She got her week started with 20 points on 57 percent from the field, a pair from downtown and two from the line against Kennesaw State on Dec. 17. She also chipped in four rebounds and a pair of assists against the Owls. Two days later against South Carolina State, Jones connected on 9-of-11 shots from the floor for an 82 percent clip and added 4-of-4 from long range and 8-of-10 from the charity stripe to finish with 30 points against the Bulldogs. The guard also collected three boards, four steals and one assist for the Blue and White. The honor is her first Player of the Week nod this year.

#### LET'S GET READY TO RUUUUMMMMBBBBLLLEEEE!!!!

The Big South Conference season is fast approaching. After Christmas, the women ring in the 2012 with 10 teams in action. The action kicks off Dec. 30 and serves as the opening weekend of the Big South Conference slate.

The first weekend in December proved to be a big one for the Big South Conference. On Friday, Dec. 2, ERIN REYNOLDS of High Point fueled the Panther offense with 36 points to lead High Point to the 82-75 win over Pitt of the Big East ... Two days later, Charleston Southern's LAKEITHA ALSTON posted a 31-point, 10 rebound double-double in the Bucs' 82-77 win over Clemson of the ACC.

#### THAT'S RIGHT ICE-MAN ... I AM DANGEROUS

Junior guard DIANA CHOIBEKOVA has established herself as one of the League's most dangerous shooters from beyond the arc. She currently ranks No. 1 in all of Division I with 4.1 triples per game. She has also scored in double-digits in all but one game this season, including 33 points against Niagra.

#### NO. 1 STUNNER

DEQUESHA McCLANAHAN has taken over as the Big South's leading scorer with 18.5 points per contests. Scoring isn't the only way McClanahan is generating offense for the Eagles as she is currently ranked No. 8 in the country with 6.6 assists per game, averaging nearly two assists more per game than any other player in the Big South.

#### FEAR OF REJECTION?

High Point's CHEYENNE PARKER has made a name for herself in the post this season. She currently ranks No. 8 in the Nation with 3.4 blocked shots per game. She posted a season-high six rejections vs. Davidson on Nov. 18. She is also currently ranked No. 12 in the country with six double-doubles on the year and is riding a four-game streak of double-digit points and rebounds.

#### 20/20

UNC Asheville's KELLI RILES set a new Big South single-game standard for rebounds as she pulled down 28 rebounds in Asheville's win over USC Upstate on Nov. 30. The game marked the second time this season that she has posted a game with 20-or-more rebounds as she pulled down 24 against Winston-Salem State in the opening game of the season ... In the game vs. WSSU, she also became the only player this season with a 20-point, 20rebound double-double ... Her 13.4 rebounds per game is currently ranked No. 1 in the nation.

#### SCORE'N AND DISH'N

Winthrop's DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN and TONISHA BAKER of Campbell have each posted double-doubles with 10 assists. McClanahan put in 20-points and dished out 10 helpers against Troy, while Baker scored 18 points and posted 10 assists against Winston-Salem State.

#### I'LL TAKE PLAYERS AVERAGING A DOUBLE-DOUBLE THIS SEASON, ALEX

The Big South has three student-athletes currently averaging a double-double in points and rebounds this season. High Point's CHEYENNE PARKER is averaging 15.8 points and 11.0 rebounds per game, while AVERY WARLEY of Liberty is averaging 13.6 points and 11.1 boards per game. UNC Asheville's KELLI RILES is currently posting 10.3 points and 12.1 rebounds per outing. While Riles leads the nation in rebounding, Warley is ranked No. 9 in the country and Parker sits at No. 10 in Division I.

#### TWIN KILL'N

This season the Big South Conference has had six teammates go for 20 points in the same contest. During all of last season the Big South only saw seven sets of teammates go for 20 points in the same game.

#### GOOD 'N' TWENTY

Radford's DANARIA ERWIN SPENCER has posted consecutive 20-point games on two occasions this season. McClanahan of Winthrop, Liberty's Warley and SHONESE JONES of UNC Asheville have also posted consecutive games with 20-or-more points. Of the four, Jones is the only player to score 30 points in the two-game spans.

#### NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

CAMPBELL
The Lady Camels, at 6-3 on the year, will take on their former conference rivals, Stetson, on Tuesday at 1 p.m. inside the Edmunds Center. CU will then face Bethune-Cookman on Wednesday at 1 p.m. Campbell is coming off a pair of single digit losses at UNC Wilmington and Elon, 79-73 and 89-88, respectively. The two outings were two of Campbell's top scoring outputs of the season, with its 88 tallies at Elon being the season high. The Lady Camels' 73 points at UNCW stand as the third most this year. Junior guard TONISHA BAKER, who notched a season-high 25 points with nine rebounds at Elon, leads the Lady Camels on the season at 13.8 points, 7.8 rebounds and 2.9 steals per game, pacing CU in all three categories. Forwards JAZMINE COOPER and KATELYN BASS add 9.8 and 9.4 points per game, respectively, combining for 11.4 rebounds a contest. Senior guard KATE CLOXTON collects a team-high 4.8 assists per game to go along with 5.6 points. ROSLYN PRESLEY, a sophomore forward, leads the Lady Camel punch off the bench at 7.7 points per game, while ASHLEY JAMES gathers 6.1 points a game.

#### CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN
The Buccaneers suffered their first home loss of the season to UNC Wilmington... Since the 2009-10 season, the Lady Bucs are 25-8 at the Buc Dome and boasted just two home losses last season... The Gator Holiday Classic is the fifth tournament in five seasons CSU will participate in... The Bucs made a season-high 20 free-throws vs. UNC Wilmington, will RACHELLE COWARD leading the way with seven - the most made by a Buccaneer this season... Their 20-of-22 shots at the charity stripe was also their highest free-throw percentage of the season at .909... LAKEITHA ALSTON is currently leading the team in both scoring (17.7 ppg) and rebounding (6.3 ppg)... The Bucs are off to their best start since the 1998-99 season when they went 8-1 through nine games... CSU's three losses have been by an average of 3 points, with their 69-65 loss to Western Carolina being their "biggest" loss of the season... Meanwhile, their six wins have come by an average of 25 points...

Coastal Carolina was unable to hold on to an early lead the Chants fell to SC State, 61-59, in their only game of the week. Coastal enters its 10 day break for the Christmas holiday with a 6-2 record ... For the second time in as many games, four Chants scored in double figures as SHANIKA MADDOX led the way with 14 points. Cole poured in 13 followed by TAYLOR EPLEY's careerhigh 11 points and KAYLA COOK's 10 ... Maddox and Epley each finished with a game-high nine boards ... The Chants shot 52.1 percent from the floor - its highest percentage since shooting 54.0 percent at USC Upstate last season - including an outstanding 66.7 clip in the first half ... Maddox's 14 points pushed her season average to 10.3 to make her the third Chanticleer averaging 10+ points per game this season along with SHATIA COLE (12.3 ppg) and ANGELICA HENRY (10.8 ppg) ... Epley and Maddox each tallied a game-high nine rebounds to help the Chants hold a dominate 31-19 edge in rebounding ... Coastal will play its final non-conference game on Thursday, Dec. 29 against USC Upstate before opening Big South play at home with Winthrop (Dec. 31) and Presbyterian (Jan. 2).

The Runnin' Bulldogs had their best offensive output on Sunday afternoon, as GWU posted 65 points in a 76-65 non-conference loss at Lipscomb. Gardner-Webb attempted to overcome a low scoring first half, in which GWU totaled only 13 points, by pouring in a season-high 52 points in the second half of play in the loss. Sophomore center CATRINA GREEN, who played most of the second half with four fouls, poured in a career-high 19 points and hauled down 10 rebounds in the loss. The Runnin' Bulldogs, who had entered the game averaging only 41 points overall on the season, scored a season-high 65 points in the loss, surpassing their previous season-high of 50 points in a home loss to Wofford. GWU will return to action on December 28th when the Runnin' Bulldogs will take on North Carolina Central in Durham, N.C. at 6 p.m. GWU will tip-off their 2011-12 Conference season at Campbell on December 30th.

