



TOAST TO THE COAST

Seven days after defeating LSU, Coastal Carolina won 60-59 at Clemson last Tuesday, marking the second-straight year that a Big South member has defeated an SEC team and ACC team in the same season. Presbyterian College did it last year in back-to-back games, as the Blue Hose won at Auburn on Dec. 18 and followed with a win at Wake Forest on Dec. 20. The Chanticleers are now the third Big South team in Conference history with SEC-ACC wins in the same campaign. The first was Campbell in 1993-94 when the Camels defeated North Carolina State and South Carolina.

BACK TO THE FUTURE

The Big South has recorded wins over the SEC, Big East and ACC during the first two weeks of the 2011-12 season, an accomplishment that has occurred just once previously in League history. The 1993-94 season was the first time the Big South Conference defeated an SEC, Big East and ACC team in the same year. Meanwhile, the Big South has now collected an SEC win five out of the last six seasons, an ACC win four out of the last five seasons, and a Big East win four out of the last eight seasons.

BUT WAIT, THERE'S MORE

This is the first time the Big South has ever posted wins over five of the six "BCS" Conferences, as Campbell's win at Iowa and UNC Asheville's victory over Utah give the Big South victories against Big Ten and Pac-12 members. It is the Big South's first-ever win over a Big Ten team, and the Conference's first win against a Pac-12 member since 1996-97.

HIGH FIVES

Coastal Carolina and Campbell both started the season 5-0 -- the first time in Big South history that two teams opened the season with five-straight wins in the same campaign. It also is the third time since 2007-08 that a Big South member opened the season at 5-0. The record for best start to a season is 8-0, which was established by the 1990-91 Radford Highlanders. Coastal's 5-0 overall start was its best as Big South members, while Campbell's 5-0 start was its best since joining Division I.

TIS THE SEASON... CONFERENCE SEASON!

The Big South Conference season begins this week with 10 games on the slate, as the Conference resumes its Thursday-Saturday playing format. It is the fourth consecutive season that the Big South is opening League play the first weekend in December. All but High Point and UNC Asheville will play two League games this week. VMI carries a five-game Conference win streak into this week's action, while UNC Asheville has won its last three Big South contests. Gardner-Webb has won its last two League games. Presbyterian College and Coastal Carolina each won their last regular-season Big South game of the 2010-11 season.

A QUICK LOOK BACK AT THE 2010-11 CONFERENCE SEASON

Of the 45 Conference series last season, 24 resulted in season sweeps (=53.3 percent). Coastal Carolina led the way with seven, followed by Liberty (5), UNC Asheville (3) and VMI (3). In 2009-10, 28 of the 45 season series resulted in sweeps (=62.2), while 2008-09 had 26 (57.8 percent).

UNBALANCING ACT

While the Big South has 11 men's basketball members for the first time, the Conference will still utilize an 18-game League schedule in 2011-12. Therefore, each team will play eight teams twice and two teams once. A new tiebreaker procedure to address this unbalanced schedule has been determined and will be posted in the Big South weekly report beginning Jan. 2, 2012.

LENDING A HELPING HAND

UNC Asheville senior guard **J.P. PRIMM** became the second player this season and 12th in Big South history to surpass 500 career assists when he eclipsed the milestone against Utah on Nov. 26. Primm is currently tied for 11th with 504 handouts. Meanwhile, Liberty senior guard **JESSE SANDERS** became the 11th player in Big South history with 500 career assists when he reached the milestone against Eastern Kentucky on Nov. 18. He is now eighth all-time in Conference annals with 520, and needs 24 to move into seventh-place. Sanders is 85 helpers shy of breaking the Conference's all-time record of 604, which was established by Radford's **AMIR JOHNSON** from 2006-10.

