Coward averaged 21 points per game and shot 49 percent from the floor to lead her squad to a 3-1 record over the Christmas break, including a 2-0 mark in Big South play. The forward put in a career-high 30 points on 59 percent shooting in the win over Maine on Dec. 21 and matched that performance with 30 points on 64 percent from the field in the 83-78 win over Winthrop on Jan. 2. She got her break started with 21 points against Florida on Dec. 20. In the four game span, Coward collected 20 rebounds. dished out four assists and came away with three steals. The honor marks her first Big South Player of the Week nod of her career.

Jones posted 19 points per game and pulled down 20 rebounds to help her squad to a 2-2 record over the Christmas break. She got her week going with 20 points and three rebounds in the win over Mercer on Dec. 21 and followed that effort with 13 points, four boards and five assists in the 74-62 win over Brevard seven days later. On Dec. 31, the guard put in 19 points and corralled eight rebounds for the blue and white against High Point and closed out her break with 24 points and five rebounds at Campbell on Jan. 2. Jones was hot from the charity stripe as she connected on 19-of-20 of her attempts to finish with a 95 percent clip. The Big South Conference season got underway during the Christmas break. Coastal Carolina, Charleston Southern, Campbell and High Point each got its season started off with a 2-0 record. Liberty also picked up a win during the break to post a 1-0 record. Radford, Presbyterian, Winthrop, Asheville and Gardner-Webb are each looking for its first League win.

GOT THAT ONE OUT OF THE WAY

High Point head coach JENNIFER HOOVER picked up her first Big South win during the Christmas break with a 89-49 win over UNC Asheville on New Year's Eve.

BCS BUSTERS

The first weekend in December proved to be a big one for the Big South Conference. On Friday, Dec. 2, **ERIN REYNOLDS** of High Point fueled the Panther offense with 36 points to lead High Point to the 82-75 win over Pitt of the Big East ... Two days later, Charleston Southern's **LAKEITHA ALSTON** posted a 31-point, 10 rebound double-double in the Bucs' 82-77 win over Clemson of the ACC.

THAT'S RIGHT ICE-MAN ... I AM DANGEROUS

Junior guard **DIANA CHOIBEKOVA** has established herself as one of the League's most dangerous shooters from beyond the arc. She currently ranks No. 2 in all of Division I with 3.8 triples per game. She has also scored in double-digits in all but two games this season, including 33 points against Niagra.

NO 1 STUNNER

DEQUESHA McCLANAHAN is the League's leading scorer with 19.6 points per contests. Scoring isn't the only way McClanahan is generating offense for the Eagles as she is currently ranked No. 7 in the country with 6.4 assists per game, averaging nearly two assists more per game than any other player in the Big South.

FEAR OF REJECTION?

High Point's CHEYENNE PARKER has made a name for herself in the post this season. She currently ranks No. 14 in the Nation with 2.9 blocked shots per game. She posted a season-high six rejections vs. Davidson on Nov. 18. She is also currently ranked No. 10 in the country with eight double-doubles and has posted a streak of four-straight games with double-digit rebounds.

20/20

UNC Asheville's KELLI RILES set a new Big South single-game standard for rebounds as she pulled down 28 rebounds in Asheville's win over USC Upstate on Nov. 30. The game marked the second time this season that she has posted a game with 20-or-more rebounds as she pulled down 24 against Winston-Salem State in the opening game of the season ... In the game vs. WSSU, she also became the only player this season with a 20-point, 20-rebound double-double ... Her 11.8 rebounds per game is currently ranked No. 5 in the nation.

SCORE'N AND DISH'N

Winthrop's DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN and TONISHA BAKER of Campbell have each posted double-doubles with 10 assists. McClanahan put in 20-points and dished out 10 helpers against Troy, while Baker scored 18 points and posted 10 assists against Winston-Salem State.

I'LL TAKE PLAYERS AVERAGING A DOUBLE-DOUBLE THIS SEASON, ALEX

The Big South has three student-athletes currently averaging a double-double in points and rebounds this season. High Point's CHEYENNE PARKER is averaging 13.6 points and 10.5 rebounds per game, while AVERY WARLEY of Liberty is averaging 13.8 points and 10.8 boards per game. Warley is ranked No. 9 in the country and Parker sits at No. 5 in Division I.

