Martin averaged 14.5 points, 12.0 rebounds, 3.5 steals and 2.0 blocks in two games last week. He led CSU to its third-straight win over The Citadel by posting a double-double with 13 points and 17 rebounds -- including 15 on the defensive end. The 17 boards matched his career-high as he went for his third career double-double against the Bulldogs. Martin then scored 14 of his 16 points at the College of Charleston in the second half as the Bucs rallied from a 12-point deficit to tie the game in the final minute. He added seven rebounds, five steals and three blocks against the Cougars, and finished the week 14-of-26 from the field (=53.8 percent).

COASTAL CAROLINA ONE VICTORY FROM BIG SOUTH RECORD

Coastal Carolina has started the season 9-1, the school's best start to a basketball season since joining the Division I ranks. The Chanticleers have a chance to become the first Big South team to win 10 of their first 11 games, and need a victory in their next contest to achieve this feat. The current Conference record for earliest to win 10 games is 12, which has been accomplished four times in League history (UNC Greensboro in 1994-95, VMI in 2008-09, and Coastal Carolina in 2009-10 and 2010-11).

SAND BLASTER

Liberty senior guard **JESSE SANDERS** has vaulted into third-place on the Big South's all-time assist list with 564, and needs just four helpers to surpass Winthrop's **CHRIS GAYNOR** (2004-08) for second-place. Sanders is 41 assists away from breaking the Big South career record of 604 that was established by Radford's **AMIR JOHNSON** from 2006-10. Meanwhile, Sanders is averaging a League-best 7.75 assists per game this season, which is currently the second-highest assist average in a single-season in Big South history. The Conference record is 9.64, which was set by Charleston Southern's **TONY FAIRLEY** in 1986-87. Sanders is the first Big South player to average at least 7.0 assists since former Flame **TEE-JAY BANNISTER** in 2007-08 (7.23), and is looking to become just the fifth overall player to average 7.0 assists in a season.

GIVE-AND-TAKE

UNC Asheville senior guard **J.P. PRIMM** recorded his 200th career steal on Dec. 15, the 13th player in Conference annals to reach the defensive milestone. He is also just the fifth player in Big South history with 500 career assists (513) and 200 career steals (202). Primm joins Winthrop's **CHRIS GAYNOR** (567 AST, 259 STL), Campbell's **BRAD CHILDRESS** (543-243), Charleston Southern's **ED O'NEIL** (504-241) and Coastal Carolina's **ROBERT DOWDELL** (561-239) in the club. Meanwhile, Primm could become the first player in Big South history with 400 rebounds, 400 assists and 200 steals. He needs 23 boards for 400 in his career.

SAM I AM

Coastal Carolina redshirt-junior **SAM McLAURIN** is 18th in Big South history with 133 career blocked shots. He needs five rebounds for 500 in his career, and once he reaches the milestone, he will be the 15th player in the Big South record books with 500 rebounds and 100 blocked shots.

LENDING A HELPING HAND

As mentioned, Liberty's **JESSE SANDERS** is now third all-time in League history with 564 career assists. UNC Asheville's **J.P. PRIMM** moved into the Top 10 this past week, as he is 10th with 513. He needs eight to break the Asheville career record of 520 assists, which is held by **K.J. GARLAND** (2003-08). Garland also holds the ninth position on the Big South's all-time assist chart.

MY FAVORITE MARTIN

Charleston Southern senior forward **KELVIN MARTIN** needs nine rebounds to surpass Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** (2008-10) for 10th-place on the Big South's career rebounding list. Martin stands 11th at 775, behind Parakhouski's 783 in two seasons with the Highlanders. Martin also needs 25 rebounds to become the ninth player in Big South history with 800 rebounds, and once he reaches that milestone, he would be just the eighth with 1,000 points and 800 boards. Meanwhile, Martin is 19 steals shy of 200 in his career, which would make him just the second player with 1,000 points, 700 rebounds and 200 steals. In addition, he needs nine blocks for 100 and could eventually become one of three in Conference history with 1,000 points, 700 rebounds, 200 steals and 100 blocks. Stay tuned.

