ASHEVILLE, COASTAL FIRST TO CLINCH FIRST ROUND BYES

UNC Asheville and Coastal Carolina have each clinched first round byes in the upcoming Advance Auto Parts Big South Men's Basketball Championship. The top six seeds earn automatic berths into the quarterfinals, with the bottom four seeds playing in the first round. The two winners secure the remaining spots in the quarterfinals.

15-FOOTERS

Campbell won its 15th game of the season with its 62-57 win over Charleston Southern last Thursday. It is the Camels' first 15-win season since winning 19 games in 2009-10, and marks the sixth time that Campbell has won 15 games in a campaign as Big South members. Meanwhile, Charleston Southern is one victory away from back-to-back 15-win seasons, a feat last accomplished from 1995-97.

ASHEVILLE'S BAKER'S DOZEN

UNC Asheville has won a school-record 13 Big South games, which is tied for the fourth-most League wins in Conference history. The Bulldogs are three away from tying the mark of 16 Big South wins, which was established last season by Coastal Carolina.

TEN-TAMOUNT

Coastal Carolina has won at least 10 Big South games for the third consecutive season, which marks the first the time Chanticleers have achieved this three-peat in school history. Meanwhile, Campbell is one League victory away from its first 10-win Big South season since 1993-94 (and fourth overall), while Charleston Southern needs two Conference victories for its first 10-win League campaign since 1994-95, and its third overall.

THIRTY SOMETHING

High Point senior guard **NICK BARBOUR** has recorded a League-high five 30-point games this season, the most in the Big South since former Radford center **ART PARAKHOUSKI** had five in 2009-10. Meanwhile, in his last three games, Barbour is 13-of-20 (=65.0) from three-point range to increase his season percentage to 50.6 from beyond the arc. No player in Big South history has ever shot 50 percent from three-point range in a single-season.

BEWARE OF THE DOG

UNC Asheville is 8-0 in Big South road games, and has a chance to become just the third team in League history to go a perfect 9-0 in Conference contests away from home. The Bulldogs, which have won a school-record nine-straight regular-season Big South road games dating back to last season, play their final League road game Tuesday, Feb. 14 at Coastal Carolina. Asheville could join the 2008-09 Radford Highlanders and the 2010-11 Chanticleers in going 9-0 in Conference road games in a season.

DOING THEIR HOMEWORK

Of the last 15 Big South games, the road teams are 9-6 in that span to move to a 41.1 winning percentage on the season. The last time the road teams won at least 40 percent of the Big South games in a single-season was 2008-09 (46.7 percent). The last two seasons, the home teams won 62.2 percent of the time (56-34) in both 2010-11 and 2009-10. This season, the 43 home wins have been by an average of 9.74 points, while the 30 road victories have been by 6.30 points. CAUGHT IN A WEBB

Twelve of Gardner-Webb's 13 Big South games this season have been decided in the final possessions. The Runnin' Bulldogs have won five of those Conference games by 2, 6, 4, 3 and 6 points (21 points combined, 4.2 average) while dropping seven contests by 6, 4, 2, 6, 2, 5 and 4 points (29 points combined, 4.1 average). GWU's first 10 League games were decided by six points-or-less, and the Runnin' Bulldogs have suffered 11 of their 15 overall losses by single-digits.

CONFERENCE TOURNAMENT APPROACHING

The 2012 Advance Auto Parts Big South Men's Basketball Championship Tournament will commence on Monday, Feb. 27 with first round games at the home sites of the No. 7 and No. 8 seeds. The winners will advance to the quarterfinals that will be contested Wednesday, Feb. 29 at the No. 1 seed -- which will again have the chance to host throughout the Tournament.

For the seventh consecutive season, the semifinals will be contested at the site of the No. 1 seed and will be broadcast live on ESPNU on Thursday, March 1. The highest remaining seed will host the Championship game on its home floor Saturday, March 3 at 12:00pm live on ESPN or ESPN2.

BARBOUR SHOP

High Point senior guard **NICK BARBOUR** is three points away from moving into seventh-place on the Big South's all-time scoring list. He enters this week with 1,966 career points, and is 34 points shy of becoming the seventh player in Conference annals with 2,000 points. Based on his season average of 19.9 points, he is on track to reach the milestone this week in the Panthers' Feb. 11 game at Charleston Southern. Here is the Big South's Top 10 all-time scorers:

WELCOME MATT

UNC Asheville's **MATT DICKEY** handed out his 400th career assist this past Saturday at Liberty, becoming the 20th player in Big South history with 400 career helpers. In the process, he became just the fifth player in League annals with 400 assists (400) and 400 rebounds (424). The others in that group are Liberty's **JESSE SANDERS** (763 REB, 670 AST), Radford's **AMIR JOHNSON** (477 REB, 604 AST), UNC Asheville's **K.J. GARLAND** (428 REB, 520 AST) and **J.P. PRIMM** (428 REB, 569 AST).