TWIN KILL'N

This season the Big South Conference has had eight teammates go for 20 points in the same contest. During all of last season the Big South only saw seven sets of teammates go for 20 points in the same game.

GOOD 'N' TWENTY

The Big South currently has six players that have posted consecutive 20-point games this season. Leading the way is SHONICE JONES of UNC Asheville with three 20-point games. DA'NARIA ERWIN SPENCER of Radford has posted back-to-back 20-point games on two occasions this season. DEQUESIA McCLANAHAN of Winthrop, AVERY WARLEY of Liberty, RACHELLE COWARD from Charleston Southern and ASHLEY BUCHANNON of Radford complete the list of student-athletes with consecutive 20-point games.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

Campbell opened Big South play with a pair of home wins, moving to 9-4 overall on the season and 6-0 at home. The 6-0 start at home is the best since the 1997-98 season, when the Lady Camels began the year 12-0 in Buies Creek, dropping only their final game in Carter Gym. The Lady Camels are 2-0 in conference play (including Big South and Atlantic Sun) for the 13th time in program history (since 1986-87). The team last began its conference slate 2-0 two seasons ago, in 2009-10. Campbell knocked down a school record 13 three pointers and tied another single game mark with nine blocks to race past UNC Asheville. The Lady Camels 13 threes breaks the previous school mark of 12, which the team hit twice in program history (vs. Georgia State March 2, 1995 and at Appalachian State on Dec. 20, 1999). Campbell also tied the school blocks record for the third time this season, also recording nine denials against Montreat and Western Carolina. CUs win over Gardner-Webb was the Lady Camels' first as a Big South member in a conference game since 1994, as Campbell played in the Atlantic Sun from 1994-2011.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN
The Buccaneers won the Big South Conference opener for the first time since the 2007-08 season with their 76-67 victory over Presbyterian on New Year's Eve... Coincidentally, their last BSC opening win in 2007-08 also came over the Blue Hose... Their 83-78 win over Winthrop put them at 2-0 to start the conference season for the first time since the 1997-98 season... Their 83 points vs. the Eagles is their second-best outpouring of the season (115 vs. Southern Wesleyan)... Their .523 FG % vs. PC was also their second-best effort of the season... The Bucs were able to shut down Maine's three-point game, allowing the Black Bears to make just one 3-pointer and marking the fourth time this season they have allowed two or less 3s... RACHELLE COWARD scored 30, 30 and 27 points for 3 of the 4 contests, marking the 2nd, 3rd and 4th highest output by a CSU player this season... HELLEN TERRY's career-high 26 points was the team's fifth best performance... ERIN BRATCHERS six 3-pointers vs. Winthrop and Coward's 6 vs. Maine were the most by the Bucs this season... Likewise, Coward's 11 free-throws were the most by a CSU player in 2011-12... The Bucs' 14 3-pointers is the most since the team hit 16 vs. Voorhees on 11-16-10... CSU is off to one of the best starts in school history, going 6-3 in the first nine games of the season for their best start since 1998-99 when they went 8-1.

COASTAL CARCUINA

Coastal Carolina claimed three wins at home this week downing USC Upstate (61-56), Winthrop (58-54) and Presbyterian (52-49) ... Coastal wrapped up its non-conference conference portion of the season with a 7-2 record ... By defeating Winthrop and PC in the opening weekend of Big South play, Coastal starts the conference season 2-0 for the first time since the 1999-2000 team started 3-0 ... The Chants came from 16 down to defeat Winthrop in its Big South opener and from seven back to drop Presbyterian ... Guards OLIVIA IRICK and SHATIA COLE paced the Chanticleers on the week with 30 and 28 points, respectively. Both finished shooting 40.0 percent from the field (10-of-25) with a combined nine treys - six for Irick and three for Cole ... Irick needs only eight more treys this season to tie Amber Rose for 10th all-time in the Chanticleer annuals ... Freshman forward SAWANAH PIPPIN, playing her first significant amount of time this season, recorded career-highs with 10 points and six rebounds against Presbyterian ... ANGELICA HEINRY and Cole combined to go 7-of-6 from the line in the final minute of Coastal's come-from-behind victories over Winthrop and PC ... The Chanticleers make their first Big South road trip of the season this weekend playing at UNC Asheville on Jan. 7 and at Gardner-Webb on Jan.