ELDER STATESMAN

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** won his 700th game as a collegiate head coach on Dec. 6 when the Chanticleers won 80-58 at The Citadel. Now in his 37th year as a head coach, Ellis stands 701-398 overall, including 89-49 (=64.5 percent) in five seasons at Coastal Carolina. He is the eighth-winningest active head coach with 623 Division I wins (623-386 at the Division I level), has directed four different Division I programs to at least two 20-win campaigns, and owns six seasons with at least 25 wins. He is 11 wins away from winning 100 games with his fourth different Division I program.

SCOREBOARD WATCHING

Reigning five-time NCAA scoring champion VMI leads the Big South and Division I with 88.7 points per game. The Keydets are going for their unprecedented sixth-straight NCAA scoring title, and has vaulted back into the national lead after being No. 12 in scoring offense the week of Dec. 4.

I LOVE THE '80s

Four Big South teams -- VMI (88.7), UNC Asheville (84.4), Coastal Carolina (81.1) and Campbell (81.1), -- are currently averaging at least 80.0 points a game, the most in Conference history. Just 10 teams in League annals have finished a season averaging 80 points game, with the most teams in one season being three in 1992-93. That year, Winthrop (83.6), UMBC (81.8) and Radford (81.3) were above the scoring mark.

BARBOUR SHOP

High Point senior guard **NICK BARBOUR** is the national leader with 3.90 three-pointers per game this season, the highest in the Big South since former Coastal Carolina standout **JACK LEASURE** averaged 3.96 threes in 2007-08. Barbour has made at least three treys in his last 11 games played (dating back to last season), the longest such streak by a Big South player since VMI's **AUSTIN KENON** buried three-plus 3FG in 11-straight games during the 2008-09 campaign. Barbour's three-point prowess has pushed his career total to 245, which is currently 15th all-time in Conference history. He needs five triples to become the 14th player with 250, and is on pace to join the League's 300 3FG club, which currently stands at six members.

DOUBLE TROUBLE

A total of six players have scored in double figures in every game thus far -- Campbell teammates **TREY FREEMAN** and **DARREN WHITE**, Coastal Carolina's **ANTHONY RAFFA**, High Point's **NICK BARBOUR**, UNC Asheville's **MATT DICKEY** and Winthrop's **ANDRE JONES**. Barbour owns the longest double-figure scoring streak in the Conference at 27 games, dating back to last season, followed by Raffa (19), Dickey (15) and Jones (13).

ANDRE THE GIANT

Winthrop's **ANDRE JONES** is third in the Big South with 18.7 points per game, the highest scoring average by a Winthrop Eagle since **FRED MCKINNON** averaged 21.1 points in 1985-86. Jones, who entered the season with a career scoring average of 8.5 points, has scored in double figures in every game and has poured in 20 points four times this season -- including three games with 25+. His 206 points scored thus far is already 64.2 percent of his season-best scoring total of 321, which was set last year.

STEADY EDDIE

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** won his 250th career game with the Bulldogs' 88-81 win over USC Upstate on Dec. 4. He is the Big South's all-time winningest coach for overall wins (222) and Big South victories (129), and is now 251-287 in 18 years as a collegiate head coach. Biedenbach needs just one win to tie **BOB HARTMAN** as the all-time victory leader at UNC Asheville.

SPEAKING OF COACHING WINS...

Charleston Southern head coach **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH** is four wins away from 100 in his career as a head coach, while VMI's **DUGGAR BAUCOM** is eight wins away from 100 victories at the Institute.

TREY-LINER

Campbell freshman guard **TREY FREEMAN** is averaging 17.0 points this season, seventh in the Big South and the 5th-highest scoring average by a freshman nationally. It is the highest scoring average for a Big South frosh since former Liberty guard **SETH CURRY** averaged a Big South freshman record 20.2 points in 2008-09. Meanwhile, Freeman is second in the Conference with an 87.9 free throw percentage, and is looking to become the first freshman to lead the Big South in free throw shooting since 1995-96 (UMBC's **ALHAMISI SIMMS**) and the fourth overall.

SAND BAR

Liberty guard **JESSE SANDERS** is 10 points away from 1,000 in his career, and he would be the 28th player in Big South history with 1,000 points and 600 rebounds. He would also be the first in the 1,000/600 club with 500 assists. Meanwhile, Sanders is the only player in the nation averaging 8.0 rebounds (8.3) and 7.0 assists (7.8), and would become the first player in Big South history to do so in the same season.

