Atkinson averaged 20.5 points, 7.5 rebounds and made 73.7 percent of his field goals in two Big South road wins last week. Entering the week averaging 9.9 points, Atkinson scored a career-high 22 points and collected seven rebounds in Asheville's 86-79 comeback win at Campbell last Thursday. The Bulldogs trailed by 17 in the first half and Atkinson led the second-half surge with 19 points. On Saturday at High Point, he tallied 19 points with a game-high eight rebounds in the win. For the week, Atkinson was 14-of-19 from the field, 13-of-18 from the charity stripe (=72.2 percent) and recorded a steal in both games.

Landis averaged 17.0 points and shot 50.0 percent from the field in three games last week. He netted 16 points on 6-of-11 shooting to help GWU top Charleston Southern, 80-77, scoring eight points in each half. He followed that up with 17 points and two steals in a near upset of Coastal Carolina two nights later, and dropped in a team-high 18 points in another narrow defeat at Campbell on Saturday. Landis' final three-pointer against the Camels cut the Bulldogs' deficit to just two points with 21.3 seconds left. For the week, Landis was 19-of-38 from the field and 10-of-25 from three-point range (=40.0 percent).

START ME UP

UNC Asheville remains the League's lone undefeated team in Big South play at 7-0, the Bulldogs' best Conference start since opening 7-0 in 2007-08. Prior to this season, a total of 10 teams started the Big South season at least 7-0 since 1985-86, and all 10 of those squads won or shared the regular-season crown. In addition, six teams that opened 7-0 went on to win the Conference Tournament title -- the last being Winthrop 2006-07, while another three finished as Big South Tournament runner-up. Meanwhile, UNC Asheville is looking to start 8-0 in the Big South for the first time since 1997-98 -- **EDDIE BIEDENBACH**'s second season as head coach.

BULLDOGS' CONFERENCE GAME WIN STREAK REACHES 10

The UNC Asheville Bulldogs have won 10 consecutive Big South games, dating back to last season when Asheville won its final three regular-season Conference games. It is the Bulldogs' longest Big South win streak since winning 10 the same way across two seasons from Feb. 17, 2007 (3) to Feb. 2, 2008 (7). Asheville's longest Big South win streak is 12, which was accomplished Feb. 10, 1997 (4) to Jan. 31, 1998 (8).

ESPN3 TO CARRY MATCH-UP OF BIG SOUTH'S TOP TWO TEAMS TUESDAY

The "BB&T Big South Game of the Week" television package continues this week with Tuesday's Coastal Carolina at UNC Asheville game airing live exclusively on the ESPN3 beginning at 7:00pm. The game is a rematch of last year's Big South Championship contest. **MATT HOGUE** (play-by-play) and **RALPH PATTERSON** (analyst) will call the action from Kimmel Arena.

DOING THEIR HOMEWORK

The home teams have claimed 27 of the 41 Big South games played this season (=65.9 percent). In recent seasons, the home teams won 62.2 percent of the time (56-34) in both 2010-11 and 2009-10. This season, the 27 home wins have been by an average of 9.9 points, while the 14 road victories have been by 5.9 points. THE 411 ON THE 225

Since Conference play resumed Dec. 31, six League games have gone to overtime, including two on the same night twice (Dec. 31, Jan. 7). The site victor is split down the middle at three home wins and three road wins. Of the six, Winthrop and Coastal Carolina have played two OT games each. Last season, eight Big South games went into overtime, with the road squads winning five times.

CAUGHT IN A WEBB

Gardner-Webb has seen all eight of its Big South games this season decided in the final possessions, as the Runnin' Bulldogs have won their four Conference games by 2, 6, 4 and 3 points (15 points combined, 3.8 average) while dropping their four League losses by 6, 4, 2 and 6 points (18 points combined, 4.5 average).

