Erwin Spencer averaged 20 points per game on 52 percent from the floor to lead her squad to a 1-1 record last week. The guard highlighted her week with 24 points as she connected on a career-high 10-of-18 from the floor for a 56 percent clip, adding 4-of-4 from the line in the win over Wofford on Dec. 10. She also chipped in four steals, two assists, two rebounds and a block against the Terriers. She got her week started with 16 points on 46 percent from the floor and 6-of-7 from the charity stripe, to go along with six helpers, five boards and a pair of steals against Wake Forest on Dec. 7. The honor is her second Player of the Week nod this season.

SLOW RIDE

Most of the Big South teams had a light week last week in order to prepare and get exams out of the way. The League will crank it back up this week, appearing at tournaments before heading in to the Conference season at the beginning of the new year.

BGS BUSTERS

The first weekend in December proved to be a big one for the Big South Conference. On Friday, Dec. 2, **ERIN REYNOLDS** of High Point fueled the Panther offense with 36 points to lead High Point to the 82-75 win over Pitt of the Big East ... Two days later, Charleston Southern's **LAKEITHA ALSTON** posted a 31-point, 10 rebound double-double in the Bucs' 82-77 win over Clemson of the ACC.

THAT'S RIGHT ICE-MAN... I AM DANGEROUS

Junior guard **DIANA CHOIBEKOVA** has established herself as one of the League's most dangerous shooters from beyond the arc. She currently ranks No. 1 in all of Division I with 4.1 triples per game. She has also scored in double-digits in all but one game this season, including 33 points against Niagara.

NO. 1 STUNNER

Radford's **DA'NARIA ERWIN SPENCER** has taken over as the League's top scorer with 19.1 ppg. She has posted three 20-point games on the year and has been named the Big South's Player of the Week twice this season.

20/20

UNC Asheville's **KELLI RILES** set a new Big South single-game standard for rebounds as she pulled down 28 rebounds in Asheville's win over USC Upstate on Nov. 30. The game marked the second time this season that she has posted a game with 20-or-more rebounds as she pulled down 24 against Winston-Salem State in the opening game of the season ... In the game vs. WSSU, she also became the only player this season with a 20-point, 20-rebound double-double ... Her 13.3 rebounds per game is currently ranked No. 1 in the nation.

SCORE'N AND DISH'N

Winthrop's **DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN** and **TONISHA BAKER** of Campbell have each posted double-doubles with 10 assists. McClanahan put in 20-points and dished out 10 helpers against Troy, while Baker scored 18 points and posted 10 assists against Winston-Salem State.

I'LL TAKE PLAYERS AVERAGING A DOUBLE-DOUBLE THIS SEASON ALEX

The Big South has three student-athletes currently averaging a double-double in points and rebounds this season. High Point's **CHEYENNE PARKER** is averaging 15.9 points and 11.0 rebounds per game, while **AVERY WARLEY** of Liberty is averaging 12.7 points and 11.1 boards per game. UNC Asheville's **KELLI RILES** is currently posting 11.6 points and 13.3 rebounds per outing.

TWIN KILL'N

This season the Big South Conference has had six teammates go for 20 points in the same contest. During all of last season the Big South only saw seven sets of teammates go for 20 points in the same game.

GOOD 'N' TWENTY

Radford's **DANARIA ERWIN SPENCER** and McClanahan of Winthrop are the only players in the Big South to post consecutive 20-point games this season. Erwin Spencer poured in 21 points against USC Upstate on Nov. 19 and followed with 27 points against UNC Greensboro on Nov. 21. Radford picked up the win in both those contests. McClanahan posted 20 points against Virginia Commonwealth on Nov. 27 and followed with 21 points against Davidson on Dec. 1.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