GARDNER-WEBB

GARDNER-WEBB
The Runnin' Bulldogs posted their first win of the season over N.C. Central on Dec. 28th, yet dropped their first two conference match ups to Campbell and High Point to fall to 1-11 overall and 0-2 in Big South play. In GWUs 56-45 road win at N.C. Central, the Runnin' Bulldogs took a half-time lead for the first time on the year and held the Lady Eagles scoreless over a 10 minute period in the second half. Gardner-Webb opened up conference play on the road at Campbell on Dec. 30th, as the Fighting Camels controlled the glass, posing 21 offensive rebounds to hold off the Runnin' Bulldogs, 62-52. Looking to split in their first two road conference games, the Runnin' Bulldogs took an early 13-10 lead over the Panthers of High Point on Monday afternoon, however, GWU then went ice cold from the floor, going 3-of-25 over the next 15 minutes of play to fall behind by double-digits in the 63-41 loss. The Runnin' Bulldogs 1-11 start is the worst in a single season since GWU started 0-10 in the 2003-04 season, while their 0-2 Big South Conference start is the worst since the 2008-09 team started the conference slate out at 0-4. That year the Runnin' Bulldogs at the Big South Tourserner Championship name as the number six seed Gardner-Meth will return home this weekend for the first time. advanced to the Big South Tournament Championship game as the number six seed. Gardner-Webb will return home this weekend for the first time since December 3rd, as the Runnin' Bulldogs will host Charleston Southern on Saturday night at 5 p.m. and Coastal Carolina on Monday night at 7 p.m. in Paul Porter Arena.

HIGH POINT

HIGH PUIN!
High Point went 3-1 on the week and started Big South play at 2-0 after defeating UMBC, UNC Asheville and Gardner-Webb. The Panthers' lone loss came to the Big East's Cincinnati. High Point opened play this week with a win over UMBC in the first round of the Hilton Garden Inn Hokie Classic. Senior SHAMIA BROWN scored 21 points to lead HPU. High Point fell to the Bearcats in the Championship game but bounced back to open conference play with back-to-back wins over UNC Asheville and Gardner-Webb. HPU beat Asheville by a score of 89-49 and Gardner-Webb by a score of 63-41. Brown again played a key role in the wins, leading HPU in scoring against Asheville by a score of 89-49 and Gardner-Webb by a score of 63-41. Brown again played a key role in the wins, leading HPU in scoring against Asheville with 17 points and finishing in double digits with 10 against GWU.

Liberty opened Big South Conference play with a victory for the 11th time in the last 12 seasons ... The Lady Flames have played seven of their first 12 games against in-state opponents, going 3-4 in those contests ... Liberty has won the rebounding battle in every game this season and has done so in 39 straight contests dating back to the 2010-11 campaign ... AVERY WARLEY has 1,031 career rebounds, meaning she needs three more boards to break KATIE FEENSTRA's school record and move into second place in Big South history ... Warley has also climbed into sixth place in program history with 1,193 career points.

PRESBYTERIAN

PC took two tough losses to open Big South Conference play despite shooting a season-high 54.9 percent from the floor in a 76-67 loss to Charleston Southern on New Year's Eve... After a 52-49 loss against Coastal Carolina on January 2, PC's record on the first game of a new year moved to 20-15... The Blue Hose also matched a season-high eight three-pointeres in the effort... MARIAH PIETROWSKI Extended her three-game old takeover of PC's Division I-era career scoring record to 755 points. Pietrowski also moved into second place among Division I-era players with four defensive rebounds against the Buccaneers, giving her 238 for her career.