SENIOR MOMENTS

UNC Asheville seniors **MATT DICKEY** and **J.P. PRIMM** have scored 15 points in the same game 23 times since arriving in Asheville in 2008-09, and the Bulldogs are 18-5 in those games. The duo has achieved this feat four times in 2011-12 (4-0 record) after reaching the total 14 times in 2010-11.

LINE LEADER

High Point's **NICK BARBOUR** is the ninth player in Big South history to make 400 career free throws, as his career total stands at 401. He needs four to move past Coastal Carolina's **ROBERT DOWDELL** (404 from 1987-91) for eighth-place in the Big South record book. Meanwhile, UNC Asheville's **MATT DICKEY** is 14 made free throws away from the milestone, and teammate **J.P. PRIMM** is 16 shy of the mark.

DOUBLE TAKE

Winthrop's **ANDRE JONES** had his double-figure scoring streak snapped at 16 games after finishing with eight points at High Point last Thursday, leaving Campbell's **DARREN WHITE** (19) as the only player to score in double figures in every game this season.

SECOND-HALF SURGE

In their last three Big South games, the UNC Asheville Bulldogs are shooting 64.9 percent from the field in the second-half. Asheville has made 50-of-77 field goal attempts in the second stanza, starting Jan. 7 against Liberty (20-of-26, 76.9) and continuing Jan. 12 at Campbell (17-of-28, 60.7) and Jan. 14 at High Point (13-of-23, 56.5).

THE BIG 5-0-0

High Point's **COREY LAW** is 13 rebounds away from becoming the fifth player this season and 65th in League history to reach 500 career rebounds in the Big South. Once he reaches the milestone, he will join VMI's **STAN OKOYE**, Coastal Carolina's **SAM McLAURIN**, Winthrop's **GEORGE VALENTINE** and PC's **AL'ONZO COLEMAN** among the 500-rebound club entrants this season.

BARBOUR SHOP

High Point senior guard **NICK BARBOUR** is 10th in Big South history with 1,810 career points, and needs 47 points to move into ninth-place. He is 190 points shy of becoming the seventh player in Conference annals with 2,000 points, and needs to average 15.8 points a game in the Panthers' 13 remaining games (12 regular-season and at least 1 Tournament contest) to reach the milestone. SAND CASTLE

Liberty senior guard **JESSE SANDERS** became the Big South's all-time assist leader Jan. 7 at UNC Asheville when he handed out his 604th career helper. He enters this week with 629. Meanwhile, Sanders is averaging a League-best 7.85 assists per game this season, which is currently the second-highest assist average in a single-season in Big South history. The Conference record is 9.64, which was set by Charleston Southern's **TONY FAIRLEY** in 1986-87. Fairley also holds the Big South single-season assist record of 270 in '86-87, and Sanders is 113 assists shy of that total and would need to average 9.4 assists in Liberty's 12 remaining games to catch Fairley's record. Sanders needs just 24 helpers to crack the League's single-season Top 10 chart.

GRAB BAG

UNC Asheville senior guard **J.P. PRIMM** is the first player in Big South history with 400 career rebounds, 500 career assists and 200 career steals. He reached the rebounding milestone Jan. 7 against Liberty. Primm is one of five players in League annals with 500 assists (542) and 200 steals (213), joining Winthrop's **CHRIS GAYNOR** (567 AST, 259 STL), Campbell's **BRAD CHILDRESS** (543-243), Charleston Southern's **ED O'NEIL** (504-241) and Coastal Carolina's **ROBERT DOWDELL** (561-239) in the club. Primm needs two assists to move into eighth all-time in Big South history in assists, and is seven steals shy of 10th-place.

MY FAVORITE MARTIN

Charleston Southern senior forward **KELVIN MARTIN** is the fourth player in Big South history to have 1,000 career points (1,270), 800 career rebounds (850) and 100 career blocked shots (101). He reached the block milestone on Jan. 5 against Campbell. Martin needs four steals for 200 in his career, which would make him the third Big South player with 1,000 points, 800 rebounds, 200 steals and 100 blocks. The other two are Campbell's **JOE SPINKS** (1,711 - 954 - 220 - 155) and Coastal Carolina's **JOSEPH HARRIS** (1,444 - 1,152 - 205 - 142).