CAMPBELL

After finishing up exams, the Lady Camels traveled to longtime rival UNC Wilmington on Saturday, nearly clipping the Seahawks with a furious second half comeback. UNCW led by as many as 17 in the game before the Lady Camels stormed back, cutting the UNCW lead to four with 20 seconds remaining. Three Seahawks combined to go 6-for-6 from the free throw line in the final seconds to hold off Campbell. The meeting was the 46th in school history, the most of any opponent. CU holds a 30-16 advantage in the all-time series. TONISHA BAKER fueled the comeback, posting 12 of her team-high 14 points in the second half. Baker, a junior guard, added five rebounds, four steals and three assists in the second half as the Lady Camels outscored the Seahawks 42-33 in the final frame. CU's 42 points in the second half were the most in any half this season. After shooting 54.3 percent (19-35) that included six threes in the first half, UNCW cooled down to an 18.2 clip from the field in the second as Campbell forced 16 turnovers, converting the Seahawk miscues into 20 points. UNCW made 24-of-32 shots from the free throw line to preserve the win. Baker finished the game with 14 points, nine rebounds, five assists and four steals, leading the team in all four categories. ASHLEY JAMES, a sophomore forward, also notched 14 points, a career high. Freshman guard KIERA GAINES also registered a career-high with 13 points, tacking on seven rebounds. Senior guard AMANDA O'NEILL recorded a season-high 11 points, while KATELYN BASS, a senior forward, pitched in nine points and eight boards.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Buccaneers went 2-0 last time out, winning the battle of Charleston with a 64-45 win at the College of Charleston before earning their first ever win over a program from a major conference with an 82-77 win at Clemson... The Bucs are now 5-1 vs. nonconference opponents from the Palmetto State, with their most impressive wins coming over CoFC, Furman and Clemson... CSU hit 18 3-point field goals this week, and stymied their opponents' 3-point game as Clemson and CoFC combined for just six buckets from beyond the arc... At 6-2 CSU is off to its best start since the 1998-99 season when they went 7-1 through the first eight games of the season... Alston's 12 field goals made at Clemson is one short of tying the CSU record of 13 set in 2007 by PAM TOLBERT... The Bucs' 16 steals at CoFC are a season-high, as are their 5 blocked shots vs. the Cougars... CSU also played some of their best defense last time out, allowing a season-low 14 field goals and holding Clemson to just one 3-pointer (.091 %).

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina dispatched Converse, 84-55, in its only game of the week to improve to 6-1 on the season and 5-0 at home ... The Chanticleers scored 27 unanswered points, part of a 35-3 Coastal run to end the game, in the second half to put the game away ... KAYLA COOK, OLIVIA IRICK, SHANIKA MADDOX and AJ JORDAN each scored in double-figures to mark the first time four Chants tallied 10-plus points since the quartet of Sydnei Moss, Amanda Stull, Kendra Reynolds and Irick did so against Charleston Southern on Feb. 13, 2010. Cook led the foursome with a career-high 17 points and Irick scored 16 while Maddox and Jordan each chipped in 13 ... In addition to her 13 points, Maddox also pulled down 10 boards to complete her third double-double on the season ... Coastal converted 44 points off turnovers and scored 44 points in the paint ... The Chanticleers return to the hardwood with their annual appearance in the Carolinas Challenge at the Myrtle Beach Convention Center on Sunday, Dec. 18. Tip-off with the South Carolina State Bulldogs is set for 5 p.m.

GARDNER-WEBB

The Gardner-Webb women's basketball team could not overcome its cold shooting and its turnovers, as the Runnin' Bulldogs fell to No. 15/13 Louisville, 92-27, on Saturday afternoon in Louisville, Ky. Sophomore center CATRINA GREEN led the Runnin' Bulldogs with 11 points, nine of which came in the second half, and eight rebounds, while no other player had more than four points for the game. The 27 points is the lowest that a GWU team has scored in a single-game since the Runnin' Bulldogs scored 31 in a loss to No. 6 Duke on November 25th at the 2011 Junkanoo Jam in the Bahamas earlier this year. The loss drops Gardner-Webb to 0-3 versus top-25 nationally ranked opponents (#19 North Carolina, #6 Duke and #13 Louisville) on the year and 0-8 overall. The Runnin' Bulldogs, who lost 84 percent of their scoring from last year due to the departures of Dominique and Monique Hudson, Sandra Vaitkute and LaTroya Pope, are averaging only 41.0 points per game this season and have only scored 50 points or more once on the year. The young Runnin' Bulldogs will look for their first win of the year this weekend, as GWU will remain on the road to take on the Lady Bisons of Lipscomb at 2 p.m. central time on Sunday, December 18th, in Nashville, Tenn.

HIGH POINT

High Point moved to 4-3 on the season after splitting back-to-back games against BCS opponents. The Panthers picked up an 82-75 win at home over Pittsburgh before falling on the road to No. 22 Vanderbilt by a score of 70-54. Junior ERIN REYNOLDS had a career night against Pitt tying the HPU Div. I single-game scoring record with 36 points in the contest. The guard nearly doubled her previous career high of 20. Senior SHAMIA BROWN and sophomore CHEYENNE PARKER also had good games with double-doubles in the win. HPU then hit the road to take on the nationally-ranked Commodores two days later. High Point fell behind early but managed to battle back to within seven in the second half before falling by 16. Parker led HPU with 19 points and 13 rebounds in the game for her fifth double-double in seven games.

