**CHRIS STEPHENSON • F**

**Punta Gorda, Fla.**

Stephenson averaged 20.7 points, 6.7 rebounds, 4.0 assists, 3.0 steals, 1.7 blocked shots and 60.5 percent from the field (26-of-43) in three wins last week. He scored a career-high 33 points in Asheville's 66-56 road win at Radford last Monday, the only Bulldog in double figures and the most points by an Asheville player since the 1998-99 season. Stephenson also grabbed 10 rebounds and went 12-of-19 from the field and 8-of-9 from the line against the Highlanders. On Thursday against VMI, he tallied 17 points, six assists, six rebounds and had four steals in a victory over the Keydets. Stephenson concluded his week with 12 points, three blocks, four assists and two steals in a win over Liberty on Saturday.

### SAND CASTLE

Liberty senior guard **JESSE SANDERS** is the Big South's all-time assist leader after breaking the record of 604 this past Saturday at UNC Asheville. He garnered his record-breaking dime at the 13:11 mark of the first half on a dish to **TAVARES SPEAKS** for a jumper. Sanders surpassed the mark that was established by Radford's **AMIR JOHNSON** from 2006-10, and enters the week with 613. Meanwhile, Sanders is averaging a League-best 8.29 assists per game this season, which is currently the second-highest assist average in a single-season in Big South history. The Conference record is 9.64, which was set by Charleston Southern's **TONY FAIRLEY** in 1986-87. Fairley also holds the Big South single-season assist record 270 in '86-87, and Sanders is 129 assists shy of that total and would need to average 8.6 assists in Liberty's 15 remaining games to catch Fairley's record. Sanders needs just 40 helpers to crack the League's single-season Top 10 chart.

### THE IMPORTANCE OF A GOOD START

UNC Asheville is the League's last undefeated team in Big South play at 5-0, the Bulldogs' best Conference start since opening 7-0 in 2007-08. Prior to this season, a total of 24 teams started the Big South season at least 5-0 since 1985-86, and 19 of those squads have won or shared the regular-season crown. In addition, eight teams that opened 5-0 went on to win the Conference Tournament title -- the last being Winthrop 2006-07, while another six finished as Big South Tournament runner-up.

### 3-0 STARTS

For the first time in League history, four Big South teams started Conference play 3-0 in the same season. Asheville started 3-0 for the seventh time -- all under head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH**. Coastal Carolina opened 3-0 in League action for the third consecutive year, marking the second time the Chanticleers have achieved this three-peat and the first Big South team to open 3-0 in back-to-back-to-back seasons since UNC Asheville in 1996-97, 1997-98 and 1998-99. Charleston Southern started 3-0 in the Big South for the first time since 2004-05. Campbell opened Big South play 3-0 for the first time since 1993-94 when the Camels opened 4-0.

### DO THE CHARLESTON

Charleston Southern won 10 of its first 15 games, the fastest the Bucs reached 10 victories in a season since 1969-70, when CSU opened 10-4 that season.

### THE 411 ON THE 225

Since Conference play resumed Dec. 31, five of the 19 games played have gone to overtime ( =26.3 percent), including two on the same night twice (Dec. 31, Jan. 7). The home teams have won three of the five games involving extra time. Last season, eight Big South games went into overtime, with the road squads being victorious five times.

### GRAB BAG

UNC Asheville senior guard **J.P. PRIMM** is the first player in Big South history with 400 career rebounds, 500 career assists and 200 career steals. He reached the rebounding milestone this past Saturday against Liberty. Primm is one of five players in League annals with 500 assists (534) and 200 steals (211), joining Winthrop's **CHRIS GAYNOR** (567 AST, 259 STL), Campbell's **BRAD CHILDRESS** (543-243), Charleston Southern's **ED O'NEIL** (504-241) and Coastal Carolina's **ROBERT DOWDELL** (561-239) in the club. Primm ranks ninth all-time in Big South history in assists and 11th in steals.

