**COASTAL CAROLINA TIES BIG SOUTH RECORD FOR CONSECUTIVE LEAGUE ROAD WINS**

Coastal Carolina has won a school-record 11-consecutive Big South road games following its 55-52 victory at High Point this past Saturday. The Chants have tied the Big South record for longest Conference road win streak that was first established by Winthrop from 2004-06 and matched by Radford from 2008-10. The Chanticleers will look to set the mark Monday night, Jan. 2 at Campbell.

**3-0 STARTS**

For the third consecutive season, two Big South team have started Conference play 3-0. Coastal Carolina is 3-0 in League action for the third consecutive year, marking the second time the Chanticleers have achieved this three-peat and the first Big South team to open 3-0 in back-to-back-to-back seasons since UNC Asheville in 1996-97, 1997-98 and 1998-99. Charleston Southern is 3-0 in the Big South for the first time since 2004-05. Coastal is looking for its fourth-straight 4-0 Big South start, while the Buccaneers last started 4-0 in Conference action in 1986-87. Meanwhile, Campbell has a chance to open Big South play 3-0 for the first time since 1993-94 when the Camels opened 4-0.

**IS THERE A SIGNIFICANCE TO OPENING 3-0??**

Prior to this season, 12 teams have started the Conference season with 3-0 records since 2003-04, and of those 12, eight teams reached the Big South Championship game. A total of 39 teams in League history have opened with 3-0 Big South records since 1985-86, and 21 of those squads advanced to the Conference title game. Among the 21 are 10 that captured the crown, the last being Winthrop in 2006-07.

**CHANTICLEERS FALL SHORT IN ATTEMPT TO SET CONFERENCE'S BEST START EVER**

Coastal Carolina won its 10th game of the season in its 13th contest, falling one game short of matching its shared Conference record for fastest team to win 10 games. The record is 12 games, which was accomplished four times previously (UNC Greensboro in 1994-95, VMI in 2008-09, and Coastal Carolina in 2009-10 and 2010-11).

**SAND BLASTER**

Liberty senior guard **JESSE SANDERS** enters the New Year needing 11 assists to become the Big South's all-time leader in the category. Sanders is second in League annals with 594 handouts, just 10 behind the Big South career record of 604 that was established by Radford's **AMIR JOHNSON** from 2006-10. Meanwhile, Sanders is averaging a League-best 8.13 assists per game this season, which is currently the second-highest assist average in a single-season in Big South history. The Conference record is 9.64, which was set by Charleston Southern's **TONY FAIRLEY** in 1986-87.

**GIVE-AND-TAKE**

UNC Asheville senior guard **J.P. PRIMM** is the fifth player in Big South history with 500 career assists (518) and 200 career steals (207). He joins Winthrop's **CHRIS GAYNOR** (567 AST, 259 STL), Campbell's **BRAD CHILDRESS** (543-243), Charleston Southern's **ED O'NEIL** (504-241) and Coastal Carolina's **ROBERT DOWDELL** (561-239) in the club. Primm, who ranks 10th all-time in Big South history in assists and 11th in steals, could become the first player in Big South history with 400 rebounds, 500 assists and 200 steals. He needs 15 boards for 400 in his career.

**SAM I AM**

Coastal Carolina redshirt-junior **SAM McLAURIN** grabbed his 500th career rebound Dec. 19 at East Carolina, becoming the 62nd player in League history to reach the milestone. He is now one of 15 players in the Big South record books with 500 rebounds (523) and 100 blocked shots (137). McLaurin is currently 18th on the all-time blocked shot chart and needs three to move past Winthrop's **BILLY HOUSTON** (139) for 17th-place.

**BE MY VALENTINE**

Winthrop redshirt-senior **GEORGE VALENTINE** became the third player this season and 63rd in League history to reach 500 career rebounds when he achieved the feat Dec. 20 at Western Michigan. Valentine, who is currently at 518 boards, needs 23 blocked shots to reach 100 in his career.

**HE'S GOT NEXT**

Presbyterian College's **AL'LOONZ COLEMAN** is 19 rebounds away from 500 during his Big South career. Coleman's overall career total stands at 632, which includes 151 during his true freshman season of 2007-08 before the Blue Hose were officially included in the Conference's statistics.