BAND OF BROTHERS

Liberty sophomore **JOHN CALEB SANDERS** has scored 138 points through 12 contests this season. He scored 126 points in 32 appearances with the Flames last year. Along with his teammate and brother **JESSE**, the two have combined to score 1,254 points for Liberty (Jesse - 990, John Caleb - 264).

THREE-FOR-ALL

VMI's **KEITH GABRIEL** has made 254 three-pointers in his career, tied with Winthrop's **LaSHAWN COULTER** (254 from 1990-95) for 12th-place on the Conference's all-time list. Gabriel needs 30 treys to crack the Big South's career Top 10 and 46 threes to become the seventh player in Big South history with 300 career three-point field goals. Meanwhile, teammate **MICHAEL SPARKS** is four threes away from 200 3FG in his career.

STAN THE MAN

VMI junior **STAN OKOYE**, who became the 106th player in Big South history to score 1,000 points on Nov. 23 at Ohio State, grabbed his 500th career rebound Dec. 10 in the Milligan game to become the 42nd player in the Conference record books with 1,000 career points and 500 career rebounds. He is the fourth Keydet to accomplish this feat since VMI joined the Big South in 2003-04.

2,000-POINT ODYSSEY?

High Point senior guard **NICK BARBOUR** is the Conference's active leading career scorer with 1,672 points, which ranks 16th all-time in Big South history. He is 96 points away from cracking the League's Top 10, and 328 points shy of becoming the seventh player in Conference annals with 2,000 points. He would need to average 16.4 points a game in the Panthers' 20 remaining games (19 regular-season and at least 1 Tournament contest) to reach the milestone. Barbour entered the season with a career scoring average of 16.9 points.

BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

Two players could surpass 1,000 career points this week and enter the Big South's all-time 1,000-point scoring club, which is currently at 106 members. Liberty's **JESSE SANDERS** needs 10 points for the milestone, while Winthrop's **ANDRE JONES** is 18 points away from the benchmark. TOAST TO THE COAST

Seven days after defeating LSU, Coastal Carolina won 60-59 at Clemson on Nov. 22, marking the second-straight year that a Big South member has defeated an SEC team and ACC team in the same season. Presbyterian College did it last year in back-to-back games, as the Blue Hose won at Auburn on Dec. 18 and followed with a win at Wake Forest on Dec. 20. The Chanticleers are now the third Big South team in Conference history with SEC-ACC wins in the same campaign. The first was Campbell in 1993-94 when the Camels defeated North Carolina State and South Carolina.

BACK TO THE FUTURE

The Big South has recorded wins over the SEC, Big East and ACC this season, an accomplishment that occurred just once previously in League history. The 1993-94 season was the first time the Big South Conference defeated an SEC, Big East and ACC team in the same year. Meanwhile, the Big South has now collected an SEC win five out of the last six seasons, an ACC win four out of the last five seasons, and a Big East win four out of the last eight seasons.

BUT WAIT, THERE'S MORE

This is the first time the Big South has ever posted wins over five of the six "BCS" Conferences in a single-season, as Campbell's win at Iowa on Nov. 23 and UNC Asheville's victory over Utah on Nov. 26 gave the Big South victories against Big Ten and Pac-12 members. It was the Big South's first-ever win over a Big Ten team, and the Conference's first win against a Pac-12 member since 1996-97.

HELLO 2-0

With the first set of Big South games concluding the first weekend of December, Campbell, Charleston Southern and Coastal Carolina emerged from the pack with 2-0 League records to sit in a three-way tie for first-place in the Conference standings. Campbell is 2-0 in the Big South for the first time since opening the 1993-94 League season at 4-0. The Buccaneers have won their first two League games for the first time since starting 4-0 in Big South play in 2004-05. Coastal Carolina is 2-0 in Conference action for the third consecutive year. The Conference season will resume Dec. 31.

