TWO IN THE POST SEASON

The Big South Conference has placed two teams in the post-season for the sixth-straight year... Liberty won the Big South Championship and will play No. 1 Notre Dame in the NCAA Women's Basketball Championship, while Big South runner-up High Point will play N.C. State in the WNIT.

WINNING THE REBOUND WAR(LEY)

Liberty's **AVERY WARLEY** has taken over No. 1 all-time on the Big South rebounding chart with 1,272... and counting.

NUMBER ONE STUNNER

High Point's **SHAMIA BROWN** became HPU's Division I scoring leader with her 13 points against Charleston Southern on Jan. 23. She surpassed former teammate **JURICA HARGRAVES** who set the record last season.

RECORD SETTERS

DIANA CHOIBEKOVA tied the Big South single-game record for three-pointers against Gardner-Webb on Jan. 16. The junior cashed in on 10 triples in the contest as she connected on 59 percent of her attempts (10-of-17) ... Also **CHEYENNE PARKER** tied a Big South single-game record as she recorded 10 blocks vs. Winthrop on Jan. 28.

NEW KIDS ON TOP

Winthrop's **DIANA CHOIBEKOVA** took over the top spot on the single-season three-pointers list as she has cashed in on 121 on the season. She is the only other player in Big South history not named **KATIE TULL** to post 100-or-more triples in a season ... **CHEYENNE PARKER** of High Point reset the single-season block standard over the weekend as she now has 120 on the year. Former Radford standout **KELLI DARDEN** held the record since the 2007-08 season with 98 rejections ... **DEQUESHA McCLANAHAN** is No. 1 on the all-time single-season assist list with 224 on the season.

BURN'N UP THE BOARDS

The Lady Flames have established themselves as one of the top rebounding teams in the country. Liberty currently sits at No. 1 in the nation with a 16.4 rebound margin.

BCS BUSTERS

The first weekend in December proved to be a big one for the Big South Conference. On Friday, Dec. 2, **ERIN REYNOLDS** of High Point fueled the Panther offense with 36 points to lead High Point to the 82-75 win over Pitt of the Big East ... Two days later, Charleston Southern's **LAKEITHA ALSTON** posted a 31-point, 10 rebound double-double in the Bucs' 82-77 win over Clemson of the ACC.

THAT'S RIGHT ICE-MAN ... I AM DANGEROUS

Junior guard **DIANA CHOIBEKOVA** has established herself as one of the League's most dangerous shooters from beyond the arc. She currently ranks No. 1 in all of Division I with 3.9 triples per game. She has also scored in double-digits in 24 games this season and has posted two games with at least 30 points.

QUEEN BEE

DEQUESHA McCLANAHAN is the League's leading scorer with 21.1 points per contest to rank No. 11 in the nation. Scoring isn't the only way McClanahan is generating offense for the Eagles as she is currently ranked No. 3 in the country with 7.2 assists per game.

FEAR OF REJECTION?

High Point's **CHEYENNE PARKER** has made a name for herself in the post this season. She currently ranks No. 3 in the nation with 3.8 blocked shots per game. Against Winthrop, she tied the Big South single-season standard with 10 blocked shots. She is also currently ranked No. 5 in the country with 19 double-doubles and posted a streak of seven games with 10-or-more rebounds, including a career-best 22 boards against Coastal Carolina on Jan. 21. In the game vs. Winthrop she notched the League's only triple-double this season as she finished with 13 points, 22 rebounds and 10 blocks. As a team, the Panthers are No. 20 in the country with 5.3 blocked shots per game.

20/20

UNC Asheville's **KELLI RILES** set a new Big South single-game standard for rebounds as she pulled down 28 rebounds in Asheville's win over USC Upstate on Nov. 30. The game marked the second time this season that she has posted a game with 20-or-more rebounds as she pulled down 24 against Winston-Salem State in the opening game of the season ... Her 10.6 rebounds per game is currently ranked No. 13 in the nation... Liberty's **AVERY WARLEY** became the just the second the second player in Big South history to post at least 20 points and 20 rebounds during the Big South Championship. Warley notched 20 points and 22 rebound in the semifinals with Charleston Southern on March 10.

DOUBLE-TROUBLE

The Big South has two student-athletes currently averaging a double-double in points and rebounds this season. High Point's **CHEYENNE PARKER** is averaging 13.3 points and 12.4 rebounds per game, while **AVERY WARLEY** of Liberty is averaging 13.1 points and 11.6 boards per game. Parker's rebound average is fourth in the nation, while Warley is ranked 7th.

