Baker averaged 11.3 points and 9.3 rebounds per game to lead the Fighting Camels to a 2-1 record last week. She posted two double-doubles on the week with 13 points and 11 rebounds in the win over Longwood on Nov. 22 and 10 points and 13 boards against Georgia State three days later. The guard finished the week with 11 points, six assists, two steals and four caroms in the win over Eastern Kentucky on Nov. 26. In the three-game span, Baker shot 57 percent from down town and posted five steals, three blocks and eight helpers. The honor marks her first Player of the Week nod this season.

UNC Asheville's **KELLI RILES** set a new Big South single-game standard for rebounds as she pulled down 24 rebounds in Asheville's win over Winston-Salem State on Nov. 12. She also put in 20 points to become the only player in the League to post a game with 20 points and 20 boards. The previous record of 23 has stood since the 2000 campaign.

SCORE'N AND DISH'N

Winthrop's **DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN** isn't afraid to get her teammates involved in the action. Besides ranking second in the League with 19.2 points per contest. She also ranks No. 1 in the Big South and No. 4 in the country with 7.17 assists per game. She is the only player this season to post a 20-point, 10 assist double-double, as well as the only player in the League to dish out 10 helpers in a game. The guard is also tied for tops in the Big South Conference with three 20-point games on the season.

No. 1 STUNNER

High Point's **SHAMIA BROWN** ranks No. 1 in the League with 19.6 points per contest. She has gone for 20 or more points in two contests on the season.

I'LL TAKE PLAYERS AVERAGING A DOUBLE-DOUBLE THIS SEASON ALEX

The Big South has three student-athletes currently averaging a double-double in points and rebounds this season. High Point's **CHEYENNE PARKER** is averaging 16.4 points and 10.8 rebounds per game, while **AVERY WARLEY** of Liberty is averaging 10.3 points and 11.2 boards per game. UNC Asheville's **KELLI RILES** is currently posting 12.8 points and 10.8 rebounds per outing.

TWIN KILL'N

This season the Big South Conference has had five teammates go for 20 points in the same contest. During all of last season the Big South only saw seven sets of teammates go for 20 points in the same game.

GOOD 'N' TWENTY

Radford's **DANARIA ERWIN SPENCER** is picking up where she left off last season. She is the only player in the Big South to post consecutive 20-point games this season. NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

CAMPBELL

Campbell moved to 4-0, the program's best start since 1985-86 before dropping its first game of the season Friday at Georgia State. The Lady Camels started the week at home, stifling Longwood in a 48-33 win. Campbell limited the Lancers to just 22 percent from the field, who did not have a player score in double figures. The 33 points allowed was a Gore Arena low, and the least allowed by a Lady Camel team since Nov. 30, 1997, when CU defeated St. Andrews 82-31 in Carter Gymnasium. Through those first four games, Campbell allowed the second-fewest points in program history, surrendering just 175 tallies. The 1973-74 squad is the only CU team in history to allow fewer points, yielding just 147 in its first four contests. With wins of 18, 17, 16 and 15 points in those games, the Lady Camels owned a 16.5 margin of victory. That margin was also the second-largest in program history through four games, trailing only the 1981-82 Lady Camels. That season, the first under head coach WANDA WATKINS, outscored opponents 362-265 for an average of 24.3 points per game in their first four. In Georgia State Thanksgiving Classic play over the weekend, the Lady Camels split, rebounding after their first loss of the season against the host Panthers for a 64-52 win over Eastern Kentucky in the tournament finale for both teams. CU junior guard TONISHA BAKER was named to the All-Classic team, scoring in double figures in both games and gathering a double-double against GSU. The Lady Camels will host Winston-Salem State in an 11:45 a.m. tilt on Tuesday, as Campbell puts on CU Education Day for the second-straight year.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Bucs improved to 4-0 at home with an 81-43 win over Bluefield College... LAKEITHA ALSTON led the scoring with 18 points, going an impressive 8-of-14 from the field... The CSU bench contributed 24 points on the night ... ERIN BRATCHER hit four 3-pointers for 12 points vs. the Rams, tying the most 3s made by a player this season... HELEN TERRY also tied the mark with four 3-pointers vs SC State... CSU suffered just its second loss of the season vs. SC State on Saturday... RACHELLE COWARD's 19 points led the scoring ... SHAY JONES became the first CSU player this season to go 100% at the free-throw line going 6-6 vs. Bluefield... Jones and Terry tied for most assist this season with five each (Jones at SC State, Terry vs. Bluefield)... Alston has scored in double-digits in every game this season and has led the team in scoring three times.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina finished 1-1 on the week to bring its overall record to 4-1 ... The Chanticleers defeated Southern Conference opponent Western Carolina, 66-56, and fell at Atlantic Sun foe North Florida, 67-37 ... The contests marked the first for the Chants away from the friendly confines of Kimbel Arena this season ... SHATIA COLE and ANGELICA HENRY were the top scorers on the week with 24 and 23 points, respectively. Both Cole and Henry poured in 16 points at Western Carolina to help push Coastal to its first 4-0 start since the 2008-09 season ... Forward SHANIKA MADDOX finished the two games with 17 total rebounds to increase her team-leading total to 46 ... The Chants entered the week averaging 6.3 blocks per game to rank 19th in the NCAA despite losing the programs all-time leading shot blocker to graduation ... Coastal returns to the hardwood on Wednesday, Nov. 30 as hosts to Coker before taking 11 days off for the fall examination period.

