**UNC ASHEVILLE WINS BIG SOUTH REGULAR-SEASON TITLE, EARNS NO. 1 SEED**

The 14-1 UNC Asheville Bulldogs has won the outright Big South regular-season championship and will be the No. 1 seed in the upcoming Advance Auto Parts Big South Men's Basketball Championship. It is the Bulldogs' first outright title since 1997-98 and the program's fifth overall League crown. As the No. 1 seed, Asheville will host the quarterfinals and semifinals of the Big South Tournament, and will have a chance to host the Championship game.

**EDDIE AND THE CRUISERS**

Asheville's regular-season crown marks the fifth under head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH**, the second-most by a head coach in Big South history. Former Winthrop leader **GREGG MARSHALL** won six regular-season titles during his nine years at the helm of the Eagles from 1998-07. Meanwhile, Biedenbach and the Bulldogs are assured of a postseason appearance (either NCAA Tournament or NIT) for the fourth time (currently at 2 NCAA, 1 NIT), which will be tied for the third-most by a Big South men's basketball program in League history.

**BYE, BYE, BYE**

The top six seeds earn automatic berths into the quarterfinals of the Advance Auto Parts Big South Men's Basketball Championship, and three squads have clinched first round byes -- regular-season champion UNC Asheville, Coastal Carolina and Campbell. Charleston Southern is one victory away from clinching a first round bye. Five teams -- Winthrop, VMI, Liberty, Gardner-Webb and High Point -- are vying for the final two automatic berths into the quarterfinals. The winners of the two first round games will secure the remaining spots in the quarterfinals.

**BARBOUR SHOP**

High Point senior guard **NICK BARBOUR** became just the seventh player in Big South history to score 2,000 career points when he surpassed the milestone this past Saturday at Charleston Southern. Barbour is seventh in League annals with 2,001 points, and based on his season average of 19.7 points, he is on track to finish his career with at least 2,080 points. **BIG SOUTH ON NATIONAL STAGE THIS WEEKEND WITH SEARS BRACKETBUSTERS**

The Big South's 11 SEARS BracketBusters match-ups this Saturday features the League's fifth appearance on national television during the series, as regular-season champion UNC Asheville will visit MAC member Ohio Saturday at 7:00pm on ESPN3. The Big South is 1-3 in its televised appearances in the event. The Big South is 8-16 all-time in the series and has the second-most Conference members participating of the 16 Leagues involved this season.

**BUC-ING THE TREND**

Charleston Southern won its 15th game of the season with its 70-67 win over High Point this past Saturday. It is the Buccaneers' second-straight 15-win season, marking the first time that CSU has won 15 games in consecutive campaigns since doing it three seasons in a row from 1994-95, 1995-96 and 1996-97. Meanwhile, the Buccaneers are one Big South victory away from their first 10-win Conference season since winning 12 League games in 1994-95.

**"BB&T BIG SOUTH GAME OF THE WEEK" RETURNS TUESDAY**

The "BB&T Big South Game of the Week" television package continues this week with Tuesday's VMI at Liberty game live on ESPN3 at 7:00pm. **PATRICK KINSAS** (play-by-play) and **NATE ROSS** (analyst) will call the action from Lynchburg.

**LIFE IS A HIGHWAY**

Radford's 58-54 win last Thursday at Gardner-Webb snapped a 29-game overall road losing streak (which included three neutral site games), a 26-game true road losing skid, and ended the Highlanders' 15-game losing streak in road Big South games.

**BEWARE OF THE DOG**

UNC Asheville is 8-0 in Big South road games, and has a chance to become just the third team in League history to go a perfect 9-0 in Conference contests away from home. The Bulldogs, which have won a school-record nine-straight regular-season Big South road games dating back to last season, play their final League road game Tuesday at Coastal Carolina. Asheville could join the 2008-09 Radford Highlanders and the 2010-11 Chanticleers in going 9-0 in Conference road games in a season.

**CONFERENCE TOURNAMENT APPROACHING**

The 2012 Advance Auto Parts Big South Men's Basketball Championship Tournament will commence on Monday, Feb. 27 with first round games at the home sites of the No. 7 and No. 8 seeds. The winners will advance to the quarterfinals that will be contested Wednesday, Feb. 29 at the No. 1 seed -- UNC Asheville, which will also host the semifinals and will have the chance to host the Championship game.

For the seventh consecutive season, the semifinals will be contested at the site of the No. 1 seed and will be broadcast live on ESPNU on Thursday, March 1. The highest remaining seed will host the Championship game on its home floor Saturday, March 3 at 12:00pm live on ESPN or ESPN2.

