BIG SOUTH SENDS MULTIPLE TEAMS TO POSTSEASON FOR FIFTH-STRAIGHT YEAR

For the fifth consecutive year, the Big South Conference has two men's basketball teams playing in the postseason in the same year. **UNC ASHEVILLE** received the League's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament, while **COASTAL CAROLINA** is the Conference's second-ever participant in the CollegeInsider.com Tournament (CIT). The last two seasons, the Big South had a team in the NCAAs and NIT, while in 2008-09 it was Radford (NCAA) and Liberty (CIT) in the postseason. In 2007-08, the Big South had participants in the NCAA Tournament (Winthrop) and NIT (UNC Asheville).

UNC ASHEVILLE SCORES SECOND CONSECUTIVE NCAA BID

Big South champion UNC Asheville is making its second-straight NCAA Tournament appearance, the first Big South team with back-to-back berths since Winthrop made four-in-a-row from 2005-08. It is Asheville's third trip to the NCAA Tournament -- all under head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** and the second-most by a Conference member. Asheville is 2-2 in the Big Dance, the most wins by a Big South member in the NCAAs.

DEJA VU ALL OVER AGAIN?

The UNC Asheville Bulldogs will face No. 1 seed Syracuse in the Second Round of the NCAA Tournament Thursday at CONSOL Energy Center in Pittsburgh, Pa. The game will be televised on TruTV at approximately 3:10pm. Asheville faced a BIG EAST member last season in the Second Round as well -- No. 1 seed Pittsburgh in Washington, D.C. The Bulldogs played a BIG EAST member earlier this season on a neutral court, falling to then No. 4-ranked UConn by 10 points at the "Battle 4 Atlantis" Tournament during Thanksgiving weekend.

COASTAL CAROLINA IN POSTSEASON FOR THIRD-STRAIGHT SEASON

Coastal Carolina will make its third consecutive postseason appearance Tuesday night, as the Chanticleers will play at Old Dominion in the first round of the fourth annual CollegeInsider.com Tournament (CIT). It is the first time in school history that the Chants have made three-straight postseason appearances, and the school's fifth overall (NCAA in 1991 and 1993; NIT in 2010 and 2011). The five overall postseason berths are the second-most in Big South history, behind Winthrop's nine (all in the NCAA Tournament). UNC Asheville is behind Coastal with four (3 NCAA, 1 NIT).

UNC ASHEVILLE CAPTURES 2012 BIG SOUTH TOURNAMENT TITLE

The No. 1 seed UNC Asheville Bulldogs defeated No. 7-seeded VMI, 80-64 in the Big South Tournament Championship Game to advance to the NCAA Tournament. It is Asheville's third berth in the Big Dance, as well as its fourth overall Big South Tournament title. UNC Asheville is the first No. 1 seed to win the Conference Tournament since 2009 and the 13th overall to capture the crown. The Bulldogs set school records for largest Tournament win in both the Quarterfinals (25 points) and Semifinals (27) and its average scoring margin of +22.7 points was the League's best since 1991 (Coastal Carolina - 25.0). UNC Asheville is the first Big South Champion to win each Tournament game by at least 15 points.

POSTSEASON MOVES - PART I

UNC Asheville head coach and Pittsburgh native **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** is the third coach in Big South Conference history to make three appearances in the NCAA Tournament, tied with **RANDY PEELE** for second-most in League annals (**GREGG MARSHALL** is first with 7). Biedenbach is the second to have at least four postseason berths. Meanwhile, Biedenbach improved his Big South Tournament career record to 20-13, the most Conference Tournament wins in League history.

POSTSEASON MOVES - PART II

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** will make his 22nd postseason appearance when the Chanticleers play in the CIT. He now has one CIT berth along with eight NCAA Tournament bids and 13 NIT appearances to his credit.

ASHEVILLE TIES LEAGUE RECORD FOR CONFERENCE WINS

UNC Asheville went 16-2 in Conference play this season, tying the League mark for most Big South wins in a single-season that was established by Coastal Carolina last season. The Bulldogs have recorded at least 10 Big South wins each of the past five seasons, a first for the program.

