



WELCOME MAT

The Big South's newest head coach -- Radford's **MIKE JONES**, picked up his first win as a collegiate head coach in his first game at the helm of the Highlanders with Radford's 58-54 home win over Delaware on Nov. 11. He joins current DePaul head coach **OLIVER PURNELL** as the only Radford head coaches to win their head coaching debuts. Purnell won his first five games leading the Highlanders in 1988-89.

STARTING AT THE TOP

UNC Asheville opened Kimmel Arena, its new 3,200-seat on-campus facility, this past Sunday in grand fashion -- hosting No. 1 North Carolina. It was the first time in Big South Conference history that a League member hosted the current national No. 1 ranked program, and the Bulldogs enjoyed a five-point first half lead before the Tar Heels prevailed.

SECOND BCS OPPONENT TO VISIT A BIG SOUTH ARENA THIS WEEK

A second member from a BCS Conference will play at a Big South venue in a three-day span, as LSU of the Southeastern Conference will play Coastal Carolina on Tuesday inside Coastal's Kimbel Arena. Last season, the Chanticleers defeated the Tigers, 78-69 in overtime in Baton Rouge.

LENDING A HELPING HAND

Liberty senior guard **JESSE SANDERS** is 11th all-time in Big South history with 489 career assists, and needs 11 to become the 11th player with 500. He is 116 helpers shy of breaking the Conference's all-time record of 604, which was established by Radford's **AMIR JOHNSON** from 2006-10. Meanwhile, UNC Asheville senior guard **J.P. PRIMM** is tied for 12th in League annals with 470 career assists.

GIVE-AND-TAKE

UNC Asheville senior guard **J.P. PRIMM** has 470 career assists and 188 career steals, and is on pace to become just the fifth player in Big South history with 500 assists and 200 steals. Primm is set to join Winthrop's **CHRIS GAYNOR** (567 AST, 259 STL), Campbell's **BRAD CHILDRESS** (543-243), Charleston Southern's **ED O'NEIL** (504-241) and Coastal Carolina's **ROBERT DOWDELL** (561-239).

ELDER STATESMAN

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** is the eighth-winningest active coach with 616 Division I wins, and he enters this week six wins shy of 700 overall victories in his head coaching career. Ellis has directed four different Division I programs to at least two 20-win campaigns, and owns six seasons with at least 25 wins. He is now 616-384 at the Division I level following Coastal's 2-0 start to the 2011-12 campaign. Ellis stands 694-396 overall in 36 years as a head coach, including 82-47 (=63.6 percent) in five seasons at Coastal Carolina. He is 18 wins away from winning 100 games with his fourth different program.

MY FAVORITE MARTIN

Charleston Southern senior forward **KELVIN MARTIN** is one of 27 players in Big South history with 1,000 career points (1,016) and 600 career rebounds (693). He needs seven boards to become the 20th player with 1,000 points and 700 rebounds. Martin is 44 steals shy of 200 in his career, which would make him just the third player with 1,000 points, 500 rebounds and 200 steals. Meanwhile, Martin has an outside chance of becoming the third Big South player in history with 1,000 points and 1,000 rebounds. Stay tuned.

STEADY EDDIE

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** is the Big South's all-time winningest coach for overall wins (216) and Big South victories (128). Biedenbach is five wins shy of 250 in his head coaching career, as he is 245-285 in 18 years as a collegiate head coach.

CLASS ACT

Liberty senior guard **JESSE SANDERS** is one of 30 national candidates for the 2011-12 Lowe's Senior CLASS Award. To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence -- Community, Classroom, Character and Competition. The award focuses on the total student-athlete and encourages students to use their platform in athletics to make a positive impact as leaders in their communities. The 30 candidates will be narrowed to 10 finalists midway through the regular season, and those 10 names will be placed on the official ballot. Sanders is the Big South's first candidate since Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** in 2007-08.

WELCOME BACK

The Big South welcomes back the return of charter member Campbell University in 2011-12, pushing the League's basketball membership to an all-time high of 11. The Camels were members of the Big South from 1983-94, and was the Conference's first-ever men's basketball automatic bid recipient to the NCAA Tournament with their 1992 League championship. Campbell went 129-128 in its first stint in the League, including 63-57 in Big South games and 9-8 in the Conference Tournament.

