Choibekova averaged 28 points per game, shot 52 percent from downtown and connected on 53 percent from the field to lead Winthrop to a 2-0 record last week. The guard got her week started with 24 points on 50 percent from the floor and 41 percent cent from the floor and 41 percent from long range, to go along with 11 rebounds and two steals in Winthrop's win over UNC Asheville on Jan. 14. Two days later against Gardner-Webb, Choibekova tied the Big South single game three-point record as she connected on 10-of-17 and added 10-of-18 from the field and two from the stripe to finish with 32 points in the Eagles' win over Gardner-Webb. She also pulled down four rebounds and dished out three assists against the Runnin' Bulldogs. The honor marks her first Big South Player of the Week The honor marks her nod of her career.

THE CRONS BRAND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

Jones, a freshman guard from Etowah, N.C., posted a pair of double-digit scoring games for UNC Asheville this past week, posting 15 points against Winthrop and 16 points against Presbyterian. She also connected on 7-of-8 free throws and shot 33 percent for the week. The award marks her second Freshman of the Week plaudit this season.

RECORD SETTER

DIANA CHOIBEKOVA tied the Big South single-game record for three-pointers against Gardner-Webb on Jan. 16. The junior cashed in on 10 triples in the contest as she connected on 59 percent of her attempts (10-of-17).

Charleston Southern has found itself among the national leaders in two offensive categories. The Bucs currently rank No. 3 in the nation with 9.3 triples per game and are No. 25 in the nation with 74.7 points per game.

BURN'N UP THE BOARDS

The Lady Flames have established themselves as one of the top rebounding teams in the country. Liberty currently sits at No. 3 in the nation with a 16.0 rebound margin.

COMING IN HOT

The High Point Panthers have gotten their League slate off to a hot start. They are the only team in the Big South that is undefeated as HPU sits at 5-0.

WINNING THE REBOUND WAR(LEY)

Liberty's AVERY WARLEY has taken over No. 2 all-time on the Big South rebounding chart with 1,076. At her current pace of 10.9 rebounds per game, she will easily break the all-time mark held by KATE SANFORD of Charleston Southern (1996-00)

GOT THAT ONE OUT OF THE WAY

High Point head coach JENNIFER HOOVER picked up her first Big South win during the Christmas break with an 89-49 win over UNC Asheville on New Year's Eve.

BCS BUSTERS

The first weekend in December proved to be a big one for the Big South Conference. On Friday, Dec. 2, ERIN REYNOLDS of High Point fueled the Panther offense with 36 points to lead High Point to the 82-75 win over Pitt of the Big East ... Two days later, Charleston Southern's LAKEITHA ALSTON posted a 31-point, 10 rebound double-double in the Bucs' 82-77 win over Clemson of the ACC.

THAT'S RIGHT ICE-MAN ... I AM DANGEROUS
Junior guard DIANA CHOIBEKOVA has established herself as one of the League's most dangerous shooters from beyond the arc. She currently ranks No. 1 in all of Division I with 3.8 triples per game. She has also scored in double-digits in all but three games this season, including 33 points against Niagra.

DEQUESHA McCLANAHAN is the League's leading scorer with 20.0 points per contest to rank No. 15 in the nation. Scoring isn't the only way McClanahan is generating offense for the Eagles as she is currently ranked No. 5 in the country with 7.1 assists per game. She is the only player in the nation that ranks in the top 15 in scoring and the top 10 in assists.

High Point's CHEYENNE PARKER has made a name for herself in the post this season. She currently ranks No. 11 in the nation with 2.9 blocked shots per game. She posted a season-high six rejections vs. Davidson on Nov. 18. She is also currently ranked No. 4 in the country with 10 double-doubles and has a streak of four games with at least 10 rebounds on two occasions this season.

20/20

UNC Asheville's KELLI RILES set a new Big South single-game standard for rebounds as she pulled down 28 rebounds in Asheville's win over USC Upstate on Nov. 30. The game marked the second time this season that she has posted a game with 20-or-more rebounds as she pulled down 24 against Winston-Salem State in the opening game of the season ... In the game vs. WSSU, she also became the only player this season with a 20-point, 20-rebound double-double ... Her 11.8 rebounds per game is currently ranked No. 5 in the nation.

SCORE'N AND DISH'N

Winthrop's DEQUESHA McCLANAHAN and TONISHA BAKER of Campbell have each posted double-doubles with 10 assists. McClanahan has posted two games with at least 20 points and 10 helpers. McClanahan's season-high came against PC on Jan. 7 as she posted 32 points and 10 assists... Baker scored 18 points and posted 10 assists against Winston-Salem State.

DOUBLE-TROUBLE

The Big South has two student-athletes currently averaging a double-double in points and rebounds this season. High Point's CHEYENNE PARKER is averaging 13.2 points and 11.4 rebounds per game, while AVERY WARLEY of Liberty is averaging 14.5 points and 10.9 boards per game. Warley is ranked No. 11 in the country and Parker sits at No. 8 in Division I.