**LENDING A HELPING HAND**

As mentioned, Liberty's **JESSE SANDERS** is now second all-time in League history with 594 career assists. He recorded 16 assists in the Flames' victory over Montreat on Dec. 20, the most assists in a game by a Big South player since Campbell's **DAN POGUE** handed out 16 dimes against UNC Asheville on Feb. 8, 1993. Meanwhile, UNC Asheville's **J.P. PRIMM** needs three helpers to break the Asheville career record of 520 assists, which is held by **K.J. GARLAND** (2003-08). Garland holds the ninth position on the Big South's all-time assist chart.

**MY FAVORITE MARTIN**

Charleston Southern senior forward **KELVIN MARTIN** became just the ninth player in Big South history to grab 800 career rebounds when he surpassed the milestone Dec. 31 vs. Liberty. He is ninth in the Conference record books with 805 career boards and needs 12 caroms to surpass Radford's **CORREY WATKINS** (816 from 1998-02) for eighth-place. Martin is now one of eight players in League annals with 1,000 career points (1,196) and 800 career rebounds. Meanwhile, Martin is four blocked shots away from 100 and 14 steals shy of 200 in his career, and is on track to become just the third player in Conference history with 1,000 points, 800 rebounds, 200 steals and 100 blocks. A total of three players are in the 1,000-point, 800-rebound, 100-blocked shot club, while two players comprise the Big South's 1,000-point, 800-rebound, 200-steal club.

**ELDER STATESMAN**

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** won his 700th game as a collegiate head coach on Dec. 6 when the Chanticleers won 80-58 at The Citadel. Now in his 37th year as a head coach, Ellis stands 702-400 overall, including 90-51 ( =63.8 percent) in five seasons at Coastal Carolina. He is the eighth-winningest active head coach with 624 Division I wins (624-388 at the Division I level) and is tied with **NORM SLOAN** for 34th-place on the all-time Division I wins list. In addition, Ellis has directed four different Division I programs to at least two 20-win campaigns, and owns six seasons with at least 25 wins. He is 10 wins away from winning 100 games with his fourth different Division I program.

**STEADY EDDIE**

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** won his 250th career game with the Bulldogs' 88-81 win over USC Upstate on Dec. 4. He is the Big South's all-time winningest coach for overall wins (223) and Big South victories (130), and is now 252-289 in 18 years as a collegiate head coach. Biedenbach is tied with **BOB HARTMAN** as the all-time victory leader at UNC Asheville.

**SPEAKING OF COACHING WINS...**

Charleston Southern head coach **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH** is one win away from 100 in his career as a head coach, while VMI's **DUGGAR BAUCOM** is seven wins away from 100 victories at the Institute.

**SCOREBOARD WATCHING**

Reigning five-time NCAA scoring champion VMI leads the Big South and is second in Division I with 86.7 points per game. The Keydets are going for their unprecedented sixth-straight NCAA scoring title, and vaulted back into the national lead the week of Dec. 4 after being No. 12 in scoring offense the week prior. The Keydets held the top spot the past four weeks before dropping behind North Carolina's 88.1 scoring average this week.

**I LOVE THE '80s**

Three Big South teams -- VMI (86.7), UNC Asheville (80.9) and Charleston Southern (80.2) -- are currently averaging at least 80.0 points a game, tied for the most in Conference history. Just 10 teams in League annals have finished a season averaging 80 points game, with the most teams in the same season being three in 1992-93. That year, Winthrop (83.6), UMBC (81.8) and Radford (81.3) were above the 80.0 scoring mark.

**BARBOUR SHOP**

High Point senior guard **NICK BARBOUR** ranks sixth nationally with 3.50 three-pointers per game. Barbour's streak of 12-straight games with at least three 3-pointers was snapped this past Saturday against Coastal Carolina. It was the longest such streak by a Big South player since Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** buried three-plus 3FG in 13-straight games during the 2005-06 campaign. Meanwhile, Barbour owns 248 career treys and needs two triples to become the 14th player with 250. He remains on pace to join the League's 300 3FG club, which currently stands at six members.

**DOUBLE TROUBLE**

Three players have scored in double figures in every game thus far -- Campbell's **DARREN WHITE** (14), High Point's **NICK BARBOUR** (12) and Winthrop's **ANDRE JONES** (14). Barbour owns the longest double-figure scoring streak in the Conference at 29 games, dating back to last season, followed by Jones (16).

