**FOUR-BYE-SIX**

The top six seeds earn automatic berths into the quarterfinals of the Advance Auto Parts Big South Men's Basketball Championship, and four squads have clinched first round byes -- regular-season champion UNC Asheville, Coastal Carolina, Campbell and Charleston Southern. Five teams -- Winthrop, Liberty, VMI, High Point and Gardner-Webb -- enter the final week of the regular-season still mathematically in contention for the remaining two automatic quarterfinal spots. The winners of the two first round games will secure the remaining spots in the quarterfinals. Radford is the No. 10 seed.

**THREE-BY-FOUR**

Campbell, Coastal Carolina and Charleston Southern are jockeying for seeds 2-4 in the Advance Auto Parts Big South Men's Basketball Championship. It will be the first time since 2003 that Charleston Southern will be seeded in the Top 4, as the Buccaneers were the No. 3 seed that season after being the No. 4 seed in 2002. Coastal Carolina will be a Top 4 seed for the third-straight year, and Campbell will be seeded in the Top 4 for the seventh time as Big South members.

**SAY YES TO THE JESS**

Liberty senior point guard **JESSE SANDERS** is the only player in Big South history with 1,000 career point (1,213), 700 career rebounds (793) and 700 career assists (700). With at least three games left in his career, he needs just seven rebounds to become what is believed to be the first NCAA Division I player to record 800 rebounds and 700 assists. He is already only one of five players to record 600 rebounds and 600 assists. Meanwhile, Sanders is believed to be the first NCAA Division I player to officially record 225 rebounds and 225 assists in a single-season (Assists became an official statistic in 1983-84).

**BARBOUR SHOP**

High Point senior guard **NICK BARBOUR**, who became just the seventh player in Big South history to score 2,000 career points when he surpassed the milestone Feb. 11 at Charleston Southern, is now sixth in League annals with 2,048 points and needs 22 markers to jump into fourth-place. Based on his season average of 20.0 points, Barbour is on track to finish his career with at least 2,088 points. Below are the Big South's all-time 2,000-point scorers:

**"BB&T BIG SOUTH GAME OF THE WEEK" CONCLUDES SATURDAY**

The "BB&T Big South Game of the Week" television package concludes this week with Saturday's Campbell at Liberty game live on MASN at 7:00pm. **MATT HOGUE** (play-by-play) and **NATE ROSS** (analyst) will call the action from Lynchburg.

**BUC-ING THE TREND**

Charleston Southern's 17 wins this season are the most since winning 17 in 1996-97, and the Buccaneers have won at least 16 games in back-to-back seasons for the first time since winning 21 games in both the 1985-86 and 1986-87 campaigns. CSU's 33 wins the past two seasons are the program's most in consecutive years since winning a combined 34 games in 1994-95 (19) and 1995-96 (15). Meanwhile, the Buccaneers have posted their first 10-win Conference season for the first time since going 12-4 in League games in 1994-95. Their 19 Big South wins the past two seasons are their most since winning 21 in the same span as above.

**20/20 VISION**

UNC Asheville and Coastal Carolina enter the final week of the regular-season with a chance to get to 20 wins. If the Bulldogs and Chanticleers are both successful, it would be just the fourth time in Big South history that two teams won 20 games prior to the Conference Tournament.

**TWENTY QUESTIONS**

UNC Asheville is one win away from back-to-back 20-win seasons for the first time as Big South members. The last time the Bulldogs won 20 games in consecutive seasons was in 1982-83 and 1983-84. During its time in the Big South, Asheville has won 20 games three times -- 1985-86 (20), 2007-08 (23) and 2010-11 (20).

**CONFERENCE TOURNAMENT IS NEXT WEEK!**

The 2012 Advance Auto Parts Big South Men's Basketball Championship Tournament will commence on Monday, Feb. 27 with first round games at the home sites of the No. 7 and No. 8 seeds. The winners will advance to the quarterfinals that will be contested Wednesday, Feb. 29 at the No. 1 seed -- UNC Asheville, which will also host the semifinals and will have the chance to host the Championship game.