This season the Big South Conference has had eight teammates go for 20 points in the same contest. During all of last season the Big South only saw seven sets of teammates go for 20 points in the same game.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

Campbell dipped to 2-3 in Big South play last week with a 77-65 loss at High Point. The Lady Camels erased an 18-point deficit with 6:31 remaining to pull within seven with four minutes to play, but fell short. JAZMINE COOPER posted 14 of her career-high 17 points in the second half, including 12 in the final 6:06. TONISHA BAKER also gathered 11 of her 16 points in the second frame, including seven in that late surge. The teams combined for 90 points in the paint and 38 second chance points. HPU posted 14 fast break points, including 12 in the first half. The Panthers also turned 10 first half Campbell turnovers into 13 points. The Lady Camels return home this week, where the team is 6-0 this season.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Bucs split this week's series, taking a 79-69 win over Radford on Saturday but falling to Liberty 79-64 on Monday... the loss was just their second home defeat of the season... LAKEITHA ALSTON notched her third double-double of the season vs. the Highlanders, posting 22 points and 10 rebounds... She also had double-doubles vs. Furman (19 pts, 10 rebounds) and Clemson (31 points, 10 rebounds)... Is the only Bucs to grab doubledigit boards this season... The Bucs' 24 free-throws made and 33 attempted vs. Radford were both season highs... Shay Jones was the leader at the charity stripe, going 8-for-11... RACHELLE COWARD tied the CSU single-game 3-point record with nine treys... KATIE TULL set the school mark last season vs. Voorhees... Coward finished the night a 3-pointer short of tying the Big South record of 10 ... She also put up a career high 32 points... Her performance ranks as the 10th-best in CSU history... The Bucs' 41 rebonds vs. Radford was a season-high and was coincidentally followed by a season-low 15 vs. Liberty.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina split its pair of games this week falling to a hot shooting Liberty team 82-45 on Saturday and defeating Radford 58-56 on Monday ... The Chants win over Radford snaps a three game losing streak, all coming against Big South opponents ... Coastal's 10 wins in 15 games this season matches the team's total wins in 29 contests last season ... OLIVIA IRICK led the Chants with 22 points over the two games, including the game-winner against Radford ... Irick made a pair of 3-pointers on against Radford to the her for 10th all-time in the Coastal record books with 93 career triples ... SHANIKA MADDOX made her return to court against Radford to the tune of six points and seven boards after missing the previous four contests with an injury ... The Chants will play its next three away from Kimbel Arena starting High Point on Saturday.

Gardner-Webb fell victim to long scoring droughts and deadly shooting by their opponents, as the Runnin' Bulldogs went 0-2 for the week with road losses at Presbyterian and at Winthrop. In the loss to PC on Saturday afternoon, Gardner-Webb saw an early five point lead evaporate as the Runnin' Bulldogs went nearly 10 minutes without a field goal in the first half to fall behind by double-digits at the break. Despite outscoring PC in the second half, timely outside shots by both Chelsea Parker and Karlee Taylor kept the Blue Hose in front, who defeated GWU 54-43. The Blue Hose shot 43.6 percent from the floor overall for the game, outscoring GWU 30-18 in points in the paint and 15-3 in second chance points. On Monday night, the Runnin' Bulldogs had their winning streak over Winthrop snapped at eight games, as the Lady Eagles drained a school-record 17 three-pointers to defeat GWU 86-48 in Rock Hill, S.C. After having four players average double figures in points last season, the Runnin' Bulldogs have struggled for scoring all season long. Outside of CATRINA GREENs 10.6 points per game, no other Runnin' Bulldogs is averaging more than eight points per contest. GWU's opponents are shooting almost a full 10 percent higher from the floor, while the Runnin' Bulldogs are shooting only 25.6 percent from behind the three-point line on the season. Gardner-Webb will look to wrap up its three game road trip with a "W", as the Runnin' Bulldogs will take on the UNC Asheville Bulldogs this Saturday afternoon at 2 p.m. in Asheville, N.C.

HIGH POINT

High Point improved to 5-0 in the Big South with a 77-65 win over Campbell on Saturday. Senior SHAMIA BROWN finished with 25 points on 12-17 shooting to go along with five rebounds, two blocks and two assists. It was the forwards third 20-point game of the season. Junior ERIN REYNOLDS and sophomore CHEYENNE PARKER also scored in double figures as Reynolds finished with 15 points and six assists and Parker recorded her 10th double-double with 12 points and 14 rebounds. TAYLER TREMBLAY led the team with eight assists in the contest. The Panthers built their lead up to 18 points in the second half and weathered a late Campbell run which cut the lead to seven before ultimatly winning by 12. The double-digit win was HPU's fourth in five conference games.