**ANDRE THE GIANT**

Winthrop's **ANDRE JONES** is second in the Big South with 19.1 points per game, the highest scoring average by a Winthrop Eagle since **FRED McKINNON** averaged 21.1 points in 1985-86. Jones, who entered the season with a career scoring average of 8.5 points, has scored in double figures in every game and has poured in 20 points five times this season -- including four games with 25+. He has led Winthrop in scoring 10 times this season -- including the last eight games, and his 267 points scored thus far is already 83.2 percent of his season-best scoring total of 321, which was set last year.

**TREY-LINER**

Campbell freshman guard **TREY FREEMAN** is averaging 16.0 points this season, tied for ninth in the Big South and the 7th-highest scoring average by a freshman nationally. It is the highest scoring average for a Big South frosh since former Liberty guard **SETH CURRY** averaged a Big South freshman record 20.2 points in 2008-09. Meanwhile, Freeman is first in the Conference with an 85.5 free throw percentage, and is looking to become the first freshman to lead the Big South in free throw shooting since 1995-96 (UMBC's **ALHAMISI SIMMS**) and the fourth overall.

**2,000-POINT ODYSSEY?**

High Point senior guard **NICK BARBOUR** is the Conference's active leading career scorer with 1,712 points, which ranks 15th all-time in Big South history. He needs 22 points to move into 13th-place, is 56 points away from cracking the League's Top 10, and 288 points shy of becoming the seventh player in Conference annals with 2,000 points. He would need to average 16.0 points a game in the Panthers' 18 remaining games (17 regular-season and at least 1 Tournament contest) to reach the milestone. Barbour entered the season with a career scoring average of 16.9 points.

**BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB**

Winthrop's **ANDRE JONES** and Liberty's **JESSE SANDERS** became the 107th and 108th Big South players, respectively, to surpass 1,000 career points. Jones eclipsed the milestone Dec. 27 at Georgia, while Sanders achieved the feat Dec. 28 at Richmond. Below is a look at the Big South's active 1,000-point scorers (currently eight), as well as those closing in on the milestone:

**SAND BAR**

Liberty guard **JESSE SANDERS** is the only player in Big South history with 1,000 career points, 600 career rebounds and 500 career assists. He needs 15 rebounds to become the 23rd player in League annals with 700 rebounds, which would make him one of 21 players with 1,000 points and 700 boards. Meanwhile, Sanders is the only player in the nation averaging 7.0 rebounds (7.9) and 8.0 assists (8.1), and would become the first player in Big South history to do so in the same season.

**THREE-FOR-ALL**

VMI's **KEITH GABRIEL** has made 259 three-pointers in his career, good for 12th-place on the Conference's all-time list. Gabriel needs 25 treys to crack the Big South's career Top 10 and 41 threes to become the seventh player in Big South history with 300 career three-point field goals. Meanwhile, teammate **MICHAEL SPARKS** is four threes away from 200 3FG in his career.

**MR. TRIPLE-DOUBLE**

Liberty senior guard **JESSE SANDERS** could become the first player in Division I history with a triple-double in four different years. He owns three of the eight triple-doubles on record in Conference annals. He recorded his first as a freshman against Presbyterian College on Feb. 9, 2009, his second during his sophomore year against Kentucky Christian on Dec. 12, 2009, and his third as a junior against Charleston Southern on Jan. 6, 2011.

**STAN THE MAN**

VMI junior **STAN OKOYE**, who became the 106th player in Big South history to score 1,000 points on Nov. 23 at Ohio State, grabbed his 500th career rebound Dec. 10 in the Milligan game to become the 42nd player in the Conference record books with 1,000 career points and 500 career rebounds. He is the fourth Keydet to accomplish this feat since VMI joined the Big South in 2003-04.

**HOMEWORK**

The home teams have claimed nine of the first 15 Big South games played this season (=60.0 percent). The home teams won 62.2 percent of the time (56-34) in both 2010-11 and 2009-10. This season, the nine home squads have won by an average of 11.6 points, while the six road team wins have been by just 4.7 points.