ANDRE THE GIANT

Winthrop's **ANDRE JONES** is third in the Big South with 18.2 points per game, the highest scoring average by a Winthrop Eagle since **FRED MCKINNON** averaged 21.1 points in 1985-86. Jones, who entered the season with a career scoring average of 8.5 points, has scored in double figures in 17 of 18 games this year -- including the first 16 contests, and has poured in 20 points six times this season -- including five games with 25+. He has led Winthrop in scoring 11 times this season, and his 327 points scored already surpasses his previous season-high of 321, which was set in 30 games last year.

FROM THE LAND OF THREE

VMI senior **KEITH GABRIEL** and High Point senior **NICK BARBOUR** are poised to join the Big South's 300 three-point field goal club, which currently stands at six members. Gabriel is tied with Coastal Carolina's **KEKE HICKS** (1992-95) for 11th all-time in League history with 272 career threes, while Barbour is right behind both players in 13th-place with 263 treys.

BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

Winthrop's **REGGIE MIDDLETON** became the fifth player this season and 109th in Big South history to score 1,000 career points when he surpassed the milestone this past Saturday at Liberty. UNC Asheville's **CHRIS STEPHENSON** is 19 points away from the scoring mark. Below is a look at the Big South's active 1,000-point scorers (currently nine), as well as those closing in on the milestone:

SAND BAR

Liberty guard **JESSE SANDERS** is the only player in Big South history with 1,000 career points (1,087), 700 career rebounds (723) and 600 career assists (629). He is one of 21 players with 1,000 points and 700 boards, and ranks 16th all-time in career rebounds -- needing 63 boards to move into the Big South's all-time Top 10. Meanwhile, Sanders is the only player in the nation averaging 7.0 rebounds (7.9) and 7.0 assists (7.9), and would become the first player in Big South history to do so in the same season.

ALL AROUND GAME

Campbell currently has the Big South's leading scorer (**DARREN WHITE** - 19.4 points), field goal shooter (**ERIC GRIFFIN** - 62.4 percent), free throw shooter (**TREY FREEMAN** - 84.8 percent) and shot blocker (Griffin - 2.28). The Big South has never had one team with the individual leader in those four categories in the same season. The Camels could have another leader, as Griffin is second in rebounding.

SCOREBOARD WATCHING

Reigning five-time NCAA scoring champion VMI leads the Big South and is second in Division I with 84.6 points per game -- just 0.6 behind North Carolina's 85.2 average. The Keydets are going for their unprecedented sixth-straight NCAA scoring title, and vaulted back into the national lead the week of Dec. 4 after being No. 12 in scoring offense the week prior. The Keydets held the top spot for four weeks before dropping to second the week of Jan. 2.

MR. TRIPLE-DOUBLE

Liberty senior guard **JESSE SANDERS** could become the first player in Division I history with a triple-double in four different years. He owns three of the eight triple-doubles on record in Conference annals. He recorded his first as a freshman against Presbyterian College on Feb. 9, 2009, his second during his sophomore year against Kentucky Christian on Dec. 12, 2009, and his third as a junior against Charleston Southern on Jan. 6, 2011.

BAND OF BROTHERS

Liberty brothers **JESSE** and **JOHN CALEB SANDERS** have combined to score 1,449 points during their respective careers with the Flames. Jesse has 1,087 of the total, while John Caleb is at 362.

MOUNTAIN TOP

League-leading UNC Asheville scored 94 points against VMI on Jan. 5 and 98 points against Liberty on Jan. 7, marking the first time ever that the Bulldogs scored 90 points in back-to-back Conference games. The Bulldogs' streak of consecutive Big South games with at least 80 points scored stands at four, which is also a first for the program.

