Parker, a sophomore from Queens, N.Y., shot 65 percent from the field and averaged 19 points and 11 rebounds per game to lead High Point to a pair of Big South wins last week. She got her week started with 21 points on 69 percent from the floor to go along with nine boards, eight blocks and three steals to lead her squad to the 60-53 win over Presbyterian College on Feb. 25. Two days later against Winthrop, Parker stayed hot as she connected on 60 percent from the floor to finish with 17 points in the win over the Eagles. The forward also ripped down 13 rebounds and posted five blocks and two steals to give the Panthers sole possession of second-place in the League standings. The honor marks her second Big South Player of the Week nod this season.

Miller, a guard from Sanger, Texas, averaged 12 points per game and shot 53 percent from the floor to help the Lady Flames to two wins last week to secure the Big South Regular-Season Championship and No. 1 seed in the upcoming Big South Women's Basketball Championship. In the win over Gardner-Webb on Feb. 25, Miller recorded 10 points on 44 percent shooting and added three assists, one steal and one rebound. She followed that effort with 14 points on 63 percent from the floor to push the Lady Flames to the 84-53 win over UNC Asheville on Feb. 27. Miller also dished out six assists and came away with two rebounds against the Bulldogs. The honor marks her fourth overall and third-straight Freshman of the Week plaudit this season.

TOO CLOSE TO CALL

The Big South season is coming down the wire in the final two games of the season. Liberty has clinched the Regular-Season Championship and the No. 1 seed in the upcoming Advance Auto Parts Big South Women's Basketball Tournament. The Lady Flames are the only team to have clinched a seed. The final weekend will play a major factor in shaking out the seeds for the tournament.

WINNING THE REBOUND WAR(LEY)

Liberty's **AVERY WARLEY** has taken over No. 1 all-time on the Big South rebounding chart with 1,221... and counting.

NUMBER ONE STUNNER

High Point's **SHAMIA BROWN** became HPU's Division I scoring leader with her 13 points against Charleston Southern on Jan. 23. She surpassed former teammate **JURICA HARGRAVES** who set the record last season.

RECORD SETTERS

DIANA CHOIBEKOVA tied the Big South single-game record for three-pointers against Gardner-Webb on Jan. 16. The junior cashed in on 10 triples in the contest as she connected on 59 percent of her attempts (10-of-17) ... Also **CHEYENNE PARKER** tied a Big South single-game record as she recorded 10 blocks vs. Winthrop on Jan. 28.

NEW KIDS ON TOP

Winthrop's **DIANA CHOIBEKOVA** took over the top spot on the single-season three-pointers list as she has cashed in on 113 on the season. She is the only other player in Big South history not named Katie Tull to post 100-or-more triples in a season ... **CHEYENNE PARKER** of High Point reset the single-season block standard over the weekend as she now has 99 on the year. Former Radford standout Kelli Darden held the record since the 2007-08 season with 98 rejections ... **DEQUESHA McCLANAHAN** is No. 2 on the all-time single-season assist list 206 on the season. She is just 1 helper away from the Big South single-season record.

BURN'N UP THE BOARDS

The Lady Flames have established themselves as one of the top rebounding teams in the country. Liberty currently sits at No. 1 in the nation with a 15.6 rebound margin.

BCS BUSTERS

The first weekend in December proved to be a big one for the Big South Conference. On Friday, Dec. 2, **ERIN REYNOLDS** of High Point fueled the Panther offense with 36 points to lead High Point to the 82-75 win over Pitt of the Big East ... Two days later, Charleston Southern's **LAKEITHA ALSTON** posted a 31-point, 10 rebound double-double in the Bucs' 82-77 win over Clemson of the ACC.

THAT'S RIGHT ICE-MAN ... I AM DANGEROUS

Junior guard **DIANA CHOIBEKOVA** has established herself as one of the League's most dangerous shooters from beyond the arc. She currently ranks No. 1 in all of Division I with 4.1 triples per game. She has also scored in double-digits in 22 games this season and has posted two games with at least 30 points.

QUEEN BEE

DEQUESHA McCLANAHAN is the League's leading scorer with 20.4 points per contest to rank No. 13 in the nation. Scoring isn't the only way McClanahan is generating offense for the Eagles as she is currently ranked No. 3 in the country with 7.5 assists per game.

