **ANDRE SMITH** in 2002-03. Dickey enjoyed his first All-Conference season last year as a First-Team honoree after averaging a team-best 15.7 points that ranked sixth in the Big South. He also was third in the Conference in free throw percentage at 85.1 percent, fourth in steals with 1.9 and ninth in assists with 3.3 per game. Dickey averaged 19.7 points in leading Asheville to the Big South Tournament title. Joining Dickey on the preseason team are Liberty's **JESSE SANDERS**, Presbyterian College's **AL'ONZO COLEMAN**, High Point's **NICK BARBOUR** and Asheville's **J.P. PRIMM**.

WELCOME BACK

The Big South welcomes back the return of charter member Campbell University in 2011-12, pushing the League's basketball membership to an all-time high of 11. The Camels were members of the Big South from 1983-94, and was the Conference's first-ever men's basketball automatic bid recipient to the NCAA Tournament with their 1992 League championship. Campbell went 129-128 in its first stint in the League, including 63-57 in Big South games and 9-8 in the Conference Tournament.

CLASS ACT

Liberty senior guard **JESSE SANDERS** has been named one of 30 national candidates for the 2011-12 Lowe's Senior CLASS Award. To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence -- Community, Classroom, Character and Competition. The award focuses on the total student-athlete and encourages students to use their platform in athletics to make a positive impact as leaders in their communities. The 30 candidates will be narrowed to 10 finalists midway through the regular season, and those 10 names will be placed on the official ballot. Sanders is the Big South's first candidate since Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** in 2007-08.

UNC ASHEVILLE MADE BIG SOUTH HISTORY IN 2010-11 WITH NCAA TOURNAMENT VICTORY

With its 81-77 overtime win over Arkansas-Little Rock last year in the NCAA Tournament, UNC Asheville is the only program in Big South Conference history with two NCAA Tournament wins. The Bulldogs were the first Conference member to win an NCAA Tournament game back in 2003 when Asheville won the Opening Round contest against Texas Southern -- which was also in overtime and also in Dayton. Head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** is 2-2 in the NCAA Tournament and is the only Big South head coach with two NCAA wins in League history.

STEADY EDDIE

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** is the Big South's all-time winningest coach for overall wins (216) and Big South victories (128). Biedenbach is 245-283 in 18 years as a collegiate head coach.

SENIOR MOMENTS

UNC Asheville seniors **MATT DICKEY** and **J.P. PRIMM** scored 15 points in the same game 14 times last season. The Bulldogs went 10-4 in those contests, with the losses coming at the hands of nationally-ranked North Carolina and Georgetown, as well as a two-point double-overtime loss at USC Upstate and a one-point setback against Northeastern in the SEARS BracketBusters. The duo has reached the 15-point threshold in the same game 19 times since arriving on campus in 2008-09, and Asheville is 14-5 in those games.

LENDING A HELPING HAND

Liberty senior guard **JESSE SANDERS** enters this season 11th all-time in Big South history with 472 career assists, and needs 28 to become the 11th player with 500. He is 133 helpers shy of breaking the Conference's all-time record of 604, which was established by Radford's **AMIR JOHNSON** from 2006-10. Meanwhile, UNC Asheville senior guard **J.P. PRIMM** is 14th in League annals with 465 career assists.

GIVE-AND-TAKE

UNC Asheville senior guard **J.P. PRIMM** has 465 career assists and 184 career steals, and is on pace to become just the fifth player in Big South history with 500 assists and 200 steals. Primm is set to join Winthrop's **CHRIS GAYNOR** (567 AST, 259 STL), Campbell's **BRAD CHILDRESS** (543-243), Charleston Southern's **ED O'NEIL** (504-241) and Coastal Carolina's **ROBERT DOWDELL** (561-239).

A LOOK DOWN THE ROAD...

Coastal Carolina carries a school-record 10-consecutive Big South road game win streak into this season. The Conference record for most consecutive road League wins is 11, first set by Winthrop from 2004-06 and tied by Radford from 2008-10. The Chanticleers' first Big South road game this season is Dec. 31 at High Point.

MY FAVORITE MARTIN

Charleston Southern senior forward **KELVIN MARTIN** is one of 27 players in Big South history with 1,000 career points (1,007) and 600 career rebounds (687). He enters the 2011-12 season needing 13 boards to become the 20th player with 1,000 points and 700 rebounds. Martin is 44 steals shy of 200 in his career, which would make him just the third player with 1,000 points, 500 rebounds and 200 steals. Meanwhile, Martin has an outside chance of becoming the third Big South player in history with 1,000 points and 1,000 rebounds. Stay tuned.

2,000-POINT ODYSSEY?

High Point senior guard **NICK BARBOUR** is the Conference's active leading returning scorer with 1,488 career points, which ranks 28th all-time in Big South history. He is 279 points away from cracking the League's Top 10, and 512 points shy of becoming the seventh player in Conference annals with 2,000 points. He would need to average 17.66 points a game to reach the milestone in the Panthers' 29 regular-season games this year, which is just above his career scoring average of 16.9 points.

BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

VMI junior **STAN OKOYE** enters the 2011-12 season 67 points away from 1,000 in his career, as he has 933 points in 60 career games played. He would become the 106th player on the Conference's all-time list. Below is a look at the Big South's active 1,000-point scorers, as well as those closing in on the milestone:

SCOREBOARD WATCHING

VMI led the nation in scoring offense in 2010-11 for the fifth consecutive season, becoming the first team in NCAA Division I history to lead the country in scoring offense five consecutive years. The Keydets averaged 87.9 points last season and return 80.0 percent of that scoring output this year.

MR. TRIPLE-DOUBLE

Liberty senior guard **JESSE SANDERS**, who is the only player in Big South history with 500 career rebounds (566) and 400 assists (472), owns three of the eight triple-doubles on record in Conference annals, including two of the five that have occurred in League games. He recorded his first as a freshman against Presbyterian College on Feb. 9, 2009, his second during his sophomore year against Kentucky Christian on Dec. 12, 2009, and his third as a junior against Charleston Southern on Jan. 6, 2011.

ELDER STATESMAN

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** made his 21st career postseason appearance when the Chanticleers played in the NIT last year. He has 13 NIT berths along with eight NCAA Tournament bids to his credit. Ellis recorded his 11th career 20-win season at the Division I level last season, and 14th overall.

BIG SOUTH TO MAKE SEVENTH APPEARANCE IN ESPN'S BRACKETBUSTERS EVENT

The Big South Conference will again participate in the SEARS BracketBusters event this season during the weekend of February 17-19, with a League-record 11 teams among the field of 142 -- the event's largest pool ever. All of the Big South's men's basketball programs are participating in the same year for the first time, and the Conference has the second-most members competing of the 16 Leagues involved this season. Five Big South teams will host a game while the remaining six members will play on the road. The Conference is 8-16 all-time in the BracketBusters, including two wins in 2006, 2007 and 2010. The Big South has also been selected for national television appearances four times in the past five years: 2007 (ESPN2), 2008 (ESPN2), 2009 (ESPNU) and 2011 (ESPNU).