BRICK AND MORTAR

Coastal Carolina redshirt-junior **SAM McLAURIN** (554, 142) and Charleston Southern senior **KELVIN MARTIN** (850, 101) are two of 16 players in Big South history with 500 rebounds and 100 blocked shots. McLaurin is currently tied for 15th on the all-time blocked shot chart and needs one to break the Coastal Carolina career mark. Martin is 27th with 101 career blocks.

HITTING THE HIGH NOTES

High Point tied the Big South record for highest three-point field goal percentage in a Conference game when the Panthers made 68.8 percent from long range against Charleston Southern on Jan. 2. HPU went 11-of-16 from beyond the arc that night, matching the record first set by Radford (also 11-of-16) against UNC Asheville on Jan. 10, 2004. The record is based on a minimum 10 3FG made.

LENDING A HELPING HAND

Liberty's **JESSE SANDERS** recorded 16 assists in the Flames' victory over Montreat on Dec. 20, the most assists in a game by a Big South player since Campbell's **DAN POGUE** handed out 16 dimes against UNC Asheville on Feb. 8, 1993.

BOTH ENDS OF THE SPECTRUM

Of the 41 Big South games played this season, 27 had winning margins of less than 10 points (=65.9 percent), with the average margin of victory in those 27 games being 5.3 points. The remaining 14 games that have decided by at least 10 points had an average winning margin of 14.9 points. Overall, the 41 Conference games played thus far in 2011-12 have had an average margin of victory of 8.59 points. Last year, the overall margin of victory in League play was 10.48, while the 2009-10 average margin was 10.51 points and the 2008-09 League season was 8.96 points.

3-0 STARTS

For the first time in League history, four Big South teams started Conference play 3-0 in the same season. Asheville started 3-0 for the seventh time -- all under head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH**. Coastal Carolina opened 3-0 in League action for the third consecutive year, marking the second time the Chanticleers have achieved this three-peat and the first Big South team to open 3-0 in back-to-back-to-back seasons since UNC Asheville in 1996-97, 1997-98 and 1998-99. Charleston Southern started 3-0 in the Big South for the first time since 2004-05. Campbell opened Big South play 3-0 for the first time since 1993-94 when the Camels opened 4-0.

DO THE CHARLESTON

Charleston Southern won 10 of its first 15 games, the fastest the Bucs reached 10 victories in a season since 1969-70, when CSU opened 10-4 that season.

COASTAL CAROLINA TIES BIG SOUTH RECORD FOR CONSECUTIVE LEAGUE ROAD WINS

Coastal Carolina's school-record 11-consecutive Big South road wins -- tied for the longest in Big South history, was snapped Monday, Jan. 2 at Campbell as the Camels claimed a 70-65 home win in overtime. The Chants had tied the mark that was first established by Winthrop from 2004-06 and matched by Radford from 2008-10. The Conference's active streak now belongs to UNC Asheville at six.

CLASS ACT

Liberty senior guard **JESSE SANDERS** is one of 30 national candidates for the 2011-12 Lowe's Senior CLASS Award. To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence -- Community, Classroom, Character and Competition. The award focuses on the total student-athlete and encourages students to use their platform in athletics to make a positive impact as leaders in their communities. The 30 candidates will be narrowed to 10 finalists midway through the regular season, and those 10 names will be placed on the official ballot. Sanders is the Big South's first candidate since Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** in 2007-08.

ALL IN

The Big South Conference will utilize a new format for its postseason men's basketball Conference Tournament in 2012, as the 2012 Advance Auto Parts Men's Basketball Championship will feature all 10 eligible teams in the field as well as the quarterfinals and semifinals contested at the No. 1 seed -- the first single-site for both rounds since 2002. The 10-team field will be the largest in the event's history, and first round games will be contested for just the second time -- the last occurring in 1993. The Tournament will begin with two first round contests on Monday night, Feb. 27, with the No. 7 seed hosting the No. 10 seed, and the No. 8 seed hosting the No. 9 seed. The winners advance into the quarterfinals on Wednesday, Feb. 29 at the home arena of the No. 1 seed. The No. 7-10 winner will play the No. 2 seed and the No. 8-9 winner will face the No. 1 seed. The bracket appears on page 10 of this report.