20/20 VISION

UNC Asheville has won a school-record 24 games this season, which is tied for fourth-most in a single-season in Big South history. It is also the Bulldogs' first back-to-back 20-win seasons as Big South members. The last time Asheville won 20 games in consecutive seasons was in 1982-83 and 1983-84. Meanwhile, Coastal Carolina is one victory shy of its third-straight 20-win season, which would be the first such streak in school history and the second-longest streak in the Conference's record books.

BIG SOUTH IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT

UNC Asheville is 2-2 all-time in the NCAA Tournament, the only Conference member with two victories. The Bulldogs are making their third trip to the Big Dance, second-most in Big South history.

The Big South Conference first secured an automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament in 1992, sending its postseason tournament champion to the Big Dance every year, with the exception of 1995.

Winthrop garnered the League's highest seed at No. 11 in 2007. Below is a look at the Conference's NCAA Tournament history:

FIVE-AND-DIME STORE

UNC Asheville senior guard **J.P. PRIMM**, who is the only player in Big South history with 400 career rebounds, 600 career assists and 200 career steals, is tied for second on the Big South's all-time assists chart with his school-record total of 604. Meanwhile, Primm is fourth in Conference history with a school-record 247 steals.

LINE LEADERS

UNC Asheville's **MATT DICKEY** is fifth all-time in Big South history with 485 made free throws, while teammate **J.P. PRIMM** is eighth with 447. High Point's **NICK BARBOUR** concluded his career this season tied for third with 487 made freebies. Meanwhile, Dickey is tied for second-place all-time in career free throw percentage at 84.2 (485-of-576).

WELCOME MATT

UNC Asheville's **MATT DICKEY** handed out his 400th career assist at Liberty Feb. 4, becoming the 20th player in Big South history with 400 career helpers. He is also one of five players in League annals with 400 assists (425) and 400 rebounds (446). The others in that group are teammate **J.P. PRIMM** (455 REB, 604 AST), Liberty's **JESSE SANDERS** (815 REB, 727 AST), Radford's **AMIR JOHNSON** (477 REB, 604 AST) and UNC Asheville's **K.J. GARLAND** (428 REB, 520 AST).

EDDIE AND THE CRUISERS

Asheville's regular-season Big South crown marked the fifth under head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH**, the second-most by a head coach in Big South history. Former Winthrop leader **GREGG MARSHALL** won six regular-season titles during his nine years at the helm of the Eagles from 1998-07. It was the Bulldogs' first outright title since 1997-98.

LIKE BROTHERS

UNC Asheville senior guards **MATT DICKEY** (1,773) and **J.P. PRIMM** (1,671) are just the second pair of four-year teammates in Big South history to each score more than 1,600 career points. The backcourt tandem join twin brothers **CHAVIS HOLMES** (2,065) and **TRAVIS HOLMES** (1,733) in this elite group. The Brothers Holmes played together at VMI from 2005-09.

SENIOR MOMENTS

UNC Asheville seniors **MATT DICKEY** and **J.P. PRIMM** have scored 15 points in the same game 27 times since arriving in Asheville in 2008-09, and the Bulldogs are 21-6 in those games. The duo has achieved this feat eight times in 2011-12 (7-1 record) after reaching the total 14 times in 2010-11.

MOUNTAIN TOP

League-leading UNC Asheville has scored at least 80 points in a game 18 times this season, the most by the Bulldogs since 20 times in 1972-73. Earlier this season, Asheville scored at least 80 points in six-straight Conference games from Jan. 5-19, a first for the program. During that streak, the Bulldogs averaged 90.5 points, and scored 90 points in back-to-back Conference games for the first-time ever. Meanwhile, the Bulldogs were just the third Big South team to score at least 80 points in three-straight Big South Tournament games (Winthrop in 1993 and Radford in 2009).

STEADY EDDIE

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** is the Big South's all-time winningest coach for overall wins (240) and Big South victories (144), and is now 269-292 in 19 years as a collegiate head coach. He became the school's all-time victory leader on Jan. 2 with his 224th win at the helm of the Bulldogs, passing **BOB HARTMAN** for the career record. Biedenbach won his 250th career game with the Bulldogs' 88-81 win over USC Upstate on Dec. 4.

