Parker shot 78 percent from the field and averaged 18 points and 19.5 rebounds per game to lead her squad to a pair of Big South wins last week. The center got her week started with 14 points on 72 percent shooting, to go along with 22 rebounds, two assists, eight blocks and a steal in High Point's win over Coastal Carolina on Jan. 21. Two days later against Charleston Southern, Parker stayed hot as she poured in 22 points on 82 percent shooting. She also pulled down 17 boards, recorded four blocks and came away with four steals in the win. The honor marks her first Big South Player of the Week nod this season.

WELCOME TO THE BIG SOUTH CONFERENCE

On Monday, Jan. 23 the Big South Conference welcomed Longwood to the League. Longwood will begin play in the Big South starting in the 2012-13 season. The addition of the Lancers gives the Big South 12 members, the most ever members in the League's history.

NUMBER ONE STUNNER

High Point's **SHAMIA BROWN** became HPU's Division I scoring leader with her 13 points against Charleston Southern on Jan. 23. She surpasses former teammate **JURICA HARGRAVES** who set the record last season.

RECORD SETTER

DIANA CHOIBEKOVA tied the Big South single-game record for three-pointers against Gardner-Webb on Jan. 16. The junior cashed in on 10 triples in the contest as she connected on 59 percent of her attempts (10-of-17).

OFFENSIVE MINDED

Charleston Southern has found itself among the national leaders in two offensive categories. The Bucs currently rank No. 3 in the nation with 9.3 triples per game and are No. 28 in the nation with 73.1 points per game.

BURN'N UP THE BOARDS

The Lady Flames have established themselves as one of the top rebounding teams in the country. Liberty currently sits at No. 1 in the nation with a 16.8 rebound margin.

COMING IN HOT

The High Point Panthers have gotten their League slate off to a hot start. They are the only team in the Big South that is undefeated as HPU sits at 7-0. Its seven wins ties for the best Conference start in school history as the Panthers started the League slate 7-0 during the 2005-06 season.

WINNING THE REBOUND WAR(LEY)

Liberty's **EVERY WARLEY** has taken over No. 2 all-time on the Big South rebounding chart with 1,094. At her current pace of 10.7 rebounds per game, she will easily break the all-time mark of 1,127 held by **KATE SANFORD** of Charleston Southern (1996-00).

GOT THAT ONE OUT OF THE WAY

High Point head coach **JENNIFER HOOVER** picked up her first Big South win during the Christmas break with an 89-49 win over UNC Asheville on New Year's Eve... Winthrop's **MARLENE STOLLINGS** grabbed her first Big South win on Jan. 7 as Winthrop downed Presbyterian College.

BCS BUSTERS

The first weekend in December proved to be a big one for the Big South Conference. On Friday, Dec. 2, **ERIN REYNOLDS** of High Point fueled the Panther offense with 36 points to lead High Point to the 82-75 win over Pitt of the Big East ... Two days later, Charleston Southern's **LAKEITHA ALSTON** posted a 31-point, 10 rebound double-double in the Bucs' 82-77 win over Clemson of the ACC.

THAT'S RIGHT ICE-MAN ... I AM DANGEROUS

Junior guard **DIANA CHOIBEKOVA** has established herself as one of the League's most dangerous shooters from beyond the arc. She currently ranks No. 1 in all of Division I with 4.3 triples per game. She has also scored in double-digits in all but three games this season and has posted two games with at least 30 points... Teammate **SAMIYA WRIGHT** has also been locked in from downtown. Her clip of 49 percent from long-range tops the nation.

QUEEN BEE

DEQUESHA McCLANAHAN is the League's leading scorer with 19.4 points per contest to rank No. 20 in the nation. Scoring isn't the only way McClanahan is generating offense for the Eagles as she is currently ranked No. 5 in the country with 7.4 assists per game.

FEAR OF REJECTION?

High Point's **CHEYENNE PARKER** has made a name for herself in the post this season. She currently ranks No. 7 in the nation with 3.2 blocked shots per game. She posted a season-high six rejections vs. Davidson on Nov. 18. She is also currently ranked No. 5 in the country with 11 double-doubles and is currently riding a streak of six games with 10-or-more rebounds, including a career-best 22 boards against Coastal Carolina on Jan. 21.

20/20

UNC Asheville's **KELLI RILES** set a new Big South single-game standard for rebounds as she pulled down 28 rebounds in Asheville's win over USC Upstate on Nov. 30. The game marked the second time this season that she has posted a game with 20-or-more rebounds as she pulled down 24 against Winston-Salem State in the opening game of the season ... In the game vs. WSSU, she also became the only player this season with a 20-point, 20-rebound double-double ... Her 11.4 rebounds per game is currently ranked No. 5 in the nation.

