Dequesha McClanahan • So. G • Winthrop Oak Ridge, Tenn.

McClanahan averaged 19.5 points per game and narrowly missed averaging a double-double as she dished out 19 assists to lead Winthrop to a pair of Big South wins over the weekend to move into a tie for second in the Conference standings. She got her week going with 18 points, nine assists, three steals and trios of rebounds to fuel her squad to a 71-69 win over league-leading Liberty on Feb. 18. The win was the first over the Lady Flames since 2008 and just the second against the Lady Flames since 1997. The guard followed that effort with her 15th 20-point game this season as she recorded 21 points in the win over Radford on Feb. 20. She also chipped in 10 assists, six boards and three steals against the Highlanders. Her 10 assists against Radford gave her 195 on the season and broke the Winthrop single-season assist record that stood for 30 years. McClanahan is only 13 helpers shy of the Big South's all-time assists record.

THE CRONS BRAND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

Reagan Miller G • Liberty Sanger, Texas

Miller, a guard from Sanger, Texas, averaged 10.5 points per contest and shot 42 percent from the field to help the Lady Flames to a 1-1 record last week. After scoring eight points, dishing out two helpers and grabbing three rebounds against Winthrop, she highlighted her week with 13 points on 60 percent from the floor to go along with five assists and two rebounds in the win at Presbyterian College on Feb. 20. She finished the week with 21 points, five rebounds and seven assists in the two-game span. The honor is marks her second Big South Freshman of the Week nod this season.

WINNING THE REBOUND WAR(LEY)

Liberty's AVERY WARLEY has taken over No. 1 all-time on the Big South rebounding chart with 1,194... and counting.

A win by Liberty in any of its last three games will clinch the No. 1 seed in the upcoming Advance Auto Parts Big South Women's Basketball Championship.

NUMBER ONE STUNNER

High Point's SHAMIA BROWN became HPU's Division I scoring leader with her 13 points against Charleston Southern on Jan. 23. She surpassed former teammate JURICA HARGRAVES who set the record last season.

RECORD SETTERS

DIANA CHOIBEKOVA tied the Big South single-game record for three-pointers against Gardner-Webb on Jan. 16. The junior cashed in on 10 triples in the contest as she connected on 59 percent of her attempts (10-of-17) ... Also CHEYENNE PARKER tied a Big South single-game record as she recorded 10 blocks vs. Winthrop on Jan. 28.

CLOSING IN ON BIG SOUTH RECORDS

Winthrop's DIANA CHOIBEKOVA currently has 105 three-pointers on the season to rank No. 2 on the Big South single-season list. She is only 3 triples shy of the all-time record held by former Charleston Southern Buccaneer KATIE TULL. Tull cashed in on 107 triples during the 2010-11 season ... Teammate DEQUESHA McCLANAHAN is No. 4 on the all-time single-season assist list 195 on the season. She is just 13 helpers away from the Big South single-season record.

The Lady Flames have established themselves as one of the top rebounding teams in the country. Liberty currently sits at No. 1 in the nation with a 15.4 rebound margin.

The first weekend in December proved to be a big one for the Big South Conference. On Friday, Dec. 2, ERIN REYNOLDS of High Point fueled the Panther offense with 36 points to lead High Point to the 82-75 win over Pitt of the Big East ... Two days later, Charleston Southern's LAKEITHA ALSTON posted a 31-point, 10 rebound double-double in the Bucs' 82-77 win over Clemson of

THAT'S RIGHT ICE-MAN ... I AM DANGEROUS

Junior guard DIANA CHOIBEKOVA has established herself as one of the League's most dangerous shooters from beyond the arc. She currently ranks No. 1 in all of Division I with 4.1 triples per game. She has also scored in double-digits in 20 games this season and has posted two games with at least 30 points.

DEQUESHA McCLANAHAN is the League's leading scorer with 20.4 points per contest to rank No. 13 in the nation. Scoring isn't the only way McClanahan is generating offense for the Eagles as she is currently ranked No. 3 in the country with 7.4 assists per

FEAR OF REJECTION?