GARDNER-WEBB

The Runnin' Bulldogs spent the Thanksgiving break in Freeport, Bahamas, where GWU competed in the 2011 Junkanoo Jam. In the Freeport Bracket, the Runnin' Bulldogs were joined by No. 3/4 Notre Dame, No. 6/7 Duke and Southern California. In GWU's first game, the length and athleticism of Duke, as well as their sharp shooting from downtown (10-of-21), was too much for the young and undersized Runnin' Bulldog squad who managed only 31 points in the loss. On Saturday, the Runnin' Bulldogs hung with the Trojans of Southern California for most of the first half, playing tough defense and protecting the ball better on the offensive end. However, in the second half, the Trojans got hot from behind the three-point line, draining seven treys to pull away for the 82-41 win. Gardner-Webb will look to regroup this week, as the Runnin' Bulldogs host the Wofford College Terriers at 4 p.m. on Saturday afternoon at 4 p.m. in Paul Porter Arena. GWU has won two straight over the Terriers in their annual match up, including a 62-47 win in the two teams' season opener last year.

HIGH POINT

High Point dropped its only game over Thanksgiving weekend, falling to Mercer by a score 75-67 on Friday. The Panthers were led by the frontcourt duo of SHAMIA BROWN and CHEYENNE PARKER in the game as the pair combined to score 52 of High Point's 67 points. Brown finished one point shy of season and career highs with a team-high 28 points. She also grabbed eight rebounds and had five steals. Parker set a new career high in points with 24 and recorded her third double-double of the season with 14 rebounds. She also blocked three shots and had two steals.

LIBERTY

Liberty went 2-1 last week, leveling its overall record at 3-3 ... The Lady Flames posted their first home win of the year on Tuesday, with an 82-39 victory over Virginia-Wise ... Liberty then went 1-1 to finish third at the Vanderbilt Thanksgiving Classic, Friday and Saturday in Nashville, Tenn. ... LAKENDRA WASHINGTON was named to the all-tournament team, after averaging 11.0 ppg in Liberty's two games ... Liberty's 76-45 loss to No. 12/14 Oklahoma on Friday came in the Lady Flames' first matchup against a Top 25 opponent since an 81-66 setback to No. 17/17 St. John's on Dec. 28, 2010 ... AVERY WARLEY finished with 27 rebounds for the week, passing former teammate MEGAN FRAZEE for third place in program history and fourth place in Big South history. Warley has now pulled down 968 career rebounds ... DEVON BROWN needs only 20 more points to become the 14th player in program history to score 1,000 career points.

