Thompson shot 45 percent and averaged 22 points per game to lead her squad to a pair of wins over Coastal Carolina and Charleston Southern, who were both unbeaten in Big South play coming into the contests. The guard got her week started with 21 points on 46 percent from the floor, a pair from downtown and 4-of-4 from the line in the 69-60 win over Coastal Carolina on Jan. 7. She also chipped in three boards, eight assists and three steals against the Chanticleers, then ranked No. 34 in the CollegeInsider.com Mid Major Poll. Two days later against Charleston Southern, Thompson connected on 44 percent from the floor, 4of-8 from long range and 6-of-6 from the line to finish with 26 points as the Bulldogs downed the Bucs, 75-68. She also dished out seven helpers and came away with four boards and one steal in the win. The honor marks her first Player of the Week nod this season.

THE CRONS BRAND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

Leah Wormack F • UNC Asheville Cumberland, Md.

Wormack averaged 14 points per game and shot 63 percent from the field to help Asheville to two Big South wins last week. Against Coastal, Wormack posted a 17-point, 10-rebound double-double as she nailed 7-of-10 from the floor and added three from the charity stripe. She also chipped in three blocks and an assist in the win. She closed her week out with 11 points on 56 percent shooting, four rebounds and an assist in the win over Charleston Southern. The honor marks her third Big South Freshman of the Week plaudit this season.

BURN'N UP THE BOARDS

The Lady Flames have established themselves as one of the top rebounding teams in the country. Liberty currently sits at No. 3 in the nation with a 15.5 rebound margin.

COMING IN HOT

The High Point Panthers have gotten their League slate off to a hot start. They are the only team in the Big South that is undefeated as HPU sits at 4-0.

WINNING THE REBOUND WAR(LEY)

Liberty's AVERY WARLEY has taken over No. 2 all-time on the Big South rebounding chart with 1,055. At her current pace of 11.0 rebounds per game she will easily break the all-time mark held by KATE SANFORD of Charleston Southern (1996-00).

GOT THAT ONE OUT OF THE WAY

High Point head coach JENNIFER HOOVER picked up her first Big South win during the Christmas break with an 89-49 win over UNC Asheville on New Year's Eve.

BCS BUSTERS

The first weekend in December proved to be a big one for the Big South Conference. On Friday, Dec. 2, ERIN REYNOLDS of High Point fueled the Panther offense with 36 points to lead High Point to the 82-75 win over Pitt of the Big East ... Two days later, Charleston Southern's LAKEITHA ALSTON posted a 31-point, 10 rebound double-double in the Bucs' 82-77 win over Clemson of the ACC.

THAT'S RIGHT ICE-MAN ... I AM DANGEROUS

Junior guard DIANA CHOIBEKOVA has established herself as one of the League's most dangerous shooters from beyond the arc. She currently ranks No. 2 in all of Division I with 3.7 triples per game. She has also scored in double-digits in all but three games this season, including 33 points against Niagra.

NO. 1 STUNNER

DEQUESHA McCLANAHAN is the League's leading scorer with 20.5 points per contest to rank No. 15 in the nation. Scoring isn't the only way McClanahan is generating offense for the Eagles as she is currently ranked No. 6 in the country with 6.7 assists per game. She is the only player in the nation that ranks in the top 15 in scoring and the top 10 in assists.

FEAR OF REJECTION?

High Point's CHEYENNE PARKER has made a name for herself in the post this season. She currently ranks No. 9 in the nation with 2.9 blocked shots per game. She posted a season-high six rejections vs. Davidson on Nov. 18. She is also currently ranked No. 8 in the country with eight double-doubles and is the only player in the League with a streak of four-straight games with double-digit rebounds.

UNC Asheville's KELLI RILES set a new Big South single-game standard for rebounds as she pulled down 28 rebounds in Asheville's win over USC Upstate on Nov. 30. The game marked the second time this season that she has posted a game with 20-or-more rebounds as she pulled down 24 against Winston-Salem State in the opening game of the season ... In the game vs. WSSU, she also became the only player this season with a 20-point, 20rebound double-double ... Her 11.3 rebounds per game is currently ranked No. 7 in the nation.

SCORE'N AND DISH'N

Winthrop's DEQUESHA McCLANAHAN and TONISHA BAKER of Campbell have each posted double-doubles with 10 assists. McClanahan has posted two games with at least 20 points and 10 helpers. McClanahan's season high came against PC on Jan. 7 as she posted 32 points and 10 assists... Baker scored 18 points and posted 10 assists against Winston-Salem State.

DOUBLE-TROUBLE

The Big South has two student-athletes currently averaging a double-double in points and rebounds this season. High Point's CHEYENNE PARKER is averaging 13.3 points and 11.2 rebounds per game, while AVERY WARLEY of Liberty is averaging 14.0 points and 11.0 boards per game. Warley is ranked No. 8 in the country and Parker sits at No. 10 in Division I.