FEAR OF REJECTION?

High Point's **CHEYENNE PARKER** has made a name for herself in the post this season. She currently ranks No. 4 in the nation with 3.6 blocked shots per game. Against Winthrop, she tied the Big South single-season standard with 10 blocked shots. She is also currently ranked No. 6 in the country with 16 double-doubles and posted a streak of seven games with 10-or-more rebounds, including a career-best 22 boards against Coastal Carolina on Jan. 21. In the game vs. Winthrop she notched the League's only triple-double this season as she finished with 13 points, 22 rebounds and 10 blocks. As a team, the Panthers are No. 19 in the country with 5.3 blocked shots per game.

20/20

UNC Asheville's **KELLI RILES** set a new Big South single-game standard for rebounds as she pulled down 28 rebounds in Asheville's win over USC Upstate on Nov. 30. The game marked the second time this season that she has posted a game with 20-or-more rebounds as she pulled down 24 against Winston-Salem State in the opening game of the season ... In the game vs. WSSU, she also became the only player this season with a 20-point, 20-rebound double-double ... Her 11.0 rebounds per game is currently ranked No. 9 in the nation.

DOUBLE-TROUBLE

The Big South has two student-athletes currently averaging a double-double in points and rebounds this season. High Point's **CHEYENNE PARKER** is averaging 13.6 points and 12.0 rebounds per game, while **AVERY WARLEY** of Liberty is averaging 13.1 points and 11.4 boards per game. Parker's rebound average is third in the nation, while Warley is ranked 7th.

TWIN KILL'N

This season the Big South Conference has had 12 teammates go for 20 points in the same contest. During all of last season the Big South only saw seven sets of teammates go for 20 points in the same game. Radford's **DA'NARIA ERWIN SPENCER** and **ASHLEY BUCKHANNON** and **DIANA CHOIBEKOVA** and **DEQUESHA McCLANAHAN** have accomplished the output three times on the season.

LIGHTS OUT

Charleston Southern currently ranks No. 5 in the nation with 9.2 three-point field goals per game, while Winthrop is ranked No. 13 with 7.6.

SOMEBODY HAS GOTTA SHOOT IT

Campbell philosophy is that it is better to give than receive. The Fighting Camels are ranked No. 13 in the nation with 16.8 assists per game.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

CAMPBELL

Campbell finished out its home schedule with a convincing 68-44 win over Presbyterian on Monday night. With 16 wins, the Lady Camels secure their first winning season since 2001, with at least three games remaining on the schedule. Campbell also finishes its 2011-12 home schedule with a 10-3 record, recording the team's first double digit home win season since 2000-01, and its ninth overall. CU is now 13-1 when surrendering under 60 points this season, and 7-0 when limiting the opposition below 50. On senior night, **KATELYN BASS** led the way with 13 points and 11 rebounds, the senior forwards third-straight double-double and fourth this season. Bass has amassed 44 rebounds in her last three outings. Bass also totaled 10 points and 16 rebounds on Saturday in a 67-66 overtime loss to Winthrop. That performance came after a 17-rebound outing at Charleston Southern last week. Junior guard **TONISHA BAKER** also scored 13, adding five rebounds, five assists and four steals, while **JAZMINE COOPER**, a junior post, notched 10 points and eight boards on Monday. Freshman guard **KIERA GAINES** also registered 11 points and six rebounds off the bench. The Lady Camels led by as many as 27 in the final stanza before taking the 68-44 home win. Campbell outscored the Blue Hose 42-21 in the second half. The 24 point win marked Campbell's largest margin of victory this season, and its 27 point lead with 1:19 to go in the game was the largest lead over any opponent this season. For the game, the Lady Camels posted 27 points off 17 PC turnovers and tallied 16 fast break points to Presbyterian's 0. Campbell also owned the paint outscoring PC 34-18, while outrebounding the Blue Hose 42-28. Campbell's overtime loss to Winthrop on Saturday was the team's first extra time game this season.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Bucs swept Palmetto State rival Coastal Carolina for the first time since the 2004-05 season... Lakeitha Alston's team high 18 points brings her within 26 of her 1,000th career point at 976... **RACHELLE COWARD** became the 3rd Buc to record a double-double this season with 17 points and a career-high 14 rebounds... **LAKEITHA ALSTON** and **SHAMBREKA JONES** also have double-double this season... CSU grabbed a season-high 46 rebounds vs. the Chants (their 2010-11 high of 53 also came vs. CCU)... Coward ranks 35th in the NCAA in PPG with 18.1 while Alston is 95th at 16.1 ... Bucs now rank 5th in three-pointers at 9.2 per game.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina fell to Charleston Southern, 70-55, in its only game of the week ... The game was the last regular season contest scheduled in Kimbel Arena as the basketball program move into the new Student Recreation and Convocation Center this summer ... Senior **OLIVIA IRICK** and sophomore **ANGELICA HENRY** paced Coastal in the scoring column with 14 points apiece ... Irick's performance marked the fifth straight game she led (or co-led) Coastal in scoring ... Sophomore forwards **SHANIKA MADDOX** and **ALEX PUCKETT** were lost for the season with injuries sustained during the week ... Coastal finished the home portion of its schedule with a program best 12-3 mark.