High Point's CHEYENNE PARKER has made a name for herself in the post this season. She currently ranks No. 7 in the nation with 3.5 blocked shots per game. Against Winthrop, she tied the Big South single-season standard with 10 blocked shots. She is also currently ranked No. 5 in the country with 15 double-doubles and posted a streak of seven games with 10-or-more rebounds, including a career-best 22 boards against Coastal Carolina on Jan. 21. In the game vs. Winthrop she notched the League's only triple-double this season as she finished with 13 points, 22 rebounds and 10 blocks. As a team, the Panthers are No. 24 in the current with 5.2 blocked cheter per games. country with 5.2 blocked shots per game.

20/20

UNC Asheville's **KELLI RILES** set a new Big South single-game standard for rebounds as she pulled down 28 rebounds in Asheville's win over USC Upstate on Nov. 30. The game marked the second time this season that she has posted a game with 20-or-more rebounds as she pulled down 24 against Winston-Salem State in the opening game of the season ... In the game vs. WSSU, she also became the only player this season with a 20-point, 20-rebound double-double ... Her 11.1 rebounds per game is currently ranked No. 8 in the nation.

DOUBLE-TROUBLE

The Big South has two student-athletes currently averaging a double-double in points and rebounds this season. High Point's CHEYENNE PARKER is averaging 13.1 points and 12.1 rebounds per game, while AVERY WARLEY of Liberty is averaging 13.1 points and 11.3 boards per game. Parker's rebound average is second in the nation, while Warley is ranked 6th.

This season the Big South Conference has had 12 teammates go for 20 points in the same contest. During all of last season the Big South only saw seven sets of teammates go for 20 points in the same game. Radford's DA'NARIA ERWIN SPENCER and ASH-LEY BUCKHANNON and DIANA CHOIBEKOVA and DEQUESHA McCLANAHAN have accomplished the output twice on the season.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

Campbell swept a Big South road trip with wins at Coastal Carolina and Charleston Southern over the weekend, securing its first 15 win season since 2000-01. Campbell head coach WANDA WATKINS posted her 475th career win at the helm in her 31st season with Monday's victory at CSU. With 15 wins, the Lady Camels secured at least a .500 season with four regular season and at minimum one conference tournament games remaining on the slate. With Monday's 76-58 win at CSU, the Lady Camels are now 25-0 all-time against Charleston Southern, including 10-0 at CSU. Campbell also improved to 18-3 against Coastal Carolina in Big South games (including BSC tournament), holding 20-17 overall record over the Chanticleers. The win broke an eight game losing streak in Conway, with the last Campbell win coming on Jan. 29, 1994 (77-73 20T). TONISHA BAKER's 25 regitte daily stream in Collway, with the last campbed will colling off sail. 29, 1994 (17-73 201). Tonish BARKERS 25 points at Charleston Southern came on 10-of-14 shooting, going 3-for-3 from distance, adding three rebounds. Baker's 25 points tied a season high and marked her sixth career game with 20 or more. KATELYN BASS gathered 13 points and a career-best 17 rebounds in the win, notching her second career double-double. Bass' 17 boards are the most by a Lady Camel since ASHLEY WILLIAMSON collected 18 against Coker to start off the 2008-09 season. Campbell's 44 points in the first half at CSU rank as the third most by the team in a single half this season behind the second half at Elon (54) and the first half against High Point (47) at home. The Lady Camels shot 50.9 percent at CSU, hitting that mark for the fourth time this season. Campbell also held its opponent under 60 points for the 13th time this year, and now hold a 12-1 record in those games. At Coastal Carolina, Campbell forced 22 turnovers in the game, the 11th time the Lady Camels have forced 20 or more, while limiting an opponent under 50 points for the seventh time this season. CU scored 18 points off Coastal turnovers. Bass paced Campbell with 16 points and six rebounds, hitting 7-of-13 from the floor in the win. With its final pair of home games coming up (Winthrop Feb. 25 and Presbyterian Feb. 27), Campbell looks to reach double digit home wins for the ninth time in program history. The Lady Camels are currently 9-2 in Gilbert Craig Gore Arena.