### DOING THEIR HOMEWORK

Of the last 26 Big South games, the road teams are 14-12 in that span to move to a 41.7 winning percentage on the season. The last time the road teams won at least 40 percent of the Big South games in a single-season was 2008-09 (46.7 percent). The last two seasons, the home teams won 62.2 percent of the time (56-34) in both 2010-11 and 2009-10. This season, the 49 home wins have been by an average of 10.27 points, while the 35 road victories have been by 6.23 points. Here is a look at each team's home and road record in Big South games, in current standings order:

### SEASON SWEEPS

With 31 Conference series in the books already, 16 have resulted in season sweeps (=51.6 percent). UNC Asheville leads the way with five, followed by Coastal Carolina (3). Last season, 24 of the 45 season series resulted in sweeps (53.3 percent), while 2009-10 had 28 (62.2) and 2008-09 had 26 (57.8).

### PEAK PERFORMANCE

UNC Asheville has won a school-record 14 Big South games, which is tied for the third-most League wins in Conference history. The Bulldogs are two away from tying the mark of 16 Big South wins, which was established last season by Coastal Carolina.

### BAND OF BROTHERS

Liberty brothers **JESSE** and **JOHN CALEB SANDERS** have combined to score 1,622 points during their respective careers with the Flames -- the fourth-highest scoring brother combination in Big South history. They are just 15 points away from moving into third-place. Jesse has 1,176 of the total, while John Caleb is at 446. Below are the Brothers Sanders with the top three combos:

### FROM THE LAND OF THREE

High Point senior **NICK BARBOUR** and VMI senior **KEITH GABRIEL** are poised to join the Big South's 300 three-point field goal club, which currently stands at six members. Barbour is tied for seventh all-time in League history with 296 career threes, while Gabriel is in 10th-place with 293 treys.

### FIVE-AND-DIME STORE

UNC Asheville senior guard **J.P. PRIMM**, who is the only player in Big South history with 400 career rebounds, 500 career assists and 200 career steals, is third on the Big South's all-time assists chart with his school-record total of 574. With at least five games remaining in the 2011-12 season, he has an outside chance of becoming the third player in Conference annals with 600 career assists -- needing to average at least 5.2 to reach that mark. Meanwhile, Primm remains seventh in Conference history with a school-record 232 steals.

### DISCOUNT DOUBLE CHECK

Campbell's **ERIC GRIFFIN** owns the Big South's longest active consecutive double-figure scoring streak at 19 games. Gardner-Webb's **TASHAN NEWSOME** is second to Griffin at 15-straight games scoring in double figures.

### LINE LEADERS

UNC Asheville's **MATT DICKEY** is sixth all-time in Big South history with 450 made free throws, just two away from moving into the fifth spot. High Point's **NICK BARBOUR** is seventh at 445, while Dickey's teammate **J.P. PRIMM** is currently 10th in the record books with 418 career free throws. Meanwhile, Dickey remains in third-place all-time in career free throw percentage at 83.8 (450-of-537).

**SPECIAL K**

Charleston Southern's **KELVIN MARTIN** became the fourth player in Big South history to grab 900 career rebounds when he surpassed the milestone this past Saturday against High Point. He needs 43 to move into third-place on the League's all-time list. Below are the Big South's all-time 900-rebounders:

1. 1,152 Joseph Harris, Coastal Carolina, 2005-10
2. 1,013 Arizona Reid, High Point, 2004-08

Meanwhile, Martin is one of three players in the Conference's record books with 1,000 career points (1,356), 900 career rebounds (912), 200 career steals (208) and 100 career blocked shots (111). The other two are Campbell's **JOE SPINKS** (1,711 - 954 - 220 - 155) and Coastal Carolina's **JOSEPH HARRIS** (1,444 - 1,152 - 205 - 142).

**50-50 RAFFLE**

Campbell ranks second nationally in field goal percentage with a Big South-leading 50.2 percent. Just five teams in Big South history have ever finished a season with a field goal percentage at or above 50 percent -- and not in the same year. The last Big South team to make at least 50.0 percent from the field in a season was Radford in 1993-94.

**REG-GIE**

Winthrop senior guard **REGGIE MIDDLETON** is five assists away from becoming the second player this season and 21st in Big South history with 400 career assists. He would be the fourth Winthrop Eagle in the Conference's 400-assist club, and the first since **CHRIS GAYNOR** surpassed the milestone in 2006-07.