GIVE-AND-TAKE

UNC Asheville senior guard **J.P. PRIMM** has 504 career assists and 197 career steals, and is on the cusp of becoming just the fifth player in Big South history with 500 assists and 200 steals. Primm is set to join Winthrop's **CHRIS GAYNOR** (567 AST, 259 STL), Campbell's **BRAD CHILDRESS** (543-243), Charleston Southern's **ED O'NEIL** (504-241) and Coastal Carolina's **ROBERT DOWDELL** (561-239) in the club. Meanwhile, Primm could become the first player in Big South history with 400 rebounds, 400 assists and 200 steals. He needs 32 boards for 400 in his career.

MR. SANDMAN

Liberty senior guard **JESSE SANDERS** is 78 points away from 1,000 in his career, and he would be the 28th player in Big South history with 1,000 points and 600 rebounds. He would also be the first in the 1,000/600 club with 500 assists.

ELDER STATESMAN

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** is the eighth-winningest active coach with 619 Division I wins, and he enters this week three wins shy of 700 overall victories in his head coaching career. Ellis has directed four different Division I programs to at least two 20-win campaigns, and owns six seasons with at least 25 wins. He is now 619-385 at the Division I level following Coastal's 5-1 start to the 2011-12 campaign. Ellis stands 697-397 overall in 36 years as a head coach, including 85-48 (=63.9 percent) in five seasons at Coastal Carolina. He is 15 wins away from winning 100 games with his fourth different Division I program.

MARQUEE HOME OPPONENTS, ACT III

A Big South member will host another major Conference school in December when High Point entertains Wake Forest on Dec. 7, marking the third occasion of the 2011-12 season. UNC Asheville hosted then-No. 1 North Carolina on Nov. 13, and Coastal Carolina hosted LSU on Nov. 15.

MY FAVORITE MARTIN

Charleston Southern senior forward **KELVIN MARTIN** grabbed his 700th career rebound on Nov. 15 against Bluefield College, becoming the 20th player in Big South history with 1,000 points (1,057) and 700 rebounds. He currently ranks 13th in League annals with 727 career boards and needs 57 caroms to move into the all-time Top 10 rebounders. Meanwhile, Martin is 33 steals shy of 200 in his career, which would make him just the third player with 1,000 points, 500 rebounds and 200 steals. In addition, he needs 17 blocks for 100 and could eventually become one of three in Conference history with 1,000 points, 700 rebounds, 200 steals and 100 blocks. Stay tuned.

SAM I AM

Coastal Carolina redshirt-junior **SAM McLAURIN** is 18th in Big South history with 126 career blocked shots. He needs 37 rebounds for 500 in his career, and once he reaches the benchmark, he will be the 15th player in the Big South record books with 500 rebounds and 100 blocked shots.

STEADY EDDIE

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** is the Big South's all-time winningest coach for overall wins (219) and Big South victories (128). Biedenbach is two wins shy of 250 in his head coaching career, as he is 248-287 in 18 years as a collegiate head coach.

SPEAKING OF COACHING WINS...

Charleston Southern head coach **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH** is seven wins away from 100 in his career as a head coach, while VMI's **DUGGAR BAUCOM** is 10 wins away from 100 victories at the Institute.

SENIOR MOMENTS

UNC Asheville seniors **MATT DICKEY** and **J.P. PRIMM** have scored 15 points in the same game 20 times since arriving in Asheville in 2008-09, and the Bulldogs are 15-5 in those games. The duo had its first such game of 2011-12 in the Bulldogs' win over Utah on Nov. 26 after reaching the total 14 times in 2010-11.

GRFFIN IS BECOMING THE BIG SOUTH'S VERSION OF BIG-E

Campbell senior **ERIC GRIFFIN** currently leads the Big South in scoring (21.2 points), rebounding (10.0) and field goal percentage (74.2 percent). Although it is very early and much basketball is still to be played, the Big South has had just two players finish as the Conference's League leader in the three categories in one season. Throw in Griffin's Big South-best 2.83 blocked shots, and he would become the first player in Conference annals to lead the League in scoring, rebounding, field goal percentage and blocks.

2,000-POINT ODYSSEY?

