She got her week started with 25 points, five assists, two rebounds and a steal to fuel Winthrop to the 65-55 win over Gardner-Webb on Feb. 11. She followed that effort with 28 points, five helpers, three steals and two rebounds in the Eagles' 79-68 win against UNC Asheville on Feb. 13. Her 53 points on the week pushed her career total to 877 as she became the first Winthrop player in school history to reach the 800 point plateau before her junior season. The honor marks her first Big South Player of the Week nod this season.

## WINNING THE REBOUND WAR(LEY)

Liberty's **AVERY WARLEY** has taken over No. 1 all-time on the Big South rebounding chart with 1,171... and counting.

## WELCOME TO THE BIG SOUTH CONFERENCE

On Monday, Jan. 23 the Big South Conference welcomed Longwood to the League. Longwood will begin play in the Big South starting in the 2012-13 season. The addition of the Lancers gives the Big South 12 members, the most ever members in the League's history.

## NUMBER ONE STUNNER

High Point's **SHAMIA BROWN** became HPU's Division I scoring leader with her 13 points against Charleston Southern on Jan. 23. She surpassed former teammate **JURICA HARGRAVES** who set the record last season.

## RECORD SETTERS

**DIANA CHOIBEKOVA** tied the Big South single-game record for three-pointers against Gardner-Webb on Jan. 16. The junior cashed in on 10 triples in the contest as she connected on 59 percent of her attempts (10-of-17) ... Also **CHEYENNE PARKER** tied a Big South single-game record as she recorded 10 blocks vs. Winthrop on Jan. 28.

## CLOSING IN ON BIG SOUTH RECORDS

Winthrop's **DIANA CHOIBEKOVA** currently has 95 three-pointers on the season to rank No. 3 on the Big South single-season list. She is only 12 triples shy of the all-time record held by former Charleston Southern Buccaneer **KATIE TULL**. Tull cashed in on 107 triples during the 2010-11 season ... Teammate **DEQUESHA McCLANAHAN** is No. 9 on the all-time single-season assist list 176 on the season. At her current pace, she will likely become one of only four Big South student-athletes to post 200 assists in a season.

## BURN'N UP THE BOARDS

The Lady Flames have established themselves as one of the top rebounding teams in the country. Liberty currently sits at No. 1 in the nation with a 15.6 rebound margin.

## GOT THAT ONE OUT OF THE WAY

Junior guard **JENNIFER HOOVER** picked up her first Big South win during the Christmas break with an 89-49 win over UNC Asheville on New Year's Eve... Winthrop's **MARLENE STOLLINGS** grabbed her first Big South win on Jan. 7 as Winthrop downed Presbyterian College.

## BCS BUSTERS

The first weekend in December proved to be a big one for the Big South Conference. On Friday, Dec. 2, **ERIN REYNOLDS** of High Point fueled the Panther offense with 36 points to lead High Point to the 82-75 win over Pitt of the Big East ... Two days later, Charleston Southern's **LAKEITHA ALSTON** posted a 31-point, 10 rebound double-double in the Bucs' 82-77 win over Clemson of the ACC.

## THAT'S RIGHT ICE-MAN ... I AM DANGEROUS

Junior guard **DIANA CHOIBEKOVA** has established herself as one of the League's most dangerous shooters from beyond the arc. She currently ranks No. 1 in all of Division I with 4.0 triples per game. She has also scored in double-digits in 18 games this season and has posted two games with at least 30 points.

## QUEEN BEE

**DEQUESHA McCLANAHAN** is the League's leading scorer with 20.1 points per contest to rank No. 14 in the nation. Scoring isn't the only way McClanahan is generating offense for the Eagles as she is currently ranked No. 4 in the country with 7.4 assists per game.