**SPEAKING OF ASSISTS....**

Liberty senior guard **JESSE SANDERS**, who became the Big South's all-time assist leader Jan. 7 at UNC Asheville when he handed out his 604th career helper, has handed out 219 assists this season -- the third-highest single-season total in Big South history. He is six away from moving into second. Sanders's League-leading 8.11 assists this year is currently the second-highest assist average in a single-season in Big South history. The Conference record is 9.64, which was set by Charleston Southern's **TONY FAIRLEY** in 1986-87. Fairley also holds the Big South single-season assist record of 270 in '86-87.

**GOING CLUBBIN'**

**SAND BAR**

Liberty guard **JESSE SANDERS** is the only player in Big South history with 1,000 career points (1,176), 700 career rebounds (774) and 600 career assists (689). He is one of 21 Big South players with 1,000 points and 700 boards, and ranks 12th all-time in career rebounds -- needing 10 boards to move into the Big South's all-time Top 10. Meanwhile, Sanders is the only player in the nation averaging 7.0 rebounds (7.7) and 8.0 assists (8.11), and would become the first player in Big South history to do so in the same season.

**SENIOR MOMENTS**

UNC Asheville seniors **MATT DICKEY** and **J.P. PRIMM** have scored 15 points in the same game 26 times since arriving in Asheville in 2008-09, and the Bulldogs are 20-6 in those games. The duo has achieved this feat seven times in 2011-12 (6-1 record) after reaching the total 14 times in 2010-11.

**WELCOME MATT**

UNC Asheville's **MATT DICKEY** handed out his 400th career assist at Liberty Feb. 4, becoming the 20th player in Big South history with 400 career helpers. He is also one of five players in League annals with 400 assists (402) and 400 rebounds (426). The others in that group are Liberty's **JESSE SANDERS** (774 REB, 689 AST), Radford's **AMIR JOHNSON** (477 REB, 604 AST), UNC Asheville's **K.J. GARLAND** (428 REB, 520 AST) and **J.P. PRIMM** (431 REB, 574 AST).

Campbell freshman guard **TREY FREEMAN** is first in the Conference with an 88.2 free throw percentage, and is looking to become the first freshman to lead the Big South in free throw shooting since 1995-96 (UMBC's **ALHAMISI SIMMS**, 88.1) and the fourth overall. The Big South single-season record for highest free throw percentage by a freshman is 88.9 percent by UNC Greensboro's **SCOTT HARTZELL** in 1992-93.

## MOUNTAIN TOP

League-leading UNC Asheville has scored at least 80 points in a game 15 times this season, the most by the Bulldogs since 16 times in 1977-78. Earlier this season, Asheville scored at least 80 points in six-straight Conference games from Jan. 5-19, a first for the program. During that streak, the Bulldogs averaged 90.5 points, and scored 90 points in back-to-back Conference games for the first-time ever.

## BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

Presbyterian College's **KHALID MUTAKABBIR** and VMI's **MICHAEL SPARKS** each scored their 1,000th career point last week, doing so in the same game when the Keydets visited PC (Mutakabbir surpassed the milestone first). The backcourt tandem join twin brothers **CHAVIS HOLMES** (2,065) and **TRAVIS HOLMES** (1,733) in this elite group. The Brothers Holmes played together at VMI from 2005-09.

## HEIR APPARENTS?

As UNC Asheville's **MATT DICKEY** and **J.P. PRIMM** conclude their collegiate careers this season, Charleston Southern's freshmen backcourt of **SAAH NIMLEY** and **ARLON HARPER** are ready to replace the soon-to-be-departing Bulldogs as the Big South's top guard tandem. Nimley has scored 350 points (team-high 14.0 points per games), while Harper has tallied 319 markers (12.8 per game). By comparison, Dickey scored 338 points (10.9 average) and Primm had 280 (9.0 a game) as freshmen in 2008-09.

## THE BIG 5-0-0

VMI's **RON BURKS** became the seventh player this season and 67th in League history to grab 500 career rebounds as he surpassed the total last Thursday at Presbyterian. He joins teammate **STAN OKOYE**, Coastal Carolina's **SAM MCLAURIN**, Winthrop's **GEORGE VALENTINE**, PC's **AL'LONZO COLEMAN**, High Point's **COREY LAW** and UNC Asheville's **CHRIS STEPHENSON** among the 500-rebound club entrants this season. **CENTURY MARK IN HIS SIGHT**

VMI head coach **DUGGAR BAUCOM** is one win away from 100 victories at the Institute. He would become just the second coach in school history with 100 wins.