CHARLESTON SOLITHERN

The Bucs split the weekend, getting a 77-72 win over High Point before falling 76-58 to Campbell... Charleston Southern ended the season with an impressive 11-3 record at the Buc Dome, and have gone 33-11 there over the past three seasons... They have not suffered more than three homes losses the past two seasons... Two of CSUs lowest offensive outputs of the season have come against Campbell (58 points at the Buc Dome, 56 points in Buies Creek)... LAKEITHA ALSTON is nearing her 1,000th career point as the season closes, with a total of 929 thus far... RACHELLE COWARD is nearing her 500th point as a Buccaneer with 473 on the season... CSU's .547 shooting percentage vs. High Point was its second best of the season (.623 vs, Southern Wesleyan).

Coastal Carolina split its two games on the week falling to Campbell (47-38) and defeating High Point (59-58) ... The Chanticleers overcame an 11-point second half deficit to defeat High Point as sophomore Angelica Henry converted a layup as time expired ... Coastal is now 12-2 at home this season ... The Chants won the rebounding battle on the week coming away with a 39-32 edge against Campbell and a 43-29 advantage over High Point ... OLIVIA IRICK led Coastal on the week with 36 total points, including a season-high tying 20 against the Panthers on Monday ... Irick's six 3-pointers on the week move her into sole possession of ninth all-time in the Coastal annuals with 110 for her career ... The Chants will play host to Charleston Southern in the final regular season game in Kimbel Arena on Saturday.

The Runnin' Bulldogs snapped a nine-game losing streak and posted another conference win last week, going 1-1 overall. On Saturday night, the Runnin' Bulldogs got a career-high 20 points from JASMINE DALE and a double-double of 17 points and 15 rebounds in a 69-52 home win over UNC Asheville. The win is GWU's second conference win and not only snapped a nine-game losing streak, but put them back in the hunt for a spot in the 2012 Big South Women's Basketball Championship come March. On Monday night, GWU stepped out of conference play one final time in 2011-12 and took on the Longwood Lancers in Farmville, Va. In a very physical game that was sloppy from start to finish, the Lancers were able to use a 10-0 run in the second half and make 10-of-12 free throws in the final two minutes of play to down the Runnin' Bulldogs 76-65. GWU had four players score in double digits, as Green posted her 10th double-double of the year with 14 points and 10 rebounds, while senior guard BRIANNA DILLARD added 11 points and 13 rebounds. With four games remaining, the Runnin' Bulldogs are in need of finishing the regular season at strong. GWU will jump back into conference play this weekend, as the Runnin' Bulldogs will take on Liberty on Saturday afternoon at 4 p.m. in Lynchburg, Va. before taking on the Radford Highlanders on Monday night at 7 p.m. in Radford, Va.

High Point dropped two close games on the road to Charleston Southern and Coastal Carolina to fall to 14-11 overall and a tie for second place in the Big South with a 9-5 mark. HPU led late in both games but was unable to come away with a win on the road. Senior SHAMIA BROWN led High Point in both games, scoring 25 against CSU and 26 against CCU. For the weekend, Brown shot 22-32 from the floor while also grabbing nine rebounds, nabbing nine steals and dishing out five assists.