### MY FAVORITE MARTIN

Charleston Southern senior forward **KELVIN MARTIN** is the fourth player in Big South history to have 1,000 career points (1,238), 800 career rebounds (833) and 100 career blocked shots (101). He reached the block milestone on Jan. 5 against Campbell. Martin needs eight steals for 200 in his career, which would make him the third Big South player with 1,000 points, 800 rebounds, 200 steals and 100 blocks. The other two are Campbell's **JOE SPINKS** (1,711 - 954 - 220 - 155) and Coastal Carolina's **JOSEPH HARRIS** (1,444 - 1,152 - 205 - 142).

### THE BIG 5-0-0

Presbyterian College's **AL'LONZO COLEMAN** became the fourth player this season and 64th in League history to reach 500 career rebounds in the Big South when he achieved the feat this past Saturday against Campbell. Coleman's overall career rebounding total stands at 652, which includes 151 during his true freshman season of 2007-08 before the Blue Hose were officially included in the Conference's statistics. Coleman joins VMI's **STAN OKOYE**, Coastal Carolina's **SAM McLAURIN** and Winthrop's **GEORGE VALENTINE** among the 500-rebound club entrants this season.

**BARBOUR SHOP**

High Point senior guard **NICK BARBOUR** is now among the Big South's all-time Top 10 scorers, as he entered the 10th position this past Saturday at Gardner-Webb. He has now scored 1,770 points in his career, and is 230 points shy of becoming the seventh player in Conference annals with 2,000 points. He would need to average 15.3 points a game in the Panthers' 15 remaining games (14 regular-season and at least 1 Tournament contest) to reach the milestone. **ELDER STATESMAN**

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** won his 700th game as a collegiate head coach on Dec. 6 when the Chanticleers won 80-58 at The Citadel. Now in his 37th year as a head coach, Ellis stands 703-401 overall, including 91-52 ( =63.6 percent) in five seasons at Coastal Carolina. He is the eighth-winningest active head coach with 625 Division I wins (625-389 at the Division I level) and is 34th on the all-time Division I wins list. In addition, Ellis has directed four different Division I programs to at least two 20-win campaigns, and owns six seasons with at least 25 wins. He is nine wins away from winning 100 games with his fourth different Division I program.

**STEADY EDDIE**

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** became the school's all-time victory leader on Jan. 2 with his 224th win at the helm of the Bulldogs, passing **BOB HARTMAN** for the career record. Biedenbach, who won his 250th career game with the Bulldogs' 88-81 win over USC Upstate on Dec. 4, is the Big South's all-time winningest coach for overall wins (226) and Big South victories (133), and is now 255-289 in 18 years as a collegiate head coach.

**RADEBAUGH AND PEELE GET MILESTONE WINS ON THE SAME NIGHT**

Charleston Southern head coach **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH** collected his 100th career head coaching win with the Buccaneers' 91-73 victory over Campbell on Jan. 5. That same night, Winthrop's **RANDY PEELE** notched his 100th win as a Big South head coach. Radebaugh's career total includes 79 wins at CSU and 21 at Queen's University. Peele has now won 101 games as a Big South head coach -- 71 at Winthrop and 30 during UNC Greensboro's membership in the Conference. Meanwhile, VMI's **DUGGAR BAUCOM** is six wins away from 100 victories at the Institute.

**DOUBLE TROUBLE**

High Point's **NICK BARBOUR** had his double-figure scoring streak snapped at 31 games after finishing with seven points at Gardner-Webb this past Saturday. That leaves Campbell's **DARREN WHITE** (17) and Winthrop's **ANDRE JONES** (16) as the only players that have scored in double figures in every game thus far. Jones' personal streak sits at 18, dating back to last season.

**BRICK AND MORTAR**

Coastal Carolina redshirt-junior **SAM McLAURIN** (543, 138) and Charleston Southern senior **KELVIN MARTIN** (833, 101) are two of 16 players in Big South history with 500 rebounds and 100 blocked shots. McLaurin is currently 18th on the all-time blocked shot chart and needs two to move past Winthrop's **BILLY HOUSTON** (139) for 17th-place. Martin is 27th with 101 career blocks.