The Highlanders are currently on a three-game losing streak after falling to in-state rival Liberty on New Year's Eve. Radford forced 39 Flames turnovers, one shy of a Dedmon Center record and turned those into 42 points. Radford tied up the game on the first possession of the second half, but Liberty went on a 16-0 run to put the game out of reach. Radford chipped away at the lead and got within as many as six, but eventually fell.

ASHLEY BUCKHANNON had a game-high 25 points, 18 of which came in the first half. DATNARIA ERMIN SPENCER also ended her double-digit scoring drought by scoring all 12 of her points in the second half and also dished out four assists. SARAH TABB had a career-best seven steals and AYANA AVERY also tallied a career-high four as well. Radford is back in action this week with a home weekend set against Campbell and High Point.

UNC Asheville went 2-2 over the winter break, with victories over Mercer and Brevard College before opening Big South Conference play with a pair of losses to High Point and Campbell. Asheville had lost six straight before defeating Mercer on Dec. 21. KELLI RILES currently leads the Big South and is ranked fifth nationally in rebounds, averaging 11.3 per contest. Freshman SHONESE JONES was named the Big South Player of the Week for the week of Dec. 20, while fellow freshman LEAH WORMACK has been named the Big South Freshman of the Week twice on the season. Senior guard LINDSEY THOMPSON set the UNC Asheville record for career 3-pointers against George Mason on 11/27. She now has 178 for her career, breaking the record of Brittany Hendley, who played for the Bulldogs from 2003-07. Thompson also needs just 102 points to reach 1,000 for her career. Kelli Riles collected her 500th career rebound against Upstate. She now has 581 rebounds and is the 12th player in school history to grab more than 500 rebounds. Riles now ranks ninth all-time in rebounds at UNC Asheville started the season with an 83-73 victory over Winston-Salem State on Nov. 12. The game was the first basketball game to be played in the brand new Kimmel Arena, UNC Asheville's new home for men's and women's basketball. The win marked the second year in a row that Asheville has opened the season with a win. Junior forward Riles started the season with a bang as she tallied 21 points and a then career-high 24 rebounds against the Rams. The 13-of-13 affort list missed the school record season with a bang as she tallied 21 points and a then career-high 24 rebounds against the Rams. The 13-of-13 effort just missed the school record of 14-of-14 from Tara McMinn set in the 1990-91 season. Riles is the first Asheville player to record a 20-20 since Sheila Ford accomplished the feat in the 1983-84 season.

Winthrop went 2-2 over the break and began the break with a blowout win over North Carolina Central. Winthrop placed five players in double-figures as the Eagles won by 39 points, which is the largest margin of victory against an NCAA Division I opponent. Winthrop also pulled off an 88-74 victory at Mercer, led by DEOUESHA MCCLANAHAN'S career-high 32 points. The 88 points is the second time the Eagles have hit the mark on the road this season. It is also the fourth time Winthrop hit the 80 mark on the year. The schol record at the Division I level for 80 point games is six set by the 1995-96 and 2001-02 teams. The 1995-96 team did it against all D-1 schools while the 01-02 only scored 80 or more against four D1 schools. Winthrop dropped its first two conference games and is off to an 0-2 start for the first time since the 2004-05 season. McClanahan surpassed the 600 career mark in points over the break and is closing in on 700 already at 661. She needs to average 19.9 points per game the rest of the way to reach 1,000 points before her junior season. At 19.6 per game, she's looking to become just the second player in school history to average 20 points. reach 1,000 points before het junior season. At 17.0 pet garrie, shes routing to decorner just the second player in school nistory to average 20 points or more in a single season. She also now has 201 career assists, just 76 away from breaking into the schools all-time Top 10. Red-shirt freshman SAMIYA WRIGHT had an impressive break as she was second on the team with a 14.3 scoring average on 48 percent shooting from the field and 47 percent shooting from behind the arc. She also averaged 5.8 rebounds, 2.5 assists and 1.5 steals. Senior TAQUOIA HAMMICK was one of four players to average double-figures during the four-game stretch as she posted 11.8 points per game and 7.8 rebounds while shooting 83 percent from the floor and 75 percent from the four line.