SCORE'N AND DISH'N

Winthrop's **DEQUESHA McCLANAHAN** and **TONISHA BAKER** of Campbell have each posted double-doubles with 10 assists. McClanahan has posted two games with at least 20 points and 10 helpers. McClanahan's season-high came against PC on Jan. 7 as she posted 32 points and 10 assists... Baker scored 18 points and posted 10 assists against Winston-Salem State.

DOUBLE-TROUBLE

The Big South has two student-athletes currently averaging a double-double in points and rebounds this season. High Point's **CHEYENNE PARKER** is averaging 13.7 points and 12.3 rebounds per game, while **EVERY WARLEY** of Liberty is averaging 14.5 points and 10.7 boards per game. Warley is ranked No. 11 in the country and Parker sits at No. 4 in Division I.

TWIN KILL'N

This season the Big South Conference has had eight teammates go for 20 points in the same contest. During all of last season the Big South only saw seven sets of teammates go for 20 points in the same game.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

CAMPBELL

Campbell improved to 8-0 at home with wins over Charleston Southern and Coastal Carolina. The Lady Camels have won 17 of their last 19 in Buies Creek. CU downed Charleston Southern 70-56 on Saturday in Gore Arena, holding the Big South's leader in scoring (74.1 ppg prior to Saturday), three-pointers made per game (9.5), field goal percentage (43.9 percent) and three-point field goal percentage (35.7 percent) well below its season averages. The Buccaneers hit 7-of-31 three point attempts for a 22.6 percent rate and shot 30.8 percent overall on the afternoon. Against Coastal, the Lady Camels faced a 10-point halftime deficit after the Chanticleers shot 60 percent in the first. After trailing by as many as 11 in the first half, **TONISHA BAKER** started off the second frame for Campbell with a pair of layups in the opening minute, slicing the Chanticleer lead to six at 34-28. The junior then posted another two buckets after a CCU three, finishing off an 8-3 run to bring the Lady Camels within five with 16:45 to play. Following two made free throws from Coastal's **ALEX PUCKETT**, Campbell continued its run, as **JAZMINE COOPER**, **KATE CLOXTON** and **KATELYN BASS** combined on seven-straight CU points, knotting the game at 39-all with 12:08 on the clock. The spurt completed a 15-5 Campbell run over the first 7:52 of the second half. Campbell owned a 36-20 advantage in the paint, and converted 14 fast break points compared to just two for Coastal. The Lady Camels also doubled-up the Chanticleers in points off the bench, 18-9. Campbell held its opponent under 60 points for the ninth time this season, while forcing 20 turnovers for the seventh time. Campbell took the 58-55 win behind that second half surge. Campbell owned a 36-20 advantage in the paint, and converted 14 fast break points compared to just two for Coastal. The Lady Camels also doubled-up the Chanticleers in points off the bench, 18-9. Campbell held its opponent under 60 points for the ninth time this season, while forcing 20 turnovers for the seventh time.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Buccaneers played without a healthy point guard for most of the High Point contest, as **SHAY JONES** joined **KIKI RUTLEDGE** and **HELEN TERRY** on the injured list... CSU's three losses in the past two weeks mark just the second losing streak the Bucs had all season (lost to UNC Wilmington and Florida in back-to-back games in mid-December)... The Bucs committed a season-high 27 turnovers vs. the Panthers... Their 15-of-17 from the charity stripe vs. Campbell was their second-best percentage of the season (.882)... HPU's 84 points was the most allowed by the Bucs this season, as was their 73 field goal attempts... Meanwhile, their 56 points at Campbell was the lowest total put up by CSU in 2011-12... **RACHELLE COWARD** became the 11th player this season to shoot 100 percent at the free-throw line vs. Campbell (5-5)... **LAKEITHA ALSTON** has scored in double figures in five consecutive games and 16 of 19 games thus far... Coward is currently on a seven game double-digit scoring streak.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina dropped both of its games on the week falling at High Point (80-65) and at Campbell (58-55) ... The Chanticleers were hindered by 45 total turnovers on the week that led to 47 points by their opponents (21 turnover/23 points off turnovers vs. High Point, 24 turnovers/24 points off turnovers vs. Campbell) ... Freshman **SHATIA COLE** led the team with 34 points on the week, including a career and Coastal season-high 20 points at High Point ... Coastal shot 44.0 percent from three (11-of-25) on the week to up its season average from 26.3 to 28.0 ... Sophomore **SHANIKA MADDOX** returned to the starting lineup and was Coastal's leading rebounder after missing four games and parts of two others due to an injury ... The Chants will play its last of three straight on the road at Charleston Southern on Saturday.