**IT'S ACADEMIC**

Coastal Carolina's **SAM McLAURIN** and Presbyterian College's **JAY REYNOLDS** have been named to the Capital One/CoSIDA Academic All-District IV First-team, and the two advance onto the national Academic All-America ballot. It is the first time since the 2008-09 season that at least two Big South men's basketball players earned Academic All-District accolades.

**ELDER STATESMAN**

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** won his 700th game as a collegiate head coach on Dec. 6 when the Chanticleers won 80-58 at The Citadel. Now in his 37th year as a head coach, Ellis stands 709-405 overall, including 97-56 ( =63.4 percent) in five seasons at Coastal Carolina. He is the eighth-winningest active head coach with 631 Division I wins (631-393 at the Division I level) and is 34th on the all-time Division I wins list -- two away from tying **HUGH DURHAM** for 33rd-place with 633. In addition, Ellis has directed four different Division I programs to at least two 20-win campaigns, and owns six seasons with at least 25 wins. He is three wins away from winning 100 games with his fourth different Division I program.

**STEADY EDDIE**

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** is the Big South's all-time winningest coach for overall wins (235) and Big South victories (142), and is now 264-290 in 18 years as a collegiate head coach. He became the school's all-time victory leader on Jan. 2 with his 224th win at the helm of the Bulldogs, passing **BOB HARTMAN** for the career record. Biedenbach won his 250th career game with the Bulldogs' 88-81 win over USC Upstate on Dec. 4.

**RADEBAUGH AND PEELE GET MILESTONE WINS ON THE SAME NIGHT**

Charleston Southern head coach **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH** collected his 100th career head coaching win with the Buccaneers' 91-73 victory over Campbell on Jan. 5. That same night, Winthrop's **RANDY PEELE** notched his 100th win as a Big South head coach. Radebaugh's career total includes 84 wins at CSU and 21 at Queen's University. Peele has now won 106 games as a Big South head coach -- 76 at Winthrop and 30 during UNC Greensboro's membership in the Conference.

**SPEAKING OF 100 WINS...**

Campbell head coach **ROBBIE LAING** won his 100th game as a collegiate head coach with the Camels' 81-75 win at Coastal Carolina last Tuesday.

**ALL IN**

The Big South Conference will utilize a new format for its postseason men's basketball Conference Tournament in 2012, as the 2012 Advance Auto Parts Men's Basketball Championship will feature all 10 eligible teams in the field as well as the quarterfinals and semifinals contested at the No. 1 seed -- the first single-site for both rounds since 2002. The 10-team field will be the largest in the event's history, and first round games will be contested for just the second time -- the last occurring in 1993. The Tournament will begin with two first round contests on Monday night, Feb. 27, with the No. 7 seed hosting the No. 10 seed, and the No. 8 seed hosting the No. 9 seed. The winners advance into the quarterfinals on Wednesday, Feb. 29 at the home arena of the No. 1 seed. The No. 7-10 winner will play the No. 2 seed and the No. 8-9 winner will face the No. 1 seed. The bracket appears on page 10 of this report.

**BIG SOUTH TIEBREAKING PROCEDURE**

While the Big South has 11 men's basketball members for the first time, the Conference is still utilizing an 18-game League schedule in 2011-12. Each team will play eight teams twice and two teams once.

A new tiebreaker procedure to address this unbalanced schedule is below and will be used to determine the seeding of teams for the Big South Tournament, if necessary.

**TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURE FOR SEEDING TWO-TEAM TIE**

(1) *Regular-season head-to-head results. If the tied teams split their two games, then proceed to Step 2 below.*

(2) *Win-loss record vs. Conference opponents occupying the highest position in the final regular-season standings in which the tied teams played an equal amount of times. Continue down through the standings until one team gains an advantage. If an advantage is not determined, proceed to Step 3.*

(3) *The team with the highest ranking on the most recent College Basketball RPI Report (or the NCAA's RPI listing). Note - the Conference office will research to determine which rating is most accurate/current.*

**TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURE FOR SEEDING MULTI-TEAM TIE**

(1) *Regular-season head-to-head results. If the tied teams split their two games, then proceed to Step 2 below.*

(2) *Win-loss record vs. Conference opponents occupying the highest position in the final regular-season standings in which the tied teams played an equal amount of times. Continue down through the standings until one team gains an advantage. If an advantage is not determined, proceed to Step 3.*

(3) *The team with the highest ranking on the most recent College Basketball RPI Report (or the NCAA's RPI listing). Note - the Conference office will research to determine which rating is most accurate/current.*

## TWENTY QUESTIONS

UNC Asheville is one win away from back-to-back 20-win seasons for the first time as Big South members. The last time the Bulldogs won 20 games in consecutive seasons was in 1982-83 and 1983-84. During its time in the Big South, Asheville has won 20 games three times -- 1985-86 (20), 2007-08 (23) and 2010-11 (20).