LIBERTY

Liberty rebounded from scoring a season-low 38 points Wednesday at Virginia to tally a Vines Center-record 116 points during a Saturday win over Glenville State ... It was the second-most points the Lady Flames have ever scored, trailing the 142 points Liberty racked up against Roanoke College on Feb. 26, 1976 ... DEVON BROWN reached a career milestone during the second half of the Virginia contest, scoring her 1,000th career point ... The 14th player in program history to reach 1,000 points, Brown has now notched 1,031 career points ... AVERY WARLEY then achieved a milestone of her own during an 18-rebound outburst against Glenville State ... The redshirt senior became the third player in program history and the fourth player in Big South history to grab 1,000 career rebounds ... With 1,001 career boards, Warley needs just 33 caroms to break Katie Feenstra's school record of 1,033 ... Warley has also climbed to 10th place in Liberty history with 1,141 career points.

PRESBYTERIAN

PC is off to its best start since the 2006-07 campaign, when the Blue Hose, then in their final year at Division II, also compiled a 4-4 record through the first eight games. A win over Columbia would give PC five wins in nine games this season, a feat not seen since the 2005-06 squad went 21-7... Senior KRISTEN STEVENS hit her 118th career three-pointer against USC Upstate on December 2, moving her into sole possession of sixth place in team history. She needs 12 more to tie for fifth place... Dria David's 11 field throws against USC Upstate set a new Division I-era single game record... MARIAH PIETROWSKI's 21 points against USC Upstate marked the eight-best scoring performance in PC's Division I history and her .800 shooting percentage (8-10) marked the second-best... A win against Columbia College on December 13 would match the longest win streak in PC's Division I history... DRIA DAVID's 15-point effort against USC Upstate on December 2 gave her 500 points for her career, making her the second player to hit the 500 mark this season after Kristen Stevens reached the plateau with 11 points at North Carolina on November 22. Pietrowski also stands three points from 700 and 25 from the school's Division I career scoring record.

RADFORD

Radford fell to ACC-foe Wake Forest, 67-90 to begin the week, but came back to end a three-game slide against Wofford 63-46 in the inaugural Asheville Collegiate Invitational on Saturday. Radford won its first road contest in the month of December since 2007, ending a four-year drought without a victory in visiting arenas. Despite the loss, SARAH TABB set a career high in points with 14 and added 7 rebounds at Wake Forest. D'ANARIA ERWIN SPENCER once again led the way in scoring with 16 against Wake Forest and 24 against Wofford. VICTORIA HAMILTON had back-to-back double digit rebound marks with 10 against the Demon Deacons and a season-high 12 against Wofford. AYANA AVERY came off the bench to help Radford put together a 25-4 second half opening run to break away from the Terriers. She finished with a career-best 13 points.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville is coming off a 85-71 defeat at the hands of Southern Conference foe Appalachian State on Saturday. The game was part of the inaugural Asheville Collegiate Invitational, featuring teams for the Big South and Southern Conferences. Asheville is now 3-13 lifetime against ASU and has lost four out of the last five meetings. ASU picked up a 99-71 win the last time the teams met in Boone on Dec. 2, 2010. Lindsey Thompson set a career-high in points with 29 against the Mountaineers in the game. Asheville is now 2-5 overall, 2-2 at home and 0-3 on the road. The Bulldogs will have two games this week, taking on Kennesaw State on Saturday before squaring off against South Carolina State on Monday. Asheville defeated South Carolina State last season 84-69 on Dec. 15 at Justice Center. Asheville has led at the half in 5-of-7 contests this season. LEAH WORMACK put in a career-high 21 points on 73 percent from the floor against USC Upstate on Nov. 30. She connected on 8-of-11 from the field and added five from the line, to go along with three boards, an assist and one steal. The game marked her first 20-point game of her collegiate career.

WINTHROP

Winthrop ended a four-game winning streak with a win over South Carolina State on Saturday. Winthrop is now 6-12 all-time against South Carolina State and it was just the sixth meeting out of 18 that was decided by less than 10 points. The Lady Eagles scored 46 points in the first half of the game Saturday. It was the third time in eight games they've scored 40 points in the first half. The team did it just one time during the 2010-11 season (31 games). Over a 31-game span in 2010-11, DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN dished out 110 assists. This season over eight games, McClanahan is over halfway to that mark with 56 (7.0 per game). She entered Saturday's game ranked sixth nationally at 6.7 per game. The last Winthrop player to average six or more assists in a season was Iva Milevoj in 2005-06 at 6.2. If McClanahan can keep pace at least six assists per game the rest of the way, she'll finish just shy of 200 (194) for the season. Winthrop's single season record for total assists is 192 set by Janet Frederick during the 1980-81 season. Milevoj dished out the school's record at the NCAA Division I level with 179 in 05-06.

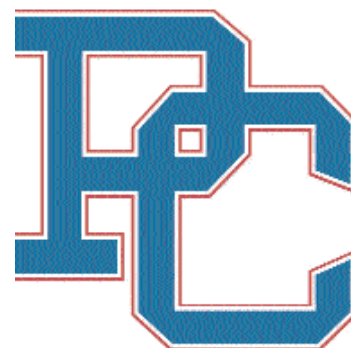
