Erwin Spencer posted a pair of 20-point games to finish the week with a 22.5 points per game average to lead her squad to a 2-0 record, including a win over then Conference unbeaten High Point. She put in 21 points on 47 percent shooting against the Panthers on Feb. 4. She also chipped in six rebounds and came away with three steals and an assist in the win. Two days later at Campbell, the guard connected on 10-of-20 from the floor, one from long range and three from the line to finish with 24 points, as well as six helpers, four steals, two boards and a block in the win. The honor is her second-straight and fourth overall Big South Player of the Week nod this season.

THE CRONS BRAND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

Shatia Cole G • Coastal Carolina Myrtle Beach, S.C.

Cole averaged 15.5 points per game and shot 45 percent from the field to push Coastal Carolina to a 2-0 record last week. Against Gardner-Webb on Feb. 4, Cole posted 16 points on 46 percent from the floor, three from long range and one from the line, to go along with six rebounds, four steals and two assists. She followed that effort with 15 points, four rebounds, three steals and an assist in the 74-58 win over UNC Asheville on Feb. 6. The award is her fourth Big South Freshman of the Week plaudit this season.

Liberty's AVERY WARLEY has taken over No. 1 all-time on the Big South rebounding chart with 1,143... and counting.

WELCOME TO THE BIG SOUTH CONFERENCE

On Monday, Jan. 23 the Big South Conference welcomed Longwood to the League. Longwood will begin play in the Big South starting in the 2012-13 season. The addition of the Lancers gives the Big South 12 members, the most ever members in the League's history.

NUMBER ONE STUNNER

High Point's SHAMIA BROWN became HPU's Division I scoring leader with her 13 points against Charleston Southern on Jan. 23. She surprassed former teammate JURICA HARGRAVES who set the record last season.

DIANA CHOIBEKOVA tied the Big South single-game record for three-pointers against Gardner-Webb on Jan. 16. The junior cashed in on 10 triples in the contest as she connected on 59 percent of her attempts (10-of-17) ... Also CHEYENNE PARKER tied a Big South single-game record as she recorded 10 blocks vs. Winthrop on Jan. 28.

CLOSING IN ON BIG SOUTH RECORDS

Winthrop's DIANA CHOIBEKOVA currently has 90 three-pointers on the season to rank No. 4 on the Big South single-season list. She is only 17 triples shy of the all-time record held by former Charleston Southern Buccaneer KATIE TULL. Tull cashed in on 107 triples during the 2010-11 season ... Teammate DEQUESHA McCLANAHAN is closing in on the single-season top 10 assist list as she has 166 on the season. At her current pace, she will likely become one of only four Big South student-athletes to post 200

BURN'N UP THE BOARDS

The Lady Flames have established themselves as one of the top rebounding teams in the country. Liberty currently sits at No. 1 in the nation with a 15.7 rebound margin.

GOT THAT ONE OUT OF THE WAY

High Point head coach JENNIFER HOOVER picked up her first Big South win during the Christmas break with an 89-49 win over UNC Asheville on New Year's Eve... Winthrop's MARLENE STOLLINGS grabbed her first Big South win on Jan. 7 as Winthrop downed Presbyterian College.

BCS BUSTERS

The first weekend in December proved to be a big one for the Big South Conference. On Friday, Dec. 2, ERIN REYNOLDS of High Point fueled the Panther offense with 36 points to lead High Point to the 82-75 win over Pitt of the Big East ... Two days later, Charleston Southern's LAKEITHA ALSTON posted a 31-point, 10 rebound double-double in the Bucs' 82-77 win over Clemson of

THAT'S RIGHT ICE-MAN ... LAM DANGEROUS

Junior guard DIANA CHOIBEKOVA has established herself as one of the League's most dangerous shooters from beyond the arc. She currently ranks No. 1 in all of Division I with 4.1 triples per game. She has also scored in double-digits in 17 games this season and has posted two games with at least 30 points.

DEQUESHA McCLANAHAN is the League's leading scorer with 19.9 points per contest to rank No. 15 in the nation. Scoring isn't the only way McClanahan is generating offense for the Eagles as she is currently ranked No. 4 in the country with 7.5 assists per

FFAR OF REJECTION?

High Point's CHEYENNE PARKER has made a name for herself in the post this season. She currently ranks No. 4 in the nation with FARKER has made a harme for hersen in the post this season. She currently ranks No. 4 in the hastion with 3.7 blocked shots per game. Against Winthrop, she tied the Big South single-season standard with 10 blocked shots. She is also currently ranked No. 3 in the country with 14 double-doubles and posted a streak of seven games with 10-or--more rebounds, including a career-best 22 boards against Coastal Carolina on Jan. 21. In the game vs. Winthrop she notched the League's only triple-double this season as she finished with 13 points, 22 rebounds and 10 blocks. As a team, the Panthers are No. 18 in the country with 5.4 blocked shots per game.