For the seventh consecutive season, the semifinals will be contested at the site of the No. 1 seed and will be broadcast live on ESPNU on Thursday, March 1. The highest remaining seed will host the Championship game on its home floor Saturday, March 3 at 12:00pm live on ESPN or ESPN2.

### DOING THEIR HOMEWORK?

Of the 89 Big South games played thus far, the home team is 53-36 (=59.6 winning percentage), meaning the road teams own a 40.4 winning percentage. The last time the road teams won at least 40 percent of the Big South games in a single-season was 2008-09 (46.7 percent). The last two seasons, the home teams won 62.2 percent of the time (56-34) in both 2010-11 and 2009-10. Meanwhile, the 53 home wins this season have been by an average of 10.21 points, while the 36 road victories have been by 6.14 points. Here is a look at each team's home and road record in Big South games, in current standings order:

### SEASON SWEEPS

With 36 Conference series in the books, 16 have resulted in season sweeps (=44.4 percent). UNC Asheville leads the way with five, followed by Coastal Carolina (3). Last season, 24 of the 45 season series resulted in sweeps (53.3 percent), while 2009-10 had 28 (62.2) and 2008-09 had 26 (57.8).

### FROM THE LAND OF THREE

High Point senior **NICK BARBOUR** became the seventh player in Big South history to bury 300 career three-point field goals when he eclipsed the mark Feb. 14 against Radford. Liberty brothers **JESSE** and **JOHN CALEB SANDERS** have combined to score 1,677 points during their respective careers with the Flames -- the third-highest scoring brother combination in Big South history. ### PEAK PERFORMANCE

UNC Asheville has won a school-record 14 Big South games, which is tied for the third-most League wins in Conference history. The Bulldogs are two away from tying the mark of 16 Big South wins, which was established last season by Coastal Carolina.

### FIVE-AND-DIME STORE

UNC Asheville senior guard **J.P. PRIMM**, who is the only player in Big South history with 400 career rebounds, 500 career assists and 200 career steals, is third on the Big South's all-time assists chart with his school-record total of 582. With at least three games remaining in the 2011-12 season, he has an outside chance of becoming the third player in Conference annals with 600 career assists -- needing to average at least 6.0 to reach that mark. Meanwhile, Primm is seventh in Conference history with a school-record 238 steals and needs two to move into sixth.

## REG-GIE

Winthrop senior guard **REGGIE MIDDLETON** became the second player this season and 21st in Big South history with 400 career assists when he reached the milestone this past Saturday at Appalachian State. He is the fourth Winthrop Eagle in the Conference's 400-assist club, and the first since **CHRIS GAYNOR** surpassed the milestone in 2006-07.

## SPEAKING OF ASSISTS....

Liberty senior guard **JESSE SANDERS**, who became the Big South's all-time assist leader Jan. 7 at UNC Asheville when he handed out his 604th career helper, has handed out 228 assists this season -- the second-highest single-season total in Big South history. Sanders's League-leading 7.86 assists per game is currently the second-highest assist average in a single-season in Big South history. The Conference record is 9.64, which was set by Charleston Southern's **TONY FAIRLEY** in 1986-87. Fairley also holds the Big South single-season assist record of 270 in '86-87.

## SPECIAL K

Charleston Southern's **KELVIN MARTIN** became the fourth player in Big South history to grab 900 career rebounds when he surpassed the milestone Feb. 11 against High Point. He needs 25 to move into third-place on the League's all-time list. Below are the Big South's all-time 900-rebounders:

Meanwhile, Martin is one of three players in the Conference's record books with 1,000 career points (1,398), 900 career rebounds (930), 200 career steals (210) and 100 career blocked shots (112). The other two are Campbell's **JOE SPINKS** (1,711 - 954 - 220 - 155) and Coastal Carolina's **JOSEPH HARRIS** (1,444 - 1,152 - 205 - 142).

## DISCOUNT DOUBLE CHECK

Campbell's **ERIC GRIFFIN** owns the Big South's longest active consecutive double-figure scoring streak at 20 games. Gardner-Webb's **TASHAN NEWSOME** was second to Griffin at 15-straight games before being limited to nine points at Charleston Southern on Feb. 14. VMI's **STAN OKOYE** moves behind Griffin's streak at 14 consecutive double figure scoring games, just ahead of High Point's **NICK BARBOUR** and Radford freshman **JAVONTE GREEN** at 12 games each.