HOME FOR THE HOLIDAYS

The home teams claimed eight of the first 10 Big South games played during the first Conference weekend (=80.0 percent), an improvement over last season's opening weekend that had five home wins in the first nine League games. The home teams won 62.2 percent of the time (56-34) in both 2010-11 and 2009-10.

BOTH ENDS OF THE SPECTRUM

Half of the 10 Big South games played the opening weekend of Conference play had winning margins of less than 10 points, with the average margin of victory in those five games being 5.6 points. The other five that were decided by at least 10 points had an average winning margin of 15.4 points. Overall, the first 10 Conference games of the 2011-12 season had an average margin of victory of 10.5 points. Last year, the overall margin of victory in League play was 10.48, while the 2009-10 average margin was 10.51 points and the 2008-09 League season was 8.96 points.

CLASS ACT

Liberty senior guard **JESSE SANDERS** is one of 30 national candidates for the 2011-12 Lowe's Senior CLASS Award. To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence -- Community, Classroom, Character and Competition. The award focuses on the total student-athlete and encourages students to use their platform in athletics to make a positive impact as leaders in their communities. The 30 candidates will be narrowed to 10 finalists midway through the regular season, and those 10 names will be placed on the official ballot. Sanders is the Big South's first candidate since Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** in 2007-08.

BIG SOUTH TO MAKE SEVENTH APPEARANCE IN ESPN'S BRACKETBUSTERS EVENT

The Big South Conference will again participate in the SEARS BracketBusters event this season during the weekend of February 17-19, with a League-record 11 teams among the field of 142 -- the event's largest pool ever. All of the Big South's men's basketball programs are participating in the same year for the first time, and the Conference has the second-most members competing of the 16 Leagues involved this season. Five Big South teams will host a game while the remaining six members will play on the road. The Conference is 8-16 all-time in the BracketBusters, including two wins in 2006, 2007 and 2010. The Big South has also been selected for national television appearances four times in the past five years: 2007 (ESPN2), 2008 (ESPN2), 2009 (ESPNU) and 2011 (ESPNU).

For the second-straight year, Campbell set a school record for the most victories before Christmas ... Campbell enters this week's action ranked 4th nationally in field goal percentage (51.8) ... CU has dropped 3-straight road games after winning its first two ... **DARREN WHITE** leads the Big South and ranks 21st in the country in scoring (20.5) ... **ERIC GRIF-FIN** leads the Big South in field goal accuracy (64.2) and blocks (2.3), while standing 4th in rebounds (8.2) and 5th in scoring (17.6) ... **TREY FREEMAN** tops Big South freshmen in scoring (17.0), assists (4.4), FG% (48.5) and FT% (87.9), while ranking 5th among the nation's top frosh leaders in points per game.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Bucs placed a season-high six players in double figures at The Citadel and held the Bulldogs scoreless for final 5:52 of first half to stage a 17-0 run. CSU connected on 14 of its first 18 shots after halftime, and **KELVIN MARTIN** tied a career-high with 17 rebounds ... **ARLON HARPER** became the sixth different player to lead the team in scoring this season by tallying 19 points at the College of Charleston ... The Buccaneers attempted a season-high 75 shots and committed a season-low 5 turnovers against the Cougars.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal played only one game last week, defeating Lynchburg College, 86-61 Friday night in Kimbel Arena ... Coastal has won four games in a row by an average of 16.5 points, while averaging 82.8 points per game ... Entering this week, the Chanticleers lead the nation in field goal percentage (53.3 percent) and are second in rebounding margin (+12.3) ... **SAM MCLAURIN** is nine blocks away from tying the school-record of 142 career blocked shots.

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb narrowly defeated Wake Forest on Sunday, as the Runnin' Bulldogs held a 33-30 halftime lead and was within four points with 1:00 remaining. **TASHAN NEWSOME** led the squad with 24 points and nine rebounds.

HIGH POINT

HPU's longest homestand of the season, three games, starts this week when the Panthers host Wofford. The second part of the schedule will be more favorable as the Highlanders close with 10 of their last 17 at home ... Dating back to 2009-10, Radford has dropped 24 consecutive contests away from home ... The Highlanders, who have lost their last 21 road tilts, are looking for their first road win since a 74-69 win at Liberty on Feb. 16, 2010 ... UNC ASHEVILLE