CLIFF NOTES

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** is one victory away from winning 100 games with his fourth different Division I program. He would become just the second coach (**LEFTY DRIESELL**, five schools) in NCAA history to record 100-or-more wins at least four Division I programs. Ellis is currently one of 10 coaches with 100 or more wins at three schools (South Alabama 171, Clemson 177, Auburn 186).

HEAD OF THE CLASS

Coastal Carolina's **SAM McLAURIN** and Presbyterian College's **JAY REYNOLDS** were voted to the Capital One/CoSIDA Academic All-District IV First-Team. It is the first time since the 2008-09 season that at least two Big South men's basketball players earned Academic All-District accolades.

SAM I AM

Coastal Carolina redshirt-junior **SAM McLAURIN** is one of eight players in Big South history with 600 career rebounds (642) and 150 career blocks (school-record 154). He ranks 35th on the League's career rebounding list and is 14th on the blocked shot chart. McLaurin needs two rejections to jump into a tie for 12th-place.

ELDER STATESMAN

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** won his 700th game as a collegiate head coach on Dec. 6 when the Chanticleers won 80-58 at The Citadel. Now in his 37th year as a head coach, Ellis stands 711-408 overall, including 99-59 (=62.7 percent) in five seasons at Coastal Carolina. He is the 10th-winningest active head coach with 633 Division I wins (633-396 at the Division I level) and is tied for 33rd-place all-time on the Division I wins list with **HUGH DURHAM**. In addition, Ellis has directed four different Division I programs to at least two 20-win campaigns, and owns six seasons with at least 25 wins.

TOAST TO THE COAST

Seven days after defeating LSU, Coastal Carolina won 60-59 at Clemson on Nov. 22, marking the second-straight year that a Big South member has defeated an SEC team and ACC team in the same season. Presbyterian College did it last year in back-to-back games, as the Blue Hose won at Auburn on Dec. 18 and followed with a win at Wake Forest on Dec. 20. The Chanticleers are now the third Big South team in Conference history with SEC-ACC wins in the same campaign. The first was Campbell in 1993-94 when the Camels defeated North Carolina State and South Carolina.

BACK TO THE FUTURE

The Big South recorded wins over the SEC, BIG EAST and ACC this season, an accomplishment that occurred just once previously in League history. The 1993-94 season was the first time the Big South Conference defeated an SEC, BIG EAST and ACC team in the same year. Meanwhile, the Big South has collected an SEC win five out of the last six seasons, an ACC win four out of the last five seasons, and a BIG EAST win four out of the last eight seasons.

BUT WAIT, THERE'S MORE

The 2011-12 campaign was the first time the Big South posted wins over five of the six "BCS" Conferences in the same season, as Campbell's win at Iowa on Nov. 23 and UNC Asheville's victory over Utah on Nov. 26 gave the Big South victories against Big Ten and Pac-12 members. It was the Big South's first-ever win over a Big Ten team, and the Conference's first win against a Pac-12 member since 1996-97.

ASHEVILLE'S 8-0 BIG SOUTH START FOLLOWED HISTORY'S SCRIPT

UNC Asheville's 8-0 Big South start matched its best-ever opening in League play that was first accomplished in 1997-98 -- **EDDIE BIEDENBACH**'s second season as head coach. Eight teams have started the Big South season at 8-0 since 1985-86, and all eight of those squads have won the regular-season crown. Six teams that opened 8-0 have won the Conference Tournament title, while Asheville being the first to do so since 2006-07. The remaining two teams finished as the Big South Tournament Runner-Up.

BIG SOUTH TOURNAMENT RECAP

For the first time since 2005 and the third time overall, the No. 7 seed advanced to the Championship game of the Big South Tournament, as No. 7-seeded VMI upset No. 2 seed Coastal Carolina in the Quarterfinals and No. 6 seed Winthrop in the Semifinals. The Keydets needed a two-point First Round win over No. 10 Radford to advance, and became just the second team in the history of the Conference Tournament to reach the title game from the First Round. No. 4 seed Charleston Southern reached the Semifinals for the first time since 2006, while Tournament Champion UNC Asheville advanced to the Semifinals for the sixth consecutive year -- becoming the first Big South team to achieve this feat since Radford did so seven years in-a-row from 1997-03. Meanwhile, the No. 1 seed reached the Championship game for the ninth-straight year, and the title contest featured No. 1-vs.-No. 7 for just the third time.