TWIN KILL'N

This season the Big South Conference has had 14 teammates go for 20 points in the same contest. During all of last season the Big South only saw seven sets of teammates go for 20 points in the same game. Radford's **DA'NARIA ERWIN SPENCER** and **ASHLEY BUCKHANNON** and **DIANA CHOIBEKOVA** and **DEQUESHA McCLANAHAN** have accomplished the output three times on the season.

LIGHTS OUT

Charleston Southern currently ranks No. 4 in the nation with 9.2 three-point field goals per game, while Winthrop is ranked No. 13 with 7.5.

SOMEBODY HAS GOTTA SHOOT IT

Campbell philosophy is that it is better to give than receive. The Fighting Camels are ranked No. 13 in the nation with 16.7 assists per game.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

CAMPBELL

Campbell, playing in its first Big South Championship since 1994 after a 17-year stay in the Atlantic Sun, fell 57-53 to Charleston Southern. The win was the Buccaneers' first ever over the Lady Camels, who now own a 25-1 record over CSU... Senior forward **KATELYN BASS** paced Campbell with 19 points, one shy of a career high, and 11 rebounds for her fifth double-double of the season. The Wake Forest, N.C. native added three blocks, tying a career-best. **TONISHA BAKER**, a junior guard, who picked up 500th career rebound in the game, posted 15 points and 12 boards. The double-double marked her team-high eighth of the season. The High Point, N.C. native tacked on four assists and three steals. Baker, who also surpassed 1,000 career points this season, is the 13th Lady Camel to make both school lists... Seniors **KATE CLOXTON** and **AMANDA O'NEILL** both played in their 119th career games, second-most in program history... The loss was just Campbell's second of the season when holding its opponent under 60 points (17 games)... Campbell's 18 wins are the program's most overall victories since 2000-01 when the team posted 22. The team also finished with a winning record for the first time since that season. This year is the 20th winning season for Lady Camel head coach **WANDA WATKINS**, who owns 478 career wins, and the 28th overall for the program dating back to 1972-73... The Lady Camels, playing in their first Big South Championship since 1994, are now 12-8 all-time in the conference's tournament (nine tournaments), and 5-3 in quarterfinal rounds.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The team compiled just with fifth winning season in school history and the second under **JULIE GOODENOUGH** with a 17-14 record... It ties the Bucs 2009-10 record as the second most wins in a season in program history... Forward **RACHELLE COWARD** smashed the single-season points record with 559 and tied the school's single-game 3-point mark with nine vs. Liberty on January 9... Coward also set new a single-season record for field goals attempted (459)... **LAKEITHA ALSTON** became the school's 14th all-time 1,000 point scorer vs. Campbell on March 9 and ranks 13th in school history with 1,014 career points... The Bucs recorded their first-ever win over a major program when they defeated Clemson 82-77 on December 4... CSU recorded its first ever-win against Campbell in the Big South Tournament Quarterfinals by a score of 57-53... The win marked their first in the Big South Tournament since the 2001-02 season and got the Bucs their first semifinal appearance since that season... CSU ended the season ranked fourth in the nation in 3-point field goals per game with 9.2 and 34th in scoring offense with 71.2 ppg... Alston ranked 21st in field goal percentage at 52.5 percent while Erin Bratcher ranked 12th in 3-point field goal percentage at 40.4 percent... Coward was 10th in the NCAA with 2.9 3-point field goals per game and 36th in ppg with 18.0.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina fell to High Point in the quarterfinal round of the Big South Tournament, closing its season with a 13-15 overall record and a 6-12 conference mark... Senior **OLIVIA IRICK** capped her career with a 19 point performance to lead a trio of Chanticleers in double digits... Irick connected on three 3-pointers in the quarterfinal to move her into seventh place in the CCU annals with 117 career 3-pointers made... Sophomore **KAYLA COOK** pulled down a career-high 11 rebounds in the quarterfinal matchup... Freshman **SHATIA COLE** earned a place on the All-Freshman team as she finished her rookie campaign averaging 10.5 points and 3.6 boards per game... Senior **TAYLOR EPLEY** was named to the Big South All-Academic team.