## LINE LEADERS

UNC Asheville's **MATT DICKEY** is fourth all-time in Big South history with 463 made free throws, while High Point's **NICK BARBOUR** is right behind in fifth at 462. Dickey's teammate **J.P. PRIMM** is currently tied for ninth in the record books with 420 career free throws. Meanwhile, Dickey remains in third-place all-time in career free throw percentage at 84.0 (463-of-551).

## FEBRUARY'S FINEST

High Point's **NICK BARBOUR** is the Big South's leading scorer in the month of February this season, as he is averaging 22.0 points in six games this month. PC's **AL'LOUNZO COLEMAN** is averaging a League-high 11.7 rebounds this month, the only player pulling down double-digit boards a game in February. Campbell's **ERIC GRIFFIN** is the League's top shooter thus far in the month of February, as he is making 62.2 percent of his field goals (28-of-45). Liberty's **JOHN CALEB SANDERS** is the top three-point shooter this month at 58.6 percent (17-of-29), while Campbell's **TREY FREEMAN** is tops from the charity stripe at 95.5 percent (21-of-22), just ahead of UNC Asheville's **MATT DICKEY** (95.1).

On the team side, UNC Asheville is making a Conference-best 84.1 percent from the free throw line this February, while Liberty is tops this month in field goal shooting at 49.5 percent and from beyond the arc with a 47.5 clip.

## TREY-LINER

Campbell freshman guard **TREY FREEMAN** is first in the Conference with an 87.7 free throw percentage, and is looking to become the first freshman to lead the Big South in free throw shooting since 1995-96 (UMBC's **ALHAMISI SIMMS**, 88.1) and the fourth overall. The Big South single-season record for highest free throw percentage by a freshman is 88.9 percent by UNC Greensboro's **SCOTT HARTZELL** in 1992-93.

## EDDIE AND THE CRUISERS

Asheville's regular-season crown marks the fifth under head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH**, the second-most by a head coach in Big South history. Former Winthrop leader **GREGG MARSHALL** won six regular-season titles during his nine years at the helm of the Eagles from 1998-07. Meanwhile, Biedenbach and the Bulldogs are assured of a postseason appearance (either NCAA Tournament or NIT) for the fourth time (currently at 2 NCAA, 1 NIT), which will be tied for the third-most by a Big South men's basketball program in League history.

## BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

The backcourt tandem join twin brothers **CHAVIS HOLMES** (2,065) and **TRAVIS HOLMES** (1,733) in this elite group. The Brothers Holmes played together at VMI from 2005-09.

## HEIR APPARENTS?

As UNC Asheville's **MATT DICKEY** and **J.P. PRIMM** conclude their collegiate careers this season, Charleston Southern's freshmen backcourt of **SAAH NIMLEY** and **ARLON HARPER** are ready to replace the soon-to-be-departing Bulldogs as the Big South's top guard tandem. Nimley has scored 358 points (13.3 points per game), while Harper has tallied 336 markers (12.4 per game). By comparison, Dickey scored 338 points (10.9 average) and Primm had 280 (9.0 a game) as freshmen in 2008-09.

## HEAD OF THE CLASS

Coastal Carolina's **SAM McLAURIN** and Presbyterian College's **JAY REYNOLDS** are members of the Capital One/CoSIDA Academic All-District IV First-Team, and the two advanced onto the national Academic All-America ballot. It is the first time since the 2008-09 season that at least two Big South men's basketball players earned Academic All-District accolades.

**100 COACHING WINS**

VMI head coach **DUGGAR BAUCOM** claimed his 100th coaching win as the Keydets' head coach with this past Saturday's victory over William & Mary. He is just the second coach in school history with 100 wins. Meanwhile, Campbell head coach **ROBBIE LAING** won his 100th game as a collegiate head coach with the Camels' 81-75 win at Coastal Carolina on Feb. 7. In addition, Charleston Southern head coach **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH** collected his 100th career head coaching win with the Buccaneers' 91-73 victory over Campbell on Jan. 5. That same night, Winthrop's **RANDY PEELE** notched his 100th win as a Big South head coach.