BARBOUR SHOP

High Point senior guard **NICK BARBOUR**, who became just the seventh player in Big South history to score 2,000 career points when he surpassed the milestone Feb. 11 at Charleston Southern, finished his career fourth all-time with 2,121 points. THE NEW 40

In High Point's regular-season finale against Campbell on Feb. 22, **NICK BARBOUR** scored 44 points in 32 minutes to lead the Panthers to a 98-60 victory over the Camels. His performance broke High Point's Division I record for most points in a game, and it was two points shy of matching the Big South single-game mark. Barbour's 44 points was the third-highest single-game scoring output in Conference history, and it was the first 40-point game by a Big South player since the 2006-07 season.

SAY YES TO THE JESS

Liberty senior point guard **JESSE SANDERS** is believed to be the first NCAA Division I player to record 800 rebounds (815) and 700 assists (727). He is already only one of five players to record 600 rebounds and 600 assists, and is believed to be the first NCAA Division I player to officially record 225 rebounds and 225 assists in a single-season (assists became an official statistic in 1983-84).

SAND BLAST

Liberty senior guard **JESSE SANDERS**, who became the Big South's all-time assist leader Jan. 7 at UNC Asheville when he handed out his 605th career helper, handed out 255 assists this season -- the second-highest single-season total in Big South history. Sanders's League-leading 7.97 assists per game is the second-highest assist average in a single-season in Big South history. The Conference record remains 9.64, which was set by Charleston Southern's **TONY FAIRLEY** in 1986-87. Fairley also holds the Big South single-season assist record of 270 in '86-87.

SPECIAL K

Charleston Southern's **KELVIN MARTIN** ends his stellar career third on the Big South's all-time rebounding chart with 968 career boards, and departs as one of three players in the Conference's record books with 1,000 career points (1,483), 900 career rebounds (968), 200 career steals (221) and 100 career blocked shots (127). The other two are Campbell's **JOE SPINKS** (1,711 - 954 - 220 - 155) and Coastal Carolina's **JOSEPH HARRIS** (1,444 - 1,152 - 205 - 142).

TREY-LINER

Campbell freshman guard and Big South Freshman of the Year **TREY FREEMAN** is first in the Conference with an 87.1 free throw percentage, and is looking to become the first freshman to lead the Big South in free throw shooting since 1995-96 (UMBC's **ALHAMISI SIMMS**, 88.1) and the fourth overall. The Big South single-season record for highest free throw percentage by a freshman is 88.9 percent by UNC Greensboro's **SCOTT HARTZELL** in 1992-93.

BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

100 COACHING WINS

VMI head coach **DUGGAR BAUCOM** claimed his 100th coaching win as the Keydets' head coach on Feb. 18 with a win over William & Mary. He is just the second coach in school history with 100 wins. Meanwhile, Campbell head coach **ROBBIE LAING** won his 100th game as a collegiate head coach with the Camels' 81-75 win at Coastal Carolina on Feb. 7. In addition, Charleston Southern head coach **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH** collected his 100th career head coaching win with the Buccaneers' 91-73 victory over Campbell on Jan. 5.

BUC-ING THE TREND

Charleston Southern's 19 wins this season were the most since winning 19 in 1994-95, and the Buccaneers won at least 16 games in back-to-back seasons for the first time since winning 21 games in both the 1985-86 and 1986-87 campaigns. CSU's 35 wins the past two seasons are the program's most in consecutive years since winning a combined 38 games in 1986-87 (21) and 1987-88 (17). Meanwhile, the Buccaneers posted their first 10-win Conference season since going 12-4 in League games in 1994-95. Their 20 Big South wins the past two seasons are their most since winning 21 in the same span as above.

For the eighth consecutive season, the Big South has had a member ranked in the *Collegeinsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 poll, as Campbell was ranked No. 25 the week of Dec. 12 and Coastal Carolina was ranked No. 25 the week of Dec. 19. It was the Camels' first appearance in the 13-year-old ranking, and the third-straight season the Chanticleers were ranked in the poll. Liberty senior guard **JESSE SANDERS** recorded his fourth career triple-double Jan. 21 at High Point, becoming the first player in Division I history with a triple-double in four different years. He tallied 14 points, 13 assists and 10 rebounds against the Panthers, and owns four of the nine triple-doubles on record in Conference annals. Sanders recorded his first as a freshman against Presbyterian College on Feb. 9, 2009, his second during his sophomore year against Kentucky Christian on Dec. 12, 2009, and his third as a junior against Charleston Southern on Jan. 6, 2011.