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb split in their Big South Conference road swing through the state of Virginia, as the Runnin' Bulldogs fell at Liberty 76-44 on Saturday, but bounced back to defeat Radford 59-55 in overtime on Monday night in Radford, Va. The Runnin' Bulldogs weekend got off to a rough start, as GWU was 0-of-16 from the floor in the first few minutes of Saturday's game at Liberty and ultimately fell behind big early. GWU was ice cold from the floor, shooting only 18 percent for the game in the 76-44 road loss. However, the determination of the girls showed through on Monday night, as GWU battled Radford point for point to send the game into overtime at 48-48. GWU outscored Radford 11-7 in the overtime period and overcame 26 percent shooting on the night by hauling down 64 total rebounds en route to the 59-55 overtime road win. The game proved to be the third time in the two teams' last five meetings to go into overtime with the Runnin' Bulldogs winning all three of those contests. GWU's 64 total rebounds was not only 19 more than Radford had for the game, but tied the Runnin' Bulldogs Division I single-game record for most rebounds in a game. With the win the Runnin' Bulldogs improved to 3-13 in conference play and are still vying for a spot in the 2012 Advanced Auto Parts Big South Women's Basketball Championship Tournament in two weeks. The Runnin' Bulldogs have two conference games left on the year, as both games will come at home in Paul Porter Arena. GWU will host High Point at 7 p.m. on Friday night and will then hold "Senior Night" on Monday, March 5th, at 7 p.m. as the Runnin' Bulldogs will do battle with Campbell.

HIGH POINT

High Point took sole control of second place in the Big South with wins over Presbyterian College and Winthrop this past week. The Panthers picked up a 60-53 win over PC on Saturday and an 81-50 win over Winthrop on Monday. **CHEYENNE PARKER** led High Point against the Blue Hose with 21 points, nine rebounds and eight blocks. The sophomore set a new HPU Div. I record for blocks in a season in the win. **ERIN REYNOLDS** chipped in with 16 points while **SHAMIA BROWN** had 10 points and five rebounds. Brown became HPU's Div. I leader in career rebounds in the win and moved to sixth on the all-time scoring list. Two days later against Winthrop, Brown celebrated her senior night in style with a team-high 23 points to go along with five rebounds and three steals. The performance Moved the forward past **JURICA HARGRAVES** for the most points scored in a season in HPU's Div. I era. Parker picked up her conference-best 16th double-double of the season with 17 points and 13 rebounds and blocked five shots to set the new Big South single-season record. Parker now has 99 blocks and moved past Kelli Darden of Radford to claim the record. **ERIN REYNOLDS** and **TAYLER TREMBLAY** also finished in double figures for HPU with 18 and 11 points respectively.