SPEAKING OF COACHING WINS...

Charleston Southern head coach **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH** is 10 wins away from 100 in his career as a head coach, while VMI's **DUGGAR BAUCOM** is 12 wins away from 100 victories at the Institute.

SENIOR MOMENTS

UNC Asheville seniors **MATT DICKEY** and **J.P. PRIMM** scored 15 points in the same game 14 times last season. The Bulldogs went 10-4 in those contests, with the losses coming at the hands of nationally-ranked North Carolina and Georgetown, as well as a two-point double-overtime loss at USC Upstate and a one-point setback against Northeastern in the SEARS BracketBusters. The duo has reached the 15-point threshold in the same game 19 times since arriving on campus in 2008-09, and Asheville is 14-5 in those games.

2,000-POINT ODYSSEY?

High Point senior guard **NICK BARBOUR** is the Conference's active leading career scorer with 1,500 points, which ranks 26th all-time in Big South history. He is 267 points away from cracking the League's Top 10, and 500 points shy of becoming the seventh player in Conference annals with 2,000 points. He would need to average 17.86 points a game in the Panthers' 28 remaining regular-season games to reach the milestone. Barbour entered the season with a career scoring average of 16.9 points.

BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

VMI junior **STAN OKOYE** is 45 points away from 1,000 in his career, as he has 955 points in 62 career games played. He would become the 106th player on the Conference's all-time list. Below is a look at the Big South's active 1,000-point scorers, as well as those closing in on the milestone:

MR. TRIPLE-DOUBLE

Liberty senior guard **JESSE SANDERS**, who is the only player in Big South history with 500 career rebounds (579) and 400 assists (489), owns three of the eight triple-doubles on record in Conference annals, including two of the five that have occurred in League games. He recorded his first as a freshman against Presbyterian College on Feb. 9, 2009, his second during his sophomore year against Kentucky Christian on Dec. 12, 2009, and his third as a junior against Charleston Southern on Jan. 6, 2011.

ROAD WORK AHEAD...

Coastal Carolina carries a school-record 10-consecutive Big South road game win streak into this season. The Conference record for most consecutive road League wins is 11, first set by Winthrop from 2004-06 and tied by Radford from 2008-10. The Chanticleers' first Big South road game this season is Dec. 31 at High Point.

BIG SOUTH TO MAKE SEVENTH APPEARANCE IN ESPN'S BRACKETBUSTERS EVENT

The Big South Conference will again participate in the SEARS BracketBusters event this season during the weekend of February 17-19, with a League-record 11 teams among the field of 142 -- the event's largest pool ever. All of the Big South's men's basketball programs are participating in the same year for the first time, and the Conference has the second-most members competing of the 16 Leagues involved this season. Five Big South teams will host a game while the remaining six members will play on the road. The Conference is 8-16 all-time in the BracketBusters, including two wins in 2006, 2007 and 2010. The Big South has also been selected for national television appearances four times in the past five years: 2007 (ESPN2), 2008 (ESPN2), 2009 (ESPNU) and 2011 (ESPNU).

CAMPBELL

Campbell set a Gore Arena record with a .609 team field goal percentage in Friday's season-opening 82-68 win over Houston Baptist. The Camels led by as many as 18 in the second half, then hit 11-of-12 free throws down the stretch to seal the win. **TREY FREEMAN** (22 points) and **ERIC GRIFFIN** (21 points, 9 rebounds) led the Camels in the victory ... Campbell is 5-1 in its last six season openers and has won six-straight home openers ... CU continues its three-game season-opening homestand Monday vs. East Carolina.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

CSU opened the season with two road games in the state of Kansas ... The Bucs were up by 15 against Big 12 power Kansas State at halftime, but struggled in the second half as the Wildcats came back to get the 72-69 victory ... Charleston Southern lost at defending NIT champion Wichita State on Sunday.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal improved to 29-10 all-time in home openers with wins over Covenant and Methodist last week ... **ANTHONY RAFFA** leads the team with 17.0 ppg, followed by **CHRIS GRADNIGO** (16.5) and **KIERRE GREENWOOD** (11.5) ... The team shot 55.4 percent from the field (77-139) in the two games ... Coastal hosts Southeastern Conference foe LSU on Tuesday.