**ANDRE THE GIANT**

Winthrop's **ANDRE JONES** is second in the Big South with 19.1 points per game, the highest scoring average by a Winthrop Eagle since **FRED MCKINNON** averaged 21.1 points in 1985-86. Jones, who entered the season with a career scoring average of 8.5 points, has scored in double figures in every game and has poured in 20 points six times this season -- including five games with 25+. He has led Winthrop in scoring 11 times this season, and his 305 points scored thus far is already 95.0 percent of his season-best scoring total of 321, which was set in 30 games last year.

**FROM THE LAND OF THREE**

VMI senior **KEITH GABRIEL** and High Point senior **NICK BARBOUR** are poised to join the Big South's 300 three-point field goal club, which currently stands at six members. Gabriel is 12th all-time in League history with 267 career threes, while Barbour is right behind him in 13th with 255 treys. Coastal Carolina's **KEKE HICKS** (1992-95) holds the 11th spot with 272.

**BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB**

Winthrop's **REGGIE MIDDLETON** is 30 points away from becoming the fourth player this season and 109th in Big South history to score 1,000 career points. Below is a look at the Big South's active 1,000-point scorers (currently eight), as well as those closing in on the milestone:

**SAND BAR**

Liberty guard **JESSE SANDERS** is the only player in Big South history with 1,000 career points (1,054), 600 career rebounds (699) and 600 career assists (613). He is on the cusp of becoming the 23rd player in League annals with 700 rebounds, which would make him one of 21 players with 1,000 points and 700 boards. Meanwhile, Sanders is the only player in the nation averaging 7.0 rebounds (7.8) and 8.0 assists (8.3), and would become the first player in Big South history to do so in the same season.

**MR. TRIPLE-DOUBLE**

Liberty senior guard **JESSE SANDERS** could become the first player in Division I history with a triple-double in four different years. He owns three of the eight triple-doubles on record in Conference annals. He recorded his first as a freshman against Presbyterian College on Feb. 9, 2009, his second during his sophomore year against Kentucky Christian on Dec. 12, 2009, and his third as a junior against Charleston Southern on Jan. 6, 2011.

**SCOREBOARD WATCHING**

Reigning five-time NCAA scoring champion VMI leads the Big South and is third in Division I with 85.8 points per game. The Keydets are going for their unprecedented sixth-straight NCAA scoring title, and vaulted back into the national lead the week of Dec. 4 after being No. 12 in scoring offense the week prior. The Keydets held the top spot for four weeks before dropping to second the week of Jan. 2.

**I LOVE THE '80s**

Three Big South teams -- VMI (85.8), UNC Asheville (81.9) and Charleston Southern (80.6) -- are currently averaging at least 80.0 points a game, tied for the most in Conference history. Just 10 teams in League annals have finished a season averaging 80 points game, with the most teams in the same season being three in 1992-93. That year, Winthrop (83.6), UMBC (81.8) and Radford (81.3) were above the 80.0 scoring mark.

**LINE LEADER**

High Point's **NICK BARBOUR** (395) is five free throws away from becoming just the ninth player in Conference history to make 400 career free throws. UNC Asheville's **J.P. PRIMM** is 24 away from the milestone.

**SENIOR MOMENTS**

UNC Asheville seniors **MATT DICKEY** and **J.P. PRIMM** have scored 15 points in the same game 21 times since arriving in Asheville in 2008-09, and the Bulldogs are 16-5 in those games. The duo has achieved this feat twice in 2011-12 (2-0 record) after reaching the total 14 times in 2010-11.