High Point senior guard **NICK BARBOUR** is the Conference's active leading career scorer with 1,569 points, which ranks 22nd all-time in Big South history. He is 31 points away from becoming the 22nd player with 1,600 career points, is 199 points away from cracking the League's Top 10, and 431 points shy of becoming the seventh player in Conference annals with 2,000 points. He would need to average 17.96 points a game in the Panthers' 24 remaining regular-season games to reach the milestone. Barbour entered the season with a career scoring average of 16.9 points.

BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

VMI junior **STAN OKOYE** surpassed 1,000 career points in the Keydets' contest at Ohio State on Nov. 23, becoming the 106th player to reach the scoring milestone in Big South history. Liberty's **JESSE SANDERS** is next to reach the mark, as he needs 78 points for 1,000. Below is a look at the Big South's active 1,000-point scorers, as well as those closing in on the milestone:

THREE-FOR-ALL

VMI's **KEITH GABRIEL** has made 249 three-pointers in his career, good for 13th on the Conference's all-time list. He is six away from surpassing Winthrop's **LaSHAWN COULTER** (254 from 1990-95) for 12th-place. Gabriel needs 35 treys to crack the Big South's career Top 10, and 51 threes to become the seventh player in Big South history with 300 career three-point field goals.

CLASS ACT

Liberty senior guard **JESSE SANDERS** is one of 30 national candidates for the 2011-12 Lowe's Senior CLASS Award. To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence -- Community, Classroom, Character and Competition. The award focuses on the total student-athlete and encourages students to use their platform in athletics to make a positive impact as leaders in their communities. The 30 candidates will be narrowed to 10 finalists midway through the regular season, and those 10 names will be placed on the official ballot. Sanders is the Big South's first candidate since Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** in 2007-08.

BIG SOUTH TO MAKE SEVENTH APPEARANCE IN ESPN'S BRACKETBUSTERS EVENT

The Big South Conference will again participate in the SEARS BracketBusters event this season during the weekend of February 17-19, with a League-record 11 teams among the field of 142 -- the event's largest pool ever. All of the Big South's men's basketball programs are participating in the same year for the first time, and the Conference has the second-most members competing of the 16 Leagues involved this season. Five Big South teams will host a game while the remaining six members will play on the road. The Conference is 8-16 all-time in the BracketBusters, including two wins in 2006, 2007 and 2010. The Big South has also been selected for national television appearances four times in the past five years: 2007 (ESPN2), 2008 (ESPN2), 2009 (ESPNU) and 2011 (ESPNU).

CAMPBELL

Campbell is off to its best start ever at the Division I level after winning its first five games of the year ... The Fighting Camels won at Iowa, 77-61, on Nov. 23 to claim their second victory over a BCS Conference team in as many years ... Since joining Division I in 1977-78, Campbell had started the season with four victories only once (1987-88) before this year's club won its first five ... As a team, the Camels lead the Big South Conference and rank 2nd in the country in field goal percentage (.545) ... CU's 62.2% output at Iowa was its best-ever against a power-Conference team.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

CSU won its third-straight home game with a 73-64 win over Stetson on Nov. 21. The Bucs will look to make it a perfect 5-0 after this week, before hitting the road to play Florida State ... **MATHIANG MUO**'s 6-of-10 effort from three-point range against Stetson helped CSU shoot 63.6 from beyond the arc in the second half against the Hatters ... **KELVIN MARTIN** had 15 points, 10 rebounds and seven steals against Stetson.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina split a pair of road games last week that both ended in buzzer beaters. The Chanticleers defeated Clemson, 60-59 at Littlejohn Coliseum on Tuesday night. **CHRIS GRADNIGO** missed a jump shot but followed his own shot and tipped it in to give the Chants their first-ever win against Clemson. The play received the No. 1 spot on ESPN's "Top Plays" that night ... Coastal has now defeated two BCS schools (LSU and Clemson) in the same season, the first time in school history ... The Chanticleers were defeated on Saturday night on a buzzer-beating jump shot by Florida International, handing them their first loss of the season. Before the loss to FIU, Coastal was off to its best start (5-0) since the 1981-82 season when the Chants started 8-0 ... After the win against Clemson, Coastal was ranked eighth in the RPI according to CBSsports.com.