ELDER STATESMAN

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** won his 700th game as a collegiate head coach on Dec. 6 when the Chanticleers won 80-58 at The Citadel. Now in his 37th year as a head coach, Ellis stands 705-401 overall, including 93-52 (=64.1 percent) in five seasons at Coastal Carolina. He is the eighth-winningest active head coach with 627 Division I wins (627-389 at the Division I level) and is 34th on the all-time Division I wins list. In addition, Ellis has directed four different Division I programs to at least two 20-win campaigns, and owns six seasons with at least 25 wins. He is seven wins away from winning 100 games with his fourth different Division I program.

STEADY EDDIE

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** became the school's all-time victory leader on Jan. 2 with his 224th win at the helm of the Bulldogs, passing **BOB HARTMAN** for the career record. Biedenbach, who won his 250th career game with the Bulldogs' 88-81 win over USC Upstate on Dec. 4, is the Big South's all-time winningest coach for overall wins (228) and Big South victories (135), and is now 257-289 in 18 years as a collegiate head coach.

RADEBAUGH AND PEELE GET MILESTONE WINS ON THE SAME NIGHT

Charleston Southern head coach **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH** collected his 100th career head coaching win with the Buccaneers' 91-73 victory over Campbell on Jan. 5. That same night, Winthrop's **RANDY PEELE** notched his 100th win as a Big South head coach. Radebaugh's career total includes 80 wins at CSU and 21 at Queen's University. Peele has now won 102 games as a Big South head coach -- 72 at Winthrop and 30 during UNC Greensboro's membership in the Conference.

CENTURY MARK IN THEIR SIGHTS

VMI head coach **DUGGAR BAUCOM** is four wins away from 100 victories at the Institute, and Campbell head coach **ROBBIE LAING** needs five wins for 100 in his collegiate head coaching career.

BIG SOUTH TIEBREAKING PROCEDURE

While the Big South has 11 men's basketball members for the first time, the Conference is still utilizing an 18-game League schedule in 2011-12. Each team will play eight teams twice and two teams once.

A new tiebreaker procedure to address this unbalanced schedule is below and will be used to determine the seeding of teams for the Big South Tournament, if necessary.

TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURE FOR SEEDING**TWO-TEAM TIE**

(1) *Regular-season head-to-head results. If the tied teams split their two games, then proceed to Step 2 below.*

(2) *Win-loss record vs. Conference opponents occupying the highest position in the final regular-season standings in which the tied teams played an equal amount of times. Continue down through the standings until one team gains an advantage. If an advantage is not determined, proceed to Step 3.*

(3) *The team with the highest ranking on the most recent College Basketball RPI Report (or the NCAA's RPI listing). Note - the Conference office will research to determine which rating is most accurate/current.*

TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURE FOR SEEDING**MULTI-TEAM TIE**

(1) *Regular-season head-to-head results. If the tied teams split their two games, then proceed to Step 2 below.*

(2) *Win-loss record vs. Conference opponents occupying the highest position in the final regular-season standings in which the tied teams played an equal amount of times. Continue down through the standings until one team gains an advantage. If an advantage is not determined, proceed to Step 3.*

BIG SOUTH TO MAKE SEVENTH APPEARANCE IN ESPN'S BRACKETBUSTERS EVENT

The Big South Conference will again participate in the SEARS BracketBusters event this season during the weekend of February 17-19, with a League-record 11 teams among the field of 142 -- the event's largest pool ever. All of the Big South's men's basketball programs are participating in the same year for the first time, and the Conference has the second-most members competing of the 16 Leagues involved this season. Five Big South teams will host a game while the remaining six members will play on the road. The Conference is 8-16 all-time in the BracketBusters, including two wins in 2006, 2007 and 2010. The Big South has also been selected for national television appearances four times in the past five years: 2007 (ESPN2), 2008 (ESPN2), 2009 (ESPNU) and 2011 (ESPNU).