BIG AL

Presbyterian College redshirt-senior **AL' LONZO COLEMAN** officially entered the Big South's 1,000-point club last week. Coleman, who scored 337 points as a true freshman in 2007-08 prior to PC officially joining the Big South in 2008, has scored 1,045 points during his Big South tenure and 1,382 points in his collegiate career at Presbyterian.

FIVE-AND-DIME STORE

UNC Asheville senior guard **J.P. PRIMM**, who is the only player in Big South history with 400 career rebounds, 500 career assists and 200 career steals, moved into third-place on the Big South's all-time assists chart following his two games last week. His school-record total now stands at 569, and with at least six games remaining in the 2011-12 season, he has an outside chance of becoming the third player in Conference annals with 600 career assists. Primm remains seventh in Conference history with a school-record 230 steals.

GOING CLUBBIN'

UNC Asheville's **CHRIS STEPHENSON** grabbed his 500th career rebound this past Saturday at Liberty, and is now one of five active Big South players with 1,000 points and 500 rebounds. Here are the five:

LINE LEADERS

High Point's **NICK BARBOUR** and UNC Asheville's **MATT DICKEY** are both tied for sixth in Big South history with 440 made free throws. They are 12 away from moving into the Top 5. Dickey's teammate **J.P. PRIMM** is currently 10th in the record books with 415 career free throws. Meanwhile, Dickey remains in third-place all-time in career free throw percentage at 83.5 (440-of-527).

FROM THE LAND OF THREE

High Point senior **NICK BARBOUR** and VMI senior **KEITH GABRIEL** are poised to join the Big South's 300 three-point field goal club, which currently stands at six members. Barbour is 10th all-time in League history with 288 career threes, while Gabriel is right behind him in 11th-place with 287 treys. Meanwhile, UNC Asheville's **J.P. PRIMM** is 11 three-pointers away from 200, which would make him the 30th player in Big South history with 200 career treys. VMI's **MICHAEL SPARKS** surpassed the mark earlier this season as the 29th player to accomplish this feat.

BIG SOUTH'S BRACKETBUSTERS OPPONENTS REVEALED; UNC ASHEVILLE GETS TV GAME

The official 2012 SEARS BracketBusters match-ups were unveiled Monday evening, Jan. 30, and for the fifth time in the Big South's seven years of participation, a League member has received a television slot. UNC Asheville will visit MAC member Ohio on Saturday, Feb. 18, live on ESPN3 at 7:00pm. All of the Big South's men's basketball programs are participating in the same year for the first time, and the Conference has the second-most members competing of the 16 Leagues involved this season. The Conference is 8-16 all-time in the BracketBusters, including two wins in 2006, 2007 and 2010. The 2012 match-ups are below.

50-50 RAFFLE

Coastal Carolina ranks second nationally in field goal percentage with a Big South-leading 50.1 percent. Campbell is on the cusp of the 50 percent threshold, as the Camels enter the week at 49.9 percent as a team. Just five teams in Big South history have ever finished a season with a field goal percentage at or above 50 percent -- and not in the same year. The last Big South team to make at least 50.0 percent from the field in a season was Radford in 1993-94.

SPECIAL K

Charleston Southern's **KELVIN MARTIN** is fourth all-time in League history with 889 career rebounds, and is 11 away from becoming the fourth player with 900. Below are the Big South's all-time leading rebounders:

The other two are Campbell's **JOE SPINKS** (1,711 - 954 - 220 - 155) and Coastal Carolina's **JOSEPH HARRIS** (1,444 - 1,152 - 205 - 142).

BAND OF BROTHERS

Liberty brothers **JESSE** and **JOHN CALEB SANDERS** have combined to score 1,561 points during their respective careers with the Flames -- the fourth-highest scoring brother combination in Big South history. SENIOR MOMENTS

UNC Asheville seniors **MATT DICKEY** and **J.P. PRIMM** have scored 15 points in the same game 26 times since arriving in Asheville in 2008-09, and the Bulldogs are 20-6 in those games. The duo has achieved this feat seven times in 2011-12 (6-1 record) after reaching the total 14 times in 2010-11.