**COASTAL CAROLINA TIES BIG SOUTH RECORD FOR CONSECUTIVE LEAGUE ROAD WINS**

Coastal Carolina's school-record 11-consecutive Big South road wins -- tied for the longest in Big South history, was snapped last Monday, Jan. 2 at Campbell as the Camels claimed a 70-65 home win in overtime. The Chants had tied the mark that was first established by Winthrop from 2004-06 and matched by Radford from 2008-10. UNC Asheville takes over the active streak at four.

**BAND OF BROTHERS**

Liberty brothers **JESSE** and **JOHN CALEB SANDERS** have combined to score 1,380 points during their respective careers with the Flames. Jesse has 1,054 of the total, while John Caleb is at 326 which includes a career-high 200 points this season.

**DOING THEIR HOMEWORK**

The home teams have claimed 18 of the 29 Big South games played this season (=62.1 percent). The home teams won 62.2 percent of the time (56-34) in both 2010-11 and 2009-10. This season, the 18 home squads have won by an average of 11.1 points, while the 11 road team wins have been by 7.3 points.

**BOTH ENDS OF THE SPECTRUM**

Of the 29 Big South games, 18 had winning margins of less than 10 points, with the average margin of victory in those 18 games being 5.6 points. The remaining 11 games that have decided by at least 10 points had an average winning margin of 15.1 points. Overall, the 29 Conference games played thus far in 2011-12 has had an average margin of victory of 9.17 points. Last year, the overall margin of victory in League play was 10.48, while the 2009-10 average margin was 10.51 points and the 2008-09 League season was 8.96 points.

**MID-MAJOR MANIA**

For the eighth consecutive season, the Big South has had a member ranked in the *Collegeinsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 poll, as Campbell was ranked No. 25 the week of Dec. 12 and Coastal Carolina was ranked No. 25 the week of Dec. 19. It was the Camels' first appearance in the 13-year-old ranking, and the third-straight season the Chanticleers were ranked in the poll. **TOAST TO THE COAST**

Seven days after defeating LSU, Coastal Carolina won 60-59 at Clemson on Nov. 22, marking the second-straight year that a Big South member has defeated an SEC team and ACC team in the same season. Presbyterian College did it last year in back-to-back games, as the Blue Hose won at Auburn on Dec. 18 and followed with a win at Wake Forest on Dec. 20. The Chanticleers are now the third Big South team in Conference history with SEC-ACC wins in the same campaign. The first was Campbell in 1993-94 when the Camels defeated North Carolina State and South Carolina.

**BACK TO THE FUTURE**

The Big South has recorded wins over the SEC, Big East and ACC this season, an accomplishment that occurred just once previously in League history. The 1993-94 season was the first time the Big South Conference defeated an SEC, Big East and ACC team in the same year. Meanwhile, the Big South has now collected an SEC win five out of the last six seasons, an ACC win four out of the last five seasons, and a Big East win four out of the last eight seasons.

**BUT WAIT, THERE'S MORE**

This is the first time the Big South has ever posted wins over five of the six "BCS" Conferences in a single-season, as Campbell's win at Iowa on Nov. 23 and UNC Asheville's victory over Utah on Nov. 26 gave the Big South victories against Big Ten and Pac-12 members. It was the Big South's first-ever win over a Big Ten team, and the Conference's first win against a Pac-12 member since 1996-97.

**MOUNTAIN TOP**

League-leading UNC Asheville scored 94 points against VMI on Jan. 5 and 98 points against Liberty on Jan. 7, marking the first time ever that the Bulldogs scored 90 points in back-to-back Conference games.

**HITTING THE HIGH NOTES**

High Point tied the Big South record for highest three-point field goal percentage in a Conference game when the Panthers made 68.8 percent from long range against Charleston Southern on Jan. 2. HPU went 11-of-16 from beyond the arc that night, matching the record first set by Radford (also 11-of-16) against UNC Asheville on Jan. 10, 2004. The record is based on a minimum 10 3FG made.

**LENDING A HELPING HAND**

Liberty's **JESSE SANDERS** recorded 16 assists in the Flames' victory over Montreat on Dec. 20, the most assists in a game by a Big South player since Campbell's **DAN POGUE** handed out 16 dimes against UNC Asheville on Feb. 8, 1993.