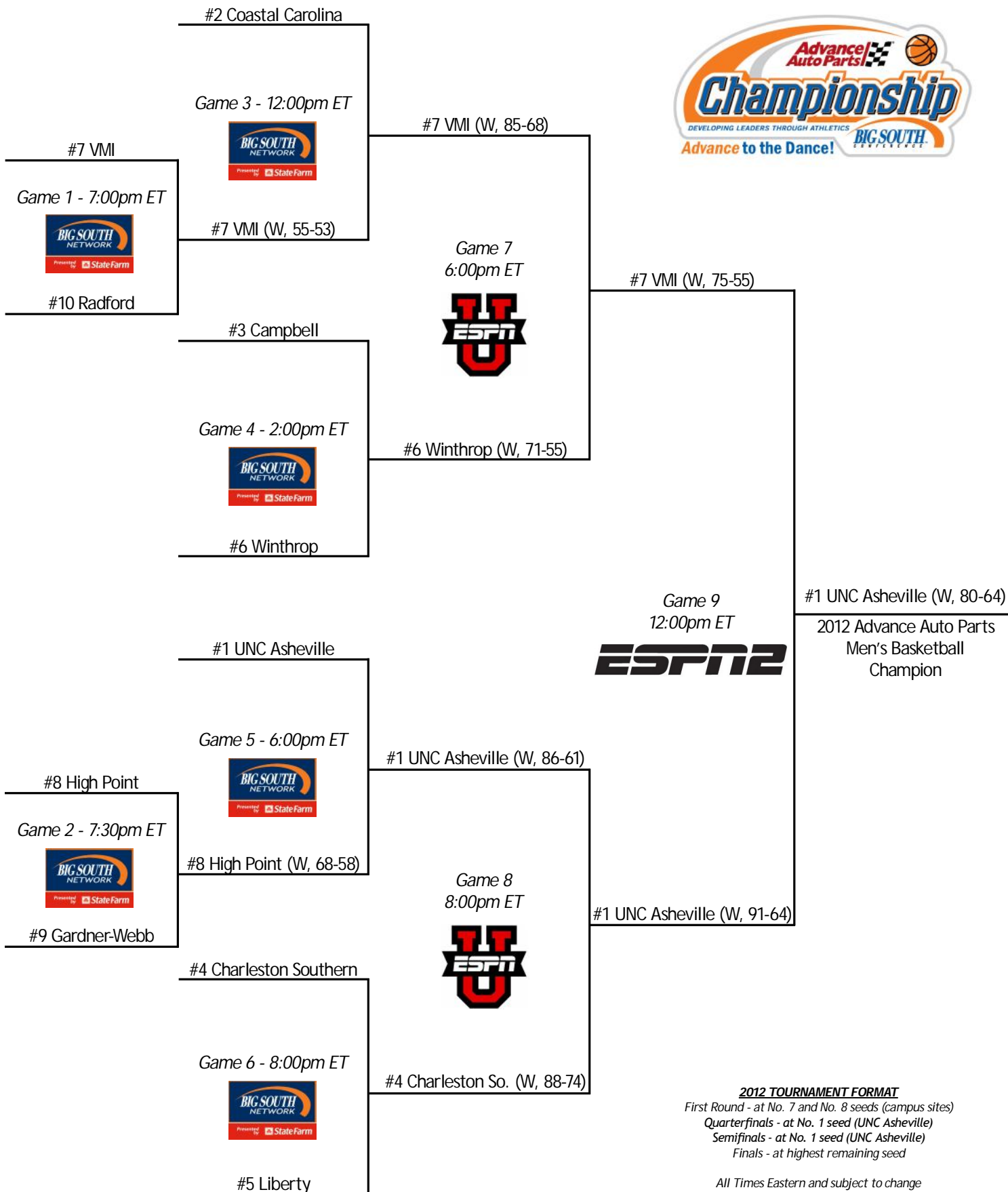