20/20

UNC Asheville's KELLI RILES set a new Big South single-game standard for rebounds as she pulled down 28 rebounds in Asheville's win over USC Upstate on Nov. 30. The game marked the second time this season that she has posted a game with 20-or-more rebounds as she pulled down 24 against Winston-Salem State in the opening game of the season ... In the game vs. WSSU, she also became the only player this season with a 20-point, 20-rebound double-double ... Her 11.1 rebounds per game is currently ranked No. 8 in the nation.

DOUBLE-TROUBLE

The Big South has two student-athletes currently averaging a double-double in points and rebounds this season. High Point's CHEYENNE PARKER is averaging 13.3 points and 12.5 rebounds per game, while AVERY WARLEY of Liberty is averaging 13.4 points and 11.0 boards per game. Parker's rebound average is third in the nation, while Warley is ranked 12th.

TWIN KILL'N

This season the Big South Conference has had 10 teammates go for 20 points in the same contest. During all of last season the Big South only saw seven sets of teammates go for 20 points in the same game. Radford's DA'NARIA ERWIN SPENCER and ASH-LEY BUCKHANNON and DIANA CHOIBEKOVA and DEQUESHA McCLANAHAN have accomplished the output twice on the season.

Charleston Southern currently ranks No. 4 in the nation with 9.1 three-point field goals per game, while Winthrop is ranked No. 12 with 7.5.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

Campbell dropped its first two home losses of the season and its first since Feb. 12, 2011. The Lady Camels' 11 game home winning streak was the longest since the 1997-98 team was 12 in a row in Buies Creek. The pair of losses also broke a streak where the Lady Camels won 17 of 19 in Gilbert Craig Gore Arena. Campbell hit 21-of-26 (80.8 percent) tries from the free throw line on Monday night against Radford, the team's second highest percentage, and second highest makes from the stripe this season. On Saturday, TONISHA BAKER passed a career milestone, scoring her 900th point. The junior guard now has 917 points, 440 rebounds, 211 assists and 144 steals through 82 career games. The Lady Camels also broke their single-season blocks record in their loss to Liberty, now with 93 team denials with seven regular season games remaining. This is the third consecutive season the record has been broken. The former record was 84. Freshman KIERA GAINES is leading the way on the defensive end, blocking a team-best 20 shots this season, the 10th most in program single season history. Campbell has recorded at least one block in all but one game this season and has registered four or more 10 times. Campbell joined the national initiative "Play 4Kay" Monday night against Radford, raising breast cancer awareness and accepting donations toward the Kay Yow Cancer Fund.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Rachelle Coward has led or tied for the team-lead in scoring in each of the past five games after going for 26 versus Asheville and then 16 against Gardner-Webb. Freshman SHAMBREKA JONES posted her first career double-double with 11 points and 10 rebounds against UNC Asheville. SHAY JONES totaled 25 points and 9 steals over 2 games in returning from injury. CSU picked up its first ever season sweep of Gardner-Webb with Monday's win. The Bucs went 13-of-27 from three-point range against Gardner-Webb, with the 48.1 % mark their second best single-game effort of the season. ANICIA DOTSON recorded her first double-double of the year wtih 13 points and 11 rebounds versus Gardner-Webb.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina never trailed in either game as it went 2-0 on the week, defeating Gardner-Webb (54-40) and UNC Asheville (74-58) to break its previous three-game losing skid ... The pair of victories improve Coastal to 11-1 at home this season ... The Chants' win over Gardner-Webb was the first since the 2008-09 season and broke a six-game losing streak to the Runnin' Bulldogs ... Coastal's 16 point win over UNC Asheville was the largest margin of victory against a Big South opponent since last season's squad posted a 19 point victory over Winthrop on Jan. 31, 2011 ... SHATIA COLE led Coastal with 31 combined points in the contests with 19 of those coming in the second halves ... TAYLOR EPLEY scored a career-high 15 points on 7-of-10 from the floor and 1-of-1 from deep against UNC Asheville ... Coastal makes its annual journey to the state of Virginia this week to play Radford (Saturday, Feb. 11) and Liberty (Monday, Feb. 13).

