Erwin Spencer averaged 21 points and shot 50 percent from the floor to lead the Highlanders to a pair of League wins last week. She got her week started with 21 points on 55 percent from the floor, one from downtown and a perfect 8-of-8 from the stripe to lead Radford to the 63-50 win over Gardner-Webb on Jan. 28. Two days later against UNC Asheville, the guard stayed hot as she connected on 47 percent from the floor and 7-of-8 from the line to finish with 21 points, including nine-straight points late in regulation to push Radford to the 72-62 win over the Bulldogs. In the two-game span, Erwin Spencer also chipped in five assists, five steals, three boards and a block. The honor marks her third Big South Player of the Week nod this season.

## WELCOME TO THE BIG SOUTH CONFERENCE

On Monday, Jan. 23 the Big South Conference welcomed Longwood to the League. Longwood will begin play in the Big South starting in the 2012-13 season. The addition of the Lancers gives the Big South 12 members, the most ever members in the League's history.

## NUMBER ONE STUNNER

High Point's **SHAMIA BROWN** became HPU's Division I scoring leader with her 13 points against Charleston Southern on Jan. 23. She surpassed former teammate **JURICA HARGRAVES** who set the record last season.

## RECORD SETTERS

**DIANA CHOIBEKOVA** tied the Big South single-game record for three-pointers against Gardner-Webb on Jan. 16. The junior cashed in on 10 triples in the contest as she connected on 59 percent of her attempts (10-of-17) ... Also **CHEYENNE PARKER** tied a Big South single-game record as she recorded 10 blocks vs. Winthrop on Jan. 28.

## RAIN MAKERS

Charleston Southern has found itself among the national leaders in three-point field goals per game. The Bucs currently rank No. 4 in the nation with 9.1 triples per game.

## BURN'N UP THE BOARDS

The Lady Flames have established themselves as one of the top rebounding teams in the country. Liberty currently sits at No. 1 in the nation with a 16.0 rebound margin.

## COMING IN HOT

The High Point Panthers have gotten their League slate off to a hot start. They are the only team in the Big South that is undefeated as HPU sits at 9-0. Its nine-straight wins set the High Point standard for the best Conference start in school history.

## WINNING THE REBOUND WAR(LEY)

Liberty's **EVERY WARLEY** has taken over No. 2 all-time on the Big South rebounding chart with 1,094. At her current pace of 10.8 rebounds per game, she will easily break the all-time mark of 1,127 held by **KATE SANFORD** of Charleston Southern (1996-00) sometime this week or next.

## GOT THAT ONE OUT OF THE WAY

High Point head coach **JENNIFER HOOVER** picked up her first Big South win during the Christmas break with an 89-49 win over UNC Asheville on New Year's Eve... Winthrop's **MARLENE STOLLINGS** grabbed her first Big South win on Jan. 7 as Winthrop downed Presbyterian College.

## BCS BUSTERS

The first weekend in December proved to be a big one for the Big South Conference. On Friday, Dec. 2, **ERIN REYNOLDS** of High Point fueled the Panther offense with 36 points to lead High Point to the 82-75 win over Pitt of the Big East ... Two days later, Charleston Southern's **LAKEITHA ALSTON** posted a 31-point, 10 rebound double-double in the Bucs' 82-77 win over Clemson of the ACC.

## THAT'S RIGHT ICE-MAN ... I AM DANGEROUS

Junior guard **DIANA CHOIBEKOVA** has established herself as one of the League's most dangerous shooters from beyond the arc. She currently ranks No. 1 in all of Division I with 4.2 triples per game. She has also scored in double-digits in 16 games this season and has posted two games with at least 30 points.

## QUEEN BEE

**DEQUESHA McCLANAHAN** is the League's leading scorer with 19.6 points per contest to rank No. 18 in the nation. Scoring isn't the only way McCLANAHAN is generating offense for the Eagles as she is currently ranked No. 4 in the country with 7.4 assists per game.

## FEAR OF REJECTION?

High Point's **CHEYENNE PARKER** has made a name for herself in the post this season. She currently ranks No. 4 in the nation with 3.6 blocked shots per game. Against Winthrop, she tied the Big South single-season standard with 10 blocked shot. She is also currently ranked No. 2 in the country with 13 double-doubles and posted a streak of seven games with 10-or-more rebounds, including a career-best 22 boards against Coastal Carolina on Jan. 21. In the game vs. Winthrop she notched the League's only triple-double this season as she finished with 13 points, 22 rebounds and 10 blocks.

## 20/20

UNC Asheville's **KELLI RILES** set a new Big South single-game standard for rebounds as she pulled down 28 rebounds in Asheville's win over USC Upstate on Nov. 30. The game marked the second time this season that she has posted a game with 20-or-more rebounds as she pulled down 24 against Winston-Salem State in the opening game of the season ... In the game vs. WSSU, she also became the only player this season with a 20-point, 20-rebound double-double ... Her 11.2 rebounds per game is currently ranked No. 6 in the nation.