**ALL IN**

The Big South Conference will utilize a new format for its postseason men's basketball Conference Tournament in 2012, as the 2012 Advance Auto Parts Men's Basketball Championship will feature all 10 eligible teams in the field as well as the quarterfinals and semifinals contested at the No. 1 seed -- the first single-site for both rounds since 2002. The 10-team field will be the largest in the event's history, and first round games will be contested for just the second time -- the last occurring in 1993. The Tournament will begin with two first round contests on Monday night, Feb. 27, with the No. 7 seed hosting the No. 10 seed, and the No. 8 seed hosting the No. 9 seed. The winners advance into the quarterfinals on Wednesday, Feb. 29 at the home arena of the No. 1 seed. The No. 7-10 winner will play the No. 2 seed and the No. 8-9 winner will face the No. 1 seed. The bracket appears on page 9 of this report.

**CLASS ACT**

Liberty senior guard **JESSE SANDERS** is one of 30 national candidates for the 2011-12 Lowe's Senior CLASS Award. To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence -- Community, Classroom, Character and Competition. The award focuses on the total student-athlete and encourages students to use their platform in athletics to make a positive impact as leaders in their communities. The 30 candidates will be narrowed to 10 finalists midway through the regular season, and those 10 names will be placed on the official ballot. Sanders is the Big South's first candidate since Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** in 2007-08.

**BIG SOUTH TO MAKE SEVENTH APPEARANCE IN ESPN'S BRACKETBUSTERS EVENT**

The Big South Conference will again participate in the SEARS BracketBusters event this season during the weekend of February 17-19, with a League-record 11 teams among the field of 142 -- the event's largest pool ever. All of the Big South's men's basketball programs are participating in the same year for the first time, and the Conference has the second-most members competing of the 16 Leagues involved this season. Five Big South teams will host a game while the remaining six members will play on the road. The Conference is 8-16 all-time in the BracketBusters, including two wins in 2006, 2007 and 2010. The Big South has also been selected for national television appearances four times in the past five years: 2007 (ESPN2), 2008 (ESPN2), 2009 (ESPNU) and 2011 (ESPNU).

**BIG SOUTH TIEBREAKING PROCEDURE**

While the Big South has 11 men's basketball members for the first time, the Conference is still utilizing an 18-game League schedule in 2011-12. Each team will play eight teams twice and two teams once.

A new tiebreaker procedure to address this unbalanced schedule is below and will be used to determine the seeding of teams for the Big South Tournament, if necessary.

**TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURE FOR SEEDING TWO-TEAM TIE**

(1) *Regular-season head-to-head results. If the tied teams split their two games, then proceed to Step 2 below.*

(2) *Win-loss record vs. Conference opponents occupying the highest position in the final regular-season standings in which the tied teams played an equal amount of times. Continue down through the standings until one team gains an advantage. If an advantage is not determined, proceed to Step 3.*

(3) *The team with the highest ranking on the most recent College Basketball RPI Report (or the NCAA's RPI listing). Note - the Conference office will research to determine which rating is most accurate/current.*

**TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURE FOR SEEDING MULTI-TEAM TIE**

(1) *Regular-season head-to-head results. If the tied teams split their two games, then proceed to Step 2 below.*

(2) *Win-loss record vs. Conference opponents occupying the highest position in the final regular-season standings in which the tied teams played an equal amount of times. Continue down through the standings until one team gains an advantage. If an advantage is not determined, proceed to Step 3.*

(3) *The team with the highest ranking on the most recent College Basketball RPI Report (or the NCAA's RPI listing). Note - the Conference office will research to determine which rating is most accurate/current.*

**CAMPBELL**

CU improved to 7-0 at home this year with a 70-65 overtime win over Coastal Carolina on Jan. 2, behind freshman **TREY FREEMAN**'s 20 points and 5 assists ... The Camels snapped a 6-game road slide this past Saturday at Presbyterian as **DARREN WHITE** scored 18 of his game-high 22 points in the second half ... **ERIC GRIFFIN** leads all Big South players with five 20-point, 10-rebound games, including 23 and 11 at Charleston Southern ... White tops the Big South and stands 17th in the country in scoring (20.0) ... CU enters the week ranked 3rd nationally in field goal percentage (50.9), 19th in blocks (5.8) and 22nd in scoring (78.4).