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb went 1-3 in the 2011 Hoosier Invitational, dropping two contests by six points-or-less ... GWU has held a lead at halftime in each of its last three games ... The Runnin' Bulldogs led 50-35 at two-time NCAA runner-up Butler on Nov. 23, marking the first time a team had scored at least 50 in a half against Butler since 2008-09 ... **MIKE BYRON** netted a pair of career-high games last week. He scored 16 points at Butler, then set a career-high with 18 points and 13 rebounds in the win at Chattanooga ... GWU has won two of its last three games against SoCon opponents, topping Western Carolina last season and preseason North Division favorite Chattanooga on Sunday.

HIGH POINT

High Point played two overtime games in a row last week for the first time in HPU's Division I era (since 1999-00). The Panthers are 6-2 in their last eight overtime games, dating back to a March 1, 2005 win over UNC Asheville. HPU had two overtime games last season and won both ... Three Panthers posted career-highs in the overtime win against The Citadel: **XAVIER MARTIN** scored 21 points to crush his previous best of 15; **COREY LAW** grabbed a season-high 15 rebounds to tie his career-high; and **TRAVIS ELLIOTT** grabbed a career-high 10 rebounds, besting his previous high of nine ... Martin and **NICK BARBOUR** combined to score all 15 of HPU's overtime points against the Citadel.

LIBERTY

The Liberty-Campbell series is tied at 9-9. The last time the two squads met was during the 2007-08 season, meeting twice in a two-week period. The Camels took the first meeting in Buies Creek, 73-70, on Dec. 15, 2007. Liberty avenged the loss on Dec. 28, defeating Campbell inside the Vines Center, 68-61 ... **JESSE SANDERS** was held to just three assists on Saturday against Georgia State. The floor general had just five games last season in which he garnered three assists or less ... Liberty is looking for its first win inside Kimbel Arena since Feb. 16, 2009, when it defeated the Chanticleers, 85-82.

PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE

The PC-Winthrop series has the Eagles holding a 11-10 advantage. After dropping seven-straight meetings, the Blue Hose won for the first time since 1986 with a 76-74 overtime win in the last game, Jan. 29, 2011 ... PC opened the series winning nine of the first 13 meetings, dating back to an 83-74 win on Jan. 25, 1979 ... The Blue Hose are 5-3 over Radford and have won the last two meetings.

RADFORD

JAREAL SMITH was named to the Basketball Hall of Fame Tip-Off All-Tournament Team ... The Highlanders have dropped 18 consecutive road games and 21-straight away from home.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville went 2-2 last week and finished 1-2 at the Battle "4" Atlantis Tournament in the Bahamas. The Bulldogs lost close games to No. 4 UConn (10 points) and College of Charleston (2 points) before roaring past Pac-12 foe Utah, 87-65 on Saturday night. The Bulldogs are now 2-1 all-time against teams from the Pac-12 ... **J.P. PRIMM** earned his 500th career assist against the Utes ... **MATT DICKEY** has scored in double figures in all seven games this year ... **JEREMY ATKINSON** filled in admirably for the injured **JARON LANE** with 14 points and nine rebounds vs. UConn and nine rebounds vs. College of Charleston.

VMI

Junior **STAN OKOYE** became the 36th player in VMI history to achieve 1,000 career points when he scored his first basket at Ohio State last Wednesday. Okoye finished the game with 12 points and six assists and one of his two dunks on the night was featured as ESPN's "Top Play" ... **KEITH GABRIEL** turned in his third 20-point game of the season with 21 points at Ohio State ... Sophomore **D.J. COVINGTON** has not played in the last four games because of injury.

WINTHROP