DISCOUNT DOUBLE CHECK

Campbell's **ERIC GRIFFIN** owns the Big South's longest active consecutive double-figure scoring streak at 17 games. Gardner-Webb's **TASHAN NEWSOME** is second to Griffin at 13-straight games scoring in double figures.

SAND BAR

Liberty guard **JESSE SANDERS** is the only player in Big South history with 1,000 career points (1,138), 700 career rebounds (763) and 600 career assists (670). He is one of 21 Big South players with 1,000 points and 700 boards, and ranks 12th all-time in career rebounds -- needing 23 boards to move into the Big South's all-time Top 10. Meanwhile, Sanders is the only player in the nation averaging 7.0 rebounds (7.9) and 8.0 assists (8.0), and would become the first player in Big South history to do so in the same season.

SAND CASTLE

Liberty senior guard **JESSE SANDERS**, who became the Big South's all-time assist leader Jan. 7 at UNC Asheville when he handed out his 604th career helper, has handed out 200 assists this season -- just the seventh 200-assist season in Big South history. Sanders's League-leading 8.00 assists this season is currently the second-highest assist average in a single-season in Big South history. The Conference record is 9.64, which was set by Charleston Southern's **TONY FAIRLEY** in 1986-87. Fairley also holds the Big South single-season assist record of 270 in '86-87.

TREY-LINER

Campbell freshman guard **TREY FREEMAN** is first in the Conference with an 87.5 free throw percentage, and is looking to become the first freshman to lead the Big South in free throw shooting since 1995-96 (UMBC's **ALHAMISI SIMMS**, 88.1) and the fourth overall. The Big South single-season record for highest free throw percentage by a freshman is 88.9 percent by UNC Greensboro's **SCOTT HARTZELL** in 1992-93.

GREEN MACHINE

Radford freshman forward **JAVONTE GREEN** is the top freshman rebounder in the Big South with 6.9 to rank eighth in the Conference. Since Jan. 12, Green is averaging 17.1 points and 8.8 rebounds in the eight-game span, and has made 50-of-91 from the field (=54.9 percent). Included in this stretch are three 20-point games, three double-doubles and two games with 20 points and 10 rebounds.

MOUNTAIN TOP

League-leading UNC Asheville has scored at least 80 points in a game 14 times this season, the most by the Bulldogs since 16 times in 1977-78. Earlier this season, Asheville scored at least 80 points in six-straight Conference games from Jan. 5-19, a first for the program. During that streak, the Bulldogs averaged 90.5 points, and scored 90 points in back-to-back Conference games for the first-time ever.

BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

Presbyterian College's **AL'ONZO COLEMAN** became the seventh player this season and 111th in League history to score 1,000 career points in the Big South when he surpassed the milestone last week. Teammate **KHALID MUTAKABBIR** (999) and VMI's **MICHAEL SPARKS** (998) are very likely to join the club this week. Below is a look at the Big South's active 1,000-point scorers (currently 11):

UNC Asheville senior guards **MATT DICKEY** (1,652) and **J.P. PRIMM** (1,559) are just the second pair of four-year teammates in Big South history to each score more than 1,500 career points. The backcourt tandem join twin brothers **CHAVIS HOLMES** (2,065) and **TRAVIS HOLMES** (1,733) in this elite group. The Brothers Holmes played together at VMI from 2005-09.

HEIR APPARENTS?

As UNC Asheville's **MATT DICKEY** and **J.P. PRIMM** conclude their collegiate careers this season, Charleston Southern's freshmen backcourt of **SAAH NIMLEY** and **ARLON HARPER** are ready to replace the soon-to-be-departing Bulldogs as the Big South's top guard tandem. Nimley is averaging a team-high 14.3 points, while Harper is contributing 13.2 points a game this season. By comparison, Dickey averaged 10.9 points and Primm scored 9.0 a game as freshmen in 2008-09.

BE MY VALENTINE

Winthrop redshirt-senior **GEORGE VALENTINE** became the 37th player in Big South history with 600 career rebounds when he eclipsed the milestone Jan. 28 against High Point. He is the sixth Winthrop Eagle among the Conference's all-time rebounders with at least 600, and is nine blocked shots away from becoming the 13th player in League history with 600 rebounds and 100 blocks. Meanwhile, Coastal Carolina's **SAM MCLAURIN** is 10 rebounds away from the 600 rebound-100 block club. He currently owns 590 boards and 149 rejections.