Liberty saw its season-best 11-game winning streak snapped with a 71-69 loss at Winthrop on Saturday ... The Lady Flames then bounced back to post a 69-64 win at Presbyterian College on Monday, improving to 9-0 all-time against the Blue Hose ... Liberty has still not lost back-to-back games to Big South opponents since Feb. 20 and 22, 1997 ... Liberty finishes the regular season with an 8-1 record in Big South road games, and the team is now 84-11 in road conference tilts under head coach CAREY GREEN The Lady Flames now lead the Big South standings by three and a half games and can clinch the No. 1 seed for the Big South Women's Basketball Championship with one more victory ... Two more wins will give Liberty its 14th 20-win season in the last 16 years ... REAGAN MILLER hit two three-pointers in each game, and her 47 triples on the year are the most by any Lady Flame since KRISTAL THARP also made 47 in 2004-05 ... Saturday's game against Gardner-Webb will be Liberty's Senior Day, and the duo of DANIKA DALE and AVERY WARLEY will be recognized prior to tipoff at the Vines Center.

The team's 69-64 loss to Liberty on Monday represented the closest loss to the Flames in program history... KRISTEN STEVENS hit a three-pointer with 13 seconds left to lift PC over Radford on Saturday, 52-49. The win marked the team's first-ever win over the Highlanders in the 10th meeting... PC moved to 4-1 this year in games decided by three points or less... PC scored 11 points in the final 1:16 against Liberty on Monday night but Liberty escaped with the win... KARLEE TAYLOR leads the team with 55 three-pointers on the year, tying her for 10th place in program history for most in a single season (matching Darah Huffman's 1999 mark)... UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville went 0-1 on the week with a 69-52 loss at Gardner-Webb on Saturday. The Bulldogs are now 7-18 overall and 3-11 in Big South games. The Bulldogs are also now 7-6 at home and 0-12 on the road. This season marks the worst road record for the Bulldogs since going 1-11 in away contests during the 2009-10 season. Asheville will hit the road to take on Radford on Saturday followed by Liberty on Monday evening. The Bulldogs dropped both home games against the two. In the game against Winthrop on Feb. 13 senior guard LINDSEY THOMPSON scored her 1,000th career point. She now has 1,020 for her career. The Bulldogs also set the team record for 3-pointers in a game against WU, scoring 14 in the contest. Junior guard GRACE BLAYLOCK set the UNC Asheville record for 3-pointers in a game with seven against Winthrop on Jan. 14, 2012. Blaylock connected on 7-of-14 from behind the arc. Senior guard Thompson set the UNC Asheville record for career 3-pointers against George Mason on 11/27. She now has 195 for her career, breaking the record of BRITTANY HENDLEY, who played for the Bulldogs from 2003-07. KELLI RILES now has 711 rebounds, which ranks seventh all time at UNC Asheville, and is the seventh player in school history to grab more than 700 rebounds.

WINTHROP

Winthrop won back-to-back games over Liberty and Radford for the first time in school history. The weekend was full or records for Winthrop as it also tide the school record for conference wins with nine. The 2008-09 team owned the record after going 9-7. Winthrop also tied a school record for four consecutive wins in Big South play, which had done earlier this season and only twice before (2001-02 and 2008-09). It was also the first ever regular season series sweep of Radford. Sophomore DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN had 10 assists against Radford and broke the school record for assists in a season. The previous record was 192 set by JANET FREDERICK in 1980-81. McClanahan now has 195 assists on the year and is closing in on the Big South record of 207 set by STEPHANIE HOWARD in 1988-89. She also scored 21 in the win over Radford, her 15th 20-plus game on the season. If she continues to score at this pace, she will become the first player since Howard (1988-89) to lead the league in both scoring and assists. No Winthrop player has ever led the Big South in scoring. In the win over Radford, McClanahan passed the 900 career point mark. SAMIYA WRIGHT tied the Winthrop freshman record for threes in a season with 51. DIANA CHOIBEKOVA became just the second different player to hit 100 or more threes in a single season over the weekend. She's now got 105 on the year and is three shy of breaking the Big South single-season mark set by KATIE TULL (Charleston Southern). As a team, Winthrop has 196 threes, which is the fifth best mark in a single season in Big South history. Winthrop can become the fifth different team and the third different school to make 200 or more in a season.