GARDNER-WEBB

The Gardner-Webb Runnin' Bulldogs' season was one of rebuilding, as the women's basketball team had eight freshmen and nine newcomers on the roster, which included only six returners from last year's 2011 Big South Championship Team. GWU, which lost their top-five scorers and over 84 percent of their scoring from a year ago, averaged only 50.8 points per game and finished the season at 4-25 overall and 3-15 in conference play. While their 3-15 conference record placed them in a tie with UNC Asheville for the eighth and final spot in the 2012 Advance Auto Parts Big South Women's Basketball Championship Tournament, the Asheville Bulldogs held the tiebreaker which forced the Runnin' Bulldogs out of the tournament. The last time that the Runnin' Bulldogs did not make the postseason conference tournament was back in 2004-05, head coach **RICK REEVES'** first season at GWU, while this season also marks the first time that Gardner-Webb did not play in the Big South Championship game since joining the Big South in 2008. Sophomore center **CATRINA GREEN**, who was named to the College Sports Madness Big South All-Conference Second-Team, led the Runnin' Bulldogs in both scoring and rebounding at 11.2 points and 8.7 rebounds per game. She posted a team-high 48 blocks, which placed her in a tie with **BRITTANY HARMON** (2003-04) for the most blocks in a single-season in GWU's Division I history, while her 128 offensive rebounds ranks as the second most offensive boards by a GWU player in a single season in the Runnin' Bulldogs' Division I history. The starting center for the Runnin' Bulldogs all season long led GWU in scoring in 16 different contests and rebounding in 18 different games, posting 10 double-doubles on the season. Green poured in a career-high 22 points in the loss at Asheville and hauled in a career-high 16 rebounds twice on the year. Senior **BRIANNA DILLARD**, who was named the Big South Co-Scholar Athlete of the Year and earned a spot on the Big South All-Academic Team for the second straight season, led the team with 61 steals on the year, which ranks fourth for the most steals by a single player in a single season in GWU's Division I history. Dillard, who also led the team in assists with 59 on the season, was third on the team with 5.6 rebounds per game and fourth in scoring with 5.9 points per game. Dillard posted a season-high 17 points in the Runnin' Bulldogs' overtime win at Radford and hauled in a career-high 13 rebounds in the loss at Longwood.

HIGH POINT

High Point advanced to the Big South Championship game for third time in team history, falling to Liberty by a score of 81-73. The Panthers picked up wins over Coastal Carolina and Radford to reach the final. Junior **ERIN REYNOLDS** and sophomore **CHEYENNE PARKER** were each named to the All-Tournament team. Reynolds led all scorers in the tournament with 73 points for an average of 24.3 per game. The junior also averaged six assists and four steals per game. Parker averaged a double-double for the three games with 13.7 points and 13.7 rebounds per game and led all players with 12 blocked shots. Prior to the tournament, three HPU players were named to the Big South All-Conference teams as senior **SHAMIA BROWN** was named to the first team and both Reynolds and Parker were named to the second team. Parker also was named the first Big South Defensive Player of the Year in HPU history. High Point moves on to the WNIT where they will play NC State in the first round.

LIBERTY

Liberty won its 14th Big South Championship title in the last 16 seasons on Sunday, defeating High Point by an 81-73 score in the championship game... The Lady Flames will now make their 14th appearance in the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Championship... Seeded No. 16 for the third time in program history but the first since 1998, Liberty will play its first-round game at No. 1 seed Notre Dame Sunday at approximately 2:40 p.m.... If the Lady Flames win, they would play either No. 8 seed California or No. 9 seed Iowa next Tuesday at 7 p.m., with a spot in the Sweet 16 on the line... **EVERY WARLEY** was named MVP of the Big South Championship, after averaging 17.0 ppg and 15.7 rpg during Liberty's three victories... During the tournament, Warley broke her own program single-season rebounding record and enters the NCAA Championship with 371 boards on the year... With Warley limited by foul trouble in the championship game, **DEVON BROWN** stepped up with 24 points and a career-high 14 rebounds, joining Warley on the all-tournament team... Freshman **REAGAN MILLER** added 15 points and eight assists in the title contest, tying her career high for assists in a game and ranking third in Big South Championship title game history... Liberty, which has won seven games in a row and 18 of its last 19 outings, owns a national-best +16.4 rebound margin... If that holds up, it would rank No. 5 in NCAA Division I history and would be the highest since the 1995-96 season, when Louisiana Tech finished at +18.2 and Stephen F. Austin followed at +17.5.

PRESBYTERIAN

PC capped its season with two wins over Coastal Carolina (56-52) and Charleston Southern (77-68), giving the program its most successful season since 2005-06... The Blue Hose ended the season winning six of its last nine games... **DEVIN FOTHERGILL** set a new PC record for most rebounds in a game since PC moved to Division I (2007-08) with 17 against Coastal Carolina, just three days before **MARIAH PIETROWSKI** matched a program D-I record with 28 points against Charleston Southern. The performance marked the most points for a Blue Hose against a Big South opponent since joining the league. Pietrowski achieved the 26 points with a 10-for-21 effort... Senior **KRISTEN STEVENS** hit a three-pointer to end her career with an even 600 points, the fourth-most in PC's Division I history. She will also leave PC with the fifth-most career three-point field goals, tallying 142.