**BOTH ENDS OF THE SPECTRUM**

Ten of the first 15 Big South games had winning margins of less than 10 points, with the average margin of victory in those 10 games being 5.5 points. The remaining five that have decided by at least 10 points had an average winning margin of 15.4 points. Overall, the first 15 Conference games of the 2011-12 season has an average margin of victory of 8.80 points. Last year, the overall margin of victory in League play was 10.48, while the 2009-10 average margin was 10.51 points and the 2008-09 League season was 8.96 points.

**SENIOR MOMENTS**

UNC Asheville seniors **MATT DICKEY** and **J.P. PRIMM** have scored 15 points in the same game 20 times since arriving in Asheville in 2008-09, and the Bulldogs are 15-5 in those games. The duo had its first such game of 2011-12 in the Bulldogs' win over Utah on Nov. 26 after reaching the total 14 times in 2010-11.

**MID-MAJOR MANIA**

For the eighth consecutive season, the Big South has had a member ranked in the *Collegeinsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 poll, as Campbell was ranked No. 25 the week of Dec. 12 and Coastal Carolina was ranked No. 25 the week of Dec. 19. It was the Camels' first appearance in the 13-year-old ranking, and the third-straight season the Chanticleers were ranked in the poll. **TOAST TO THE COAST**

Seven days after defeating LSU, Coastal Carolina won 60-59 at Clemson on Nov. 22, marking the second-straight year that a Big South member has defeated an SEC team and ACC team in the same season. Presbyterian College did it last year in back-to-back games, as the Blue Hose won at Auburn on Dec. 18 and followed with a win at Wake Forest on Dec. 20. The Chanticleers are now the third Big South team in Conference history with SEC-ACC wins in the same campaign. The first was Campbell in 1993-94 when the Camels defeated North Carolina State and South Carolina.

**BACK TO THE FUTURE**

The Big South has recorded wins over the SEC, Big East and ACC this season, an accomplishment that occurred just once previously in League history. The 1993-94 season was the first time the Big South Conference defeated an SEC, Big East and ACC team in the same year. Meanwhile, the Big South has now collected an SEC win five out of the last six seasons, an ACC win four out of the last five seasons, and a Big East win four out of the last eight seasons.

**BUT WAIT, THERE'S MORE**

This is the first time the Big South has ever posted wins over five of the six "BCS" Conferences in a single-season, as Campbell's win at Iowa on Nov. 23 and UNC Asheville's victory over Utah on Nov. 26 gave the Big South victories against Big Ten and Pac-12 members. It was the Big South's first-ever win over a Big Ten team, and the Conference's first win against a Pac-12 member since 1996-97.

**BIG SOUTH TO MAKE SEVENTH APPEARANCE IN ESPN'S BRACKETBUSTERS EVENT**

The Big South Conference will again participate in the SEARS BracketBusters event this season during the weekend of February 17-19, with a League-record 11 teams among the field of 142 -- the event's largest pool ever. All of the Big South's men's basketball programs are participating in the same year for the first time, and the Conference has the second-most members competing of the 16 Leagues involved this season. Five Big South teams will host a game while the remaining six members will play on the road. The Conference is 8-16 all-time in the BracketBusters, including two wins in 2006, 2007 and 2010. The Big South has also been selected for national television appearances four times in the past five years: 2007 (ESPN2), 2008 (ESPN2), 2009 (ESPN2) and 2011 (ESPN2).

**DARREN THE DESTRUCTOR**

Campbell junior **DARREN WHITE** leads the Big South in overall scoring with 21.2 points per game and in League games at 24.0, and his scoring average against Conference members is currently the highest since the 2006-07 season. The last player to lead the League in both overall scoring and Big South games was Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** (21.4 overall, 21.1 Big South) in 2009-10. Meanwhile, White is looking to become the third Campbell player to lead the Big South in scoring and the first since **HENRY WILSON** averaged 18.5 points to pace the Conference in 1988-89.

**ALL AROUND GAME**

Campbell currently has the Big South's leading scorer (**DARREN WHITE** - 21.2 points), field goal shooter (**ERIC GRIFFIN** - 63.8 percent), free throw shooter (**TREY FREEMAN** - 85.5 percent) and shot blocker (Griffin - 2.46). The Big South has never had one team with the individual leader in those four categories in the same season. The Camels could have two additional leaders, as Freeman is second in assists and Griffin is third in rebounding.

**BAND OF BROTHERS**

Liberty brothers **JESSE** and **JOHN CALEB SANDERS** have combined to score 1,335 points during their respective careers with the Flames. Jesse has 1,032 of the total, while John Caleb is at 303 that includes a career-high 177 points this season.