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb was once more haunted by a slow start on Saturday afternoon, as the Runnin' Bulldogs fell behind Asheville 29-7 in the first nine minutes of the game to put themselves in a huge deficit off of the opening tip. After cutting the lead to 19 at the half (39-20), GWU held Asheville scoreless for eight minutes in the second half, cutting the lead to six with four minutes to play. However, despite outscoring Asheville 42-35 in the second half, the 19-point halftime lead was too large, as GWU fell at Asheville, 74-62. Gardner-Webb is 0-15 when trailing at the halftime break this season. In the loss, GWU had three players post career-highs in points, while sophomore center **CATRINA GREEN** had her sixth double-double of the year. Gardner-Webb will look for some home cooking this weekend, as the Runnin' Bulldogs will host Radford and Liberty in a three-day span. GWU will host Radford at 5 p.m. on Saturday and then Liberty on Monday night at 7 p.m., with both contests coming in Paul Porter Arena.

HIGH POINT

High Point improved to 12-6 overall and a perfect 7-0 in the Big South thanks to wins over Coastal Carolina and Charleston Southern at the Millis Center. The Panthers picked up an 80-65 win over the Chanticleers and followed it up with an 84-58 win over the Lady Buccaneers. HPU forced 48 turnovers in the two games and had 37 steals. Junior **ERIN REYNOLDS** finished one steal shy of a triple-double against CCU, scoring 25 points, dishing out a career-high 10 assists and nabbing a career-high nine steals. Sophomore **CHEYENNE PARKER** set a new HPU Div. I single-game record in the contest, pulling down 22 rebounds to go along with 14 points and a career-high eight blocks. Parker continued her strong play against Charleston Southern where she had 22 points, 17 rebounds, four blocks and four steals. High Point suffocated the league's top scoring offense, limiting the Buccaneers to just 47 shots in the game and forcing 27 turnovers. Along with Parker, four other High Point players scored in double digits against CSU, including senior **SHAMIA BROWN** who scored 13 points and moved into first place on the HPU Div. I career scoring list with 1,333 points. Brown passed former teammate **JURICA HARGRAVES** who set the record in the final game of the 2010-11 season.

LIBERTY

Liberty won home games against Presbyterian College and Winthrop, boosting its season-long winning streak to five contests ... The Lady Flames have won those five games by an average of 25.2 points/game ... Liberty's 59-39 win over Presbyterian College improved the Lady Flames' all-time record against the Blue Hose to 8-0 ... The Lady Flames then defeated Winthrop, 74-49, on Monday, posting their eighth straight win over the Eagles and their 20th straight home win against Winthrop ... It was also the 24th straight time Liberty has held the Eagles below 60 points ... UNC Asheville went 1-0 on the week with a 74-62 victory over Gardner-Webb. Shonese Jones scored a game-high 27 points while fellow underclassman LEAH WORMACK recorded her second career double-double as the two helped lead the Bulldogs to the 12-point win. Asheville is 7-11 overall with a 7-2 mark at home and a 0-9 mark on the road. The Bulldogs are also 3-4 in Big South play. Junior guard GRACE BLAYLOCK set the UNC Asheville record for 3-pointers in a game with seven against Winthrop on Jan. 14, 2012. Blaylock connected on 7-of-14 from behind the arc. She posted a career-high 23 points in the process. The previous record was six, held by four different players. Wormack has been named the Big South Freshman of the Week three times on the season. Freshman guard SHONESE JONES has been named the Big South Player of the Week and the Big South Freshman of the Week twice. Senior guard LINDSEY THOMPSON set the UNC Asheville record for career 3-pointers against George Mason on 11/27. She now has 186 for her career, breaking the record of Brittany Hendley, who played for the Bulldogs from 2003-07. Thompson also needs just 34 points to reach 1,000 for her career (966). KELLI RILES collected her 600th career rebound against Charleston Southern. She now has 639 rebounds, which ranks eighth all time at UNC Asheville, and is the ninth player in school history to grab more than 600 rebounds.

WINTHROP

Winthrop went 1-1 on the weekend swing through Virginia. On Saturday, MARLENE STOLLINGS became the first coach in Winthrop history to defeat Radford in their first try. The victory at the Dedmon Center was just the fourth ever for Winthrop. DIANA CHOIBEKOVA scored 25 points against the Highlanders as she hit six threes and in the process became the single season record holder for triples at Winthrop. She passed Tiffany Rodd's record of 74 from the 2007-08 season. Choibekova had four more at Liberty and now has 81 in her career. 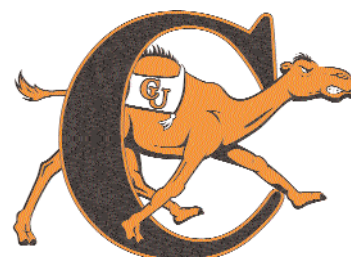

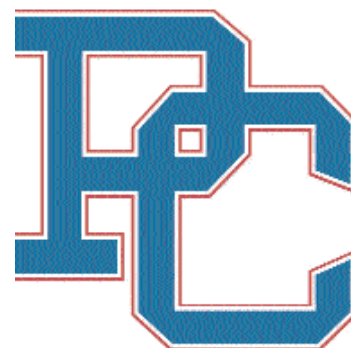