**ELDER STATESMAN**

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** won his 700th game as a collegiate head coach on Dec. 6 when the Chanticleers won 80-58 at The Citadel. Now in his 37th year as a head coach, Ellis stands 710-406 overall, including 98-57 ( =63.2 percent) in five seasons at Coastal Carolina. He is the eighth-winningest active head coach with 632 Division I wins (632-394 at the Division I level) and is 34th on the all-time Division I wins list -- one away from tying **HUGH DURHAM** for 33rd-place with 633. In addition, Ellis has directed four different Division I programs to at least two 20-win campaigns, and owns six seasons with at least 25 wins. He is two wins away from winning 100 games with his fourth different Division I program.

**STEADY EDDIE**

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** is the Big South's all-time winningest coach for overall wins (235) and Big South victories (142), and is now 264-292 in 18 years as a collegiate head coach. He became the school's all-time victory leader on Jan. 2 with his 224th win at the helm of the Bulldogs, passing **BOB HARTMAN** for the career record. Biedenbach won his 250th career game with the Bulldogs' 88-81 win over USC Upstate on Dec. 4.

**ALL IN**

The Big South Conference will utilize a new format for its postseason men's basketball Conference Tournament in 2012, as the 2012 Advance Auto Parts Men's Basketball Championship will feature all 10 eligible teams in the field as well as the quarterfinals and semifinals contested at the No. 1 seed -- the first single-site for both rounds since 2002. The 10-team field will be the largest in the event's history, and first round games will be contested for just the second time -- the last occurring in 1993. The Tournament will begin with two first round contests on Monday night, Feb. 27, with the No. 7 seed hosting the No. 10 seed, and the No. 8 seed hosting the No. 9 seed. The winners advance into the quarterfinals on Wednesday, Feb. 29 at the home arena of the No. 1 seed. The No. 7-10 winner will play the No. 2 seed and the No. 8-9 winner will face the No. 1 seed. The bracket appears on page 10 of this report.

**UNC ASHEVILLE WINS BIG SOUTH REGULAR-SEASON TITLE, EARNS NO. 1 SEED**

UNC Asheville won the outright Big South regular-season championship Feb. 11 and is the No. 1 seed in next week's Advance Auto Parts Big South Men's Basketball Championship. It is the Bulldogs' first outright title since 1997-98 and the program's fifth overall League crown. As the No. 1 seed, Asheville will host the quarterfinals and semifinals of the Big South Tournament, and will have a chance to host the Championship game.

**CAUGHT IN A WEBB**

Thirteen of Gardner-Webb's 16 Big South games this season have been decided in the final possessions. The Runnin' Bulldogs have won five of those Conference games by 2, 6, 4, 3 and 6 points (21 points combined, 4.2 average) while dropping eight contests by 6, 4, 2, 6, 2, 5, 4 and 4 points (33 points combined, 4.1 average). GWU's first 10 League games were decided by six points-or-less, and the Runnin' Bulldogs have suffered 12 of their 17 overall losses by single-digits.

**BIG SOUTH TIEBREAKING PROCEDURE**

While the Big South has 11 men's basketball members for the first time, the Conference is still utilizing an 18-game League schedule in 2011-12. Each team will play eight teams twice and two teams once.

A new tiebreaker procedure to address this unbalanced schedule is below and will be used to determine the seeding of teams for the Big South Tournament, if necessary.

**TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURE FOR SEEDING****TWO-TEAM TIE**

(1) *Regular-season head-to-head results. If the tied teams split their two games, then proceed to Step 2 below.*

(2) *Win-loss record vs. Conference opponents occupying the highest position in the final regular-season standings in which the tied teams played an equal amount of times. Continue down through the standings until one team gains an advantage. If an advantage is not determined, proceed to Step 3.*

(3) *The team with the highest ranking on the most recent College Basketball RPI Report (or the NCAA's RPI listing). Note - the Conference office will research to determine which rating is most accurate/current.*

**TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURE FOR SEEDING****MULTI-TEAM TIE**

(1) *Regular-season head-to-head results. If the tied teams split their two games, then proceed to Step 2 below.*

(2) *Win-loss record vs. Conference opponents occupying the highest position in the final regular-season standings in which the tied teams played an equal amount of times. Continue down through the standings until one team gains an advantage. If an advantage is not determined, proceed to Step 3.*

(3) *The team with the highest ranking on the most recent College Basketball RPI Report (or the NCAA's RPI listing). Note - the Conference office will research to determine which rating is most accurate/current.*

**MOVIN' ON UP**

Liberty and Presbyterian College are now the Conference's active leaders for most consecutive regular-season Big South road wins at three each. The Blue Hose will put their streak on the line this week, starting Thursday at Radford. The Flames will carry over their streak into the 2012-13 season.

**SENIOR MOMENTS**

UNC Asheville seniors **MATT DICKEY** and **J.P. PRIMM** have scored 15 points in the same game 26 times since arriving in Asheville in 2008-09, and the Bulldogs are 20-6 in those games. The duo has achieved this feat seven times in 2011-12 (6-1 record) after reaching the total 14 times in 2010-11.

**MOUNTAIN TOP**

League-leading UNC Asheville has scored at least 80 points in a game 15 times this season, the most by the Bulldogs since 16 times in 1977-78. Earlier this season, Asheville scored at least 80 points in six-straight Conference games from Jan. 5-19, a first for the program. During that streak, the Bulldogs averaged 90.5 points, and scored 90 points in back-to-back Conference games for the first-time ever.

**THE BIG 500-0**

For the eighth consecutive season, the Big South has had a member ranked in the *Collegeinsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 poll, as Campbell was ranked No. 25 the week of Dec. 12 and Coastal Carolina was ranked No. 25 the week of Dec. 19. It was the Camels' first appearance in the 13-year-old ranking, and the third-straight season the Chanticleers were ranked in the poll. **CAMPBELL**

**TREY FREEMAN** saw his single-season school record of 35-straight made free throws end on Saturday at Northwestern State, but he has made 38 of his last 39 (97.4) ... **DARREN WHITE** (490) and **ERIC GRIFFIN** (469) are on pace to become the first Fighting Camel teammates to score 500 points in a season since 1976-77 ... Griffin has already broken his own school record for blocks in a season (65) and on Saturday set a school senior class mark with 249 rebounds ... White is just six points shy of breaking **MARK MOCNIK**'s junior class scoring record (495 in 1991-92) ... CU enters the final week of the regular-season with the opportunity to break the school record for Big South wins in a year (12 in 1993-94).

**CHARLESTON SOUTHERN**

The Bucs have held three-straight opponents below 43.0 field goal shooting during their current winning streak. CSU held Gardner-Webb to 37 percent shooting in the second half, and then held Wofford to a 32 percent mark in the first half ... Against Gardner-Webb, CSU used a 28-11 game-ending run to erase a 47-45 deficit. **MATHIANG MUO** pumped in 21 points. **SAAH NIMLEY** did not score for the first time this season in the game ... **PAUL GOMBWER** notched his second career double-double and second in three games in the win over Gardner-Webb, as he grabbed 10 rebounds and set a career-high with 14 points.

**COASTAL CAROLINA**

Coastal split a pair of home games last week. The Chants broke a three-game losing streak against first-place Asheville on Tuesday night, 74-69. Coastal held the seventh-ranked shooting team in the country to 25 percent shooting in the first half to build a 15-point lead at the break. Asheville would rally and pull within one but the Chants went 9-of-10 from the foul line in the second half to knock off the Bulldogs for the first time in the last four attempts ... On Saturday against Tennessee Tech, the Chants lost a 15-point first half lead and would trail by 16 midway through the second half.

**GARDNER-WEBB**

Gardner-Webb won its first ever BracketBusters game, edging Delaware State, 57-56 this past Saturday. Gardner-Webb had gone 0-3 in the previous three games. Center **MIKE BYRON** had a career-high nine offensive rebounds vs. Delaware State, and finished with 10 points and 12 rebounds in a fine performance in the paint. Delaware State entered the game on an eight-game win streak and just a half game out of first in the MEAC standings ... Last Tuesday's loss at Charleston Southern marked the first time all season that no Gardner-Webb player scored in double figures.