CENTURY MARK IN THEIR SIGHTS

Campbell head coach **ROBBIE LAING** needs one win for 100 in his collegiate head coaching career, and VMI head coach **DUGGAR BAUCOM** is one win away from 100 victories at the Institute.

IT'S ACADEMIC

Coastal Carolina's **SAM McLAURIN** and Presbyterian College's **JAY REYNOLDS** were named to the Capital One/CoSIDA Academic All-District IV First-team last week. The two advance onto the national Academic All-America ballot. It is the first time since the 2008-09 season that at least two Big South men's basketball players earned Academic All-District accolades.

ALL IN

The Big South Conference will utilize a new format for its postseason men's basketball Conference Tournament in 2012, as the 2012 Advance Auto Parts Men's Basketball Championship will feature all 10 eligible teams in the field as well as the quarterfinals and semifinals contested at the No. 1 seed -- the first single-site for both rounds since 2002. The 10-team field will be the largest in the event's history, and first round games will be contested for just the second time -- the last occurring in 1993. The Tournament will begin with two first round contests on Monday night, Feb. 27, with the No. 7 seed hosting the No. 10 seed, and the No. 8 seed hosting the No. 9 seed. The winners advance into the quarterfinals on Wednesday, Feb. 29 at the home arena of the No. 1 seed. The No. 7-10 winner will play the No. 2 seed and the No. 8-9 winner will face the No. 1 seed. The bracket appears on page 10 of this report.

ELDER STATESMAN

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** won his 700th game as a collegiate head coach on Dec. 6 when the Chanticleers won 80-58 at The Citadel. Now in his 37th year as a head coach, Ellis stands 709-402 overall, including 97-53 (=64.7 percent) in five seasons at Coastal Carolina. He is the eighth-winningest active head coach with 631 Division I wins (631-390 at the Division I level) and is 34th on the all-time Division I wins list -- two away from tying **HUGH DURHAM** for 33rd-place with 633. In addition, Ellis has directed four different Division I programs to at least two 20-win campaigns, and owns six seasons with at least 25 wins. He is three wins away from winning 100 games with his fourth different Division I program.

STEADY EDDIE

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** became the school's all-time victory leader on Jan. 2 with his 224th win at the helm of the Bulldogs, passing **BOB HARTMAN** for the career record. Biedenbach, who won his 250th career game with the Bulldogs' 88-81 win over USC Upstate on Dec. 4, is the Big South's all-time winningest coach for overall wins (234) and Big South victories (141), and is now 263-290 in 18 years as a collegiate head coach.

RADEBAUGH AND PEELE GET MILESTONE WINS ON THE SAME NIGHT

Charleston Southern head coach **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH** collected his 100th career head coaching win with the Buccaneers' 91-73 victory over Campbell on Jan. 5. That same night, Winthrop's **RANDY PEELE** notched his 100th win as a Big South head coach. Radebaugh's career total includes 83 wins at CSU and 21 at Queen's University. Peele has now won 105 games as a Big South head coach -- 75 at Winthrop and 30 during UNC Greensboro's membership in the Conference.

BIG SOUTH TIEBREAKING PROCEDURE

While the Big South has 11 men's basketball members for the first time, the Conference is still utilizing an 18-game League schedule in 2011-12. Each team will play eight teams twice and two teams once.

A new tiebreaker procedure to address this unbalanced schedule is below and will be used to determine the seeding of teams for the Big South Tournament, if necessary.

TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURE FOR SEEDING TWO-TEAM TIE

(1) *Regular-season head-to-head results. If the tied teams split their two games, then proceed to Step 2 below.*

(2) *Win-loss record vs. Conference opponents occupying the highest position in the final regular-season standings in which the tied teams played an equal amount of times. Continue down through the standings until one team gains an advantage. If an advantage is not determined, proceed to Step 3.*

(3) *The team with the highest ranking on the most recent College Basketball RPI Report (or the NCAA's RPI listing). Note - the Conference office will research to determine which rating is most accurate/current.*

TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURE FOR SEEDING MULTI-TEAM TIE

(1) *Regular-season head-to-head results. If the tied teams split their two games, then proceed to Step 2 below.*

(2) *Win-loss record vs. Conference opponents occupying the highest position in the final regular-season standings in which the tied teams played an equal amount of times. Continue down through the standings until one team gains an advantage. If an advantage is not determined, proceed to Step 3.*

(3) *The team with the highest ranking on the most recent College Basketball RPI Report (or the NCAA's RPI listing). Note - the Conference office will research to determine which rating is most accurate/current.*

WILL ASHEVILLE'S 8-0 BIG SOUTH START FOLLOW PAST HISTORY?