## FEAR OF REJECTION?

High Point's **CHEYENNE PARKER** has made a name for herself in the post this season. She currently ranks No. 5 in the nation with 3.6 blocked shots per game. Against Winthrop, she tied the Big South single-season standard with 10 blocked shots. She is also currently ranked No. 3 in the country with 15 double-doubles and posted a streak of seven games with 10-or-more rebounds, including a career-best 22 boards against Coastal Carolina on Jan. 21. In the game vs. Winthrop she notched the League's only triple-double this season as she finished with 13 points, 22 rebounds and 10 blocks. As a team, the Panthers are No. 22 in the country with 5.2 blocked shots per game.

## 20/20

UNC Asheville's **KELLI RILES** set a new Big South single-game standard for rebounds as she pulled down 28 rebounds in Asheville's win over USC Upstate on Nov. 30. The game marked the second time this season that she has posted a game with 20-or-more rebounds as she pulled down 24 against Winston-Salem State in the opening game of the season ... In the game vs. WSSU, she also became the only player this season with a 20-point, 20-rebound double-double ... Her 11.4 rebounds per game is currently ranked No. 7 in the nation.

## DOUBLE-TROUBLE

The Big South has two student-athletes currently averaging a double-double in points and rebounds this season. High Point's **CHEYENNE PARKER** is averaging 13.6 points and 12.3 rebounds per game, while **AVERY WARLEY** of Liberty is averaging 12.9 points and 11.3 boards per game. Parker's rebound average is third in the nation, while Warley is ranked 6th.

## TWIN KILL'N

This season the Big South Conference has had 12 teammates go for 20 points in the same contest. During all of last season the Big South only saw seven sets of teammates go for 20 points in the same game. Radford's **DA'NARIA ERWIN SPENCER** and **ASHLEY BUCKHANNON** and **DIANA CHOIBEKOVA** and **DEQUESHA McCLANAHAN** have accomplished the output twice on the season.

## LIGHTS OUT

Charleston Southern currently ranks No. 4 in the nation with 9.4 three-point field goals per game, while Winthrop is ranked No. 12 with 7.5.

## SOMEBODY HAS GOTTA SHOOT IT

Campbell philosophy is that it is better to give than receive. The Fighting Camels are ranked No. 12 in the nation with 17.2 assists per game.

## NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

## CAMPBELL

In its only game of the week, Campbell defeated Big South rival High Point 89-68, notching season-highs in points and margin of victory (+21). The Lady Camels also shot a season-high 65.5 percent, the program's best shooting rate since Jan. 17, 2005 when Campbell downed Longwood 83-56 with a 67.4 (29-43) clip. Campbell hit an astounding 77.8 (21-27) percent of its first half shots to build a 19 point lead by the break. Team posted its seventh 20-plus assist game with 26, while forcing 20 turnovers for the 10th time this year. The win was head coach **WANDA WATKINS'** 473rd of her career, all coming at Campbell. The win over High Point was Campbell's first over the Panthers since Dec. 9, 2008. CU is now 8-18 all-time against the Panthers. The Lady Camels reached 100 team blocks on Saturday, registering seven against HPU. CU broke its single season record earlier this year (formerly 84, 2010-11). Seven denials marks the second-most for the team in a single game this season after tying the school record of nine three times. Campbell has posted four or more team blocks 11 times this year. Campbell is now 9-2 in Gilbert Craig Gore Arena this season. The trio of **JAZMINE COOPER**, **TONISHA BAKER** and **KATELYN BASS** all posted 18 points in the win, with Baker adding seven assists and Bass tacking on six rebounds. **ROSLYN PRESLEY** also scored 12 on 6-of-6 shooting, while freshman **KIERA GAINES** tallied 10 rebounds to go with five points and four assists.

## CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Buccaneers have dropped back-to-back games for just the third time this season... Their double overtime loss to Liberty on Saturday was just their third overtime loss in four seasons and their fourth since the 2000-01 season... The Bucs are 7-4 in overtime games in that time period... As they remain one of the nation's best 3-point shooting teams, eight of their ten buckets in the second half vs. the Flames were from beyond the arc... CSU has outscored its opponents in the second half in four of their five last games for a total score of 205-160... The Buccaneers celebrated the return of **KIKI RUTLEDGE** to the lineup this past weekend... Rutledge missed the past month and a half with an injury... **RACHELLE COWARD's** streak of leading the team in scoring was snapped at five games when teammate **LAKEITHA ALSTON** put up 27 points vs. Radford... Coward kept her cool in the final four seconds of the first overtime vs. Liberty, sinking all three free-throws after drawing a foul while attempting a trey... The Bucs' 40 3-point field goal attempts vs. Liberty were the most all season... Radford's 63.6 shooting percentage was the highest allowed by the Bucs all-season long... Alston shot an impressive 76.9 percent vs. the Highlanders.

## COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina went 0-2 during its annual trip to the Commonwealth of Virginia ... After falling to Radford (55-43) and Liberty (66-54) the Chanticleers are now 1-9 away from the friendly confines of Kimbel Arena ... Senior **OLIVIA IRICK** led Coastal with 15.5 points per game on the week ... Irick sank six 3-pointers on the week, including four of Coastal's five at Radford, to move into sole possession of ninth all-time in the Coastal record books with 104 career treys ... Coastal held Liberty to a Big South season low 33.9 percent from the field ... Freshman **JENA HAMRICK**, who entered the weekend with five career points, sank two key triples in the first half against Liberty ... Coastal opens its final three game homestand on Saturday as hosts to Campbell.

## GARDNER-WEBB

The Runnin' Bulldogs losing streak was pushed to nine straight games after GWU went 0-2 at home this week, suffering tough losses to Winthrop and PC. In GWU's 10-point loss to Winthrop on Saturday night, the Runnin' Bulldogs were within striking distance at 10-points or less for much of the contest. However, GWU couldn't keep the Lady Eagles off the glass nor out of the paint, as Winthrop hauled in 27 offensive rebounds and outscored GWU 32-14 in points in the paint. On Monday night, Gardner-Webb and Presbyterian played a back-and-forth contest which saw 15 lead changes and eight ties. However, GWU failed to put the game away late in the contest, which allowed PC to tie the score up at the free throw line with less than a minute to play and force the game into overtime. In the OT period the two teams traded the lead back-and-forth, however, PC got a late lay-up by Shenese Smith and converted on one of their two free throws to escape with a 59-57 overtime win over GWU. A win would keep the Runnin' Bulldogs alive for a spot in the Big South Championship Tournament come March.

## HIGH POINT

High Point fell to Campbell by a score of 89-68 in the Panthers' only game this week. CU came out on fire from the floor, shooting 78 percent in the first half to take a 19-point lead. Junior **LAURA WHITT** set a new career-high with 21 points on 6-14 shooting. Whitt set a new career-high with 5 three pointers in the game.

## LIBERTY

Liberty won a pair of home games this past week, extending its winning streak to 11 games ... This is the Lady Flames' longest winning streak since an 18-game streak spanning Dec. 29, 2008 and March 6, 2009 ... Liberty needed double overtime to defeat Charleston Southern on Saturday ... It was the Lady Flames' first double overtime contest and first overtime victory of any kind since a 76-72 double overtime triumph at American on Jan. 6, 2004 ... On Monday, Liberty defeated Coastal Carolina for the 38th straight time ... That ties Tennessee (vs. Alabama) for the third-longest active NCAA Division I women's basketball winning streak against a single opponent ... **EVERY WARLEY's** career-high 23 rebounds against Charleston Southern tied the Vines Center record ... **REAGAN MILLER** scored a career-high 23 points versus Charleston Southern while tying a program record with 48 minutes played against the Lady Buccaneers ... Liberty, which is now 87-7 in February games under head coach **CAREY GREEN**, has clinched its 16th straight winning season ... This weekend, the Lady Flames will play their final two road games of the regular season, at Winthrop and Presbyterian College ... If Liberty wins both contests, it will finish with a perfect Big South road record (9-0) for first time since the Lady Flames' 2004-05 Sweet 16 team went 7-0 in road Big South tilts