## SCORE'N AND DISH'N

Winthrop's **DEQUESHA McCLANAHAN** and **TONISHA BAKER** of Campbell have each posted double-doubles with 10 assists. McCLANAHAN has posted two games with at least 20 points and 10 helpers. McCLANAHAN's season-high came against Campbell on Jan. 30 as she posted 15 helpers and 23 points... Baker scored 18 points and posted 10 assists against Winston-Salem State.

## DOUBLE-TROUBLE

The Big South has two student-athletes currently averaging a double-double in points and rebounds this season. High Point's **CHEYENNE PARKER** is averaging 13.2 points and 12.6 rebounds per game, while **EVERY WARLEY** of Liberty is averaging 14.1 points and 10.8 boards per game. Parker's rebound average tops the nation, while Warley is ranked 13th.

## TWIN KILL'N

This season the Big South Conference has had 10 teammates go for 20 points in the same contest. During all of last season the Big South only saw seven sets of teammates go for 20 points in the same game.

## NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

## CAMPBELL

The Camels used a 15-2 run down the stretch to pick up their first Big South road win of the year after dropping their previous three conference outings away from Buies Creek. The win marked the 472nd of CU head coach WANDA WATKINS' career. Junior guard TONISHA BAKER paced the Lady Camels with 18 points at PC, adding four steals and three rebounds. JAZMINE COOPER, a junior forward, added 10 points and eight rebounds with a career-high six steals. Cooper has gathered 10 steals in her last two games. At Winthrop, Campbell led 57-50 with 10:45 to play before the Eagles put together a decisive 22-6 run to take an 11-point lead by the 2:33 mark. KATELYN BASS posted a career-best 20 points in the loss, hitting 8-of-12 attempts from the floor and 4-of-4 from the line. Fellow senior AMANDA O'NEILL tallied a season-best 13 points, hitting three triples, while tacking on five rebounds. Baker posted her team-high fifth double-double of the season with 10 points and 10 rebounds, adding a career-high three blocks along with three steals. KATE CLOXTON gathered nine points and nine assists, hitting three baskets from long range. With her three threes, the senior guard becomes Campbell's all-time leader in three pointers made with 146, passing SARA MOORE's total of 145. Campbell also tied its single-season blocks record with six over the weekend.

## CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Buccaneers broke a three-game Big South losing streak with their 69-66 win over Palmetto State foe Coastal Carolina... RACHELLE COWARD hit a near-half court buzzer beater for the win... The Bucs were once again without a point guard, as forwards LAKEITHA ALSTON and Coward were asked to step in... Coward once again tied her career-high and the school's 10th-best single game performance with 32 points... Alston recorded her fourth double-double of the season (11 pts, 12 reb)... Despite the injuries the Bucs still rank fourth in the NCAA with 9.1 3-pointers per game ... They continue to be among the nation's top offensive teams as well ranking 34th with 72.1 ppg ... Coward is 48th in scoring at 17.8 ppg while Alston is 30th in FG % at .531.

## COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina fell to Charleston Southern, 69-66, via a 35-foot 3-pointer as time expired in its only game of the week ... SHATIA COLE and OLIVIA IRICK scored 22 and 20 points, respectively, to become the first set of Chanticleer teammates to score 20-plus points in the same game since AMANDA STULL (23 points) SYDNEI MOSS (22 points) did so at Campbell on Nov. 16, 2009 ... Cole's 22 points were a career-high and Coastal Carolina season-high as Irick's 20 were a season-high ... Cole went 4-of-5 from beyond the arc, including two key threes in the final 17 second of the game ... SHANIKA MADDOX finished with 11 boards to eclipse the 10-plus rebounds plateau for the first time since returning from an injury ... Coastal hosts Gardner-Webb on Saturday and UNC Asheville on Monday, the Chants lost to both teams on the road in early January.

## GARDNER-WEBB

The Runnin' Bulldogs saw their current losing streak extend to five games, as Gardner-Webb suffered back-to-back home losses to Radford and Liberty this past week. GWU battled Radford for a very tough 20 minutes to start the contest, yet suffered a scoring lull in the early goings of the second half to fall behind in double-digits in the 63-50 loss. The same occurred in the game on Monday night versus Liberty, as GWU held an early lead, yet fell behind by way of a 26-8 run by Liberty to end the first half, as the Lady Flames led by double-digits the rest of the way in the 78-51 win. Gardner-Webb's 1-8 conference start is the worst that they have had in a single-season since joining the League back in 2008-09, while their 17 overall losses is the most they have had since dropping 18 back in 2007-08. Gardner-Webb will hit the road for their next two contests, as the Runnin' Bulldogs will take on the Coastal Carolina Chanticleers on Saturday at 4:30 p.m. and then will turn around to face off with the Buccaneers of Charleston Southern at 7 p.m. on Monday night.