LIBERTY

With Liberty's 76-44 win over Gardner-Webb on Saturday, the Lady Flames clinched their 13th Big South regular-season title in the last 15 seasons, as well as the No. 1 seed for the Big South Championship ... Liberty's 84-53 home triumph over UNC Asheville on Monday marked the Lady Flames' 20th win of the season ... This is Liberty's 14th 20-win campaign in the last 16 years ... The Lady Flames have also tied the 2008-09 Liberty and 2009-10 Gardner-Webb teams for most Big South wins in a single season with 15 ... Huge runs were key to both Liberty victories this past week, as the Lady Flames started the Gardner-Webb contest with a 31-4 burst and then notched a 28-0 run spanning both halves of the UNC Asheville game ... Liberty hit a season-high 11 three-pointers against Asheville, falling just one shy of the program single-game record ... **AVERY WARLEY** played in the 127th game of her career Monday versus Asheville, tying **COURTNEY WATKINS** program record for games played ... **REAGAN MILLER** totaled six made three-pointers for the week, giving the freshman 53 this season ... That is the most triples by a Lady Flame since the 1991-92 campaign, when CYNTHIA THOMSON knocked down 56.

PRESBYTERIAN

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville went 0-2 on the week with losses to Radford and Liberty this past weekend. The Bulldogs are now 7-20 overall and 3-13 in Big South games. The Bulldogs are also now 7-6 at home and 0-14 on the road. This season marks the worst road record for the Bulldogs since going 1-11 in away contests during the 2009-10 season. Asheville will host Campbell on Friday evening before hosting High Point on Monday. The Bulldogs game against Campbell will be played at Justice Center, the home of the women's basketball team since its inception. The Blue & White will close out the 2011-12 regular season with senior night at Kimmel Arena, as the Bulldogs will honor **LINDSEY THOMPSON** and **KATIE WISE**, who will both be playing in their final home game. In the game against Winthrop on Feb. 13 senior guard Lindsey Thompson scored her 1,000th career point. She now has 1,047 for her career. The Bulldogs also set the team record for 3-pointers in a game against WU, scoring 14 in the contest. Junior guard **GRACE BLAYLOCK** set the UNC Asheville record for 3-pointers in a game with seven against Winthrop on Jan. 14, 2012. Thompson set the UNC Asheville record for career 3-pointers against George Mason on 11/27. She now has 199 for her career, breaking the record of **BRITTANY HENDLEY**, who played for the Bulldogs from 2003-07. **KELLI RILES** now has 722 rebounds, which ranks seventh all time at UNC Asheville, and is the seventh player in school history to grab more than 700 rebounds.

WINTHROP

Winthrop split on its last road swing of the regular season with a last second win at Campbell on Saturday and a loss on Monday at High Point that ended a five-game win streak. The five consecutive wins in conference play set a new school record, breaking the previous record of four that had been achieved four times, twice by this year's team. The win over Campbell also gave Winthrop 10 conference wins, which breaks the school record of 9. It also tied the school record for most road wins in a season at 8. Winthrop's win at Campbell on Saturday was the first ever in a Big South Conference league game. The Eagles swept the Camels for the first time ever in a regular season series. Winthrop has swept a school record four league teams this year. Junior **DIANA CHOIBEKOVA** became the Big South Conference single-season record holder for threes after she knocked down seven at Campbell. She finished with nine on the weekend and now has 113 on the year. She broke the previous mark of 107 set by Charleston Southern's **KATIE TULL**. She still leads the country in threes per game at 4.0 and total threes made. **DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN** continues to lead the league in scoring at 20.3 points per game. She is just two assists away from breaking the Big South Conference single-season mark of 207. In addition to her chasing the assists record, McClanahan enters the final two regular season games chasing down 1,000 career points. She has 955 and has at least three games remaining on the year and needs to average 15.2 points per game to pass the mark. If McClanahan can keep her current scoring average, she'll become just the second player in school history to average at least 20 points per game.

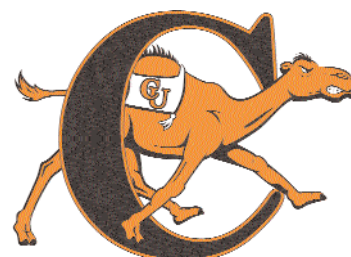

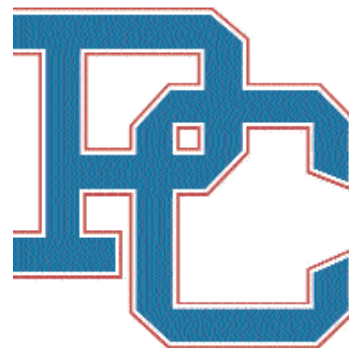