**CHARLESTON SOUTHERN**

Freshman **ARLON HARPER** drained a career-high five 3-pointers against Coastal Carolina on Saturday ... CSU tied a season-high with 13 threes against Campbell last Thursday. It was the third time this year the Bucs hit that many ... **SHELDON STRICKLAND** and **JEREMY SEXTON** each scored in double-figures in back-to-back games off the bench against High Point and Campbell.

**COASTAL CAROLINA**

Coastal finished last week 1-1 after playing two overtime games on the road. Coastal lost by five at Campbell last Monday before claiming a three-point win Saturday night at Charleston Southern ... Coastal battled back from a 12-point deficit at Campbell but failed to make a field goal in overtime in dropping its first Conference road game since February 2010 ... Coastal trailed by nine points against Charleston Southern but came back and won after **KIERRE GREENWOOD** nailed a 3-pointer in overtime to put the Chants ahead by two with less than 30 seconds to play. It marked the third-straight win on the road against the Bucs as well as the sixth-straight victory against CSU.

**GARDNER-WEBB**

Gardner-Webb will endure its busiest, and perhaps toughest, stretch of the Big South season this week, taking on the League's top-3 teams in the standings in five days -- with two on the road ... GWU has posted six of its eight wins in the past 10 games ... The 'Dogs did not record their eighth win of the 2010-11 season until February 5 and did not record win No. 7 until January 20 ... **JASON DAWSON** scored eight of his team-high 14 points in the final 32.4 seconds of regulation to send Saturday's game vs. High Point into overtime ... Gardner-Webb is 2-0 in overtime games so far this season.

**HIGH POINT**

High Point won its first two Big South games of the season last week, defeating Charleston Southern and Presbyterian ... The Panthers got their first road win of the season on Thursday at Presbyterian, a 63-57 victory. HPU has beaten Presbyterian five times in a row since **SCOTT CHERRY** became head coach ... **NICK BARBOUR** scored just seven points at Gardner-Webb on Saturday, his first single-digit scoring performance of the year ... **SHAY SHINE** averaged 19.3 points last week, scoring 22 points against both Charleston Southern and Gardner-Webb and 14 against Presbyterian. He shot 58.1 percent from the floor, 61.5 percent from beyond the arc and 87.5 percent from the free throw line in the three games.

**LIBERTY**

**JESSE SANDERS** needs 36 helpers to surpass **KARL HESS** (1977-80, 648 assists) for Liberty's all-time assist record ... Jesse Sanders is currently leading the Flames in points (12.8 ppg), rebounds (7.8 rpg) and assists (8.3 apg). He is one of eight players in the country leading his team in all three categories ... The last time Liberty started 0-5 in Big South play was the 1998-99 season, when the Flames finished 0-10 in Conference action ... **DAVID MINAYA** (599) needs one point to reach 600 for his Liberty career. **ANTWAN BURRUS** is 12 shy of 600 ... Since VMI joined the Big South in 2003-04, the Flames have won the opening meeting each season all but once (2005-06).

**PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE**

PC went 1-2 last week, dropping its second game in a row for just the second time this season ... The Blue Hose have not lost three in a row since a four-game stretch in early February of last year ... **AL'LONZO COLEMAN** has proven to be an important player in the success of the Blue Hose. In wins, he averages 19.1 points and 8.4 rebounds, and connects on 54.5 percent of his field goals. In losses, he is averaging just 11.8 points and 6.6 rebounds per game while making 43.5 percent from the floor ... The Blue Hose are exactly where they were last season after 16 games at 8-8.