PRESBYTERIAN

Senior KRISTEN STEVENS cracked the 500-point barrier with 11 points against North Carolina, putting her at 506 for her career and ranking fifth in the Division I era. She also stands one three pointer shy of tying for sixth for three-point field goals made in program history... MARIAH PIETROWSKI has 657 career points and stands 65 points away from PC's career Division I points record... Sophomore KARLEE TAYLOR is one three-pointer away from tying for third in the Division I-era in that category... The Blue Hose have gone 46 straight games making at least one-three pointer in every game... PC held North Carolina to season-lows in points and shooting percentage and held South Carolina to 22 points in the first half, matching a season-low for the Gamecocks.

RADFORD

Radford suffered its first loss of 2011-12 on Saturday at George Washington, 83-59. After starting the year 4-0 for the first time since 1983-84, the frontcourt size and defensive pressure led to the Colonials' win. Despite the loss, Radford went 18-of-23 from the stripe (78 percent) and out-rebounded GW 49-44. After a shaky start, Radford returned in the second half to outscore the Colonials 48-43 behind 15 second-half points by junior ASHLEY BUCKHANNON. Buckhannon totaled a game-high 19, while backcourt mate DARNIA ERWIN SPENCER was the other Highlander in double figures with 13. SARAH TABB held her own on the glass, collecting a career high 9 boards, 7 offensive.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville went 0-1 on the week, falling to George Mason out of the Colonial Athletic Association on Sunday afternoon. The Bulldogs could not slow down the hot-shooting Patriots, who shot 56 percent from the floor. Asheville is now 2-3 overall on the season, 2-0 at home and 0-3 on the road. The Bulldogs have led at the half in four out of five games this year. Asheville will host USC Upstate on Wednesday evening at Kimmel Arena at 7 p.m. The Bulldogs defeated the Spartans last season, 95-76 at Justice Center. UNC Asheville started the season with an 83-73 victory over Winston-Salem State on Nov. 12. The game was the first basketball game to be played in the brand new Kimmel Arena, UNC Asheville's new home for men's and women's basketball. The win marked the second year in a row that Asheville has opened the season with a win. Junior forward KELLI RILES started the season with a bang as she tallied 21 points and a career-high 24 rebounds against the Rams. Riles' previous career-high rebounds was 22 against Radford last season. The 13-of-13 effort just misses the school record of 14-of-14 from TARA MCMINN set in the 1990-91 season. Riles is the first Asheville player to record a 20-20 since SHEILA FORD accomplished the feat in the 1983-84 season.

WINTHROP

College Sports Madness has named Winthrop junior guard DIANA CHOIBEKOVA has been named the Big South Women's Basketball Player of the Week (Nov. 21). Choibekova averaged 20 points and 5.7 rebounds while shooting 43 percent from the floor and 47 percent from behind the arc as Winthrop went 1-2 at the Winthrop Classic. The Lady Eagles offense has averaged 72.8 points through the first five games, which ranks 7th all-time in school history. The most a Winthrop team has ever averaged over the course of the first five games of a season is 82.4 in 1984-85. The program has never had a team average 70 or more points since making the move to the NCAA Division I level. The last team to average 70 or more was in 1985-86. Choibekova knocked down 25 three-pointers through the first five games of the season and has 27 through six. Her 25 three-pointers were the most ever over the first five games of the season by any Winthrop player. The previous record was held by TIFFANY RODD, who had 13 in 2005-06. Choibekova and DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN were each named to the Winthrop Classic All-Tournament Team, hosted by the Lady Eagles from Nov. 18-20. Choibekova and McClanahan posted 22 and 20 points respectively in the season opener at Troy. Choibekova is the first player to score 20 or more points in their Winthrop debut since Tiffany Rodd scored 23 on Nov. 18, 2005 against North Florida. It was also the first time since Feb. 23, 2009 when two Winthrop players scored 20 points or more in the same game. Rodd and Ashley Fann each scored 23 points against Gardner-Webb on Feb. 23, 2009.

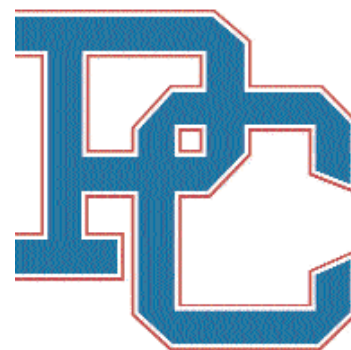