## HIGH POINT

High Point wrapped up the first half of Big South play with a perfect 9-0 record thanks to wins at Winthrop and Presbyterian College. The start to conference play by HPU is the Panthers' best since joining the Big South. High Point picked up a hard fought 58-53 win at Winthrop thanks in large part to sophomore CHEYENNE PARKER who recorded HPU's first Div. I triple-double with 13 points, 22 rebounds and 10 blocks. Parker's 22 rebounds tied her own HPU single-game record and her 10 blocks tied both the Big South single-game record and the HPU single-game record. SHAMIA BROWN also recorded a double-double for HPU with a team-high 24 points and 10 rebounds. Against PC, High Point used a late run to pick up a 63-51 win in Clinton, S.C. ERIN REYNOLDS led HPU with 26 points on 8-18 shooting while Brown finished with 13 points and a team-high nine rebounds.

## LIBERTY

Liberty posted victories at UNC Asheville and Gardner-Webb, extending its season-long winning streak to seven games ... The Lady Flames have won six of those seven contests by 20 or more points ... Monday's victory at Gardner-Webb was No. 299 of CAREY GREEN's 13-year coaching career at victory ... He will have a chance at career win No. 300 Saturday at Campbell in what will be the 1,000th game in program history ... Another milestone could take place at Campbell, as AVERY WARLEY now has 1,117 career rebounds. She needs 11 more boards to break the Big South all-time record, currently held by former Charleston Southern standout KATE SANFORD ... Warley notched the 40th double-double of her career Monday at Gardner-Webb, which ranks No. 3 in program history ... DEVON BROWN had 25 points, nine rebounds, six assists and five steals at UNC Asheville on Saturday, marking the second time in her career she has totaled at least 25 points, five rebounds and five assists in the same game ... **UNC ASHEVILLE**

UNC Asheville went 0-2 on the week, falling to Liberty and Radford at Kimmel Arena. The Bulldogs led both teams heading into the half. Asheville is now 7-13 overall, 3-6 in the Big South, 7-4 on the road and 0-9 on the road. Asheville has yet to win on the road this year. The Blue & White have five road contests left this season. Senior guard **LINDSEY THOMPSON** currently leads the Big South and is fourth in the country in free throw percentage, with a mark of 91.4 percent. Junior guard **GRACE BLAYLOCK** set the UNC Asheville record for 3-pointers in a game with seven against Winthrop on Jan. 14, 2012. Blaylock connected on 7-of-14 from behind the arc. She posted a career-high 23 points in the process. The previous record was six, held by four different players. **LEAH WORMACK** has been named the Big South Freshman of the Week three times on the season. Freshman guard **SHONESE JONES** has been named the Big South Player of the Week and the Big South Freshman of the Week twice. Senior guard Thompson set the UNC Asheville record for career 3-pointers against George Mason on 11/27. She now has 188 for her career, breaking the record of **BRITTANY HENDLEY**, who played for the Bulldogs from 2003-07. Thompson also needs just 24 points to reach 1,000 for her career (976). **KELLI RILES** collected her 600th career rebound against Charleston Southern. She now has 656 rebounds, which ranks eighth all time at UNC Asheville, and is the ninth player in school history to grab more than 600 rebounds.

**WINTHROP**

Winthrop endured two different types of games over the weekend and came away with a 1-1 record after facing league-leading High Point and Campbell, which entered the game in third place in the Big South. The Lady Eagles dropped a close game on Saturday and rebounded to end its two-game skid with a rally from nine-points down to defeat Campbell 83-73. It was the seventh 80-point game of the season for Winthrop and its third in league games. Winthrop posted a season-high 50 points in the second half against the Camels. The win over Campbell marked the first one ever in a Big South league game, a record that stretched over 16 games so Winthrop is now 1-16 all-time against Campbell in conference games and just 5-19 all-time. **TAQUOIA HAMMICK** reached the 500 career rebound mark over the weekend and now has 504 in her career. She tied her career-high of 16 points in the win over Campbell. **DEQUESA MCCLANAHAN** dished out a career-high 15 assists in the win over Campbell on Monday night, tying the school's Division I record for most assists in a single game. The effort ties **SHEILA BAILEY**'s mark, which she achieved three different times. Bailey is Winthrop's all-time career leader in assists with 595. She entered the game ranked fourth nationally in assists per game. Over the weekend, McClanahan averaged 23.5 points, 10.5 assists, 5.0 rebounds and 2.5 steals. The double-double was McClanahan's fifth of the season. The 15 assists against High Point is tied for the third most in a single game this season. She scored 24 points against High Point and 23 points against Campbell and now has 11 games on the year with 20 or more points. With the 23 points against Campbell, she surpassed the 800 career point mark and is over 400 points on the season. She also has 272 career assists, which is just five shy of breaking into Winthrop's All-Time Top 10. Something she's accomplished in less than two seasons. Winthrop is closing in on the school record for threes made in a single season. Winthrop has 159 makes on the year and is now just six shy of tying the mark set by the 2006-07 team.

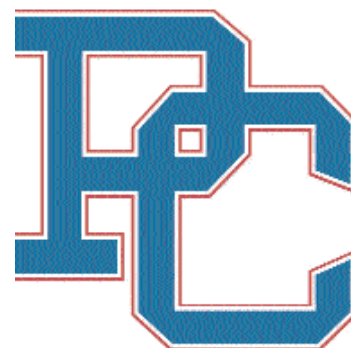