High Point dropped its first game in the Bahamas Sunshine Shootout to Georgia State by a score of 79-68. HPU led eraly but a 12-0 run by Georgia State midway through the first half gave GSU the lead for good. CHEYENNE PARKER picked up her sixth double-double of the season with 15 points and 11 rebounds while ERIN REYNOLDS led all scorers in the game with 20 points and LINDSAY PUCKETT scored a career-high 18.

Liberty has won its last two games, both against Division II opponents, and averaged 99.0 ppg in the pair of contests ... The Lady Flames set new program and Vines Center records with 51 free throw attempts during Thursday night's win over Virginia Union ... AVERY WARLEY continued to climb various record lists during Thursday's contest against Virginia Union ... She is now tied with former Radford standout Karen Bowles for third place in Big South history with 1,012 career rebounds ... Warley also ranks eighth in program history with 1,163 career points ... Liberty will not play another home game at the Vines Center until Jan. 7, when the Lady Flames host High Point.

PRESBY LEMAN

PC is off to its best record in its Division I history at 6-5 and its four-game win streak equaled its longest since the 2005-06 season... SHONDA BURNSIDE moved into ninth place in program history with her 44th and 45th career blocks against Alabama on December 19... MARIAH PIETROWSKI'S 8-for-9 shooting performance against Montreat marked the second-best single game percentage (.889) in PC's Division I history... Five members of the Blue Hose scored in double-figures in two consecutive games in contests against Columbia College and Montreat... PC scored 92 points against Columbia College, marking the most since scoring 94 at USC Upstate on December 17, 2006.

#### **RADFORD**

Radford went 1-1 over the week with a 80-68 win at Norfolk State and lost to ACC-foe Virginia 43-92 on Sunday. At Norfolk State, DA'NARIA ERWIN SPENCER had 20 points for the second straight game and became the lone player in the Big South to record 20 or more points in back-to-back games on two separate occasions. VICTORIA HAMILTON recorded her second career double-double with 15 points and 12 rebounds. It was also Hamilton's third straight game with 10 or more rebounds. Radford jumped out to a quick 8-0 lead to start the game against Virginia, with all 8 points scored by ASHLEY BUCKHANNON. However, Virginia responded with a 25-4 run and went on to win 43-92. For the week, Buckhannon averaged 14.5 points per contest and she netted a team-high 14 against the Cavaliers. Despite the loss, Radford continued its great free throw shooting, going 11-for-14 and remains atop the Big South in that category, shooting 74 percent as a team.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville went 0-2 on the week with losses to Kennesaw State and South Carolina State. Freshmen BRITTANY GWYN and SHONESE JONES each scored career-highs and KELLI RILES picked up her fourth double-double of the season, but the Bulldogs could not survive a furious second-half rally by Kennesaw State as UNC Asheville fell to the Owls 83-79 at the KSU Convocation Center on Saturday evening. Jones then scored another career high against SCSU on Monday, tallying 30 points for the Blue & White. Senior guard LINDSEY THOMPSON set the UNC Asheville record for career 3-pointers against George Mason on 11/27. She now has 176 for her career, breaking the record of Brittany Hendley, who played for the Bulldogs from 2003-07. Thompson also needs just 141 points to reach 1,000 for her career. Riles collected her 500th career rebound against Upstate. She now has 543 rebounds and is the 12th player in school history to grab more than 500 rebounds. Junior forward Riles started the season with a bang as she tallied 21 points and a then career-high 24 rebounds against the Rams. The 13-of-13 effort just missed the school record of 14-of-14 from Tara McMinn set in the 1990-91 season. Riles is the first Asheville player to record a 20-20 since Sheila Ford accomplished the feat in the 1983-84 season. Sheila Ford accomplished the feat in the 1983-84 season.

Through 10 games, DIANA CHOIBEKOVA has knocked down 41 threes and leads the nation in threes made per game. Her 41 triples are more than halfway to the school record for threes in a single season. That record is 73, held by Tiffany Rodd. Rodd did that during the 2007-08 season. Choibekova needs to average just 1.6-1.8 threes made per game the rest of the season to break Rodd's record. She already set the single-game record for threes made with nine in the win over Niagara. Winthrop scored 88 points on the road at Monmouth on Dec. 14. It was the most on the road since the 1996-97 team put up 90 at Radford in a 110-90 loss.