TWIN KILL'N

This season the Big South Conference has had eight teammates go for 20 points in the same contest. During all of last season the Big South only saw seven sets of teammates go for 20 points in the same game.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

Campbell dropped its first two Big South games during the week, falling at Radford and Liberty to dip to 2-2 in league play. At Liberty on Monday, Campbell's three seniors combined for 43 of the team's 61 points, led by KATE CLOXTON's 17. The guard hit five threes for the second time this season in the loss, adding eight assists. Forward KATELYN BASS posted 16 points for the second straight game, hitting 6-of-12 attempts, with six rebounds. Guard AMANDA O'NEILL tacked on 10 points with five assists in the loss. At Radford on Saturday, junior guard TONISHA BAKER led Campbell with 18 points, including 14 in the second half alone, adding four rebounds and three steals. Senior forward Bass recorded 16 points and 10 rebounds for her first career doubles of the country of the second strains of the second stra

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN
LAKEITHA ALSTON tied her career high with 31 points at UNC Asheville... The Bucs' 25.9 percent from beyond the arc vs. the Bulldogs was their second lowest 3-point percentage of the season... The team had a season-high seven blocks at Gardner-Webb with ANICIA DOTSON and LAKEITHA ALSTON each recording two... CSU's win vs. GWU in Boiling Springs marked just the second time in school history the Bucs had beating the Runnin' Bulldogs and the first time they had ever won at Paul Porter arena... The Bucs' four-game win streak was the longest in seven seasons... The last time CSU won four or more straight was in 2004-05 (five straight)... It was also the first time since 2009-10 they had won three or more consecutive BSC games... CSU's 21 free-throws at GWU is a season high and the most made by the Bucs since 12/31/10 when they sunk 24... Their seven blocked shots is the most since 12/22/09 when they had 10 vs. Savannah State.

COASTAL CAROLINA
Coastal Carolina dropped both games on the week falling 69-60 at UNC Asheville and 73-63 at Gardner-Webb ... The Chanticleers are now 9-4 overall and 2-2 in Big South contests ... Olivia Irick paced the Chants in scoring on the week with 29 point as she scored 10 against Asheville and a season-high tying 19 at Gardner-Webb ... Coastal was outrebounded in back-to-back games for the first time this season as Asheville held a 52-34 margin and Gardner-Webb a 48-33 edge ... Coastal returns to Kimbel Arena, where the Chants are unbeaten on the season, on Saturday, Jan. 14 to take on Liberty followed by Radford on Monday, Jan. 19 to tak

GARDNER-WEBB

GARDNER-WEBB

The Runnin' Bulldogs played two tough Big South Conference games over the week, splitting with Charleston Southern and Coastal Carolina at home. The loss was GWU's first to CSU at home in Paul Porter Arena and was only GWU's second loss to CSU since joining the Big South in 2008. The young Runnin' Bulldogs bounced back on Monday night, jumping out to a 10-0 lead to route the Lady Chants of Coastal Carolina 73-63. GWU, who led by as much as 18 in the second half, had four players in double figure scoring led by a career-high 17 points from freshman guard MAYHAND DUNOVANT. Fellow newcomer JESSICA HEILIG hauled down a career-high and game-high 14 rebounds, as the Runnin' Bulldogs shot 51 free throws in the victory. The win was GWU's first conference win of the year and their first home win of the season in Paul Porter Arena. GWU will now look to carry over the momentum from Monday nights win this week, as the Runnin' Bulldogs hit the road to take on PC and Winthrop. The Runnin' Bulldogs will play the Lady Blue Hose of PC on Saturday at 3 p.m. in Clinton, S.C. and will then turn around to take on Winthrop on Monday night in Rock Hill, S.C. at 7 p.m.

HIGH POINT The High Point University women's basketball team improved to 4-0 in the Big South with road wins over Liberty and Radford this past weekend. The Panthers opened the weekend with a 73-69 win overtime win at Liberty, HPU's first at the Vines Center since 2007. High Point trailed the Flames by nine, 60-51 with 6:26 left but closed the game on a 12-3 run to tie the game and send it to overtime where the Panthers outscored Liberty 10-6 to pick up the win. Junior ERIN REYNOLDS scored a game-high 21 points with 16 coming at the end of regulation and in overtime. High Point next played at Radford where HPU started the game shooting 6-6 from the floor and opened an early 22-point lead before ultimatly winning by 16, 81-65. Reynolds again led all scorers with 24 points on the night, her second-most in a game this season. With the two wins High Point has now won five of its last six and moves into sole possesion of first place in the Big South.