MID-MAJOR MANIA

For the eighth consecutive season, the Big South has had a member ranked in the *Collegeinsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 poll, as Campbell was ranked No. 25 the week of Dec. 12 and Coastal Carolina was ranked No. 25 the week of Dec. 19. It was the Camels' first appearance in the 13-year-old ranking, and the third-straight season the Chanticleers were ranked in the poll. TOAST TO THE COAST

Seven days after defeating LSU, Coastal Carolina won 60-59 at Clemson on Nov. 22, marking the second-straight year that a Big South member has defeated an SEC team and ACC team in the same season. Presbyterian College did it last year in back-to-back games, as the Blue Hose won at Auburn on Dec. 18 and followed with a win at Wake Forest on Dec. 20. The Chanticleers are now the third Big South team in Conference history with SEC-ACC wins in the same campaign. The first was Campbell in 1993-94 when the Camels defeated North Carolina State and South Carolina.

BACK TO THE FUTURE

The Big South has recorded wins over the SEC, Big East and ACC this season, an accomplishment that occurred just once previously in League history. The 1993-94 season was the first time the Big South Conference defeated an SEC, Big East and ACC team in the same year. Meanwhile, the Big South has now collected an SEC win five out of the last six seasons, an ACC win four out of the last five seasons, and a Big East win four out of the last eight seasons.

BUT WAIT, THERE'S MORE

This is the first time the Big South has ever posted wins over five of the six "BCS" Conferences in a single-season, as Campbell's win at Iowa on Nov. 23 and UNC Asheville's victory over Utah on Nov. 26 gave the Big South victories against Big Ten and Pac-12 members. It was the Big South's first-ever win over a Big Ten team, and the Conference's first win against a Pac-12 member since 1996-97.

CAMPBELL

Campbell split a pair of home games last week. CU dropped its first home decision of the year, an 89-82 setback against League-leading UNC Asheville Thursday in front of a season-high crowd of 3,035 at 3,095-seat Gore Arena. CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

CSU's win over Presbyterian was the first time this season the Bucs won a game in which they scored fewer than 70 points ... Charleston Southern has scored 80 or more in nine of their 11 victories.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal defeated Gardner-Webb and Presbyterian last week, improving to 6-1 in the Conference ... Against Gardner-Webb, the Chants trailed 8-0 to start the game but answered with a 24-6 run and eventually led by a game-high 11 points ... The Runnin' Bulldogs tied the game but a pair of **KIERRE GREENWOOD** free throws proved to be the game-winning points ... Coastal forced 18 turnovers against Presbyterian for its largest margin of victory in Conference play this season (18). The Chants have now won five-straight against the Blue Hose ... **SAM McLAURIN** moved into a tie for first in Coastal Carolina history for the most career-blocked shots (142).

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb has seen 13 of its 20 games so far this season decided by two possessions or less, including all eight of its Big South games ... GWU is 6-7 overall in those 13 games and 4-4 in League play ... **JASON DAWSON**, The team's second-leading scorer, went down with an injury after just two minutes of play (one point) at Coastal Carolina and missed the Campbell game ... Gardner-Webb improved to 6-1 at home this season with its 80-77 win over Charleston Southern on Jan. 10 ... The 'Dogs played three of the League's top-4 teams in a matter of five days last week, including two road games.

HIGH POINT

With its 64-54 win over Winthrop last Thursday, High Point has defeated the Eagles five times in a row at the Millis Center ... In Liberty's win over Radford, the Flames made 30 free throws, the most since Feb. 28, 2009 when Liberty put in 32 from the line in a 92-85 win at Radford.