**ALL IN**

The Big South Conference will utilize a new format for its postseason men's basketball Conference Tournament in 2012, as the 2012 Advance Auto Parts Men's Basketball Championship will feature all 10 eligible teams in the field as well as the quarterfinals and semifinals contested at the No. 1 seed -- the first single-site for both rounds since 2002. The 10-team field will be the largest in the event's history, and first round games will be contested for just the second time -- the last occurring in 1993. The Tournament will begin with two first round contests on Monday night, Feb. 27, with the No. 7 seed hosting the No. 10 seed, and the No. 8 seed hosting the No. 9 seed. The winners advance into the quarterfinals on Wednesday, Feb. 29 at the home arena of the No. 1 seed. The No. 7-10 winner will play the No. 2 seed and the No. 8-9 winner will face the No. 1 seed.

**CLASS ACT**

Liberty senior guard **JESSE SANDERS** is one of 30 national candidates for the 2011-12 Lowe's Senior CLASS Award. To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence -- Community, Classroom, Character and Competition. The award focuses on the total student-athlete and encourages students to use their platform in athletics to make a positive impact as leaders in their communities. The 30 candidates will be narrowed to 10 finalists midway through the regular season, and those 10 names will be placed on the official ballot. Sanders is the Big South's first candidate since Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** in 2007-08.

**BIG SOUTH TIEBREAKING PROCEDURE**

While the Big South has 11 men's basketball members for the first time, the Conference is still utilizing an 18-game League schedule in 2011-12. Each team will play eight teams twice and two teams once.

A new tiebreaker procedure to address this unbalanced schedule is below and will be used to determine the seeding of teams for the Big South Tournament, if necessary.

**TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURE FOR SEEDING****TWO-TEAM TIE**

(1) *Regular-season head-to-head results. If the tied teams split their two games, then proceed to Step 2 below.*

(2) *Win-loss record vs. Conference opponents occupying the highest position in the final regular-season standings in which the tied teams played an equal amount of times. Continue down through the standings until one team gains an advantage. If an advantage is not determined, proceed to Step 3.*

(3) *The team with the highest ranking on the most recent College Basketball RPI Report (or the NCAA's RPI listing). Note - the Conference office will research to determine which rating is most accurate/current.*

**CAMPBELL**

Campbell has dropped its last five outings, but the last three have been decided by a total of 11 points ... The Camels are coming off an 87-81 loss Thursday at N.C. State. **DARREN WHITE** scored 25 points (9-of-11 FG), while **TREY FREEMAN** added 15, plus 7 assists, 3 steals and 0 turnovers. **LORNE MERTHIE** (4-of-6 3FG) chipped in a season-high 15 off the bench and **ERIC GRIFFIN** contributed 14, plus 5 blocks ... Griffin and White were named to the *CollegeHoopsNet.com* December Big South All-Conference team along with Coastal's **ANTHONY RAFFA**, HPU's **NICK BARBOUR** and PC's **AL'ONZO COLEMAN**.

**CHARLESTON SOUTHERN**

**SAAH NIMLEY** has scored in double figures in eight-straight games ... **KELVIN MARTIN** posted back-to-back double-doubles against Erskine and Liberty ... CSU has scored at least 81 points in each of its last three games ... **ARLON HARPER** tied his career-high with four 3FG against Erskine and is 15-of-28 from beyond the arc over his last five games (=53.6 percent).

**COASTAL CAROLINA**

Coastal Carolina dropped back-to-back games against East Carolina (Dec. 19) and College of Charleston (Dec. 22), the first time the Chants have lost two consecutive regular-season games since Nov. 16 and 18 of last season ... Coastal posted a season-high 19 turnovers in the loss against the Pirates and found themselves down by 15 against CoC before rallying to within three, eventually losing by seven for its first home loss of the year ... **ANTHONY RAFFA**'s 21 consecutive double-figure scoring streak, dating back to Feb. 12 of last year, was snapped after being held to eight points against High Point on Dec. 31.

**GARDNER-WEBB**

Gardner-Webb has now won three-straight over Radford, and is now 4-1 when playing the Highlanders in Radford, Va. ... The Runnin' Bulldogs used an 11-2 run to surge in front at Radford this past Saturday ... GWU is now 2-1 when playing on New Year's Eve as a Big South member ... Guard **TASHAN NEWSOME** is averaging 11.3 points in Big South Conference play, and 18.3 points per game in his last three starts.