**RADFORD**

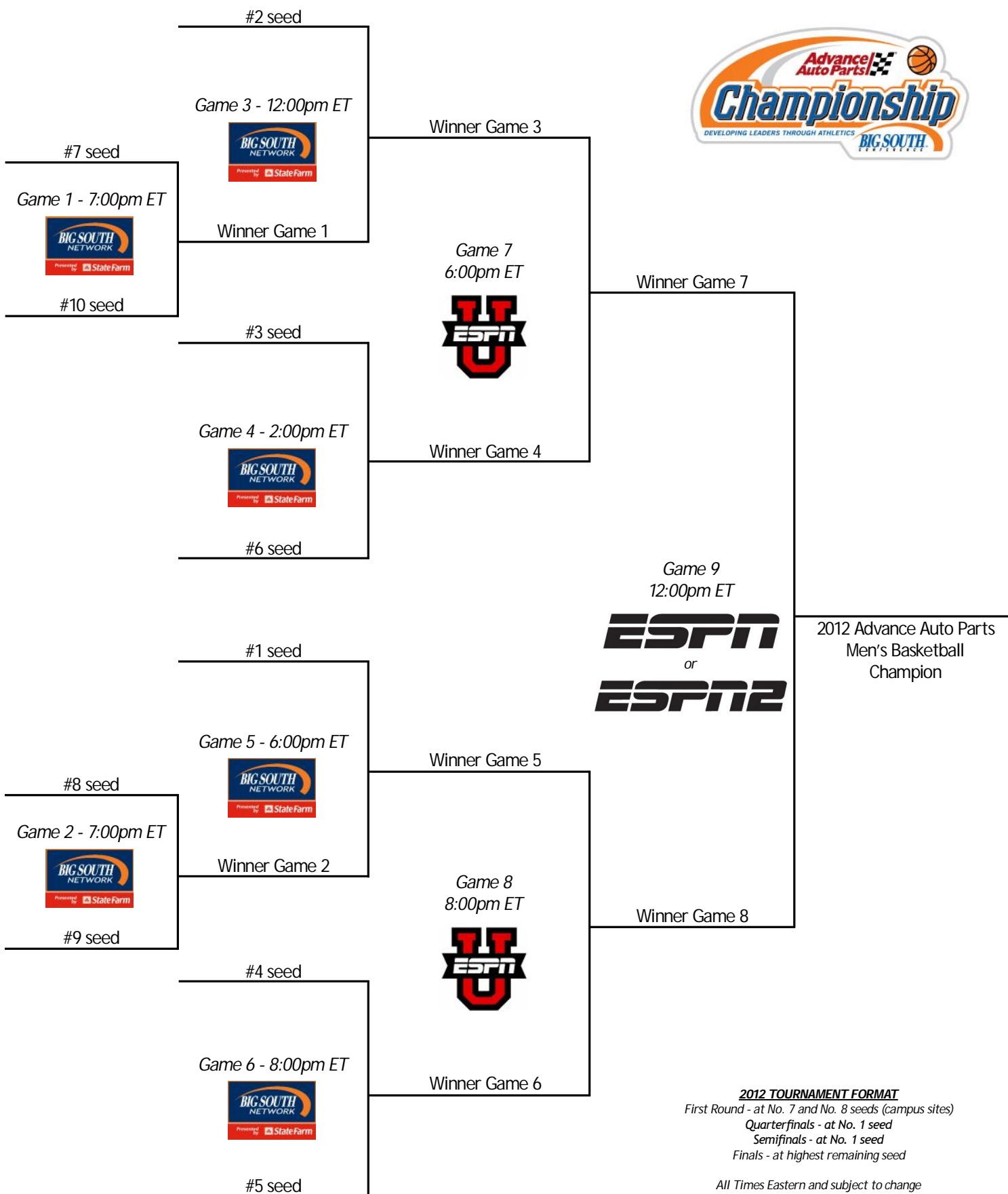