UNC Asheville's 8-0 Big South start matched its best-ever opening in League play that was first accomplished in 1997-98 -- **EDDIE BIEDENBACH**'s second season as head coach. Prior to this season, a total of seven teams started the Big South season at least 8-0 since 1985-86, and all seven of those squads won the regular-season crown. In addition, five teams that opened 8-0 went on to win the Conference Tournament title -- the last being Winthrop 2006-07, while the remaining two finished as Big South Tournament runner-up.

MR. TRIPLE-DOUBLE

Liberty senior guard **JESSE SANDERS** recorded his fourth career triple-double Jan. 21 at High Point, becoming the first player in Division I history with a triple-double in four different years. He tallied 14 points, 13 assists and 10 rebounds against the Panthers, and owns four of the nine triple-doubles on record in Conference annals. Sanders recorded his first as a freshman against Presbyterian College on Feb. 9, 2009, his second during his sophomore year against Kentucky Christian on Dec. 12, 2009, and his third as a junior against Charleston Southern on Jan. 6, 2011.

THE BIG 500-0

UNC Asheville's **CHRIS STEPHENSON** became the sixth player this season and 66th in League history to grab 500 career rebounds as he surpassed the total this past Saturday at Liberty. He joins VMI's **STAN OKOYE**, Coastal Carolina's **SAM McLAURIN**, Winthrop's **GEORGE VALENTINE**, PC's **AL'LONZO COLEMAN** and High Point's **COREY LAW** among the 500-rebound club entrants this season. BOTH ENDS OF THE SPECTRUM

Of the 73 Big South games played this season, 48 have had winning margins of *less than* 10 points (=65.8 percent), with the average margin of victory in those 48 games being 5.04 points. The remaining 25 games that have been decided by at least 10 points had an average winning margin of 14.64 points. Overall, the 73 Conference games played thus far in 2011-12 have had an average margin of victory of 8.33 points. Last year, the overall margin of victory in League play was 10.48, while the 2009-10 average margin was 10.51 points and the 2008-09 League season was 8.96 points.

MID-MAJOR MANIA

For the eighth consecutive season, the Big South has had a member ranked in the *Collegeinsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 poll, as Campbell was ranked No. 25 the week of Dec. 12 and Coastal Carolina was ranked No. 25 the week of Dec. 19. It was the Camels' first appearance in the 13-year-old ranking, and the third-straight season the Chanticleers were ranked in the poll. Campbell is tied for fourth in the country in team field goal percentage (49.9) with Missouri ... CU plays at Coastal Tuesday in a match-up of two of the country's best shooting clubs ... Last Thursday's win over Charleston Southern was the 99th career coaching victory for head coach **ROBBIE LAING** ... **LORNE MERTHIE** enters Tuesday's game just 12 points shy of becoming the 25th player in CU history (since '61-'62) to reach 1,000 in his career ... This Thursday's contest vs. Winthrop marks the final regular-season home appearance for seniors Merthie, **AMIR CELESTIN** and **ERIC GRIFFIN**.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

CSU was held under 60 points in back-to-back games for the first time this season and is now 0-4 when that has occurred ... The Bucs attempted a season-high 35 three-pointers against Campbell last Thursday, connecting on nine ... CSU collected 18 offensive rebounds against Coastal Carolina this past Saturday, matching its second-highest total of the year. Twelve were grabbed in the first half, which is the most in any single stanza this season ... **PAUL GOMBWER** made his first career start against Coastal, posting four points and eight rebounds, including five on the offensive end ... **ARLON HARPER** scored 22 points vs. the Chanticleers for the second time this season.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal improved to 6-0 at home in the Big South with a 71-58 win over Charleston Southern on Saturday. The Chants have now won four-straight games to push their record to 11-1 at Kimbel Arena. **CHRIS GRADNIGO** scored a Coastal career-high 24 points while grabbing seven boards and three takeaways. **ANTHONY RAFFA** added 15 points for his 20th double-figure game this year. The Chants shot 51.1 percent from the field while holding CSU to 30.3 percent from inside the arc.