Despite back-to-back double-doubles from sophomore CATRINA GREEN, the Runnin' Bulldogs were unable to pick up a win, as their losing streak now sits at seven. Gardner-Webb struggled on the offensive end on Saturday afternoon, as GWU shot only 28.8 percent from the floor and allowed Coastal Carolina to have 24 points off of the Runnin' Bulldogs' 20 turnovers in the 54-40 conference loss. The loss snapped GWU's winning streak over Coastal Carolina at six overall and spoiled GWU's chances of the regular season series sweep of the Lady Chants. On Monday night, GWU's offense woke up, however, the Runnin' Bulldogs could not stop the Charleston Buccaneers from draining three's as the Bucs hit 13 three-pointers in the 86-66 win. For the third straight game, GWU was outrebounded on the boards, while the Bucs also took advantage of 25 GWU fouls, going 21-of-29 (72.4 percent) from the free throw line compared to GWU's 16-of-27 (59.3 percent). Sophomore center Green continues to have a strong season, as she posted back-to-back doubles over the weekend to give her eight on the season. Green had a teamhigh 15 points and 10 rebounds in the loss at Coastal Carolina and a game-high 19 points and 11 rebounds in the loss at Charleston Southern. The Runnin' Bulldogs are on the verge of not winning double digit games for the first time since 2004-05, head coach RICK REEVES' first year at the helm of the program. GWU has repeatedly struggled in the first half, as the Runnin' Bulldogs are 0-19 when trailing at the halftime break on the season. GWU will look to snap its current skid, as the Runnin' Bulldogs return home to host Winthrop at 5 p.m. on Saturday afternoon and Presbyterian at 7 p.m. on Monday night in Paul Porter Arena.

HIGH POINT

High Point dropped it's first two conference games with home losses to Radford and Liberty. The Panthers struggled early against the Highlanders but closed to within one before ultimatly losing by five, 66-61. SHAMIA BROWN led HPU with 19 points in the game while CHEYENNE PARKER had a double-double with 14 points and 12 rebounds. Against Liberty, HPU had a late comeback but could not catch the Flames, losing 73-65. TAYLER TREMBLAY scored a career-high 21 points in the loss while Parker had 13 points and 11 rebounds

Liberty took over sole possession of first place in the Big South standings with road wins at Campbell and High Point ... The Lady Flames have now won a season-high nine games in a row and are 7-0 in Big South road tilts this season ... AVERY WARLEY enjoyed a milestone of her own on Saturday at Campbell, breaking the Big South career rebounding record formerly held by Charleston Southern's KATE SANFORD ... Warley finished the week with 1,143 career boards ... High Point snapped Liberty's streak of 48 straight games outrebounding its opponent on Monday ... However, the Lady Flames were able to extend a couple trends ... The team has now held 44 straight opponents to below 50 percent field goal shooting ... The Lady Flames are also 83-1 all time under Carey Green when shooting 50 percent or higher from the field.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville went 0-2 on the week, falling to Charleston Southern and Coastal Carolina on the road. Asheville is now 7-15 overall, 3-8 in the Big South, 7-4 at home and 0-11 on the road. Asheville has yet to win on the road this year. The Blue & White have three road contests left this season. This week the Blue & White will host Presbyterian and Winthrop at Kimmel Arena. looking to avenge road losses to both squads. Junior guard GRACE BLAYLOCK set the UNC Asheville record for 3-pointers in a game with seven against Wintrhop on Jan. 14, 2012. Blaylock connected on 7-of-14 from behind the arc. She posted a careerhigh 23 points in the process. The previous record was six, held by four different players. Freshman guard SHONESE JONES has been named the Big South Player of the Week and the Big South Freshman of the Week three times. Leah Wormack has been named the Big South Freshman of the Week three times on the season. Senior guard LINDSEY THOMPSON set the UNC Asheville record for career 3-pointers against George Mason on 11/27. She now has 188 for her career, breaking the record of BRITTANY HENDLEY, who played for the Bulldogs from 2003-07. Thompson also needs just 11 points to reach 1,000 for her career (976). KELLI RILES collected her 600th career rebound against Charleston Southern on Jan. 9. She now has 681 rebounds, which ranks seventh all time at UNC Asheville, and is the ninth player in school history to grab more than 600 rebounds.

With the loss to PC on Saturday, Winthrop has now split the season series with the Blue Hose three straight seasons. In the loss, sophomore DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN had a game-high 23 points on 8-for-15 shooting to go along with four assists. She now has 824 career points and can reach 1,000 in her career prior to her junior season if she averages 19.5 points per game the rest of the way (including first round conference tourney game). She's now got 166 assists on the season, which is closing in on Winthrops single-season record of 192. The 23 points gives her 12 games of 20 or better this season. Her 166 assists are four shy of breaking into the Top 10 single season performances in Big South history. McClanahan is on pace to reach 200 assists for the season, which only three players in league history have accomplished before. DIANA CHOIBEKOVA posted 22 points in the loss to PC, but hit five three-pointers as she continues to lead the nation in threes per game at 4.1. She's got 90 threes on the season, which is the fourth best mark in league history in a season. She's 17 away from tying the season record set by KATIE TULL of Charleston Southern in 2010-11. She needs to average 2.3 over the next eight games to pass the mark. With the team's seventh three against PC on Satursday, Winthrop broke the school's season record of 165 threes. Choibekova knocked down the three with 33 seconds left to cut the lead to one point.