## PRESBYTERIAN

PC picked up its second and third consecutive road Big South Conference wins with victories over UNC Asheville, 62-45, and Gardner-Webb, 59-57... The streak represents the longest PC road Big South winning streak in team history and the squad's five wins ties last season's tally for the most Big South wins in a season... **MARIAH PIETROWSKI's** five rebounds on Monday night made her the PC career leader in Division I rebounds, with 436. ## RADFORD

Radford went 2-0 over the weekend and stretched its season-best winning streak to seven games. The streak is the longest in league play since 1993-94, when that club also won seven consecutive. In both games, Radford led by double digits in the second half. Radford led by as many as 14 in the final stanza and Erwin Spencer led the way with 23 points, her 11th outing of 20 or more this season. **SARAH TABB** averaged 7.5 rebounds per game over the two-game weekend.

## UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville went 0-2 on the week, with a pair of losses to Presbyterian and Winthrop. The Bulldogs dropped a 62-45 decision to PC on Saturday before dropping another home game to the Lady Eagles, 79-68 on Monday evening. In the game against Winthrop senior guard LINDSEY THOMPSON scored her 1,000th career point. She now has 1,017 for her career. The Bulldogs also set the team record for 3-pointers in a game against WU, scoring 14 in the contest. Junior guard GRACE BLAYLOCK set the UNC Asheville record for 3-pointers in a game with seven against Winthrop on Jan. 14, 2012. Blaylock connected on 7-of-14 from behind the arc. She posted a career-high 23 points in the process. The previous record was six, held by four different players. Freshman guard SHONESE JONES has been named the Big South Player of the Week and the Big South Freshman of the Week three times. LEAH WORMACK has been named the Big South Freshman of the Week three times on the season. Senior guard LINDSEY THOMPSON set the UNC Asheville record for career 3-pointers against George Mason on 11/27. She now has 194 for her career, breaking the record of BRITTANY HENDLEY, who played for the Bulldogs from 2003-07. KELLI RILES collected her 600th career rebound against Charleston Southern on Jan. 9. She now has 707 rebounds, which ranks seventh all time at UNC Asheville, and is the seventh player in school history to grab more than 700 rebounds.

## WINTHROP

Winthrop captured its 7th road win of the season on Monday at UNC Asheville, which ties a school record for the most road wins in a season. It's the second most ever by a Winthrop team since its move to the NCAA Division I level. The school record for wins on the road in a single season at the D1 level is eight set by the 2008-09 team. The seven road wins are tied for second most by a Big South school this season. Freshman TAYLOR CALVERT continues to make an impact since being inserted into the starting line-up on Jan. 7 at Presbyterian College and had a big weekend on the road. Calvert set a new career-high in Saturday's game at Gardner-Webb with 12 rebounds, only to top that on Monday evening with 19. The 19 rebounds were one shy of tying the school record of 20, set by Sarah Dukes on Feb. 7, 1980 against Longwood. Calvert averaged nine points and 15.5 rebounds in the two games. Sophomore DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN had back-to-back 20-point games over the weekend, which gives her six straight games with 20-plus and 14 games on the season. Eight of her games with 20 or more points have come on the road. She now has 877 career points and is in search of 1,000 before the end of her sophomore season. McClanahan is averaging 20.5 points per game and trying to become just the second player in school history to average 20 points. DIANA CHOIBEKOVA ran into foul trouble at Asheville and came away with just two threes and now has 95 on the season, just 12 back of tying the Big South single-season mark.

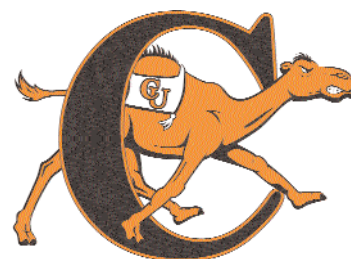

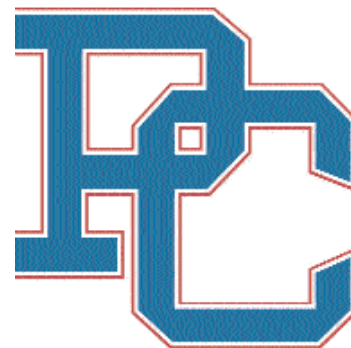