**HIGH POINT**

**NICK BARBOUR** has scored more than 20 points in each of the last three games and has scored over 20 points 47 times in his career. He is averaging 23.2 points over the last five games. Meanwhile, Barbour (2,048 points) is 21 points behind HPU's No. 2 career scorer and Division I scoring leader, **ARIZONA REID**, who scored 2,069 points from 2004-08 ... High Point has at least one win over six of the seven Big South opponents it has faced twice this season ... The Panthers' game at Stephen F. Austin was the first time HPU faced a member of the Southland Conference and the first time HPU men's basketball played in Texas.

**LIBERTY**

**JESSE SANDERS** has 228 assists on the season, setting a Liberty record for more assists as a senior. Sanders' mark surpasses **TEEJAY BANNISTER**, who collected 224 dimes in 2008. The Sugar Land, Texas native need 28 more to set the Liberty single-season assist record, which is currently held by **ED GOMES** (256, 1976) ... Liberty shot 46.9 percent from the field at Morgan State, ending a three-game streak of shooting 56.0 percent or better.

**PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE**

**AL'LONZO COLEMAN** is just 52 points away from reaching 1,500 career-points ... Coleman and **KHALID MUTAKABBIR** have proven to be important players in the success of the Blue Hose. In wins, they average 33.0 points and 13.4 rebounds per game. That is almost half of the team's scoring average of 71.0 and rebounding average of 31.3 ... With the 67-48 loss at Jacksonville State, the Blue Hose drop to 1-2 in BracketBuster games ... PC embarks on its final road trip of the season with games at Radford on Thursday and at Gardner-Webb on Saturday.

**RADFORD**

Radford improved to 2-1 all-time in BracketBusters matchups with its win over Binghamton Saturday ... The Highlanders will conclude their regular-season with home contests against Presbyterian and Charleston Southern ... Freshman **JAVONTE GREEN** has hit the 10-point plateau in 12-straight contests, while recording four double-doubles and three 20-point efforts. Green leads all Big South freshmen in rebounding and double-doubles (7) ... Fellow freshman **R.J. PRICE** is looking to become just the second frosh in school history to lead the team in scoring.

**UNC ASHEVILLE**

The Bulldogs had a tough week with two road losses. Asheville lost at Coastal Carolina, 74-69 as the Bulldogs were denied a chance to go unbeaten on the road in Big South play, finishing the season with an 8-1 road record in League games -- the best mark in school history ... The Bulldogs fell at Ohio in the BracketBuster series, 81-62. **MATT DICKEY** moved into third-place on Asheville's career scoring list.

**VMI**

With Saturday's 73-65 win over William & Mary, **DUGGAR BAUCOM** became only the second VMI head basketball coach in school history to net 100 wins and is second-place behind only **BART BELLAIRS** (116 wins from 1995-05) ... VMI is 9-1 this season when leading at halftime ... **KEITH GABRIEL** recorded his 200th career steal Saturday and stands fourth all-time at VMI ... Freshman **JARID WATSON** blocked a career-high four shots in the first half of Saturday's William & Mary game. For the game, it was the first time VMI notched double-figure blocks this season and was the first since blocking 13 Southern Virginia shots on Nov. 23, 2010 ... VMI has now posted 11-win seasons at home each of the last two years.

**WINTHROP**

Winthrop lost its final home game to Presbyterian College on Senior Night followed by a loss at Appalachian State in BracketBusters. It was Winthrop's third-straight BracketBusters loss as the Eagles fall to 3-4 in seven appearances ... **MATT MORGAN** continued his late season surge as he scored in double-figures in both games, including a career-high 22 points on 10-of-14 shooting at ASU. The 6-9 senior has now scored in double-figures in 7-straight games and has averaged 13.9 points during that stretch ... Leading scorer **ANDRE JONES** had a tough week as he scored four points in each game ... Point guard **REGGIE MIDDLETON** reached 400 assists in his career and is now one of five players in Winthrop history to score 1,000 points and have 400 assists.