Liberty went 2-0 on its road trip to Coastal Carolina, winning its 37th straight head-to-head matchup with the Chanticleers and claiming victory in its 50th all-time meeting against the Buccaneers ... With the wins, the Lady Flames claimed sole possession of second place in the Big South standings at 4-1 and improved to 79-10 in Big South road games under head coach CAREY GREEN ... Liberty took control of the game at Coastal Carolina by shooting 78.3 percent from the field during the first half ... The Lady Flames' 82 points against the Chanticleers gave them back-to-back 80-point showings in Big South Conference play for the first time since Feb. 12 & 17, 2000 ... On Monday at Charleston Southern, Liberty won its first game when trailing at halftime this season, thanks to a 56-point second-half scoring outburst ... AVERY WARLEY led the way, with 22 of her season-high 26 points coming after the break ... DEVON BROWN totaled 39 points on the weekend, moving into ninth place in program history with 1,163 career

PRESBYTERIAN

PC picked up two consecutive wins in conference play, knocking off Gardner-Webb, 54-43, before downing UNC Asheville, 62-54... The Blue Hose set a Division I-era single-game record with eight blocks against Gardner-Webb and followed up on Monday with seven against UNC Asheville... SHERECE SMITH grabbed 15 rebounds against the Bulldogs, the most since Chelsea Wright did it on March 5, 2010. The feat matches the second most in PCs Division I history... SHONDA BURNSIDE turned in two impressive games, collected a career-high 12 rebounds against Gardner-Webb before scoring a season-high 11 points against UNC Asheville... DRIA DAVID converted five field goals in three straight games before hitting two against Asheville, marking the longest such stretch of her career.

RADFORD

Radford lost both league contests against Charleston Southern and Coastal Carolina this weekend. The Highlanders dropped to 1-4 in the conference with the two setbacks. Radford held the lead early and shot 47 percent from the field but couldn't overcome the Buccaneers second half free throw shooting, as they knocked down 21. DA'NARIA ERWIN SPENCER had a team-high 17 points, including three treys, while freshman AYANA AVERY tallied 15 off the bench. The Coastal Carolina matchup was tight the entire game. Radford took the lead with an ASHLEY BUCKHANNON free throw with 7 seconds remaining but OLIVIA IRICK drove down the court and hit a three-point play to give Coastal a slim two-point victory. Erwin Spencer recorded her sixth 20-plus point outing this season with a game-high 24 points.

UNIC Asheville went 0-2 on the week, with losses to Big South Conference foes Winthrop and Presbyterian College. Asheville dropped an 84-68 decision to the Lady Eagles on Saturday and then fell to PC 62-54. The Bulldogs have yet to win a road game this season, having lost all nine away games. Junior guard GRACE BLAYLOCK set the UNC Asheville record for 3-pointers in a game with seven against Wintrhop on Jan. 14, 2012. Blaylock connected on 7-of-14 from behind the arc. She posted a career-high 23 points in the process. The previous record was six, held by four different players. Senior guard LINDSEY THOMPSON set the UNC Asheville record for career 3-pointers against George Mason on 11/27. She now has 184 for her career, breaking the record of Brittany Hendley, who played for the Bulldogs from 2003-07. Thompson also needs just 46 points to reach 1,000 for her career (954). KELLI RILES enjoyed her sixth double-double of the season at Winthrop with 12 points and 14 rebounds. Riles collected her 600th career rebound against Charleston Southern. She now has 634 rebounds, which ranks eighth all time at UNC Asheville, and is the ninth player in school history to grab more than 600 rebounds.

Winthrop went 2-0 after recording 80 or more points in back-to-back games for the first time since the end of the 2002 season. In the two games, Winthrop was an impressive 26-for-55 behind the arc and shot 44 percent from the field. The team only averaged 13 turnovers per game and forced 20.5 turnovers (13.5 steals per game). The Lady Eagles came out firing threes Monday night against Gardner-Webb and it never seemed to stop as they broke the school record with a total of 17 triples. That's one shy of the conference record set by Charleston Southern, which it did twice in the same season (2011). Winthrop was 17-for-30 behind the arc Monday night. The previous record was 13 set on Jan. 16, 2002 against Liberty at home. Another record broken on the night was by DIANA CHOIBEKOVA as she broke her own school record of threes in a game with 10. She was 10-for-17 from deep and finished with 32 points, her second 30-point game of the season. Choibekova is now averaging 4.2 threes per game and was leading the nation going into the game against Gardner-Webb. She's also now just two baskets away from tying the school record for threes in a season. TIFFANY RODD set the record of 73 in 2006-07. The win also marked the first victory over the Runnin' Bulldlogs since they became a member of the Big South. The previous win came in 2002 and Gardner-Webb went on to win eight straight. Choibekova wasn't the only offensive bright spot for Winthrop as freshman SAMIYA WRIGHT averaged 18 points, 4.0 rebounds, 4.5 assists and 2.0 steals while shooting 44 percent and 53 percent behind the arc. Wright set a personal best when she hit six threes against Gardner-Webb. The team's leading scorer, DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN, averaged 16.5 points and 10 assists as she set a career-high on Saturday with 12 assists as she recorded her fourth double-double of the season.