**HIGH POINT**

High Point committed just four turnovers against Wofford on Dec. 21, an HPU Division I record. The previous record low was seven on three occasions ... The Panthers have handed out 20-or-more assists three times this season, most recently with 20 against Wofford. HPU topped 20 assists just once last season ... **NICK BARBOUR** went 9-of-9 from the free throw line against Wofford, one off HPU's Division I-era record. Barbour played in his 100th career game on Dec. 31 against Coastal Carolina, scoring 14 points to elevate his career total to 1,712. He is just the fifth Panther to clear the 1,700-point plateau ... Five of High Point's eight losses this season have come by five points-or-less.

**LIBERTY**

Liberty is looking to avoid starting the Conference season 0-4 for the first time since going 0-10 against the League in 1998-99 ... **JESSE SANDERS** is currently leading the Flames in points (13.1), rebounds (7.9) and assists (8.1) ... At Richmond on Dec. 28, Sanders missed his first free throw, halting a streak of 24 consecutive free throws made. Sanders inked his name in the Liberty annals that night as he became the 22nd member of the program's 1,000 point club ... The Flames had zero steals at Richmond, marking the first time in at least 12 years the Flames have failed to record a single theft in a contest ... Sanders set a Vines Center record with 16 assists against Montreat on Dec. 20.

**PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE**

PC's season-high three-game win streak ended with an overtime loss at VMI on Dec. 31 ... While the Blue Hose own a 6-5 mark over the Flames, they have only won once away from home, a 74-60 decision back in 1978 ... PC defeated Liberty in last season's finale at home, 73-66, for the first win in five tries ... **KHALID MUTAKABBIR** scored 24 points against VMI, just one shy of his career-high of 25 set at Cincinnati earlier this season ... **PIERRE MILLER** posted his third-straight double-figure scoring game with 12 against VMI -- all coming from a 4-of-8 effort from beyond the arc.

**RADFORD**

Radford is looking to end an 11-game losing streak ... The Highlanders have dropped 25 consecutive contests (3 neutral) away from home ... Despite its record, Radford leads the Big South Conference in offensive rebounding, averaging 14.6 per contests, which also ranks among the Top-25 in the nation ... **R.J. PRICE** continues his impressive play, as the 6-0 point guard is averaging 16.2 points, 4.8 rebounds and 3.2 assists per game over his last five contests ... **JAREAL SMITH**, who leads the team in scoring for the second-straight season, is contributing 15.8 points, 2.8 three-pointers made and 2.5 assists since the Dec. 17 contest at Cincinnati four games ago.

**UNC ASHEVILLE**

UNC Asheville ended a two-game losing streak with a 73-68 overtime victory at Winthrop on Dec. 31. The Bulldogs trailed by 14 before rallying for the win. **MATT DICKEY** scored 18 points in the game and moved into 8th-place on Asheville's all-time career scoring list with 1,445 points ... The Bulldogs have won eight of their last 11 Conference road games, dating back to last season ... **CHRIS STEPHENSON** recorded his second career double-double with 15 points and 13 rebounds at Western Carolina ... Walk-on center **JEREMY HARN** has earned some playing time in the last two games and responded. He grabbed a career-best six rebounds at WCU and then tallied a career-high six points at Winthrop.

**VMI**

VMI won its first overtime game since Feb 4, 2009, when it outlasted Presbyterian, 78-70, on Dec. 31 ... The Keydet bench scoring has held sizable advantages over the last three games. Winthrop lost three close games over the past two weeks, including two overtime games to Georgia and UNC Asheville. The Eagles have now lost four-straight ... **ANDRE JONES** became the 19th player in school history to reach the 1,000 point club on his fifth point of the Georgia game. He scored a career-high 33 points against UGA ... **GEORGE VALENTINE** became the 13th Winthrop player to reach 500 career rebounds when he grabbed five at Western Michigan on Dec. 20 ... Freshman **DERRICK HENRY** (Covington, Ga.) had a homecoming to remember when he scored a season-high 17 points at Georgia as he connected on 6-of-8 FG, including 3-of-3 from behind the arc.