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb split the opening weekend, falling at Clemson on Friday and winning Sunday at Lipscomb ... The Runnin' Bulldogs were tied with the Tigers at halftime, and were led by **LARON BUGGS'** 14 points and seven rebounds ... **JASON DAWSON** paced the Runnin' Bulldogs in the Lipscomb win with 18 points off the bench.

HIGH POINT

High Point opened the season with a win for the third time in a row with a 95-52 win over Bridgewater College on Saturday. It was the first-ever meeting between the two teams ... Six players scored in double-figures vs. Bridgewater, led by senior **SHAY SHINE**. Shine went 7-for-7 from the free-throw line, while sophomore guard **XAVIER MARTIN** went 4-for-5 from the floor and 5-for-5 from the line in the win ... Senior guard **NICK BARBOUR** ranks seventh all-time at HPU with 1,500 career points.

LIBERTY

Liberty will play William & Mary twice within a week, as the Flames travel to Kaplan Arena Monday night before hosting the Tribe on Sunday in the final matchup of the 2K Sports Classic benefiting Coaches vs. Cancer ... In Friday's 81-58 win over Randolph College, **JESSE SANDERS** finished just shy of his fourth career triple-double with 11 points, nine rebounds and eight assists. If Sanders is able to accomplish the feat this season, he will be the only player in Division I history to have at least one triple-double each of his four years in college ... **JOHN CALEB SANDERS** scored a career-high 18 points in the season opener at nationally-ranked Texas A&M.

PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE

The Blue Hose opened the season 1-0 for the first time since the 2006-07 season with their 103-73 win over Monmouth ... The 103 points was the most scored in a game for PC since a 111-51 win over Carver Bible College during the 2007-08 season.

RADFORD

JOHNATHAN EDWARDS (13.0), **JAREAL SMITH** (12.5) and **R.J. PRICE** (12.0) are averaging double figures for Radford through two games ... The Highlanders are looking to start 3-0 for the first time since the 2003-04 season and eighth time in school history ... Radford will play seven games in 13 days to open the 2011-12 campaign ... The Highlanders have eight new players on the 2011-12 roster, which includes three players with the last name "Smith" -- junior **BLAKE SMITH**, sophomore **JAREAL SMITH** and senior walk-on transfer **CHANCE SMITH**.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville opened the season with two losses against ACC teams ... The Bulldogs fell at N.C. State Friday night, 84-75 as they out-scored the Wolfpack in the second half, 48-40. **MATT DICKEY** led Asheville with 17 points ... Asheville opened its new on-campus arena, Kimmel Arena, with a 91-75 loss to top-ranked North Carolina. The Bulldogs led for part of the first half before the taller Tar Heels took control with their inside game. **J.P. PRIMM** led Asheville with 23 points, while **JARON LANE** added a career-high 21 points. Kimmel Arena was sold out as 3,280 fans filled the new arena.

VMI

The Keydets opened the season with a 103-100 win over The Citadel at the All-Military Classic in Colorado Springs. VMI fell to host Air Force, 75-65 on Saturday ... **KEITH GABRIEL** and **RODNEY GLASGOW** were named to the All-Tournament Team. Gabriel averaged 15.5 points in the two games, while Glasgow contributed 13.5 points and 4.5 assists.

WINTHROP

Winthrop opened the season with a Homecoming Day loss to Eastern Kentucky, 71-59. The contest was a return game from the 2010 BracketBuster. The Eagles opened with a quick 7-0 lead and held a 20-11 advantage just eight minutes into the contest, but scored just 39 points over the final 32 minutes ... ECU connected on 12-of-30 three-pointers, compared to Winthrop's 4-of-19 from beyond the arc ... **MATT MORGAN** had a team-high 14 points and 8 rebounds in the opener ... Winthrop meets Virginia on Tuesday night before the two teams head to St. Thomas, USVI for the 2011 Paradise Jam. The Eagles are 4-2 in their previous two appearances at the Paradise Jam as Winthrop finished third in 2004 and brought home the runner-up trophy in 2007. Winthrop will face No. 19/21 Marquette on Friday night, will play either Mississippi or Drake on Saturday, and will face a to-be-determined opponent on Sunday's final day.