LiBERTY
Liberty's 73-69 overtime loss to High Point on Saturday was the Lady Flames' first overtime game since Jan. 20, 2007, also against High Point ... Liberty bounced back two days later with a 90-61 win over Campbell, meaning that the Lady Flames have still not lost back-to-back Big South games within a single season since Feb. 20-22, 1997. ... The Lady Flames' meeting with Campbell was their first tilt against the Lady Camels since Nov. 29, 1999, and their victory was their first over Campbell since Nov. 25, 1997. ... Liberty's 90-point outburst against Campbell marked the most points the Lady Flames have scored in a Big South game since a 94-66 win at UNC Asheville on Feb. 27, 2010. ... The Lady Flames are now 3-0 this season and 81-1 under head coach CAREY GREEN when shooting 50 percent or higher from the field ... During the first half of the High Point game, AVERY WAR-LEY grabbed her 1,034th rebound, breaking KATIE FEENSTRA's program record ... Warley enters this weekend's games with 1,055 career boards, ranking No. 2 in Big South history ... Liberty will aim for its 37th straight win over Coastal Carolina Saturday in Conway, S.C.

PRESPYTERIAN
PC dropped its only contest of the week, falling to Winthrop by a 70-62 margin. The Blue Hose whittled down a 19-point deficit to seven while mounting a late comeback bid but could not pull any closer. Despite three Blue Hose scoring in double figures for the sixth time this season, PC is off to its first 0-3 start in Big South start since its first year in the league (2008-09). The team's 6-8 record still marks the best start since making the transition to Division I... KARLEE TAYLOR knocked down six three-pointers against the Eagles to tie PC's Division I-era single game high... MARIAH PIETROWSKI extended her hold on PC's Division I-era scoring leader with her 767th career point... Over their last five games, Taylor and DRIA DAVID lead the team with 14.0 points per game.

RADFORD

RADFORD
After defeating Campbell 80-70 on Saturday for its first conference win, Radford fell to a hot shooting High Point squad, 65-81, on Monday evening. In the Campbell game, DA'NARIA ERWIN SPENCER once again led all scorers with 21 points, while JORDYNN GAYMON came off the bench to tally 8 points, 12 rebounds and 3 blocks, all career highs. KATHERINE BROCKETT also helped the bench with a career-high 13 points. On Monday, the Highlanders saw High Point convert 61 percent of its field goal attempts in the first half and battled back, but couldn't overcome the hot shooting. Erwin Spencer and ASHLEY BUCKHANNON recorded 18 points apiece and one two of four Highlanders in double figures. VICTORIA HAMILTON tallied her third career double-double and second this season with 10 points and 10 rebounds while SARAH TABB also turned in a solid day with 10 points and 7 rebounds. Radford looks to get back on track with the beach trip this weekend against Charleston Southern and Coastal Carolina.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville went 2-0 on the week, with a victories over Coastal Carolina and Charleston Southern. Both the Chanticleers and Lady Bucs were undefeated in Big South Conference prior to their game with the Bulldogs. Asheville has now won four out of six games, and is 6-2 at home. Asheville allowed just 60 points against Coastal Carolina and that was season-low for a Bulldog opponent this year. The Blue & White will hit the road this week, traveling to Winthrop on Saturday and then Presbyterian on Monday. Senior guard LINDSEY THOMPSON set the UNC Asheville record for career 3-pointers against George Mason on 11/27. She now has 184 for her career, breaking the record of BRITTANY HENDLEY. Thompson also needs just 58 points to reach 1,000 for her career. KELLI RILES collected her Soft career rebound against Upstate. She now has 608 rebounds and is the 12th player in school history to grab more than 500 rebounds. Riles now ranks ninth all-time in rebounds at UNC Asheville, trailing Tara McMinn (623).

WINTHROP

WINTHROP After playing six of the last seven games on the road, Winthrop welcomes a two-game home stand against UNCA and Gardner-Webb this coming week. Winthrop is 13-12 all-time in their first home conference game. In the stretch of seven games, Winthrop was 4-3. Winthrop is averaging an impressive 71.7 points per game in nine road games. DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN is averaging 21.8 points per game on the road as well as 6.3 assists and 2.2 steals. McClanahan scored 32 points at Presbyterian college on Saturday, tying her career-high that she set on Dec. 28, 2011 at Mercer. She had 30 points in the loss at Charleston Southern and now has 30 or more points in three of her last four games. STEPHANIE MORRIS holds Winthrops all-time record for most 30-point games with four. In McClanahan's three 30-point games, she's combined to shoot 59 percent from the field, 40 percent from three and 75 percent from the foul line while dishing out 8.7 assists, 3.7 rebounds and getting 2.0 steals. She's also had a 2.36 assist/turnover ratio in those three games. In the last four games she's averaged 26.5 points shooting 51 percent from the floor, 57 percent from three, 75 percent from the floor, 50 rebounds and 1.5 steals. SAMIYA WRIGHT has remained steady as she averaged 12.5 points on 50 percent shooting, 46 percent behind the arc and 80 percent at the foul line.