RADFORD

The Highlanders wrapped up their 2011-12 season with a loss in the semifinals to No. 2 High Point. Radford finished the year 16-15, its 27th winning season in program history. **DA'NARIA ERWIN SPENCER** was voted to the all-tournament squad with her 17.0-point average over the two opening games. She became the 30th player in program history to be named to the tournament team. In addition, Erwin Spencer is four points shy of making Radford's career Top-10 in points and already joined the list in steals and assists earlier this year. **AYANA AVERY** averaged 16 points per game coming off the bench, including an 8-of-20 mark from downtown. **ASHLEY BUCKHANNON** also hit the double figure mark in points in both games with 11 against Winthrop and 16 against High Point. **VICTORIA HAMILTON** wrapped up a nice year on the glass, by averaging 9.5 rebounds in the tournament. The bench came through, outscoring Winthrop 19-0 and 25-7 against High Point.

UNC ASHEVILLE

Freshman guard **SHONESE JONES** was named the 2011-12 Big South Conference's Freshman of the Year on Thursday evening, becoming the sixth Bulldog to earn the honor, and the first since **KYLA JONES** in 2007. Jones, a guard from Etowah, N.C., was tabbed the Big South's Freshman of the Week four times during the year and was selected as the League's Player of the Week on Dec. 20. She has recorded nine games with at least 20 points and has scored 30-or-more points on two occasions. She finished with at least 20 points in three straight games on the year from Dec. 17-21. She also posted 11 rebounds against Coastal Carolina on Jan. 7. Jones has led her squad in scoring 14 times during the year and is the League's top-rated freshman scorer with 15.4 points per game. She is also the first freshman to lead the Bulldogs in scoring since Kristal Hood in the 2002-03 season. Senior guard **LINDSEY THOMPSON** reached the 1,000-point plateau against Winthrop on Feb. 13, reaching the mark on a 3-pointer in the first half. She is the 15th player in school history to hit the mark and is the third in two years. Kendall Shepard and Lindsey Montgomery reach 1,000 career points last season. Thompson now sits at 1,080 for her career. Both Jones and **LEAH WORMACK** were named to the Big South's All-Freshman squad this year. Jones was named the Freshman of the Week four times this year with Wormack earning the honor on three occasions. Junior forward Kelli Riles is third in the Big South and is ninth in the nation in rebounds per game, averaging 10.7 per contest. The Bulldogs set the school record for 3-pointers in a game against Winthrop on Feb. 13, connecting on 14 treys in the game. Junior guard **GRACE BLAYLOCK** set the UNC Asheville record for 3-pointers in a game with seven against Winthrop on Jan. 14, 2012. Blaylock connected on 7-of-14 from behind the arc. She posted a career-high 23 points in the process. The previous record was six, held by four different players. **KELLI RILES** collected her 700th career rebound this season. She now has 752 rebounds, which ranks sixth all time at UNC Asheville, and is the seventh player in school history to grab more than 700 rebounds. Thompson set the UNC Asheville record for career 3-pointers against George Mason on 11/27. She now has 203 for her career, breaking the record of Brittany Hendley, who played for the Bulldogs from 2003-07. Asheville did not win on the road this year.

WINTHROP

Winthrop's season ended on a sour note with a first round loss in the conference tournament to Radford. It was just the second time in seven seasons that Winthrop lost in the first round. Despite the first round upset, this season has been anything but a disappointment as the Eagles either broke or tied 38 records between school and Big South... The range of record broken among the coach, individuals and team. Coach Stollings 18 wins were the most by a first-year coach at Winthrop and she led the team to a school-best 12 league wins. **DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN** broke the school record for points in a season and became the first player to 1,000 points before her junior season in Winthrop history. **DIANA CHOIBEKOVA** broke the school and Big South single-season record for threes. McClanahan finished the season with a school record 21.1 points per game average. Her 224 assists per game average is also a school/Big South record... Winthrop's 18 victories in a season were tied for the third most in school history and the second most since becoming an NCAA Division I member... **TAQUOIA HAMMICK** grabbed a career-high 19 rebounds in her final game as an Eagle. In her seven career games at the Millis Center, Hammick hauled in 10 or more rebounds in six games. The 19 rebounds were one shy of the school record and the second time a Winthrop player reached 19 this season (**TAYLOR CALVERT** at UNC Asheville broke the Winthrop freshman record with 19 rebounds).

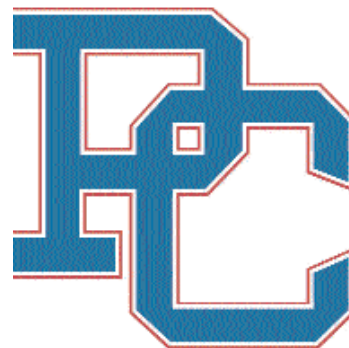