## ASHEVILLE'S 8-0 BIG SOUTH START FOLLOWING HISTORY'S SCRIPT

UNC Asheville's 8-0 Big South start matched its best-ever opening in League play that was first accomplished in 1997-98 -- **EDDIE BIEDENBACH**'s second season as head coach. A total of eight teams have started the Big South season at least 8-0 since 1985-86, and now including Asheville, all eight of those squads won the regular-season crown. Looking ahead, five teams that previously opened 8-0 went on to win the Conference Tournament title -- the last being Winthrop 2006-07, while the remaining two finished as Big South Tournament runner-up.

## CAUGHT IN A WEBB

Thirteen of Gardner-Webb's 15 Big South games this season have been decided in the final possessions. The Runnin' Bulldogs have won five of those Conference games by 2, 6, 4, 3 and 6 points (21 points combined, 4.2 average) while dropping eight contests by 6, 4, 2, 6, 2, 5, 4 and 4 points (33 points combined, 4.1 average). GWU's first 10 League games were decided by six points-or-less, and the Runnin' Bulldogs have suffered 12 of their 16 overall losses by single-digits.

## THIRTY SOMETHING

High Point senior guard **NICK BARBOUR** has recorded a League-high five 30-point games this season, the most in the Big South since former Radford center **ART PARAKHOUSKI** had five in 2009-10. The last Big South player with at least six 30-point games in a campaign was VMI's **REGGIE WILLIAMS** with 11 in 2007-08.

## MR. TRIPLE-DOUBLE

Liberty senior guard **JESSE SANDERS** recorded his fourth career triple-double Jan. 21 at High Point, becoming the first player in Division I history with a triple-double in four different years. He tallied 14 points, 13 assists and 10 rebounds against the Panthers, and owns four of the nine triple-doubles on record in Conference annals. Sanders recorded his first as a freshman against Presbyterian College on Feb. 9, 2009, his second during his sophomore year against Kentucky Christian on Dec. 12, 2009, and his third as a junior against Charleston Southern on Jan. 6, 2011.

## BOTH ENDS OF THE SPECTRUM

Of the 84 Big South games played this season, 54 have had winning margins of *LESS THAN* 10 points (=64.3 percent), with the average margin of victory in those 54 games being 5.04 points. The remaining 30 games that have been decided by at least 10 points had an average winning margin of 15.03 points. Overall, the 84 Conference games played thus far in 2011-12 have had an average margin of victory of 8.58 points. Last year, the overall margin of victory in League play was 10.48, while the 2009-10 average margin was 10.51 points and the 2008-09 League season was 8.96 points.

## MID-MAJOR MANIA

For the eighth consecutive season, the Big South has had a member ranked in the *Collegeinsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 poll, as Campbell was ranked No. 25 the week of Dec. 12 and Coastal Carolina was ranked No. 25 the week of Dec. 19. It was the Camels' first appearance in the 13-year-old ranking, and the third-straight season the Chanticleers were ranked in the poll. As a team, the Camels are just four rejections short of breaking the school record of 155 set a year ago.

**CHARLESTON SOUTHERN**

CSU has now attempted at least 20 three-pointers in five-straight contests, and made at least eight in seven consecutive outings ... Saturday's win over High Point marked the first time this season that CSU has won a game while shooting under 40 percent from the field ... **SHELDON STRICKLAND** came off the bench to knock down his first five shots in the loss to Liberty Thursday, and finished 7-of-8 for a season-high 17 points ... **MATHIANG MUO** set a career-high with 26 points in the win over High Point, and matched a single-game program record with eight three-pointers. High Point committed just seven turnovers in the win over Coastal Carolina on Thursday, HPU's second-best mark of the season ... HPU's win at Coastal Carolina was its first road win over the Chanticleers since 2006-07.

**LIBERTY**

**ANTWAN BURRUS'** 30-foot three-point buzzer-beater to give the Flames a 75-74 win over Charleston Southern last Thursday appeared at No. 2 on ESPN's SportsCenter "Top 10 Plays." The bucket, which was also featured on College Game Day, was the junior's first career made 3-pointer ... In its last five games, Liberty has shot 41.5 percent (22-of-53) from three-point range, while holding opponents to 29.5 percent (28-of-95). During the span, the Flames are also shooting 75.6 percent (65-of-86) from the foul line ... **JESSE SANDERS** is approaching Liberty's single-season assist record, which is currently 256 (**ED GOMES** in 1976).