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb dropped a pair of close games on the road last week, falling 63-58 at Liberty and 81-77 in overtime at High Point. The overtime loss was GWU's first of the season in three tries ... Over the past two seasons, Gardner-Webb has played in 27 games decided by two possessions or less (10-17 record), including 12 of its 13 Conference games this season ... GWU has dropped six in a row on the road in League play, with all six coming by six points (two possessions) or less ... **TASHAN NEWSOME** posted his third 20-point game of the season with his 21 points at Liberty on Feb. 2 ... Graduate student **DAVID BROWN** netted a career-high 15 points at High Point on Feb. 4.

HIGH POINT

NICK BARBOUR became HPU's all-time leader in three-pointers this past Saturday, hitting seven against Gardner-Webb to raise his career total to 288. He broke **EUGENE HARRIS**'s HPU record of 283 that he set from 2006-10 ... Barbour is on pace to become the third player in HPU history with 2,000 points behind **EUGENE LITTLES** (2,398) and **ARIZONA REID** (2,069) ... High Point played its fourth overtime game of the season on Saturday, the most the Panthers have played in their Division I era (since 1999-2000). HPU is 2-2 in OT this season and 7-3 in its last 10 overtime games ... After a season-worst five-game losing streak, High Point has won two of its last three games.

LIBERTY

After going 0-7 in the first half against Gardner-Webb, **DAVID MINAYA** posted 16 second half points on 6-for-7 shooting and 4-of-4 from the charity stripe. The performance marks the second time the redshirt senior has posted 16 second half points in Big South play this season, first doing so against Charleston Southern (Dec. 31) ... Minaya scored his 700th career point at Liberty during the UNC Asheville game and now has 702 ... **JESSE SANDERS** finished with nine rebounds last Thursday, surpassing **MIKE COLEMAN** (1989-92, 755) for fifth all-time on Liberty's career rebounding list.

PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE

The Blue Hose snapped a seven-game losing streak with back-to-back road wins last week. It was the first time PC won consecutive Big South road contests since Dec. 3-6, 2008 when the Blue Hose won at Coastal Carolina and High Point ... With 15 points against Campbell, **KHALID MUTAKABBIR** moved to within one point of reaching the career 1,000 point mark. With one more point he will become just the second player in PC's Division I history and 22nd under Head Coach **GREGG NIBERT** to reach that milestone ... Last week's win over High Point was the first for PC in six tries and the first one in High Point since a 70-53 win Dec. 6, 2008.

RADFORD

Despite its record, Radford has led or been tied at the half in eight of its 13 Big South contests ... Radford has dropped a school-record 29 consecutive (3 neutral site) contests away from the Dedmon Center ... After playing three-straight on the road, the Highlanders will conclude their regular-season with three consecutive home contests.

UNC ASHEVILLE

The Bulldogs won at VMI last Thursday, 89-86, to hand the Keydets their first home loss of the season and snapped VMI's 13-game home win streak. Asheville got 26 points from **MATT DICKEY** and 19 points from **CHRIS STEPHENSON** in the win ... Asheville is 19-1 in games against Big South Conference opponents, dating back to last season ... In Saturday's win at Liberty, the Bulldogs had three players collect at least 10 rebounds -- the first such occurrence in Asheville's Division I history ... The Bulldogs are off until a Saturday home game against Radford.

VMI

KEITH GABRIEL scored nine of VMI's final 10 points in the second half en route to 32 points and help the Keydets rally from a seven-point deficit to defeat Winthrop on Saturday. His 3-pointer with 34 seconds left made it a two-possession game and he helped cement the win with a rebound and two free throws 12 seconds later ... In the win, freshman **QUINTON UPSHUR** stole the ball which led to a Gabriel layup that ignited an 11-4 run to help the Keydets pull even ... VMI head coach **DUGGAR BAUCOM** now stands one win away from his 100th career win at VMI and logged his 99th victory Saturday against Winthrop. Only one other coach, **BART BELLAIRS** (1995-05) has amassed more wins (116) as a head basketball coach at VMI.

WINTHROP

Winthrop continued its pattern of win one, lose one this past weekend after winning at Radford and falling at VMI ... The Eagles shot better than 50 percent in both games and lost to VMI despite connecting on eight more total field goals and grabbing 17 more rebounds ... **GEORGE VALENTINE** tied his career high with 16 points vs. VMI and collected his sixth double-double of the year and second in a row. He is close to averaging a double-double in Big South games with 10.1 points and 9.6 rebounds per game ... **ANDRE JONES** moved into 12th-place on the Winthrop career scoring list. He needs 42 more points to move into the top 10.
